1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in
2 Santa Maria, CA—and your brain masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

4 Rameriz publishes some great political cartoons — lately, I found one depicting Hillary
5 wearing a T that says, "Me-*Two face*." She think her husband admitting doing the
6 Lewdinsky in the Oval Office is okay, but Kavanaugh being accused of sexual misconduct
7 when he was 17 years old and in High School is cause to tar and feather him — All the
8 women who accused Clinton of groping them, even of rape, are not to be believed —
9 remember, drag a 100 bill through a trailer park — but let a flaming liberal make
10 unfounded and contradicted accusations against Kavanaugh and you must support rape
11 if you question her testimony —

12 The only thing harder than getting Obama to release his Birth Certificate was getting
13 Warren to submit to a DNA test to prove her claim to be Cherokee. But, she did it!
14 Results? She is — 1/1024th Cherokee. I'm probably more Cherokee than she is. My
15 grandmother was half Cherokee — I've never made any kind of thing out of it.

16 But this sort of thing is important in the Democrat world — because you get Political
17 Correctness points for something like this. You get one point for being dedicated to the
18 left's ideology, another for being a woman, another for being Native American, another
19 for being LGBT — and so on. The higher level of PC points you have the more latitude
20 you are given for things like making stupid and unfounded statements, like being
21 concerned if we send troops to Guam, because it's such a small Island, we might cause it
22 to capsize — Hank Johnson, Democrat, or the many inane things that have tripped off the
23 tongue of Biden, or the moronic things said by Pelosi—"we have to pass it to find out
24 what is in it," or when other lefties show their woeful ignorance of guns — or when Al
25 Gore claimed he "took the initiative to create the Internet," or when first stepped into
26 Monticello, pointed to busts of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson and Lafayette and
27 asked, "who are these people?" But if a conservative misspells Tomato we never hear the
28 end of it. Oh, that was Potato, sorry. I must flagellate myself for that error, because I don't
29 have the PC points necessary to make those sorts of goofs and get a pass. But if you have
30 sufficient PC points, well, you can boast about your wild days as a teenager (Obama), you
31 can grope women, and even force them (Clinton), you can flee an accident when drunk,
32 then lie about it, you can tell your supporters you support legalization of narcotics and
33 then deny it to another group — that's Beto O Roark, running against Ted Cruz in Texas
34 — but it's okay if you have enough PC points — it's almost like Catholic indulgences.
35 Give enough money to the Church, and you can do just about anything — hah, you can
36 even purchase an indulgence for a sin you plan to commit —

37 On the other hand, if you do not have sufficient PC points you are going to be in trouble
38 no matter what you do. If you do a good thing, you will be accused of something, bad
39 motives, or something. You can do nothing right if you are *right* and nothing wrong if
40 you are *left*. For the left, morality is political. What do I mean by that?

41 Of course, certain areas of politics have always intersected moral concerns.

42 Life is a moral concern. Marriage is a moral concern. Even contracts and agreements
43 involve moral concerns. Virtually all of tort law involves questions of morality.

44 There has always been a connection between morals and politics. But when I say on the
45 left, politics *is* their morality, I mean that they have so thoroughly expressed their
46 morality through their politics that they have merged, forged, their political perspective
47 together with their perspective on morality, so that they are indistinguishable. Their
48 politics *is* their morality.

49 Religion has always been the force that shapes the values and beliefs of a community,
50 which defines their morality. For the left, politics has become that religious force. Having
51 removed "religion" from politics, their have ironically made a religion of their politics.

52 It's an odd thing that has developed in our country. At one time it was get your morality
53 out of my politics, you can't legislate morality, remember that one? Now their politics
54 have become their morality. Morality is political. Politics *is* their religion. It defines their
55 values and informs their conscience. That's what religion does. Politics, specifically, PC
56 politics, is the religion of the left. And the religion of PC politics is intolerant of other
57 religions. Isn't it bizarre how we have come full circle? We are fighting the same kind of
58 bigotry that our Baptist forefathers fought in the decades leading to the American
59 Revolution.

60 The adherents to the political PC religion are zealots. Like the old days, before religious
61 liberty was established in our country, one sect warred against the other sect. I mean, it
62 was war.

63 It was not polite debate over differences of opinion about dogma, or about the broader or
64 finer points of doctrine — it was war.

65 If you did not believe the way another group believed, you were forbidden to speak in
66 public. You would be shouted out and down, you would be pilloried — that means you
67 were put in stocks in a public place, and people were obliged to jeer at you, ridicule you,
68 mock you, even spit on you, or throw things, rocks, rotten pears, whatever —

69 If you spoke contrary to the teachings the religion of the colony, you would be
70 imprisoned, imprisoned for saying something that was not politically correct—religiously
71 correct. Like what happened to Brunson in Turkey. Thrown into prison for the crime of
72 "Christianization." I met a fellow on my plane ride back from South Carolina. He
73 ministers in Turkey.

