- 16 Okay, my friends! It's time for your brain massage.
- 17 [TRUTH]
- 18 Trump gives NATO a *trumpin'* — time to "pay your fair share" — a conservative twist on
- 19 "pay to play"? It looked to me like the leaders of NATO were in agreement. This while
- 20 Trump is sending warning messages to Iran and Russia — what does this mean?
- 21 Every American, who is one, watching the clip of President Trump trumpin' the leaders of
- 22 23 NATO telling them it's high time NATO members paid their membership dues would
- have to cheer but when the Americans, who really aren't, see this they cry in despair of
- 24 25 their mighty Quinn but what they don't get is that Trump is our Quinn. (Hmm, that
- might require the application of cultural hermeneutics —hehe).
- 26 Okay, I'll indulge you! Remember Dylan's song, Quinn The Eskimo? No? Right! Well,
- <del>2</del><del>7</del> you've heard of Bob Dylan. Most of you! Come on, I just mentioned him, so! The ever
- 28 enigmatical Dylan wrote a happy little tune with the chorus "When Quinn the Eskimo 29 gets here, everybody's gonna jump for joy" "all the pigeons gonna run to him" and
- 30 "everybody's gonna wanna doze" — 'cause "you'll not see nothing like the mighty Quinn."
- 31 (haha — without some context it sounds like jibberish.)
- 32 Anthony Quinn was a famous actor who was in some hit films in the fifties through the
- 33 1990s and died in 2001. He starred in a 1960s film titled The Savage Innocents — and the
- 34 plot of this story is based on the clash of two cultures. Quinn, the Eskimo in the story,

receives a Priest as a guest in his home. The culture of the Inuit, according to this movie, was to offer guests food and the pleasure of his wife's company. The priest refused, and enraged by the insult, the Eskimo kills the priest. So, here come the police to investigate, and to arrest *Quinn the Eskimo* who is cast as the hero in this story of the clash of cultures old and new.

So, it's like the culture war in which we are engaged today. In one version, Quinn represents the hedonistic culture of paganism, the "way of the world," the morals and values of the current progressive snobs — and Trump represents the priest who comes into their home and disses their cultural values so they want to kill him; but this is where the story departs from that conceived by Swiss novelist Hans Rusch (R-00-SH). David Adelman is keying in on Trump's assessment of the NATO Summit (by the way, NATO stands for the NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION), so Trump was enthusiastic about the response he got from NATO members when he challenged them to step up to their responsibilities to the mutual defense treaty. The agreement includes a commitment to contribute 2% of the countries GDP to national defense. But here is the key point.

I watched the clip where Trump is explaining to the NATO leaders the need for each country to fulfill their obligations under the terms of the treaty. I watched as the members, in the main, nodded in agreement. Germany, which comes short of their obligation, paying only 1.19% of GPD for defense, also has committed fuel resources to Russia that compromises the interests of NATO, and Trump did not hesitate to bring that out and put it on the table. Merkel squirmed a little; but what can she say? It's OBVIOUSLY TRUE. So Trump is *trumpin'* NATO.

Okay, so Trump is enthusiastic about the results of the meeting, and in typical Trump fashion, he exults emotionally and uses hyperbole to express his enthusiasm: saying the members of NATO had agreed to increase their defense spending to levels they had never thought before.

The French President released a statement in which he said France "reaffirms its commitment to 2% in 2024. That is all." So Adelman says this is a "direct and blatant contradiction of the American President by a leader who was once his best friend in Europe." I don't doubt he intended to reassure his country that he did not make any commitment beyond what had already been stipulated, and I'm also sure he did not get his nose bent over Trump's statement. I don't think he is that petty. But, well, the French!

Okay, so the President of France admits France is a welcher —! But, to be fair, France does contribute 1.78%, the Turks 1.56, Germany 1.19, Italy 1.1 and Canada .99 — and remember this is percentage of GDP so we are talking about a significant welching scam going down on NATO.

But here's the thing — that's all Trump asked for, and it's obvious that he is aware of the French agreement made earlier to bring their contribution up to expected levels by 2024, and I think he's good with that; it's also obvious that it is not likely Trump knows what each of the members have "ever thought of" — but the fact is several of the members of NATO are not keeping their obligations according to the terms of the treaty — and that this has been going on for DECADES — and that no one has had the guts to say or do anything about it — until TRUMP!.

