10 Buellton's Industrial Eatery is not likely the sort of place many would use to reward Mom

12 The restaurant owners decided to make a statement with their sandwiches — at least one
13 of them. I forget what it's called, but they included a message with the sandwich — F
14 Trump —.

15 Who are these people? They talk about inclusiveness, and rail against bigotry and
16 prejudice, and intolerance — but they have no tolerance of Trump supporters, they are
17 bigoted against Trump supporters, and prejudiced against us — Look, the liberals are
18 militant, vicious, and resort to bullying and physical attacks — it's getting very
19 concerning. There is no way I would ever eat and an establishment that decided to target
20 for bullying and name calling any group — I mean if Chic-Fil-A decided to add a message
21 to their meals that said F Pelosi, or anything like that — I'd steer clear of any
22 establishment that was operated by such vile, and vulgar, and mean spirited people. No

26 When is this going to stop on the left — this craziness?

27 Adam Schiff is deranged — you know, it's like the entire Democrat Party (at least the
28 leadership) is OCD when it comes to Trump. They exhibit all the symptoms. They simply
29 cannot let go of their hatred of Trump — and for what? For beating Hillary! That's it!
30 Before he beat Hillary, most liberals tolerated him, and even liked him. Especially if he
31 gave them money.

32 So now this group boasts they have 10 million signatures calling for Trump to be
33 impeached. Yeah! They probably got them from the same place Hillary got most of her
34 votes — probably from the same place Newsome got his votes here in California — about
35 100,000 came in across our border over the last month or so — and you understand what

36 I'm saying! 10 million signatures? Okay, I refuse to believe there are 10 million brain dead
37 idiots in America, even today. Let's hope not. Impeach him FOR WHAT?

38 Here is an example of how stupid these people are. I'm trying to find any chargeable
39 offenses that would lead to impeachment: here is something from a left wing group called
40 The Action Network — " We have reached this point already - articles of
41 impeachment need to be drawn up against President Donald
42 Trump. And we all know this process would have already started if
43 Trump had been successful in firing special prosecutor Mueller,
44 as it's now clear he tried to do in June of 2017 and again in
45 December 2017."¹ You can't impeach a President for exercising his
46 powers under the Constitution.

47 What has become CLEAR is that Mueller SHOULD HAVE BEEN
48 FIRED. Bits and pieces are surfacing that when put together paint a
49 picture that is deeply disturbing. We knew it was bad, but I'm
50 afraid we were only looking at what they call the tip of the iceberg.

51 Evidence is surfacing that suggests Mueller involved Steele and
52 Fusion GPS in his attempt to find collusion between Trump and
53 Russia. We know he incorporated much of the Steele report into
54 his report in ways suggesting they support suspicion about
55 Trump's involvement. In one case, in a footnote, Mueller slips in a
56 reference to a text Cohen received from a Russian business man
57 suggesting support for the allegation that Russia had
58 "compromising tapes" of Trump with Russian hookers — that
59 business man is Giorgi Rtskhiladze, an American from Georgia,
60 Russia, has directed his lawyers to demand a retraction of that
61 footnote because Mueller left out a little something from that text.
62 The fact that Girogi stipulated in the text that HE DID NOT
63 BELIEVE ANY SUCH TAPES EXISTED, which is corroborated by
64 the fact that no evidence of their existence has ever surfaced.

65 I told you that the Mueller report is political propaganda —
66 Mueller could not find anything to justify charges of collusion, and

67 he could not find anything more than circumstantial evidence, and
68 weak circumstantial evidence at that, to support any charge of
69 obstruction — every complaint Trump made against the Mueller
70 investigation has proved to BE TRUE — you can't be faulted for
71 trying to obstruct INJUSTICE — in fact, that is the President's JOB
72 — his power to fire the prosecutor is Constitutional, and I saw
73 through Mueller's unjust investigation early on, along with many
74 others — he was abusing the office he held and should have been
75 fired FOR CAUSE. So now it turns out that Mueller paid Steele
76 money, tax payer dollars, paid to Steele by Mueller — and on top of
77 that, he hired Fusion GPS to conduct dirt sweeps on Trump — so
78 don't tell me Mueller was not aware of the antics of this company
79 and Mr. Steele —

80 Mr. Mueller was using the Steele Dossier as a road map for his
81 investigation. And that makes sense if you understand what is
82 going on with all of this.

