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1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in
2 Santa Maria, CA—and your brain masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

3 How do we make a difference? Is it enough to be informed; what actions must be taken to
4 make a difference? — we'll talk about that today.

5 And, let's see, yeah! Okay, let's do a fly over on the news then finish up on my definitive
6 argument that Trump is NOT a racist.

7 My friends, it's time for your brain massage.

8 [TRUTH]

9 Exhibit A — the Democrat Party has consistently favored policies that compromise the
10 security of Israel and favor the interests of her enemies. Consistently! (Yet liberal Jews
11 continue to vote for them.)

12 Exhibit B — Antisemitic sentiment is growing more public in Democrat circles — liberal
13 Women's March got all tangled up in Anti Semitic slanders in Jan this year — Ilhan Omar
14 (D. MN) angrily claimed America's allegiance to Israel is purchased by Israeli lobbyists in
15 DC — suggests Jews in the US are attached to Israel and suspected as disloyal to the US —
16 (so her ethnicity should make us suspicious about her loyalties, right?) — so some
17 Democrats are concerned about how this makes them look and they put out a statement
18 that effectively rebukes her and her defenders argue that she is being attacked because she
19 is Muslim???? So the Democrat leadership backs off. Omar complains that because she is
20 Muslim people assume her loyalties are aligned against the interests of the US — at least
21 against the America you and I remember and love — If you don't see the irony (not to
22 say, blind hypocrisy) in this you are probably new to the Brain Massage show and in great
23 need of regular brain massages.

24 Exhibit C — high-level Democratic leaders have for many years fraternized with Louis
25 Farrakhan, and anti-Semitic statements are becoming more common among them — and
26 in defense of this, some say, "well, Republicans have said worse about other ethnic
27 groups" and I ask oh, name one; and the response is crickets.

28 Exhibit D — There is a creepy alliance developing between anti-Christ and Anti-Semitic
29 sentiment in this country in the Democrat Party. Christians can be slaughtered in various
30 parts of the world and it appears no one is concerned about it, or says anything about it;
31 but if any such thing happened among Mohammedans, you'd certainly hear about it; but
32 not for babies slaughtered in the womb, for turtles, or salamanders, or whales, you would
33 certainly hear the outrage. The number of anti Christ statements coming from the Left is
34 really alarming. From Christmas bashing, to the constant flagrant dismissing and open
35 mockery of Christian values and beliefs, throughout the education establishment, and all

36 over media, the environment being created is one where Christians are being
37 marginalized, even being told they have no place in government if they are Christians,
38 and it goes on so frequently in this country today it's become the NORM on the left.

39 Exhibit E — Liberals are getting meaner and more overtly aggressive all the time,
40 physically assaulting people wearing MAGA hats, do I need to assemble the list of
41 incidents? No, good, there are so many and many more we don't hear about. You have
42 heard the angry calls to attack conservatives — you've seen the videos — you might have
43 experienced it yourself — so, the point is, they are getting vicious and violent. Just plain
44 mean. A pro-life group of students at the University of Michigan secured a permit to
45 place 1000 small pink crosses on campus lawns commemorating aborted babies. A woker
46 (that's a new one — refers to someone who is awake to injustice, but it only applies to
47 those who are blind to injustices perpetrated against innocent babies in the womb, blind
48 to the injustice of trampling under their feet the free speech rights of those with whom
49 they disagree, the injustice of — okay, you get the point) — so this Woker, actually, it was
50 a few of them, come along with trash bags and start pulling up the little pink crosses and
51 placing them in the trash — when confronted by campus police, this particular woker
52 explains she was just collecting trash, and didn't know she was taking up someone's
53 property, so when asked to replace them, she said she could not remember exactly where
54 she found them and dumped her bag on the sidewalk and walked away — this is how
55 these people protest — they are rude, crude, angry, bullying, arrogant — and this
56 particular exhibit goes to the point that the liberals are becoming increasingly physical,
57 and openly hostile toward those with whom they disagree ...

58 Exhibit F — The fraternity between the Democrats and the MMMMM(Smack)uslim
59 community is troubling, not because I think all Muslims are radical Jihadis but because
60 soooooo many of them are. I agree we need to take care and judge each person on his or
61 her own merits — but when I hear assimilated Muslim immigrants warning me about the
62 non-assimilated Muslim community, it is concerning. Then when I see a Muslim in the
63 Congress trash talking America, taking positions that are clearly contrary to our
64 Constitutional form of government — Ilhan, look at this, cuddling up to Linda Sarsour —
65 who openly advocates for Sharia law. So, it is deeply concerning that Jeanine Piro is
66 suspended from her FOX show because she dared ask whether Omar's sporting of the
67 headdress required under Sharia law together with her cozy relationship with Sharia law
68 advocate and apologist Sarsour might suggest Omar's allegiance to the American
69 Constitution is open for question.

