

## Brain Massage: Show No. 714 Republican Senate Joins Democrats To Throw President Trump, And America, Under The Bus.

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1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in  
2 Santa Maria, CA—and your brain masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

3 Republican Senate caves to the House Dems, uses threat of government shut down to  
4 betray America to those who want to destroy the U.S. — drops the wall on Trump!

5 What is the real *end game* for the Dems, for the GOPers, for Trump, and then for US?

6 Let's see, here is a headline for you, "Cory Booker beclowns himself during Neomi Rao  
7 confirmation hearing." I listened to some of Booker's inquisition of Neomi Rao, Trump  
8 appointee to take Kavanaugh's seat on the court of appeals, D.C. circuit. I am deeply  
9 disturbed by this trend in the Democrat party to set up courts of inquisition unabashedly  
10 using religious tests to disqualify appointments to our courts — another example of  
11 Christians need not apply.

12 Is there a general move to intentionally push Christians out of public life? I've  
13 experienced this personally — right here in our court in Santa Maria, by the way. I'll tell  
14 you about it.

15 Hmmm, let's see — Dinesh called a racist by an all white mob of protestors at Dartmouth  
16 College — black commentator, Terrence Williams, tweets — "Look at these college  
17 students @dartmouth throwing temper tantrums & screaming racism because  
18 @DineshDSouza is there. He is a successful immigrant & I thought they love and support  
19 all immigrants." On the video he attached he called them out — here is a group of all  
20 white college students calling a minority a racist? I thought minorities could not be racist.  
21 Here you are attacking an immigrant; I thought you loved all immigrants. I thought you  
22 were the people of tolerance —

23 McCabe — will he be the John Dean of collusion-gate? Some in my audience are too  
24 young to remember that Dean is remembered for being the one who ultimately brought  
25 Nixon down in the infamous Watergate scandal back in the early 70s. McCabe probably is  
26 not a parallel to Dean, he is playing a very different role in collusion-gate — his role is  
27 rather more like that of Deep Throat! That's the FBI agent that leaked inside information  
28 about the Watergate investigation — and there is another difference. Andrew McCabe is  
29 undoing the Dems investigation, a sort of reverse Deep Throat. He is inadvertently  
30 revealing some very dirty secrets — like in 2016 when Trump was elected a plot was  
31 considered to conspire against the President, to frame him with a false charge they could  
32 use to initiate the 25th — to have him removed from office: a conspiracy to overturn the  
33 election of the American people.

34 Well, maybe I'll get to that — hmmm, the Smollett attack is looking more like a hoax as  
35 the investigation proceeds. The two caught on video that were thought to have been  
36 involved — turns out they were former cast members on Empire — Smollett's gig! So they  
37 are buds — Nigerian — a far cry from the white MAGA hat homeys throwing bleach and

38 racist slurs that as reported by Smollett. But, the investigation continues — so, who  
39 knows! They might find an Oswald or two they can pin this on — hehe. Look, such  
40 behavior is outrageous and anyone perpetrating such racist bigotry must be brought to  
41 justice. Can I get an Amen?

42 The Green New Deal will be voted on in the Senate and Schumer is none too happy about  
43 it! McConnell wants to allow Senator's to go on record in support or in opposition to  
44 AOC's push for socialism in America as we go into the 2020 election. Oh yeah, California  
45 governor Gavin Newsome gave a 28 minute State of the State address: heavy on emotion,  
46 light on substance, typical Dem-speak.

47 Well folks, it's time for your brain massage.

49 Republican Senate caves to the House Dems. What is the real *end game* for the Dems, for  
50 the GOPers, for Trump, and then for US?

51 More than 60% of the American people want the wall (you'll notice they are trying to  
52 transition to *barrier* — the animus against Trump runs so deep in the psyche of these  
53 people they simply cannot yield to him any credit for anything he has done. He talked  
54 about the wall throughout his campaign — and he is actually getting it built, too, but you  
55 would never know.