- 120 with almost all of it — it simply depends on what perspective you have — hey, I don't
- 121 want to be one of those ridiculous American idiots who can't tell difference between a
- 122 boy and a girl, who thinks the government is the answer to all problems, and that mothers
- 123 and their doctors conspiring to kill her baby in the womb is something Jesus would
- 124 sometimes approve of. I don't want to be an American Idiot either; I don't want to be one
- 125 of those Americans who think the Socialism that has ruined your country, and every other
- 126 country where it has been tried, would be a good thing for us; I don't want to be an
- 127 American Idiot that thinks it's just fine for American taxpayers to fund the Anti-American
- 128 UN and the WELCHERS on NATO — and just, you know, shut up, sit down, and pay up
- 129 America! So, may I encourage you to quit being a BRITISH IDIOT — and wake up
- 130 before your Island comes under the control of some Mullah in Iran.
- 131 Okay, so, sometimes Trump *overspeaks*. Not likely he knows what any or all of the
- 132 133 members of NATO "ever thought" — but think about it. How often do you think
- Germany's leaders have talked together about getting their defense spending in line with
- 134 the treaty they signed with NATO. Or Turkey, or ... you see what I mean. It's not an
- 135 unreasonable statement. If anyone takes this to mean he expected any of the members to
- 136 pay more than the 2% required by the treaty — then they are the idiots! If someone's
- 137 fragile ego has been dented by Trump's candor, what a bunch whiney wimps! I would
- 138 much prefer a President who *overspeaks* to the ones before him who SAID NOTHING,
- 139 who laid Americans at the feet of these other nations to wipe their feet on US. Done with
- 140 that!
- 141 Bible THUMP ALERT: The Bible promises that the nation whose God is the LORD
- 142 would be among the nations that would be "the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be
- 143 above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments
- 144 of the LORD thy God" Deuteronomy 28:13
- 145 Okay, that's segment one. Hold on through the break. I'll be right back.
- 146 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,
- 147 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church
- 148 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
- 149 liberty.
- 150 Update on the Russian collusion investigation in wake of the Strzok hearing. Strzok is the
- 151 FBI agent that "fixed" the Comey statement on his disposition regarding the Hillary
- 152 "matter" — he is the subject of an inquiry regarding the influence of political bias in the
- 153 FBI using their relative positions of responsibility to engage in a conspiracy to influence
- 154 an election; and, that failing, to execute a coup against the Presidency — I hope you
- 155 listened, because THAT's WHAT THIS IS ABOUT.
- 156 So a Fox News *Commentatorette* rants about Louis Gohmert trying to give religion to
- 157 Strzok — I watched the exchange between Gohmert and Strzok, and it was a classic
- 158 example of a clash of opposite cultures, represented by the left and the right. Gohmert
- 159 chastises Strzok for bringing shame upon the FBI and himself, and accuses him of lying
- 160 — and of course Strzok sits there with his smug smirk on his weasel face — and Gohmert

- nails him; I wonder how many times you looked into the face of your wife and lied about
- 162 your affair with what's her name! I don't, oh yeah, Page ouch! What impact it had
- on Strzok, I don't know; but you should have heard the floor explode with outrage and
- now this Fox News Commentatorette (hah) snidely criticizes Gohmert for trying to give
- Strzok religion well, that's what he needs. Gohmert is certainly representative of an
- older set of values and the reaction of the *Demoncrats* was a perfect illustration of the
- ongoing culture crash that is taking place in America right now.
- Gohmert ran headlong and at full steam into the wall surrounding the newer value system
- that has been built upon the foundation our Founders and that noise you heard from
- the left and from the "daughters of Canaan" was the CRASHING OF CULTURES —
- 171 Issa made Strzok read his emails. I think you have read them. Peter Strzok does not
- simply disagree with Trump's political views; his personal animus is venomous. He
- mentioned *impeachment* I think two or three times; he promised that he would do all he
- 174 could to stop Trump. And all of this was not done on his personal phone. He used his FBI
- issued official phone in this way. A case should be made that he was acting in his official
- capacity because if he was not, he should have used his personal phone: very
- 177 unprofessional to say the least.
- 178 Why are the emails and text messages pertinent? Of course government employees have
- personal opinions about politics. It was unprofessional for him to use his FBI cell and
- computer to communicate his personal views; but hey, federal employees do not check
- their first amendment rights at the door when they take a federal job. That being said,
- however, the reason these texts and emails are pertinent is that they go to the question of
- his state of mind while HE WAS DOING OTHER THINGS.
- 184 Changing the language of Comey's statement in which he described Hillary's behavior as
- 185 "grossly negligent" to "extremely careless." "Gross negligence" meets a legal threshold —
- 186 it's prosecutable; extreme carelessness would be merely questionable. Anyone knowing
- the facts would have to agree her behavior was GROSSLY NEGLIGENT. The only reason
- to change this wording would be to PROTECT HILLARY.
- 189 Strzok is also the guy who was given the now infamous Dossier he is the one who
- carried the ball on this Russian Collusion scam investigation he was their point man.
- Now we know the Dossier was phony. Now we know it was Hillary's opposition research
- firm, Fusion GPS, that paid to have this phony document created.
- 193 Therefore, the fact that Strzok failed to vet the document as would normally have been
- done, raises questions as to his intent; and the emails and texts speak to his state of mind.
- But wait, I'm not done.
- 196 New revelations have surfaced. The FBI has used stonewalling, and delaying tactics, I
- mean they have circled the wagons to keep certain key information from Congress one
- of the things we want to know is what, exactly, triggered the investigation, and second,
- what is the information trail of the now debunked so called Trump Dossier?

