23 Get ready for Trump to be called the Antichrist — he is preparing to reveal his plan for
24 peace in the Middle East.
25 Trump to talk with Iran's Ayatollah? Assures Israel it does not signal a change in US
26 policy.
27 And, oh man, you've got to be kidding me! Obama visits Kenya this past July and tells a
28 crowd in Kogelo: "Three years ago, I visited Kenya as the first sitting American president
29 to come from Kenya." You've got to be kidding me.
30 Okay folks, it's time for your Brain Massage.
31 [TRUTH]
32 I understand Paul Packer is the Trump appointee for the U.S. Commission for the
33 Preservation of America's Heritage Abroad —
34 Seems to me we need someone to protect it here — especially in our schools. DWEMs
35 are ridiculed and dismissed as passe' by so many teachers in public schools today. What's
36 a DWEM? Dead White European Men — you know, the type New York Times new
37 Tech editor #CancelWhitePeople sees reflected in all white people today. But more on
38 that later. DWEMs — dead white European men — that's the new politically correct way
39 to speak of our Founders.
40 TexasScorecard contributor Bill Ames' article "Public Schools Are Not Teaching
41 America's Heritage"¹ explains the reason a recent Pew Research study finds today's
42 *millennials* are "the only American demographic group that favors socialism over
43 capitalism" is that Public School Districts are not teaching American Heritage to the
44 students.
45 In the words of Townhall columnist, Jonah Goldberg, "Schools have been force-feeding
46 left-wing propaganda to kids like it was feed for geese in a foie gras (fwah 'grah)
47 factory."² (*Foie gras is the liver of a factory-fattened goose for food.*) How can this be?
48 In 2010, the Texas State Board of Education adopted revised standards for U.S. history
49 and government courses. In those standards a focus on patriotism was mandated, and the
50 schools were instructed to emphasize "America's heritage: the Founding Fathers, the
51 Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and American exceptionalism."³ So, what
52 went wrong?
53 Many of the schools adopted something called CSCOPE, a curriculum that "portrays
54 America in a negative light, depicting, as one example, the Boston Tea Party as
55 terrorism."⁴ Others developed their own curriculum but ignored the standards mandated
56 by Texas law. Ames, the writer of this article for TexasScoreCard, sat on the committee

57 for curriculum development in his District, and had to fight tooth and claw to get the
58 curriculum developers to obey State law. He reports: "I was able to negotiate the required
59 items into the ultimate ... curriculum. It took nearly a year of contentious meetings with
60 reluctant curriculum developers, and escalation to the superintendent, to accomplish
61 this."⁵

62 His conclusion: "Bottom line, there is no formal oversight of public school curriculum
63 development at the district level. Districts are free [to] teach their own versions of U.S.
64 history, based upon the ideology of the school board, superintendents, curriculum
65 developers, administrators and teachers."⁶

66 So, we must go deeper in our analysis to get to the root of this problem. Why are there so
67 many God hating, America despising people running our schools? How do these people
68 get on our school boards? Why are those who create curriculum for our schools bent on
69 undermining America as founded, and pushing socialist propaganda down the throats of
70 our children? How did the communists take over our schools?

71 The roots of our liberties extend deep into our Christian heritage as a nation. (I preached
72 a series titled *The Bible And The Bill Of Rights* in six messages. You can find the series
73 online at santamarialighthouse.org. Go to the RESOURCES menu and scroll down to
74 find *The Bible And The Bill Of Rights*. This series documents the connection between
75 the Bill of Rights and the Bible.)

76 Here is the point—we have separated American ideals of freedom and liberty from the
77 soil in which these ideals grew. Secularists have attempted to replant the tree of liberty in
78 the soil of humanism, and that soil kills the fruit of liberty. In that soil, the only thing that
79 will grow is the fruit of tyranny in its many forms, including socialism — where the
80 collective neutralizes all individuality of thought and belief and brings production and the
81 means of it under the control of an elite band of corrupt thugs who sit astride the beast
82 that is the masses, and rules them like they are nothing more than the evolved animals
83 they perceive them to be.

84 How did this get started? Here is a shocking look at the beginning phase of this effort to
85 separate America from the King James Bible.