74 He told me that his ministry among the Iranians in Turkey was not a problem for the
75 Turkish government. He said, however, if you attempt to witness to the Kurds, or the
76 Turks, you will be arrested. He explained that Turkey views the Kurds as allied with the

77 west and a westerner fraternizing with Kurds is suspect. He did say, however, Erdogan is
78 responding to pressure to move the country more toward a Muslim state — it's supposed
79 to be a secular state, but Erdogan is moving it toward becoming a Muslim state — and he
80 seemed to expressed concern about this, that it might motivate the State to look more
81 closely at his own activities.

82 I asked him if Turkey had a law against Christianization? He said they do, but that they
83 look the other way when it comes to the Iranians who fled into Turkey to escape
84 Kohmenie. He said the upper middle class, the educated Iranians, despise Kahmanie, they
85 do not support the terrorism, the oppression of the people. In other words, when the
86 Iranians went into the streets protesting that brutal regime it was a genuine cry for
87 freedom but Obama ignored them. At least Bush I imposed sanctions on China after the
88 Tiananmen Square massacre. But Obama ends up awarding Iran with billions in aid —

89 Increasingly, Iranian Muslims are pulling away from Khamanie and his bullies. (Not to be
90 confused with Kohmanie, by the way.)

91 Isn't it ironic how the Democrats today behave exactly like these bully countries — to
92 force you to think the way they say you should think, to say only what they allow you to
93 say, and punish you if you step out of line.

94 They don't have the political power to call out the tanks or send out the troops — but they
95 can harass you, threaten you, attempt to intimidate you.

96 We are regressing. Back the colonial period, in order to speak freely in the colonies, you
97 had to secure a license from the town magistrate, and this had to be approved by the
98 religious leaders of the colony. If you accepted the license, then you could preach, but
99 they would take away your license if you offended anyone by your teaching. Sound
100 familiar?

101 Baptists refused to accept licensing by the State, claiming their authority to preach was a
102 divine right given to them by Christ, the risen LORD of lords and KING of kings over
103 heaven and earth.

104 So they would preach anyway, and get thrown into prison. Patrick Henry, an attorney in
105 the Colonial days, famous for saying, "Give me liberty, or give me death," was also famous
106 for coming into one of these PC colonies, inquiring whether any Baptists were there
107 imprisoned, and offering to advocate on their behalf — often paying their bail, and
108 standing for their defense before their tribunals.

109 Today we have Christian Law Association, and other great organizations like that (such as
110 the Alliance Defending Freedom), who step in to defend religious liberty from the PC
111 oppressors — the intolerant politically correct religious bigots that attack people who
112 disagree with their religious tenets.

113 Jack Philips, remember him? He owned Masterpiece Cakeshop in Colorado. He was fined
114 and forced out of the wedding cake business because he politely declined an order to bake
115 a cake for a homosexual wedding. He recommended another establishment who would
116 bake their cake, he did not cajole or ridicule them; he simply declined their order. They

117 sued — anyway, it went all the way to the Supreme Court, and religious liberty prevailed.
118 He won.

119 Guess what Colorado did? Almost as soon as, in fact, on the same day that the court
120 announced it would hear his case, a lawyer in Colorado called his business and ordered a
121 special cake that was intended to "represent and celebrate a gender transition."¹ Mr.
122 Philips thought the timing of this order was suspicious — and indeed, it was a set up.
123 That lawyer filed a discrimination complaint against Masterpiece Cakeshop — and then
124 less than one month after the Supreme Court ruled in his favor, the State of Colorado
125 announced it was coming after him again. Yep. They are threatening him, and I think
126 they have fined him again, so he is going to go after these politicians who are using their
127 positions of government power to harass a man because he does not believe they way they
128 want him to believe — you see! That's exactly what we threw out of this country back in
129 the Revolution and that exactly the sort of thing our Constitution and Bill of Rights was
130 designed to STOP THE GOVERNMENT FROM EVER BECOMING AN OPPRESSIVE
131 RELIGION.

132 Okay, gotta go to break! But, here is some more good news — Atlanta lost! Do you
133 remember the fire chief who was, well, fired, because he wrote a book expressing his
134 Christian beliefs and included in that book was a statement that he believed marriage was
135 for one man and one woman for life?

136 Because this was in direct contradiction to the PC religion of Atlanta Georgia, he was
137 fired. He sued! And he won! Atlanta will pay Kevin Cochran 1.2 million restitution for
138 violating his inalienable rights recognized and defended by the Constitution — it has
139 DONE ITS JOB AGAIN! The founders would be pleased.