- It has come out that the Russian originated document came to the attention of the British before it got into American hands. As you know, Steele, the skunk that Fusion GPS hired
- to get dirt on Trump, and so created it was a former British spy. Now we know that
- someone in Britain contacted Trump's campaign about allegations of Trump-Russia
- collusion, and contacted the FBI. This was in the Spring of 2016, about a month or so
- before the investigation was launched in July. The British contact is something the FBI,
- under Sessions but CONTROLLED ENTIRELY BY OBAMA OPERATIVES MUELLER
- AND SKUNK Strzok, is hiding from Congress and the American people.
- 208 We have learned that at this time Strzok went to London and met with these "sources." It's
- beginning to look like he was read-in to a conspiracy to insure Hillary's election.
- According to some emails between Strzok and Page, they discussed evidence that the
- White House is running this"? That would be the Obama White House.
- It's getting real tense folks. This is a ticking time bomb that is counting down to a major
- blow up in Washington.
- The Strzok hearing, we are told, went badly for both sides. You know, if it's close or a tie
- 215 Progressives claim overwhelming victory. If they clearly lose then it's very close,
- 216 both sides lost.
- 217 I think the conservatives in Congress are smart enough to know they are winning. The
- chairman at one point said he would have Strzok brought back to face charges of
- 219 contempt. It did not go well for smirky-Strzok. Strzok's girlfriend warned him once that
- 220 they could not withstand the pressure for too long and I think I saw the Strzok smirk
- begin to break down; they are going to collapse this thing must be EXPOSED.
- His self-righteous rant about the dignity of the FBI being hurt by the questioning of his
- actions was disgusting coming out of the foul deceiving lying weasel mouth of that
- 224 corrupt traitor.
- But, of course, he thinks what he is doing was in service to the "country that he loves." He
- knew the Dossier was faked; he was in collusion with some intelligence operatives from
- Russia and someone in Britain to conspire against an American election and an American
- 228 President. But he thinks it was justified because he was in the right! The problem today is
- that there is no longer a shared set of values in America those who hate America as
- founded consider themselves American patriots as much as true America AS FOUNDED
- patriots believe they are true patriots.
- Both sides believe theirs is the side of "GOOD," and the other is the side of "EVIL." One of
- the reasons people like Obama, et al, can do what they do and lie with such *conviction* is
- 234 that they believe in lying for the truth. Their *truth* is what they believe in; and if it requires
- 235 lying to defend it, so be it.
- 236 Lincoln said, RIGHT MAKES FIGHT and it's true, in great measure. It steels resolve,
- strengthens commitment, and nothing has greater sway upon a man than the firm belief
- that he is RIGHT.

- Since we have no, or very little remaining, commonality in morals, and even ethics, and
- values, Waters can claim GOD IS ON OUR SIDE while we would hear that in amazement
- 241 how could God be on the side of homosexual marriage, or baby murder? I could
- elaborate extensively on this and bring out the difference in viewpoints over how rightly
- to address poverty, immigration, and so on. We don't have a shared set of values.
- But here is the point both sides are convinced they are RIGHT and the other side is
- 245 wrong.
- When someone is wrongly attacking you, that's one thing. The thief might know that he is
- a thief, and trying to steal from you. But what if that same thief has come to believe that
- 248 what you have actually is rightfully his, that he is morally righteous to take what you have
- because he believes you procured it either immorally or unfairly.
- Now he is no longer a thief; in his mind he is serving justice; his actions are believed by
- him to be righteous.
- 252 That's where we are headed: a total collision between two entirely opposite cultures —
- 253 opposing belief systems.
- A tweet from someone I don't know, his name is Norm MacDonald, and I will assume he
- originated the thought, and it goes like this: "The idiot sees the world as Good vs Evil.
- 256 The cynic sees the world as Evil vs Evil. The truth that no one seems able to see is that
- 257 the world is, and always has been, a battle of Good vs. Good."
- He is attempting in a clever way to make the point I just offered above both sides
- believe they are on the side of good, even though the contrast could not be more
- 260 complete.
- However, what it seems Mr. MacDonald fails to see is that his formula literally erases the
- 262 concept of evil.
- He contrasts *good verses evil* (indicating a recognition of both good and evil), *evil versus*
- 264 evil (suggesting there is no good, only evil on both sides of a conflict), and good versus
- 265 good (and here is the problem, in this scenario he supposes both sides are good—there is
- no evil). Or perhaps he considers these are artificial concepts that have no universal but
- only personal meaning. This describes our battle today.
- Think about it. First question that always comes up in this debate: is there such a thing as
- evil. And Hitler always comes first to mind. He believed he was doing the world a favor
- by getting rid of the Jews—in his view this was "good." However, in no sane universe
- would it be considered a good thing to murder an entire race of people for no other
- reason than their race. The conflict with Hitler was not Good versus Good.
- On an existential level it is clear that evil does exist (Jeffery Dahlmer, and we could go on
- and on). And yet, the men and women fighting against this evil, whether as soldiers in
- 275 WWII or the police officers tracking Dahlmer, were not altogether good they were not
- perfect, or sinless. Many imperfect people fought on the side of the GOOD against the
- side that was EVIL. (A better analogy of this might be the Civil War here in America.