86 I have a copy of an 1859 book by George B. Cheever, D.D. from the Harvard University
87 Library of the Graduate School of Education, titled *RIGHT OF THE BIBLE IN OUR*
88 *PUBLIC SCHOOLS*. In the preface, we read:

89 "The argument in these pages was constructed with special reference to some labored and
90 plausible endeavors to commend to the Christian community the banishment of the Bible
91 and religious instruction from our Common Schools. These endeavors are made with
92 reference to the demands of a portion of the leaders of a particular sect, and for a
93 temporary purpose; it is the priests of Romanism, and not the common people, nor their
94 children, who would break up our common school system for sectarian purposes, and
95 shut out the light and influence of the Word of God."⁷

96 He concluded his preface by quoting Daniel Webster: "there is nothing that we look for
97 with more certainty, that this general principle, THAT CHRISTIANITY IS PART OF
98 THE LAW OF THE LAND."⁸

99 Men like Cheever and Webster were among the "first responders" to the assault of the fire
100 whirl of humanism against America as founded. Interestingly, the writer of the book I
101 quoted here was a widely popular proponent of the death penalty and he was fighting the
102 fire whirl of humanist thought that began burning through our laws destroying the
103 foundations of justice in this country. The Pope has recently come out — he has declared
104 the Vatican in opposition to capital punishment for any reason. Another step to the left
105 for the Catholic Church.⁹

106 But, back to the point. Packer has been appointed by President Trump to protect
107 American heritage abroad, and Mr. Packer is calling on Zuckerberg to remove Holocaust
108 deniers from the Facebook platform. He believes that Facebook allowing this to be
109 promoted on their platform sends the wrong message to the world about America's
110 heritage — America, after all, did make a very significant payment in the blood of our
111 own to free the world from Hitler and his death camps. So ...

112 Like me, and probably everyone listening to me right now, Paul Packer despises
113 Holocaust deniers; and he is concerned about social media being used to re-write the
114 history of that atrocity, believing, as he has said, the next generation will have no
115 defenders of the victims of Hitler's devilish plot.

116 But, here is the problem. Must we sacrifice free speech to protect the truth? Is it true that
117 unless we abridge free speech, the truth will die?

118 NO!

119 That's the most ridiculous argument I've ever heard — very close to pass another gun law
120 and guns will stop killing people.

121 So, what's a *Zuckerberg* to do? The conservatives are telling Zuckerberg, hey, on the
122 principle of FREE SPEECH we insist you quit messing with conservative speech you
123 don't like. Then we turn around and demand Facebook curtail the free speech of liar-
124 deniers of the holocaust.

125 Well, here is the thing! Opinions, perspectives, that's one thing. But *fake news* is another.
126 Opinions and perspectives on truth is one thing, but reporting lies is not the same thing as
127 declaring an opinion, right? Public lying about others is no one's *right*. But declaring
128 one's personal opinion about others and about anything else is everyone's right. So, unless
129 we are talking about clearly established facts that are being denied we need to leave it
130 alone, right? But even that is tricky. Some are of the opinion that evolution is a fact —
131 but really it's an unsupportable opinion. Some are of the opinion that climate change is a
132 fact — but, again, this is debatable.

133 However, the documentation, thanks to Ike, by the way, the documentation of the
134 holocaust is incontrovertible. To deny it happened is to lie. Someone cannot have an

135 honest opinion that the holocaust never happened. That's like saying someone can have
 136 an honest opinion that people do not need to breathe to live. On the other hand, denying
 137 to someone the "right" to deny obvious truth and tell obvious lies only opens the door to
 138 controlled speech.

139 We need to be very careful of all those who tout the abuse of the right to bear arms as the
 140 reason to deny the right to bear arms; and we must beware the insidious devils that tout
 141 the abuse of free speech as the reason we must deny free speech. Gun control laws have
 142 incrementally abridged our fundamental right to self defense — and speech control laws,
 143 like AB 2943, begin the incremental encroachment upon our free speech.

144 Truth is never the casualty of free speech. But it is always the casualty of censorship.
 145 Defeat Holocaust deniers with Holocaust truth. Stop AB-2943 — it's a "speech control
 146 law" and it's deadly to liberty.

147 Hold on through the break, I'll be right back.

148 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,
 149 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church
 150 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
 151 liberty.

152 Has social media become the new public square where lynching was used to rid ourselves
 153 of society's undesirables — today called the *politically incorrect*?

154 New York Times hired a racist! Sarah Jeong, an American of Asian descent, hailed by all
 155 as an outstanding tech writer — so, New York Times added her to their editorial board.
 156 Turns out she posted some racist Tweets a while back, lately purged, by the way, but we
 157 have some screen-shot copies of her tweets; and it turns out she has expressed very racist
 158 views. The Times has defended her, and has thus far refused to fire her.

159 Here is a sampling of her racist comments. Under the hashtag #CancelWhitePeople,
 160 @sarahjeong wrote "I was equating Trump to Hitler before it was cool." And, "I open my
 161 mouth to politely greet a Republican, but nothing but an unending cascade of vomit flows
 162 from my face." (Well, thanks for that image forever imprinted on my mind in connection
 163 with this picture of you, Sarah.)

164 Then she reposted this juicy tweet: "White people have stopped breeding. You'll all go
 165 extinct soon. This was my plan all along. (followed by a devil emogee)."