56 Anyway, they can't have a report out there that says more than 60% of the American  
57 people want the wall — so they have it say, 60% of the American people want the *barrier*.  
58 It would be funny if it were not so sad.

59 Enough Republicans in the Senate joined with Democrats to pass the budget deal — all  
60 that is left is for Trump to sign it. What's in this bill, and will Trump sign it?

61 McConnell tells us he talked with Trump and that Trump will sign the bill and call for a  
62 national emergency to get funding to build the wall, and that he would support the  
63 national emergency. It sounds like he negotiated a deal with the President, you sign the  
64 bill, and we will stand behind your declaration of a national emergency.

65 However, I understand there are things in this omnibus bill that undermine the  
66 President's policies on immigration and there is concern that one provision in it could  
67 block building "the wall" even if the President had the funding he is asking for.

68 In other words, I'm being told there are some items in this bill that undermine the  
69 President's promise to protect us from the illegal invasion from our southern border.

70 It's over 1000 pages of legaleze — how can anyone be expected to have time to read over  
71 this before they decide how to vote? I'm being told there are some provisions here that  
72 encourage illegal immigration. Provisions for a fast track to amnesty, providing what  
73 amounts to recreational centers for those caught attempting to cross our border illegally  
74 — and very little if any provision for the WALL.

75 I'm told there is a provision allowing localities to deny a Federal wall to be built in their  
76 jurisdiction — and a number of other alarming things about this bill —

77 I've browsed, briefly browsed over the language of the bill and I must say, I did not notice  
78 any of these things in the summary or in the language — but, hey, this is a 1000 + plus  
79 page document and I would need an entire day to pour over it before I could say I'm  
80 comfortable with it.

81 One thing I would recommend to our President, he should not sign it until he has had  
82 people he trusts supports his agenda on immigration reform read over it and advise him  
83 of its contents.

84 Now, I've not heard that Trump has signed it — I have heard that he is going to sign it,  
85 but no definitive report that he has signed it.

86 If the bill incorporates the sorts of provisions I'm being told it does, I pray he becomes  
87 alerted to this soon enough and does not sign it.

88 60+ percent of the American people want the wall funded. When it comes to him  
89 declaring a national emergency to circumvent Congress and direct funding for the wall is  
90 not so well supported — something like 30% maybe it's closer to 40% — but the  
91 American people want the wall — but those governing us do not want the wall.

92 There are many reasons for this — but don't underestimate the power of drug money to  
93 influence corrupt politicians.

94 Don't underestimate the influence of a lust for power to corrupt some others of these  
95 swamp creatures and motivate them to undermine the will of 60%+ of the American  
96 people. Some think it is a political win to have illegals come into our country and vote.  
97 (Real Americans would not vote Democratic today if they had any sense of what is going  
98 on in that party. The survival of that party today totally depends marxist socialists  
99 flooding our voting booths — they depend on people voting whose motivation is one  
100 thing — stay in the country — it's the most bizarre thing — so many here illegally voting  
101 in our elections who could care less about America, and only care for their personal  
102 situation. Socialist politicians are manipulating the system to stay in power hoping to  
103 transform America into a communist dictatorship.

104 They have manipulated the language of debate very successfully, they are winning what I  
105 called the rhetoric wars several years ago, and that's because the communists control the  
106 MSM and the Education system in this country — and they have been promoting  
107 communist policies in our government for decades under other names — so that today,  
108 ironically, the principles of communist socialism, are advocated under the name of  
109 Democracy.

110 And one party is so overrun with socialist/dictators — people who believe the  
111 government should own the means of production and be empowered to distribute the  
112 wealth of the nation as they see fit — to destroy the inalienable right of a man to OWN  
113 the product of HIS OWN LABOR and to keep what his PARENTS pass to him or her —  
114 it's robbery, plain and simple —

115 I'm getting off into the Green New Deal — and I want to save that for the next segment —

142 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,  
143 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church  
144 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
145 liberty.