- Robert E. Lee was a good man on the wrong side of that conflict.) And this leads us to the  $\frac{278}{270}$
- 279 next proposition:
- The cynic says it's a battle between evil versus evil. Ill motivations may be found in the
- hearts of combatants on either side of any disagreement or conflict. So the cynic throws
- his hands up and says well, all conflicts are ultimately evil versus evil.
- This person would at least be partially correct.
- But to say every conflict is a battle between good versus good is the most illogical of the
- three propositions, and maybe the most dangerous.
- 286 It justifies both sides in every conflict it reduces all conflict to a mere pragmatic
- formula based on opposing rationalizations. Going back to our Mighty Quinn analogy
- presented earlier, this view says that Quinn killing the priest, because the priest dissed his
- hospitality, was acting in GOODNESS as understood in his culture; and the priest, who
- refused the Inuit's hospitality on the ground of his moral restrictions against taking
- another man's wife, was also acting in GOODNESS as understood in his culture so it
- was a battle between Good vs. Good but this is not true.
- But by what do we know that one is GOOD and the other EVIL?
- GOOD and EVIL are categories that stand apart from the character of the players or the
- warriors engaged in the conflict. To make this simple:
- 296 If an immoral man, by whatever standards of morals you might subscribe too, saves a
- woman from drowning, we would agree that he served GOOD even if he is not himself
- 298 good. So the soldier fighting a battle on the side of GOOD is battling for GOOD even if
- he is not particularly good.
- And the same thing happens in reverse a good man whose morals conform to what
- you would consider righteous or moral can find himself sometimes in a situation where
- he is fighting FOR THE SIDE THAT IS EVIL. You know, for example all those very fine
- upstanding citizens who voted for Obama. (haha—Okay, okay, take the Civil War as an
- example. Again, Robert E. Lee was a good an on the WRONG SIDE OF THAT
- 305 CONFLICT.)
- Now, having clarified that, the next question is whether or not there are any absolute
- criteria by which we may identify GOOD and EVIL?
- 308 Yes. Our Creator established this in the beginning and I'll preach about it this coming
- 309 Sunday night.
- 310 But our Creator made the rules and established the distinctions.
- 311 By His criteria we can readily declare certain things evil and certain things good. God
- warned us the day would come when they will call good evil, and evil good: Isaiah 5:20
- 313 "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light
- for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!"

- 315 The culture war in this country is an argument over what is good and evil. Certain parties
- 316 have coalesced around a certain set of values that derive from beliefs that are in
- 317 opposition to the values that derive from the beliefs expressed in the BIBLE.
- 318 And we are at a strange place. This country was founded upon the Bible, so both sides are
- 319 320 claiming the Bible as their source of authority. Jimmy Carter said he believes Jesus
- would approve of some abortions and that he would accept same sex marriage. He is
- 321 supposed to be a Christian, so we suppose the Bible shapes or at least influences his
- 322 moral viewpoint. Maxine Waters recently invoked the Bible, so did Chuck Schumer —
- 323 she screeched that God is on "THEIR SIDE." So the argument has come full circle back
- 324 to the Bible and how we understand our CHRISTIAN HERITAGE.
- 325 I've run out of time, and I would really like to have had the time to fine-tune these
- 326 thoughts — sorry! Gotta go!
- 327 Hey, come on out to the Lighthouse this Sunday. I'm preaching on The Chronicles of
- 328 Jacob: Lessons Learned In The House Laban. Believe me the title does not do it justice.
- 329 We are digging out of these great Scripture stories insights that are truly mind blowing
- 330 but more importantly, faith building.
- 331 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me know if you see them.
- 332 It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE ON and you will ride like Revere and spread
- 333 the warning, (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say LIGHTS
- 334 OFF — which means you reject what I'm saying and disagree strongly with me. So, what
- 335 will it be today, lights on, or lights off?