70 Exhibit G — consider all the Anti American system rhetoric and policy suggestions we
71 are hearing from Democrats these days. (Look, I've been around a while. I can tell you
72 that people are so focused on selfish, feely, me-me, type concerns, they will attend
73 churches that flatly deny what they say are their beliefs — they will remain loyal to groups
74 where they have personal relationships no matter what — lately the United Methodists,
75 United Church Of Christ, Lutherans and Episcopalians all unite behind baby murdering
76 Planned Parenthood — but many who call themselves Christians continue to support
77 with their time, talent, and treasure, these so-called Churches — and does anyone wonder
78 why we are in the mess we are in? So, I know that most Democrats will not leave that

79 wicked party no matter how outlandish they become — but TRUTH is the TRUTH — do
80 you understand my dear friends?

81 I am not strategizing how to defeat this or that party. I'm not concerned about offending
82 the Democrats, or the Republicans, or the Independents, or the Libertarians — it's about
83 the TRUTH, the WHOLE TRUTH, and NOTHING BUT!

84 Not only are they calling for murdering babies right up the moment the breach the
85 womb, and if they happen to survive an attempt on their lives in the womb, to murder
86 them after they are born alive — that's the modern Democrat Party USA — that's who
87 they are! Not only are they calling for virtual infanticide, which is a criminal offense in
88 the US, but won't be long if the Democrats have their way, but they want to destroy

90 For example, Exhibit G1 — they want to eliminate the electoral college. This will

93 New Jersey have passed laws that are intended to keep Trump off their ballot in 2020.
94 Talk about "voter suppression." Ballot harvesting is legalized in CA — allowing operatives
95 to gather ballots to deliver them to polling places but there are zero controls on this, no
96 way to know if these "harvesters" are even delivering the ballots, or that they are not
97 tampering with them. It's a felony in some states, ought to be here — the voter fraud in
98 California is appalling — illegal aliens vote in this state, they are encouraged to vote in
99 this state, Democrats are calling for the laws to be changed to allow non-citizens to vote
100 throughout America — your country is being taken away from you by radical Democrats
101 —

102 They are so angry that Trump beat Hillary that they have gone insane—

103 Exhibit G2 — they want to stack the court — that's right. They want to stop all judicial
104 appointments until Democrats have control of both houses so they can control who gets
105 appointed to the courts. We are in war — my friends. I hope it stays political — but check
106 your history. There is a coup afoot in this country; it's been in the offing for a long time —
107 but it's coming out into the open now. The Constitution allows the nationally elected
108 President to appoint Judges and the Senate to advise and consent — this has ALWAYS
109 been understood to mean the Senate evaluates the candidates in terms of their
110 qualifications and not according to their own ideological agenda. The idea is that the
111 nationally elected office would more fairly represent the sentiments, values, and so forth
112 of the majority of the citizens. So it was considered appropriate to defer to the nominees
113 of a President unless there was a clear reason to be concerned with his or her
114 qualifications.

115 We have two entirely different Americas today. Anyway, the Democrats want to
116 fundamentally change America into a socialist country where the government grants
117 special privilege rights to certain groups, and uses those rights to attack groups they hate
118 — Christians and Jews. They want to grant special rights to homosexuals that position
119 Christians against the laws so they can justify persecuting them.

120 It's HAMAN all over again. Make a law the Christians cannot obey, then use it to justify
121 destroying them.

122 Exhibit H— but they also practice wanton voter fraud. I already mentioned the blanket
123 disenfranchisement of voters in the States of Washington and New Jersey who are
124 effectively being told they cannot vote for Trump in 2020. The border policy of
125 Democrats has one strategic purpose — bring in as many illegals who are not concerned
126 about breaking out laws for entry and will want to protect their status here and so will
127 have no conscience at all about breaking our voter laws — THEY DON'T RESPECT OUR
128 BORDER LAWS WHY RESPECT OUR VOTER LAWS.

