

# Brain Massage: Show No. 718 The "War" Report From The Brain Masseur / The Definitive Proof Trump Is NOT Racist (Part Two)

1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in  
2 Santa Maria, CA—and your brain masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

3 [TRUTH]

4 I want to complete my definitive proof that Trump is NOT racist — but before I do that,  
5 let's do some touch and goes on the pertinent news this week.

6 Newsome is queasy about the death penalty for murderers — but he is perfectly okay with  
7 the death penalty for innocent babies in the womb, and in fact, wants taxpayers to pay for  
8 them.

9 And he likes this too — HHS extends disgusting contract with university to create  
10 “Humanized Mice” — okay, that's weird enough. But get this, they are using “late-term  
11 aborted babies in this research. So there goes another, what is it, 100 million taxpayer  
12 dollars in research using aborted babies. In California, we pay to murder the babies, and  
13 then pay for scientists to use the babies murdered in research.

14 A high schooler was suspended because she posted Bible verses in School that had  
15 LGBTQ pride flags decorating the halls.<sup>1</sup> The principal allegedly said she was "targeting  
16 the organization" in her school that displayed the homosexual propaganda all over her  
17 school. So, a Christian has no right of free speech to express his or her views but the  
18 LGBTQ organization in her school has the right to free speech to promote their point of  
19 view — a point of view that is an assault on the beliefs and values traditional Americans  
20 have held for centuries? It's like I've said — homosexual rights cannot co-exist with a  
21 Christian's rights — here you have a situation where the Christian is not arguing the  
22 LGBTQ crowd cannot express their opinion, she is willing to cede that right to them. But  
23 the Homosexual activists are NOT WILLING TO YIELD THAT RIGHT TO  
24 CHRISTIANS — think about that!

25 A "far-right" White Supremacist attacked a Mosque in New Zealand killing 49 — Trump  
26 is to blame for his hate speech against Muslims — which, by the way, does not exist. Can  
27 you believe these people? Can any story be about, well, about what it is, and not about  
28 Trump? Anyway, this guy left a, I think it was a thirty-one page, manifesto in which he  
29 essentially declares his actions are in retaliation against what he considers a Muslim  
30 invasion of his country, among other things, specifically mentioning the Muslim driver  
31 that mowed down eleven year old Ebba Aukerlund in 2017 in Stockholm. In fact, her  
32 name was inscribed on one of the guns he used in his attack. Of course, he is described as  
33 "far-right" — when consistently the so-called "far-right" do not support conservative  
34 principles or represent conservative values. For example, in this case, the guy states in his

35 manifesto that he could be called far right or far left depending on the definition. He  
36 declares that he is not a conservative, because "conservatism is corporatism in disguise."

37 Then you dig deeper. He reveals that he was first a communist, then anarchist, then  
38 libertarian, then eco-fascist. What is an Ecofascist?

39 "Ecofascism is a theoretical political model in which a totalitarian government would  
40 require individuals to sacrifice their own interests to the "organic whole of nature" and  
41 which would rely on militarism, expansionism, and possibly racism to defend the  
42 land." Wikipedia

43 That sounds like the Democratic Party USA. Hey, the country with a political system  
44 most in alignment with his beliefs? China.

45 The reason he choose to use firearms is because, according to his own manifesto, he knew  
46 the Western media would lob onto that fact and it would give his story 24/7 exposure.

47 His aim, to provoke civil war in America through exacerbating tensions between the left  
48 and right.

49 What led him to do this? He explained it is generally because he feels angry that nothing  
50 is being done about immigration, that the Muslims, whom he calls "invaders" are  
51 displacing his people and his culture, and that the trigger that turned this dissatisfaction  
52 into rage was when a Muslim immigrant ran down an eleven year old in Stockholm in  
53 2017 in a terrorist vehicular terrorist attack.

54 You know, it's interesting that the MSM in America will almost certainly attempt to  
55 blame Trump for this; in fact already they are throwing it out there. But when you read  
56 this guys manifesto, it becomes apparent that he is one them. This consistently happens.  
57 These people who do these things are never Christian or Jewish conservatives — it's  
58 always some guy that identifies with communists, in fact he identifies as a socialist, by the  
59 way, believes in the worker owning means of production — so long as the worker is of the  
60 nationality of the country they are in — and it's always like that. Why do you suppose?

61 Well, look at the spirit of these people as it acts out here in our country. Who are the  
62 people physically attacking their political opponents? It's never the conservative attacking  
63 a liberal, it's always a liberal attacking a conservative.