146 "Cory Booker beclowns himself during Neomi Rao confirmation hearing." On my way  
147 back from Sacramento, where I had the pleasure to hear some truly God fearing patriot  
148 representatives in our State government speak to us about what's going on in Sacramento  
149 and what they are doing to protect our liberties from the communist tyrants there  
150 working day and night to steal from us our liberties — (by the way, this group of pastors  
151 are rallying to Pastor John Evertson's leadership in California of something called Awake  
152 America — California. Look it up online and jump in and help us) — anyway, on my way  
153 home ...

154 I listened to some of Booker's inquisition of Neomi Rao, Trump appointee to take  
155 Kavanaugh's seat on the court of appeals, D.C. circuit.

156 He was badgering her to declare her personal beliefs about morality as if somehow her  
157 religious beliefs and convictions could disqualify her from holding a position on the  
158 court.

159 I was not really thrilled with her responses, either, but the fact is, these questions have no  
160 place in ascertaining the qualification for holding a position on our courts.

161 Booker asked Rao whether she thought homosexual relationships, in her opinion, were  
162 immoral.<sup>1</sup>

163 She attempted to dodge the question: "Umm, Senator, I'm not sure the relevance of that  
164 ..." and Booker interrupted her, "I think it's relevant to your opinion if you think African-  
165 American relationships are immoral, do you think gay relationships are immoral?"

166 She answered, "I do not."

167 Booker was not satisfied with that answer. He followed up with "Do you believe they are a  
168 sin?"

169 Rao answered, "Senator, my personal views on any of these subjects are things I would  
170 put to one side."

171 Booker charges in: "So you're not saying here whether you believe it is sinful for two men  
172 to be married. You're not willing to comment on that?"

173 To which Rao replied: "Senator, no."

174 Booker wants to amplify her response so he used an old trick: "Excuse me? I didn't hear  
175 your response."

176 Rao answered: "My answer is that these personal views are ones that I would put to one  
177 side, whatever my personal views are on this subject, I would faithfully follow the  
178 precedents of the Supreme Court."

179 Stage was set — Booker went off on a screed about past abuses, of long histories of  
180 violence, intimidation, and bullying, often done in the name of religion — but what does  
181 any of that have to do with questioning someone about their qualifications to hold a  
182 position on the court?

183 Wait! Hold on! Think about this.

184 All of the jurists claim some religious persuasion. His tirade indiscriminately  
185 discriminated against all religion — there is only one conclusion anyone could take from  
186 his monologue — religious people who hold traditional beliefs about sexual morality have  
187 no place on the court, or in government, or in public life —

188 In other words, was he accusing Rao of perpetrating violence, intimidation, bullying,  
189 against anyone? No! His only accusation was that such things have been done in the name  
190 of religion.

191 Well, Booker, such things have been done in the name of atheism too; millions have been  
192 murdered in the name of Socialism, millions have been murdered in the name of  
193 Communism (I know, same thing). Hey, Mr. Booker, since 1973 more than 54 million<sup>2</sup>  
194 babies have been murdered in the wombs of their mothers in the name of choice. Hey,  
195 Mr. Booker, Christians are being harassed, bullied, intimidated, and even physically  
196 attacked in the name of gay rights, and abortion rights —

197 And if it was only Booker — we have been seeing this sentiment, this business, of  
198 applying a religious litmus test on candidates for appointments to our courts coming  
199 from Democrats for a while now: Feinstein, D. CA, Kamala Harris, D. CA, Mazie Hirono,  
200 D. Hawaii, Sheldon Whitehouse, D. RI, Dick Durbin, D. ILL. All of these Democrat  
201 Representatives and Senators have attempted to impugn the faith of those Trump has  
202 nominated to the court —

203 I am deeply disturbed by this trend in the Democrat party to set up courts of inquisition

206 I wish these nominees would turn the tables on these yahoos. I guess they are concerned  
207 they will not get the recommendation from the Congress they think they need — the  
208 Constitution says the President appoints and the Congress gives their advice and consent  
209 — and for decades the Congress has always deferred to the President's nominations and  
210 the only concern they raised in their questioning of the candidates was strictly limited to  
211 their judicial qualifications — their personal opinions were off limits.