129 They violate our border laws because they want to get in, why would not violate our voter
130 laws to stay?

131 There is a national emergency on the border — true enough that MS-13 gang members
132 are allowed in for so-called "sanctuary" and then they commit murder while here —
133 recently, one guy was arrested something like six times and released into our
134 communities, and over in San Jose he brutally murdered a woman: ENOUGH~ and you
135 are probably mystified why the Democrats don't want to do anything about this border
136 situation? VOTES, BABY, IT'S ABOUT VOTES.

137 You are talking about a party that characteristically disrespects the rule of law.
138 Disrespects our law enforcement, disrespects laws — Obama, picked and chose which
139 laws he would enforce — the country is polarized between two opposing world views, two
140 diametrically opposite ideologies — it's ALL about who gets power next.

141 I've got about five more Exhibits, but only time for one more and then the closing
142 statement.

143 Exhibit M — 35 Muslim America training camps operate in the US today. They are
144 training for war. Some intel has surfaced saying some of them have weapons of mass
145 destruction. If you thought they were done on 9-11, you are simply wrong. That was their
146 opener — Bush II held them off and pushed them back hard. Obama began a new
147 approach — Hillary was going to finish it off, but she lost. They are becoming impatient
148 and want to overthrow this government — these terrorist cells, I think that's exactly what
149 they are, a powder keg that can blow up anytime. And you have GUN BAN BERNIE out
150 there doing everything he can to disarm the American citizen.

151 So, you put it together. Here is what you must do. And these are not in an order of
152 importance, I'll tell you what I think is the number one most important thing to do in a
153 moment. You need be informed and not be afraid of the truth about what's going on.

154 Get informed — get prepared! You should have some food stored and you should do
155 what Jesus told you to do and arm yourself for self-defense. You should VOTE — and
156 you should actively recruit others who are like-minded to VOTE. You should work to
157 convince your friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors to VOTE and to VOTE for
158 America as founded, FOR the protection of unborn babies, FOR securing our borders.
159 You should get informed, get prepared, vote, teach others, use your influence wisely, and
160 you should identify groups that are making a difference and get behind them. Judicial

161 Watch is getting things done, President Trump is getting things done. Levin, Rush,
162 Hannity, Crowder, Bongino, Pirro, Allie, and many others, you need to actively support
163 these people. Promote the Brain Massage show, like it, repost it, encourage others to tune
164 in — and others like it. If you are a pastor, get involved in Awake America, and Capital
165 Connection — these are people who are making a difference. It will take sacrifice and
166 commitment and persistence. But, THE NUMBER ONE MOST IMPORTANT THING
167 YOU CAN DO IS PRAY — prayer and fasting, engage in spiritual warfare. Get my book

170 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,
171 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church
172 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
173 liberty.

174 The accusation that Trump is racist is bogus. You probably know that. But, unless they
175 can get something they can use to convince Americans their witch hunt found one, or
176 unless Adam Shifty can concoct something, but first they'll need to deal with the recent
177 revelations out of Ukraine that their Director Of Anti-Corruption Bureau attempted to
178 interfere with US Elections on behalf of — Hillary! So! I think this racism business is
179 going to be a major part of the Democrat Parties assault on him coming into the most
180 important election in America's history — the election of 2020.

181 First off, it's not like Trump needs us to defend him on this charge — he does a great job
182 handling it himself. In November last year, during a press conference this nonsense was
183 thrown at him — about him making "racist" comments. He denied having ever made any
184 racist comment — and he turned it on the reporter and accused him of asking a "racist
185 question." Because Trump identified himself as defending national interests over
186 international interests, some took his comments as if he were declaring himself to be an
187 ideological Nationalist. No doubt he shares many views in common with Nationalists, so
188 do I and so does anyone who loves America — but that does not make one a
189 "Nationalist." Anyway, Trump explained this — that he was saying as opposed to being a
190 globalist, he believes it is his responsibility to represent America's interests. When accused
191 of using "racist language behind closed doors" — he said he had never used racist
192 language —

193 Another reporter asked him whether he regretted running an ad connecting those seeking
194 asylum in the US with an undocumented criminal that had been convicted of killing
195 police officers in California. You've got to love Trump for his candor and simple honesty.
196 He says, "Do I regret it? I'm surprised you asked the question. I do not." He believes we
197 are foolish to allow the horde gathering at our border to come into our country so long as
198 we have illegal aliens here killing our citizens. Amen!

199 There is an idea for you. Stop all immigration until we get the illegals here under control,
200 and out of here. No body else from Mexico can come in until the illegals are gone.