83 Mueller needed to find a way to substantiate the Steele Dossier —
84 that was the basis for the FISA warrants and, now we learn, it was
85 the basis of Mueller's investigation. Yeah! The debunked dossier —
86 Mueller desperately needed to manufacture support for that
87 dossier to save Hillary and Obama from getting tangled up into
88 this mess — Mueller was the fixer, the cleaner — and he could not
89 get it done.

90 Anyway, it's obvious what Mueller is doing with his report — he is
91 trying to give the Dems something, something they can use to keep
92 a cloud of cover for Hillary and Obama.

93 That's why they need to attack Barr — they must! They have no
94 choice. In their world view — Barr is the enemy because Barr has
95 threatened to investigate the very thing they have been trying to
96 cover up.

97 So now they are trying to keep Barr in the ropes while they pile on
98 with one stupid accusation after another.

99 Whose *they*? Come on! You don't know who *they* are? Really? The Clinton machine, man.
100 The Clinton-Obama led *let's transform America* Saul Alinsky style network of nogoodnics
101 connected together by one goal and one mission — pull America out from under God
102 and under tyranny. That's who *they* is!

103 So now they want to charge Barr with obstruction of justice. And all the guy is trying to
104 do is obey the law. He cannot, by LAW make public parts of the Mueller report that are a
105 matter of Grand Jury testimony — it's AGAINST THE LAW —

106 But they keep clamoring for him to release a fully unredacted version of the Mueller
107 report. He has, virtually. First, the one that is made public is 95% unredacted — it's all
108 there. You can't know the names of those who were compelled to give testimony in the
109 Grand Jury and so forth because their identities are PROTECTED BY LAW. He is
110 required by LAW to hold back information included in an ongoing matter, or
111 investigation. But members of the house intelligence committee have seen 98% of the
112 report — and he has offered to allow some bi-partisan committee to see all of it — you
113 cannot get more cooperative than Barr has been.

114 I mean, not without breaking the LAW — now, here is the dirty little secret. Adam Schiffy
115 knows there is nothing under the color coded black out sections that proves Trump
116 colluded with Russia or that proves he obstructed justice, or even tried to obstruct justice.
117 This is a ruse.

118 They need to keep the suspicion alive into the 2020 election — they desperately need their
119 support base to keep on believing Trump obstructed justice — or they will simply have no
120 voter base in 2020.

121 That's one part of this. The other part is they need to under any remotely plausible
122 pretense, keep up the attack. They cannot allow Barr to get too concentrated on his
123 investigation into the origins of the investigation — I'm telling you folks, only one thing
124 makes any sense out of how ridiculously OCD the Democrat leadership is about this
125 Mueller report and the whole obstruction issue — the truth exposes Hillary and Obama.
126 I'm growing increasingly convinced of that the more crazy the Dems act about all of this.

127 Look, even one of their own, a liberal law professor, considers the effort to build a
128 contempt case against Barr is ludicrous, at best, and self-defeating for the Democrats.
129 Jonathan Turley, Law Professor and champion of Progressive causes — is at least willing
130 to be honest about this.

131 He said, "Barr promised to release as much of the report as possible, and he has
132 delivered." He tries to explain to his Progressive counterparts in the political arena that
133 this could backfire on them in a big way. He explained to them that Barr "is not expressly
134 given the authority to release the confidential report." But Barr released it anyway. Turley,
135 Progressive Law Professor, went on to explain that "the key obstruction portion of the
136 report is virtually unredacted." He tries to tell his Progressive friends that only 8% of the

137 public report was redacted," and "the sealed version of the report given to Congress only
138 had 2% redacted." The only material redacted is grand jury material — that's it.

139 Do the Democrats, like Adam Schiffy and the rest really believe the smoking gun they are
140 looking for is in the redacted Grand Jury testimony?

141 The Law Professor is incredulous — befuddled by his fellow Progressives obtuseness —
142 obtusity — that's obesity of the brain — their fat headed unyielding obsession to continue
143 this charade — now, you should know, that's my description of what I'm reading here —
144 the Professor seems bewildered by the inanity of it all: "So Congress now will ask a court
145 to find civil contempt for Barr refusing to release grand jury information." In other
146 words, the irony is this — the Democrat controlled Congress is asking a court to rule Barr
147 in contempt for OBEYING THE LAW. Barr is in contempt for OBEYING THE LAW.
148 This is the new Democrat party for you. If you OBEY THE LAW, they hold you in
149 contempt.