212 That has changed. And it has changed because Democrat appointed jurists have  
213 aggressively used their influence on the court to advance their Democrat agenda — in  
214 other words, the Democrats know they appoint Jurists who will faithfully promote their  
215 agenda — and they are afraid of judicial activism working the other way for a change and  
216 so they are concerned.

217 Look, I'd say, Senator, you are rightly concerned about judicial activism. I appreciate that  
218 concern, in fact, I share in that concern. For many years now we have had appointees  
219 from your side of the aisle who have used their position on the court to advance their  
220 personal agendas. They have acted as if they were the law, and used their power on the  
221 court to advance their personal opinions about social issues — and I resent that. So, allow  
222 me to assure you that I will not be a judicial activist like so many judges have been that  
223 you approve of. I am different. I will rule based on LAW.

224 My personal opinions will not influence my decisions. If a case comes before me  
225 regarding abortion, I will rule according to the law of the land. If a case comes before me  
226 on the issue of homosexuality, or gay marriage, I will rule according to the law.

227 Making law is something you do — adjudicating cases is the work of applying the law to  
228 each case as it appears before me.

229 Now, as for my personal beliefs. That is none of your business, officially, that is. However,  
230 if you would like to have a theological discussion about sin, I would be very glad to oblige.  
231 I'm sure we can find space on my calendar to meet for a private and personal  
232 conversation, I'll have one of my secretaries contact your office.

233 If the Senator persisted, I would cite the Constitution prohibition against a religious test  
234 and, playfully, rule him out of order, or something like that.

235 The Senate is not GOD — Senators are servants of the American people sworn to uphold  
236 the Constitution.

237 No Senator has a right to badger a nominee, nor does any Senator have the right to apply  
238 a religious test for holding office. That is contrary to the LAW — Ted Cruz was right to  
239 chastise the Senator from Illinois for his unlawful inquisition.

240 The Green New Deal will be voted on in the Senate and Schumer is none too happy about  
241 it! McConnell wants to allow Senator's to go on record in support or in opposition to  
242 AOC's push for socialism in America as we go into the 2020 election.

243 What's with this Green New Deal? The first summary put up by AOC's team specifically  
244 stipulated economic security for all in America, whether they were unable or unwilling to  
245 work. When this was brought out and AOC started getting hammered for such a  
246 ridiculous proposal, they pulled that doc off and put up a rewrite. The rewrite says the  
247 new deal will guarantee economic security to all Americans — or, actually, to every one in  
248 America, which leave it open to everyone residing in our country.

249 That's even crazier than Communism — at least under Communism the people had to  
250 work. If they did not work, where the government told them to work, how long the  
251 government told them to work, as hard as the government told them to work, then they  
252 were arrested as hooligans, sent to prison, where they were force to work. Of course, the  
253 trick there was that if you were a Christian, you were not allowed to get a job, so you were  
254 then arrested for being a hooligan, and put in prison and forced labor.

255 Unless you would recant, denounce your belief in God — then you could return to society  
256 and get a job in government employment because everyone worked for the government.

257 Of course that system collapsed after 70 years — so do we have to go into 70 years of  
258 darkness and oppression before we figure out that people like AOC have no idea what  
259 they are talking about.

260 Or, they do! And what they want is total government control of everything. In fact, AOC  
261 admitted as much. When she was asked if her Green New Deal would require a massive  
262 government takeover, she said, "yeah, I have no problem saying that."

263 During a radio interview with NPR host Steve Inskeep, Ocasio-Cortez admitted she  
264 knows her proposal would require a massive government takeover of the economy.