64 Just today, during show prep, I came across two more stories of somebody being  
65 physically, or personally assaulted by a liberal over a MAGA hat. One guy was run out of  
66 a bar because of his MAGA hat, and some 18-year-old liberal admitted to slashing the  
67 tires of a car because she saw a MAGA hat in the cab. It's always liberals who are mean,  
68 aggressive, and physical in their attacks. Remember the liberal that beat up a conservative  
69 on the Berkley campus. I hope that bully ends up in jail.

70 And while we are talking about liberals attacking conservatives wearing MAGA hats —  
71 remember the 16 year-old kid that was libeled by CNN and the Washington Post? You  
72 know, the fake Indian story — the older man that rudely got into the face of this kid in a  
73 MAGA hat and attempted to intimidate him and CNN and Washington Post smeared  
74 this kid all over America probably ruining any chance for him to have any kind of normal

75 life — well, the family sued, CNN for 275 Mil. and Wapo for 250 million. And I pray he  
76 wins!

77 It's the liberals who act out on their political differences physically, who attack people that  
78 disagree with them in an effort to ruin their lives, to drive them out, make them hide —  
79 wear your MAGA hat, but never go alone. Have someone with you ready to video this  
80 stuff and sue them every time they pull this stuff.

81 And, yes, that is the CHRISTIAN thing to do. Haha! But really, it is. I'll address that in the  
82 Issachar Report this Sunday night.

83 So it's always the liberal that is caught physically assaulting a conservative, yet here is a  
84 Liberal, an Asian running for President, who said he is concerned that as the whites  
85 become the minority they will "resort to outright deadly violence against Asian  
86 Americans."<sup>2</sup>

87 Hmmm. You know the Bible says the "wicked flee when no man pursueth" (Proverbs  
88 28:1).

89 And finally, let's touch and go on the *Russian Collusion* conspiracy to execute a coupe  
90 against a sitting President — another example of the aggressive, mean, evil, wicked, dirty  
91 fighting tactics of the Left these days. Guess what, of course we knew this all along — but  
92 now it's out in the open. Lisa Page said FBI discussed charging Hillary Clinton with gross  
93 negligence in 2016 in the matter of email-gate — but Obama's DOJ shut it down. Flatly  
94 ordered the FBI do not charge Hillary. That's right! That's how the left plays. And they get  
95 away with it because they have media covering them, and a spineless, amoral, wicked  
96 leadership in their party that closes ranks and defends these high-profile criminals in  
97 their party, and an opposition party that has no spine — or that is infiltrated with

102 The theory has been they don't know how to win, or how to wield power when they have  
103 it. I'm beginning to think these characters are specifically planted to do one job —  
104 neutralize the conservatives when they are in power until the Dems can work their way  
105 back in. You have got to throw out every one of these characters that keep resisting what  
106 is good for this country. VOTE CHRISTIAN CONSERVATIVE —

107 Gotta go to break. Sanctuary State CA — how's that working for you liberals in this state?  
108 "On Monday, Carlos Eduardo Arevalo Carranza, 24, an illegal alien from El Salvador, was  
109 arrested for allegedly beating and stabbing Bambi Larson, 59, to death in her own home  
110 in south San Jose two weeks ago. According to ICE, Carranza had at least 10 prior arrests  
111 over the past three years, including several convictions for drugs, kidnapping, battery  
112 against a police officer, and burglary. ICE placed detainers on him six times, two with the

113 Los Angeles Police Department Central Jail in 2016 and four with the Santa Clara County  
 114 Jail between May 2017 and January 2019. **The two jurisdictions ignored the detainees**  
 115 **each time.** According to ICE, the most recent detainer was issued in January after  
 116 Carranza was picked up on drug charges. This senseless and completely avoidable murder  
 117 happened while Carranza, a self-admitted gang member, was on probation for possession  
 118 of methamphetamine, paraphernalia, false imprisonment, and burglary."<sup>3</sup>

119 Newsome — a soft hearted guy! A real sweetie liberal. He has so much sympathy for the  
 120 illegals he has made this state a sanctuary state, and so much hatred for Trump he has  
 121 forbidden our State for cooperate with ICE. THAT'S WHY THIS HAPPENED. Newsome  
 122 is responsible for this, and everyone who voted for him. (How do you like that, liberal?  
 123 How do you like it when a conservative starts doing to you what your representatives do  
 124 to us? How do you like being told that because you voted for someone, you are  
 125 responsible for any negative thing that happens — but, wait! Actually, Trump supporters  
 126 are happy to take responsibility for what he is doing because he is making America Great  
 127 again. So, okay, I'll take it. Now, you take it. You voted this guy in, he made California a  
 128 sanctuary state, he has declared he will not cooperate with ICE, now this woman in San  
 129 Jose is DEAD and her blood is on your hands. Soft hearted? No, soft-headed! Queasy  
 130 about killing murderers, okay with killing babies in the womb. All mushy about  
 131 protecting the illegal criminal immigrants flooding out state, HEARTLESS WHEN THEY  
 132 COMMIT MURDER! These people are perverted. They have perverse affections. Okay,  
 133 gotta go to break. I'll be right back. "Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without  
 134 natural affection, implacable, ..."