201 Here, *Politico* editorializes: "Although he has repeatedly denied using racist language,
202 Trump has repeatedly called Sen. Elizabeth Warren (D—Mass.), 'Pocahontas.'" That's

203 what they call racism. This guy probably also believes the Tomahawk Chop used by
204 football fans was racist — there is nothing racist about such statements. But you'll have to
205 go back and revisit my comments defining racism and we can't do that now. I mean,
206 Pocahontas was a famous personality in our history, and we use these sorts of statements
207 regularly — people are way too sensitive these days. It's a joke because Elizabeth Warren
208 is a joke, not because Pocahontas is. You understand? I mean, suppose someone claimed
209 to be related to George Washington, and it was discovered that he had virtually zero
210 genetic connection to Washington and someone quipped, jokingly, *yeah, you know*
211 *'George' over there*. That would not be taken as disparaging remark about George
212 Washington, it would be understood for what it was — a jab at the fake who tried to make
213 himself somebody by making a false claim.

214 Like calling Al Gore *Mr. Internet*. During this briefing, while these reporters were doing
215 all they could to pin the kick me sign on Trump's back, by trying to get him to admit he
216 was racist — a Japanese reporter asked a question. Trump noticed his accent, but wasn't
217 sure if it was Korean, Japanese, or whatever, so he asked the reporter where he was from.
218 The reporter told him, and Trump, in a really friendly way, said, "Say hello to the
219 Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe" — and so it's a joke. A light moment; why are
220 liberals so thin skinned — does anyone think for a moment that if under similar
221 circumstances Trump was asked where he was from and the response included a jocular
222 comment like this that he would be offended? He concluded by remarking on how sad it
223 was that the media were so hostile toward him.¹

224 Okay, so you are almost certainly going to run into this accusation as we proceed into the
225 2020 and you should be prepared to respond. Now, if he is racist, that should be pointed
226 out. But these guys try to make a case that does not stand on merit. Only someone who
227 wants to believe it could possibly take seriously what these guys call "the definitive list" or
228 Trump's racism.²

229 We left off after I addressed the charge that Trump is a racist because he led the charge on
230 Obama's birth certificate scandal. I pointed out that there are substantive reasons to
231 suspect Obama was attempting to cover up some anomaly related to his birth and the
232 evidence for this is very compelling. But regardless of the truth about Obama's birth,
233 calling this into question with Obama was no more racist than when these questions were
234 raised about McCain, or Cruz. It's just so WRONG-HEADED to include something like
235 this in a list that is supposed to be evidence of Trump's racism and it proves the whole
236 exercise is a sham. It demonstrates how far the left has to reach, is willing to stretch, to get
237 something, anything, they can use to turn public sentiment against President Trump.
238 Who continues, in spite of it all, to ride very healthy job approval ratings; something they
239 simply do not understand and can't stand.

240 All right, let's take it from here.

241 Next, "Trump called Obama (who was editor in chief of the Harvard Law Review) 'a
242 terrible student, terrible.'" Again, how does that make someone racist? This should
243 disturb every freedom, free speech, and freedom of thought loving American very deeply.
244 These people are saying that if the subject is black, you can't have any opinion about him
245 that is negative, that if you do, it means you are racist. And here, we go back to Obama's
246 refusal to open his records for public scrutiny. He refused to allow us to see his academic
247 records. We still don't know why.

248 Besides that, the testimony we received from those who knew him in school, and, by the
249 way, from his own book, indicates that he was not a good student. So, whether Trump is
250 right or wrong in his assumptions about Obama, they were constructed upon rumors that
251 circulated during that time about him, and there was never one time that Trump, or
252 anyone else I know, said Obama must have been a bad student, after all, look at the guy,
253 he is black you know! Watch for some devil to edit this and make it out that I made that
254 statement. One of the most brilliant scientists in America's history was a black man with
255 the name George Washington Carver. Ben Carson is one of the most brilliant surgeons in
256 America today, and Trump loves the guy. Come on!

257 The next one, let's see; here we go. "Trump frequently claimed that Obama did not work
258 hard as president." Well, that's my opinion, so does that make me a racist? Really? The
259 only motivation anyone could have for having such an opinion about Obama would be
260 because he is black — well, sort of. Half white, actually. But, truthfully, that does not
261 matter — do you really believe the only basis Trump had for his conclusion that Obama
262 was not a hard working president was because he was black?