265 NPR's Steve Inskeep said "As you know, congresswoman, one reason that people who are  
266 politically conservative are skeptical of efforts to combat climate change is that it sounds  
267 to them like it requires massive government intervention which they just don't like," and

268 then he asked, "Are you prepared to put on the table that yes, they're actually right, what  
269 this requires is massive government intervention?"

270 Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez said, right outloud, in front of God and she thought only the  
271 NPR audience:

272 "It does." "It does. Yeah, I have no problem saying that."

273 However, the same day, during an interview on MSNBC, Ocasio-Cortez criticized the  
274 political Right, saying that the Right was trying to "mischaracterize" her plan. She said,

275 "One way that the Right does try to mischaracterize what we're doing as though it's like  
276 some kind of massive government takeover."

277 She continued. "Uh, obviously what we're trying to do is, well obviously it's not that  
278 because what we're trying to do is release the investments from the federal government to  
279 mobilize those resources across the country."

280 Now, all normal people are frowning their brow, A. trying to comprehend this  
281 convoluted gobbeldygook<sup>3</sup>, and B. getting the gist of it exclaiming, you've got to be  
282 kidding me.

283 So, the right is mischaracterizing her Green New Deal proposal when they claim it will  
284 require massive government take over of the American economy — it will destroy  
285 capitalism and replace it with virtual socialism — because what she wants to do is, and  
286 listen carefully here, "release the investments from the federal government to mobilize  
287 those resources across the country." Right? Got it? No? I know, she said nothing. First,  
288 what investments are being held by the government right now! Would that be our taxes,  
289 our investment of tax dollars — what is she saying? Whatever investments the  
290 government is holding that she wants to release she wants released to "mobilize those  
291 resources" — what resources? The resources she speaks of in the proposal? Well, if that's  
292 the case, she wants a massive redistribution of our tax dollars — and where will she get  
293 enough to cover universal pre-paid health care for everyone, free education through  
294 university for everyone, and this includes all illegals — whom she does not call illegal  
295 since they are descendants of the indigenous peoples of these United States — all of this  
296 will be paid for by — well, for starters, by taxing the "rich" 70% on everything they earn  
297 above 10 million — and I think I heard her say one time that she wants to tax the wealth

299 I mean who needs more than 10 million dollars worth of assets. Are you listening to what  
300 these people are proposing?

301 They want the government to waltz in and take property away everything someone owns  
302 over 10 million dollars. That's not just income, that's wealth.

303 That won't disturb a great many people I know — but it disturbs me deeply.

304 And, I need to close, but I really want to put this out there. I keep hearing people respond  
305 to AOC's green new deal like this, well that's great, but how will you pay for it? By the  
306 time she runs through all the wealth she would confiscate from the rich, she will then  
307 have to turn to the second tier rich and do it again, and then when they run through all  
308 that, they'll have to come after the middle class, and then finally after everyone — the  
309 minute you give the government the right to take private property from those who own it,  
310 you have LOST YOUR LIBERTY! It's gone.

311 I wish people would quit reacting to her proposal as if it's a "great idea, but it's  
312 impractical." NO! It's not a great idea. It's SINFUL. It's wicked thievery, it's STEALING  
313 the property that rightly and justly belongs to another. It's not social justice, it's social  
314 stealing!

315 These people are robbers! They are thieves at heart. They have no respect the PRIVATE  
316 PROPERTY — and while they are wearing the mask of compassion, encouraging and  
317 executing policies that play on evil passions (envy, jealousy, and laziness — oohh, I can  
318 get theirs for nothing, sexual immorality, indolence) they will finally break us away from  
319 any protection (the Declaration, the Constitution, the BIBLE, GOD) and enslave us to  
320 their hunger for power and control. It's not who owns the wealth, but who controls it,  
321 after all, at the end of the day, that truly has the power.

322 Exactly as our founders warned — democracy is fine until wicked people of low character  
323 find out they can use their vote to take away the wealth of others to fill their own pockets.