150 Mr. Turley, law professor, remembered what the Democrats were trying to do to Barr
151 during the confirmation hearings. He remembers trying to explain to them than that Barr
152 cannot promise to break the law in order to get their confirmation for his nomination —
153 but that is what they were trying to do. He said, "I testified that they were asking Barr to
154 commit a potential criminal act to secure his own confirmation."

155 So now the President has stepped in, again, to protect the JUSTICE SYSTEM in this
156 country, to PROTECT the RULE OF LAW and he has invoked executive privilege over
157 the Mueller report in order to protect Barr from these foolish contempt allegations.

158 Rosenstein saw the entire report, he is a folk hero of the left — he is no friend to Trump,
159 he cannot be called a sycophant, he is not a Trump supporter, he is a liberal — he saw the
160 redacted portions of the report, he knows what was redacted, he signed off on the
161 conclusion there was nothing there to support a charge of Russian Collusion and nothing
162 sufficiently substantial to support a charge of obstruction — and, by the way, no one has
163 offered any justification to suppose Barr is "working for Trump."

164 Barr is well known for his independence, and integrity.

165 Rosenstein appointed Mueller and defended his investigation all the way — he stood by
166 him even when his boss, who had the power to fire him, was sending signals of serious
167 dissatisfaction about his handling of Mueller — he became a folk hero of the left — he
168 saw the redactions, and having seen the redactions, he signed off on the conclusion that
169 there was NOTHING IN THE REPORT that was ACTIONABLE against Trump.

170 And the point is, as I prepare to take a short break — the point is the Democrats know
171 full well there is nothing redacted that gives them any thing — they know this — but
172 Adam Shifty, along with Pelosi and the others, keep kicking up dust about Barr's refusal
173 to release an unredacted report — when they know he CAN'T by LAW do that. But you
174 see they NEED to keep the smoke covering Hillary and Obama's escape from justice as
175 thick as possible and keep suppressing fire on Barr and the department to protect
176 Obama's and Hillary's cover until the 2020 when they hope they can organize enough
177 voter fraud to pull off the coup they've been working on since Trump took office.

181 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
182 liberty.

188 I'm troubled by what happened in Colorado last week, Tuesday — in Highland Park,
189 which, I think that's part of, or very near Littleton, where the massacre took place that in
190 many ways started all this. It's Mother's Day this Sunday — and I can't begin to imagine
191 what the Mother's in that town are feeling right now.

192 Our hearts are heavy with the news from Colorado — another school shooting. This time
193 1 was killed and 8 wounded. The shooters are students of the school one is 18 and the
194 other is 16, she is a transgendered girl-to-boy thing going on there. There is much we
195 don't know yet — what was their relationship, why they decided to target the charter
196 school there in Colorado — except we do know that the tranny-kid posted an "I hate
197 Christians that hate gays" thing on social media. I looked at it, and it appears to me she
198 believes all Christians hate gays — .

199 However, we don't know whether the two would be Columbine copy-cats were going to
200 go from student to student asking, "are you a Christian," and then shooting them is they
201 said yes — because, some brave young men charged the shooters before they could begin
202 any planned executions.

203 Brendan Bialy (Bi-al-le) and Kendrick Castillo - 18. These two were sitting near the
204 classroom door when a student walked in late and pulled a gun. Castillo rushed the
205 gunman immediately, and pinned him against the wall. He was shot, and I don't know if
206 Brendan was wrestling the gun from the second shooter or followed up on Castillo's
207 attack — this article does not say which shooter was attacked by which of these students
208 — but I'm assuming Castillo attacked Devon. From another article, it is clear that Castillo
209 initiated the defensive action, and was shot, and two other students moved in on one of
210 the shooters, Bialy wrestled the gun from him and another pinned him — also, a security
211 guard the school had hired, rushed into the room from another part of the campus, but
212 got there in time to disarm and detain the second shooter — 8 students were wounded,
213 but some of these wounds were not gun shots — from what I can gather — after Bialy got
214 the gun from the shooter he was wrestling, he went to check on Castillo but found him
215 dead from the gun shot —

216 These two Colorado killers certainly intended to kill several students when they started
217 their attack — they were not expecting to face these brave students — We don't know
218 how many lives Castillo saved last Tuesday — but you know every parent of a child in

219 that school, especially of every student in that classroom will be eternally grateful for the
220 courage of these young heroes, and for the sacrifice of Kendrick Ray Castillo.