135 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,  
 136 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church  
 137 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
 138 liberty.

139 Okay, let's finish the definitive statement on Trump's racism — proving he is NOT a  
 140 racist. In last week's show I carefully laid out the etymology of the words *racist* and  
 141 *racism*. We showed that Trotsky did not invent the word in 1930, but that in fact it was in  
 142 use by Darwin in 1859 in the title of his book *On The Origin of Species by Means of*  
 143 *Natural Selection, or the Preservation of Favoured Races in the Struggle for Life*. And  
 144 before him it was in use in the early 1800s in France, taken from an Italian word, *razza*. It  
 145 meant breed, or lineage. Of course, certain Hispanic groups in California use *Razza* to  
 146 refer to the Hispanic *race* and issues related to their concerns: stuff like flooding  
 147 California with Mexican immigrants in order to overwhelm the political system and take  
 148 California under Mexican rule. It's the belief in the superiority of the Mexican race; a sort  
 149 of nicely tanned version of White Supremacy. Anyway, I laid out the evolution of the  
 150 word to its present meaning and use. The bottom line is that *racist* was identified with a  
 151 belief in racial superiority connected with an aggressive mission to dominate, or  
 152 subjugate, inferior ones.

153 So, a racist is someone who believes he is superior, or inferior, to others based on racial  
154 identity. We showed that it is the Democrats today that are racists — who view other  
155 races as inferiors, as dependents. Whereas, we do not measure a person by their race,  
156 rather we measure them by their character: not by the color of their skin but by the  
157 content of their character, right?

158 Then we began exploring the question whether Trump is racist. We began by pointing  
159 out his Presidency has done more for people of color than the Democrats have done in all  
160 their pretentious posturing as there to take care of the inferior minorities who in their  
161 opinion cannot take care of themselves.

162 Then we began looking at the specific charges liberals use to prove Trump is a racist. We  
163 addressed the inside favorite: Turmp's alleged discrimination against blacks in his rental  
164 policies and practices in New York. Proved that to be a false charge. Never could prove it,  
165 never charged, paid no fine — it was New York trying to strong arm Trump into taking  
166 on Section 8 renters and he did not want to get involved with it.

167 Then the charge that he treated black differently than whites in his casinos — all denied,  
168 and no allegation proved, no witnesses, no corroborating evidence. Hear-say! It's enough  
169 to convict you with Liberals who hate you — and ask Hillary, nothing will convict you if  
170 they have a reason to protect you. So!

171 Then there is the full-page ad in New York newspapers urging the death penalty for  
172 anyone raping and killing a fellow-New Yorker. I quoted from the ad, and explained that  
173 this is not a case of racism, it's a case of anti-criminal coddling.

174 Next, this definitive list accuses Trump of having an obsession with Dark-skinned  
175 immigrants. That's insulting! The fact is Trump hired immigrants all the time to work in  
176 his casinos and hotels — and treated them fairly and paid them well, by the way. It's  
177 ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS that is the problem — and, by the way, this has been a growing  
178 problem for all of us, and I mean all Americans of every color and non-color (black and  
179 white are not, technically speaking, colors) are concerned about the issue.

180 He made a comment about MS-13 and the Liberals twist it into a comment about all  
181 immigrants — If I was an immigrant I'd be insulted by the liberals because they are the  
182 one assuming all immigrants are alike and speak negatively of one is to speak negatively  
183 of all — once again, it's the liberals who are racists.

184 Trump calls for the shutting down of immigration until we can fix it, calls for all Muslims  
185 specifically to be banned from entering the country or re-entering if they are citizens until  
186 we can properly vet them. That was in the heat of 9/11 — and it was not a racist policy, it  
187 was about protecting the national interests of the country. Unless there is something the  
188 Liberals know about FDR that we don't, he interned the Japanese during WWII to protect  
189 the national security, not because he was racist against Japanese people. Or, well, you  
190 know, now that I hear how the Liberals think about this, maybe not. It might simply be  
191 another of a long list of situations where when conservatives do it it's evil and when  
192 liberals do it it's for understandable reasons. Well, that's where we left off. Let's pick it up  
193 from here.