140 Okay, okay, I'll be right back.

141 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,
142 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church
143 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
144 liberty.

145 Hillary has warned us that unless we bow to the PC religious bigots controlling the
146 Democratic party today, we can expect more bullying, more intimidation, more
147 harassment — more incivility!

148 Brietbart has listed 258 physical attacks or threat of physical violence against
149 Conservatives since Trump became President.

150 Here is a sampling: Martin Astrof threatened to kill Republican Representative Lee
151 Zeldin, and Trump supporters. He left in rage and nearly ran down a campaign staffer.

152 A Trump hater punched a homeowner in Boynton Beach, FL because he had a Trump
153 flag in his front yard. Apparently, the Trump supporter tried to keep the guy there for the

154 police, but he drove off, dragging this man thirty feet — a bookstore owner in Richmond,
155 VA called the police when a woman started harassing former Trump advisor Steve
156 Bannon while he was browsing. When former Clinton Aide, Philippe heard of this, he
157 tweeted out the bookstores' address and implied his fellow Trump haters should pay the
158 store a "visit." — Philippe defended his Tweet as providing a "service." — A group of
159 protestors followed McConnell out of a restaurant in Kentucky chanting "vote you out"
160 and, are you ready for this? They shouted, "We know where you live — b—tch."

161 I understand the famous horror novelist, Steven King got in trouble for encouraging
162 Trump haters to find a Trump supporter and give them a hug, and for Trump supporters
163 to go find a Trump hater and give them a hug — he called for just one day of peace — it
164 was a "why can't we all just get along" moment for liberal, Trump hating Steven King:
165 "just for today, let's all be Americans."² He was deluged with hate mail — outrage! One
166 woman said that was the "scariest thing [King has] ever written."

167 In Minnesota, Republican state representative Sarah Anderson was punched in the arm.
168 What? Yeah! Some guy was destroying yard signs promoting Republican candidates and
169 she called on him, and asked him what he was doing, and the guy went crazy. He charged
170 at her yelling, "Why don't you go kill yourself?"³

171 A Republican candidate for Minnesota state legislature was sucker punched while
172 meeting with some of her constituents in a restaurant. Yeah! Gave her a concussion.

173 Some guy posted on his Facebook page that the Democrats are going to bring
174 Republicans to the guillotine in the coming elections.

175 Do you suppose Democrat Cory Booker urging his followers to "get up in the face" of
176 politicians they disagree with might be encouraging this mob like behavior? Do you
177 suppose Maxine Waters calling on her supporters to harass Trump supporters, to let
178 them know they are not welcome, might have something to do with this trend?

179 And such incidents are increasing. Why? Well, consider that each one of these incidents
180 that were reported on by MSM was reported in a way that justified the behavior. Someone
181 took the time to count them. To count the number of times someone in the MSM
182 justified and/or encouraged aggressive behavior from the PC religious zealots against

191 down our throats and I mean literally railroad that bill into law, and we watched them
192 denigrate our faith, and people of faith, we've put up with this for many years, decades
193 really, especially in our schools, so we finally got upset enough about it to act and we
194 massed and voted and they just can't handle it.

195 So now they are tearing down even those few American values that we continued to
196 share, like innocent until proven guilty, and resolving political conflicts by public
197 discourse and elections.

198 It's like I said in the first segment. The left has become adherents to a political religion.
199 The people who shouted the loudest against mixing religion with politics and created the
200 ultimate monster of political religion — politics has *become* their religion. In the same
201 way that religion defines the values and beliefs into a systematic dogma, the left has
202 created the ultimate combination of politics and religion — it has made politics the
203 shaper and definer of values and beliefs — they are religious zealots who are only
204 different from the Ayatollahs of Iran in the amount of government power they can wield
205 to force their will on the people.

206 Who, who looking at their behavior over the last, well, since Trump beat Hillary, who can
207 look at the way they have reacted to this, this loss of power, and not see clearly that if they
208 could, they would certainly be hauling us off to madam guillotine.

209 The country is overrun by adherents of the religion of Political Correctness. Adherents to
210 this religion are religious zealots that believe others do not have a right to speak against
211 their religious tenets.

212 Not one decent red-blooded American of any political affiliation should take this from
213 any political movement! Let's declare NO MORE VIOLENCE — Democrats for Decency!
214 Calling all Americans — this certainly is the time to come to the aid of your country —
215 vote PATRIOTIC — vote FOR GOD AND COUNTRY — vote for FREEDOM of
216 RELIGION, vote for LIBERTY and JUSTICE, and today, that means vote Republican —
217 straight down the ticket. There is not a better way to make a clear statement to the
218 Democrats that their bully tactics will. not. work.