166 And then, my personal favorite: "Oh man it's kind of sick how much joy I get out of being
 167 cruel to old white men."¹⁰ The one that wins the prize for most revealing of a filthy heart?
 168 "dumb-a s s f***ing white people"

169 Okay. So, why did the Times fire Quinn Norton when inflammatory statements that she
 170 made on social media were discovered? Here are a few samples:

171 "I am a friend of @rabite's. I can't believe it took a picture of a swastika for y'all to notice
 172 his whole white pride trip. He's not subtle."

173 When she was taken to task for having such friendships, she Tweeted:

174 "i have been friends with various neo-nazis in my time, yes. i have never agreed with
175 them, and i've been clear on that."

176 As for her homophobic comments, here is the only sample I can find:

177 "I keep forgetting then getting surprised when "fag" and "tard" mean something other
178 than person from IRC."

179 She was criticized for holding on to a friendship with an anti-Semitic activist who hides
180 his real identify behind the pseudonym weev. She responded:

181 "For those of you honestly concerned. I don't support weev, that's not given in how I
182 define friendship. I believe white folks should engage with the racists in their life:

184 and I believe all people are redeemable, and "all people" is all people."

185 So, the gist of it is this, she used the word *fag* in quotations, which suggests the idea was
186 *so-called fag*, she used the expression "tard" which is an offensive derogation of retarded
187 persons. She explained that this was only in the context of 4CHAN, which is a chat room
188 where the conversation is very, shall we say, relaxed, personal, with an assumed privacy
189 and anonymity that borders on stupid!

190 No excuse for any of this — even her philosophy about *friendships* is wrong headed.
191 Who does not know you are known by the company you keep, and "how can two walk
192 together except they be agreed," and while I totally get the idea of reaching out, and that
193 even the worst among us is redeemable — anyway, the point is this. Have you, did the
194 Times, ever take the *time* to listen to Norton's explanation for her Tweets?

195 They did take the time to listen to Sarah's explanation. What was it? Her explanation was
196 that in context, her tweets were tongue in cheek, hyperbole, word-banter with friends,
197 who, including the white among them, all testify to her coolness with everyone.

198 Here is my bottom line. Anyone so foolish as to drop that sort of heart excrement on the
199 public streets of the Internet is not someone I would want to trust the reputation of my
200 company to. Simple as that! I would not have either of these girls take a seat in my
201 organization, unless it was in the pew where I could hope to inculcate some wisdom into
202 their silly heads.

203 But there is another story underneath this. True, it is clear that the New York Times is far
204 more concerned about criticisms against them that come from the left than they are about
205 those that come from the right. (Although, no one I know would attempt to defend either
206 of them.) A white racist — *no way! You're gone!* A politically correct racist — *well, of
207 course we can understand how you might make those sorts of comments in certain contexts.*
208 But there is something else, too, that is even more concerning.

209 The social media environment is one where Fire Whirls are easily generated and rampage
210 across the Internet burning down reputations and destroying lives. It's like watching hell
211 open its maw in a devouring rage across the Internet. An intense heat of human passion
212 rises suddenly up in the Internet world, and then others are drawn in quickly, who blow

213 their own hot air into it, making it swirl, and it swirls out of control into a reputation-
214 melting blaze.

215 So, we have fire whirls of two kinds today, actually, of three kinds. Those that are ravaging
216 our friends in Redding — our prayers are with you all. Those that come from the hot air
217 blown into our schools, and our public debate about gun control and speech control —
218 burning down the supports for our liberties. And then the sort that rises up in social
219 media — and we need to beware these Fire Whirls.

220 Okay, I need to move toward a close here. Get ready for Trump to be called the Antichrist
221 — he is getting ready to broker a peace deal in the Middle East.

222 As for Russian collusion—the latest is that Trump has revived the second fleet,
223 commissioned to patrol the seas tracking Russian subs. Obama decommissioned that
224 fleet, tried to turn it into the GREEN FLEET — he did that arguing that Russia is no
225 longer a threat. Do you remember Obama's first response to allegations that Russia was
226 interfering with our elections? You don't. Google it! He laughed it off. He said, *that's old*
227 *news*. When did it become the obsessive concern of Democrats? When they found
228 themselves in need of an excuse for Hillary losing to Trump; and what that meant, now
229 they have to find a way to keep Americans from looking at their own collusion with
230 Russia.

231 And, oh that bit about Obama visiting Kenya this past July and telling a crowd in Kogelo:
232 "Three years ago, I visited Kenya as the first sitting American president to come from
233 Kenya"? Obama was asked about it and declined to answer, so his friends in the MSM
234 have, once again, come to the rescue. Obama was simply saying that his roots are in
235 Kenya, not that he was born there.

236 Well, one thing we know for certain about Obama, he was not an American President —
237 he was the world's President. Remember that? Thank God we have an American
238 President right now.

239 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me know if you see them.
240 It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE ON and you will ride like Revere and spread
241 the warning, (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say LIGHTS
242 OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and disagree strongly with me. So, what
243 will it be today, lights on, or lights off?