194 I'm using the New York Times definitive list proving Trump's racism, written by  
 195 Leonhardt and Philbrick, and published January 15, 2018. It's titled, "Donald Trump's  
 196 Racism: The Definitive List.

197 Continuing with the heading "An Obsession With Dark-Skinned Immigrants."

198 "Trump said a federal judge hearing a case about Trump University was biased because of  
 199 the judge's Mexican heritage." What did Trump actually say? On June 2, 2016, after the  
 200 Judge in question, Judge Curiel, ruled against Trump, Trump told the *Wall Street*  
 201 *Journal* that he thought Curiel had a conflict of interest. Because he was convinced the  
 202 merits of the case supported a ruling in his favor, that the Judge's Mexican lineage and  
 203 affinities (not to mention he was an Obama appointed judge) probably influenced his  
 204 decision. This is no more a racist statement than it is racist for the New York Times to  
 205 include this as proof Trump is a racist. Understand? Look! Trump gets a ruling he did not  
 206 expect, and one that he believed was wrong, and he is trying to figure out why, and he  
 207 looks at this judge, and he is a Mexican, and so he reasons, the guy must be a racist. I  
 208 don't agree with that sort of thinking — I think it's careless, and presumptuous. Which is  
 209 exactly what I think about using this as proof that Trump is a racist. If anything, it shows  
 210 that Trump is also concerned about iniquities occurring on the basis of race — and don't  
 211 tell me you don't see that he has been the victim of this sort of racism hundreds of times.

212 But the point is, making such an assessment is not presuming some superiority of his race  
 213 over another. Trump was no more racist to suspect racism was at the root of this Judge's  
 214 ruling than Leonhardt and Philbrick are racist for suspecting Trump is racist because he  
 215 thought the Judge was. It's just more evidence of how hard they have to reach and stretch  
 216 to find something to justify their charge.

217 Next: "In June 2017, Trump said 15,000 recent immigrants from Haiti 'all have AIDS' and  
 218 that 40,000 Nigerians, once seeing the United State, would never 'go back to their huts' in  
 219 Africa."<sup>4</sup> But then again, there is the ever-necessary context of these things. Trump was  
 220 angry that his team was not following through on his instructions regarding immigration  
 221 policy and stormed into his office waving a paper that reported 2,500 immigrants from  
 222 Afghanistan had received visas — he said, "that's a terrorist haven." He told them they  
 223 were making him look foolish, and like he did not take his promises to the American  
 224 people seriously. He was unhappy, okay? He spoke of the 15,000 from Haiti, then,  
 225 according to this report, he grumbled, "they all have AIDS." Well, I am going to guess the  
 226 good liberals like Leonhardt and Philbrick never use hyperbole when speaking, especially  
 227 when they are exasperated, or angry, so, you know the super humans that they are —  
 228 stones in hand — ready to cast them at any conservative who uses such rhetorical devices  
 229 when speaking emotionally — and then he spoke of the report that 40,000 Nigerians who  
 230 got temporary visas into the country that once they got a taste of America, they would  
 231 "never go back to their huts."

232 Do I need to elaborate on this? You are, more than likely, not one of the super-human  
 233 liberals who never make outlandish statements — oh, wait a minute, Liberals do this all

234 the time. They make snide remarks about Christians — which is a kind of racism, you  
235 know, when you really think about how liberals use that word today — at the very least it  
236 is bigotry — and yet they consistently get a pass. Besides, what Trump was saying was  
237 grounded in truth. Haiti is rife with sexually transmitted diseases — and many people  
238 from Nigeria live in what we would call huts. At least that's the pictures we see all the time  
239 — taken by liberals and put in front of our faces over and over again —. That statement  
240 can be more about exasperation that his team allowed 40,000 immigrants to come in  
241 whom he believed would disappear in the population and we'd never find them than it  
242 has anything at all to do with racism — a belief in the superiority of his race over others  
243 and a desire to dominate or subjugate them.