263 I wonder if you get what I'm getting at. If it's true that the only basis anyone could have to
264 think Obama was not a hard working president was that he is black — I don't know! Isn't
265 THAT RACISM? Leonhardt and Philbrick are racist to hear someone criticize Obama's
266 work ethic in the White House and immediately go there. I remember the stories coming
267 out about Obama's work ethic — every time I turned around the guy was on a vacation or
268 playing golf. We never had such a golf pro wannabe in the White House. This guy
269 practically lived on the golf course. I understand with technology being what it is a fellow
270 can get a lot of work done and stay in touch pretty well wherever he is, but there are many
271 things you need to be in the office to tend to — and besides, golf requires a considerable
272 amount of concentration, for even the best players, and I was not comfortable with the
273 idea that the President spent more time on the golf course than he did in the White
274 House — I'm just sayin' and I get that I might be mistaken, and I get it that this is a
275 personal opinion, and I get it, I get it, okay! But I remember Bush coming to the place
276 where he said he realized that so long as he had soldiers deployed he did not think it was a
277 good idea to be out playing golf — it simply speaks of a different view of his job — and I
278 feel like Obama was way less serious about his job — so call it what you will, but *racist*?
279 What does that have to do with anything.

280 I hear a story about Obama being briefed on Benghazi, and yawning, and off to bed,
281 because he had an early T time, or, no, it was an early political fund raising event the next

282 day — so, anyway, the guy who immediately thinks racism is behind everything is almost
283 always the racist.

284 Next: "Trump falsely claimed that President Obama 'issued a statement for Kwanzaa but
285 failed to issue one for Christmas.'" You are certainly beginning to see this for yourself.
286 The only people reading this and responding to each of these allegation with agreement
287 that this proves Trump is racist already thought so, they already believe it, and don't need
288 any evidence to support it. This is nonsense.

289 But, let's take a look. Yes, it's true that Obama issued a statement for Kwanzaa, and a big
290 deal was made of this, by Obama. Because of other statements that came from the White
291 House, and from the Democrats during that time that made Merry Christmas trigger
292 words for fist fight — yeah! I'm not kidding. More than once during the Obama years, I
293 thought someone to whom I said Merry Christmas was going to bite my head off — or
294 try! hehe

295 I watched near physical fights break out when some liberals would get all hot and angry
296 and rudely snap back, *happy holiday*. I mean, with a sneer, and even a bit of teeth
297 grinding. It was bad.

298 And I remember that indeed Obama did not release a formal, from the White House,
299 Merry Christmas to the American people, but did, from the White House, issue a formal
300 Happy Kwanzaa — so, you can't pull that on me. I remember his "Happy Holiday" card
301 with a picture of his dog, Bo. And the fact that he avoided using the expression Merry
302 Christmas in any formal way as President, even though he did use it in personal
303 appearances, and so on. But he went out of his way to make a formal statement about
304 Kwanzaa — and it's because that was Obama's thing. To tweak "White America" to stand
305 beside what he considered was the "little guy" in America and side with them against
306 America — he did that regularly.

307 Okay, so Trump picked up on the news cycle of his day, and responded to it like a good
308 ole red blooded American — and connected with how so many traditional Americans felt
309 about all this. But the bottom line here, in what way is this a racist thing to do. Okay?
310 Look! Is it racist to point out that Obama went out of his way to say happy Kwanzaa but
311 avoided making formal proclamations about Christmas, or, when he did, avoided using
312 the word Christmas? Again, don't throw all the time he mentioned the word personally;
313 I'm talking about as President of the US — he tended to go out of his way to identify with
314 those who for one reason or another hated America. Do you understand that Kwanzaa is
315 a racist thing. It's about anger at the White man, and refusal to identify with his customs
316 and holidays. But our insistence that we do is not racist because it is the custom of our
317 country since it's inception.

318 Okay, so that takes through about half the arguments presented in this "definitive list"
319 proving Trump is a racist. We'll continue next time.

320 Trump might be one of the most sincere Presidents we've ever had, the most immune
321 President to the manipulation of the left — and probably the most honest all around. Pray
322 for him and his family, our Vice President, all the cabinet — and as I mentioned at the

323 close of the first segment: get informed, inform others, vote and influence others to vote,
324 find people making a difference and get behind them to increase their effectiveness, and
325 above all things PRAY.

326 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me know if you see them.
327 It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE ON and you will ride like Revere and spread
328 the warning, (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say LIGHTS