244 Finally, under this heading, Trump's obsession with dark-skinned immigrants — they  
245 include this little nugget: "At the White House on Jan. 11, Trump vulgarly called for less  
246 immigration from Haiti and Africa and more from Norway." Well, whether it was vulgar  
247 could be something we could discuss, but whether it was racist, well, that's nonsense;  
248 unless liberals are here admitting their own racism. Let me explain. Remember when  
249 Blacks complained that whites dominated TV and Movies and felt underrepresented —  
250 that it made America look all white, and suggested they did not exist? I agreed with that,  
251 by the way, and I think TV and movies have been very much enriched by including the in  
252 many cases exceptional talents of many wonderful black actors and actresses. (We don't  
253 need to include in our discussion the technical fact that filming black actors and actresses  
254 was challenging back in the day, but nevertheless, it is true that something needed to be  
255 done about this, and I certainly welcome it — Denzel, frankly, is one of my favorite  
256 actors. Will Smith is another that I enjoy. Anyway! I remember this. Also, I can see the  
257 sense of many white people today wondering about the massive influx of "people of color"  
258 and beginning to become concerned about the impact this is having on our culture —  
259 particularly when we find ourselves continuing to be pushed aside, losing our language,  
260 losing even our political values and beliefs are being disrespected — some burning our  
261 flag in our streets — refusing to stand for the national anthem — it's getting wearying so,  
262 once again, on a visceral level, Trump channels American angst — but taken in whole, it's  
263 not a racist statement to ask why don't we have more immigrants that "look like us"? Isn't  
264 that what the black community was saying back in the 60s, why don't we see more people  
265 on TV that look like us? I don't think that was a racist thing, coming from the Blacks, I  
266 mean, and I don't think it should be assumed to be racist when a white man asks a similar  
267 question.

268 The next heading, or category of proofs that Trump is racist is titled: Obama As  
269 Unqualified, Lazy, And Un-American. And the first thing in this list is that Trump "spent  
270 years suggesting that the nation's first black president was born not in the United States  
271 but in Kenya." Leonhardt and Philbrick decided to add a lie to this charge and say that  
272 this was "a lie that Trump still has not acknowledged as such." Trump did back off that  
273 and took credit for compelling Obama to finally release his certificate — but as far as  
274 whether this makes him racist, good night! The New York Times writers are so bigoted,  
275 and racists, they see bigotry and racism in anything that resembles an opinion they don't

276 like about someone they do. Really? I can't express a negative personal opinion about  
277 Obama without being called a racist?

278 As for the birth certificate thing, I can tell you that I probably qualify as the nearest thing  
279 many of you will ever meet as an expert on the subject — the jury is still on that. There  
280 continues to be substantive reason to doubt Obama's birth story and it's exactly as I  
281 predicted back when this first came up. If Obama had come out with his birth certificate  
282 immediately, and had not sent his lawyers all over the country attempting to quash every  
283 legal effort to compel him to show his certificate, this would have gone away long before  
284 it became an engrained suspicion in the American psyche — and believe me when I tell  
285 you that many Obama supporters actually, when they look at the evidence, become  
286 suspicious, but they say, effectively, that they don't care.

287 So, questioning Obama's birth-story does not a racist make, or prove.

288 Next, "Trump called Obama (who was editor in chief of the Harvard Law Review) 'a  
289 terrible student, terrible.'" Again, how does that make someone racist? This should  
290 disturb every freedom, free speech, and freedom of thought loving American very deeply.  
291 These people are saying that if the subject is black, you can't have any opinion about him  
292 that is negative, that if you do, it means you are racist. And here, we go back to Obama's  
293 refusal to open his records for public scrutiny. He refused to allow us to see his academic  
294 records. We still don't know why. And besides that, the testimony we received from those  
295 who knew him in school, and, by the way, from his own book, indicates that he was not a  
296 good student. So, whether Trump is right or wrong in his assumptions about Obama,  
297 they were constructed upon rumors that circulated during that time about him, and there  
298 was never one time that Trump, or anyone else I know, said Obama must have been a bad  
299 student, after all, look at the guy, he is black you know! Watch for some devil to edit this  
300 and make it out that I made that statement. One of the most brilliant scientists in  
301 America's history was a black man with the name Goerge Washington Carver. Ben  
302 Carson is one of the most brilliant surgeons in America today, and Trump loves the guy.  
303 Come on!

304 And, well, here we go again; I'm out of time. But I think I'll proceed in this way until I've  
305 gone through the entire list, then I'll combine all these segments into one audio file and  
306 post it for you.

307 I feel like I need to stay in touch with current topics of concern to God fearing patriots,  
308 but also, I want you to have a properly documented and well thought out response to the  
309 charge that Trump is racist. So, next time, we will take up the New York Times definitive  
310 list proving Trump is a racist and I'll show you that they have absolutely NO CASE to  
311 support the claim.

312 What they don't like about Trump is that he is an AMERICAN who gets it. He has  
313 connected with the current state of the soul of this country and people are connecting to  
314 him on so many levels it scares the Progressives — because it threatens their agenda to  
315 drag America down into the slime pits of Socialism and turn this country into another  
316 Venezuela.