221 The presence of the armed guard, and the willingness of Brendan Bialy and Kendrick Ray
222 Castillo to put their own lives at risk and stand up to these killers saved lives — and I
223 appreciate the effort on the part of media to avoid reporting on this in a way that brings a
224 lot of attention to the killers, and dramatizes their actions as if they did something
225 warranting significant mention.

226 During the vigil when the students gathered to console one another and seek some
227 comfort in the grief that united them — some Denver Democrats tried to hi-jack the
228 occasion to push their political agenda — they tried to make it all about guns, and the
229 need for gun control — although none of them could say how any gun law would have
230 stopped what happened. The students, many of them, began chanting "mental health,
231 mental health" — and a significant number of the students, deeply offended that these
232 politicians were trying to exploit their grief for their own political agenda, left the vigil
233 and made their own — elsewhere. That was a serious slap in the face of the gun control
234 group that was there trying to turn the shocking and horrible atrocity into — well, you
235 know how the Democrats think these days — they wanted to take full advantage of a
236 crisis because it would be a shame to let such a crisis go to waste. Right?

237 Let's do some more work on the Definitive List Of Proofs That Trump Is Racist —

238 And then, next, on the point that Trump is friendly with proud racists and White
239 Nationalists — "Trump hired Steve Bannon as his campaign head and later White House
240 chief strategist. Under Bannon's leadership, the website Breitbart made white nationalism
241 a central theme. It featured a section, for example, on 'black crime.'"

242 If anyone should know something about extremists embedding themselves within your
243 organization and creating problems for your party it would be, well, the DEMOCRATS,
244 ya think?

245 Bannon did not come into the Trump organization because he was a white racist, it was
246 because he had some brilliant ideas about campaign strategy — that it turned out he had
247 another agenda is not something that should be laid at Trump's feet, especially since, HE
248 GOT FIRED! These people are too much. Feinstein has a spy for China on staff for years
249 — no one decides Feinstein was complicit with China, do they? Of course not. AOC has
250 taken center stage in the Democrat party, much to the chagrin of Dem leaders, who are
251 not sure what to do about her. And an avowed Communist, Bernie Sanders is a very

257 Okay, get technical with me — libs love to get very legalistic when it comes to holding
 258 their opponents hostage to their own ideals: he resigned, I know. Right! Yeah, he
 259 resigned. Unreal!

260 And then finally, on proofs Trump is friendly toward proud racists and white nationalists
 261 — this is offered as their last proof: "Trump endorsed and campaigned for Roy Moore,
 262 the Alabama Senate candidate who spoke positively about slavery and who called for an
 263 African-American Muslim member of Congress not to be seated because of his religion."
 264 Well, now, that brings us full circle, does it not?

265 Trump's endorsement of Roy Moore would be problematic if you believe all the lies the
 266 media told about Roy Moore. He has no sympathy for slavery — to take a remark he
 267 made in which he effectively said at one time in history, black families were strong, even
 268 though it was a time of slavery, at least their families were strong, and construe that as a
 269 soft endorsement of slavery is like saying when Obama said Christians in the fly over
 270 country cling to God and their guns was an endorsement of antichrist bigotry and liberal
 271 snobbery — with one important difference.

272 When Moore made his comment about the general break down in the American black
 273 family, something Candace recently spoke to, telling us in the 60s single parent mothers
 274 were 23% and now they are 74% of all black households — and blaming Democrat
 275 policies for it, and rightly so, by the way — he was lamenting a reality, he was in fact not
 276 even talking about slavery as an issue, when slavery as an issue comes up, he is adamant
 277 and clear in his denunciation every time — and furthermore, to claim Moore is racist
 278 because he acknowledges the challenges presented by the 10th and 14th amendments on
 279 Constitutional grounds, again, does not make him racist. He has never advocated taking
 280 away the right of blacks to vote — that's never the context in which that conversation
 281 takes place — but the liberals like to twist every thing into race because, like Candace said,
 282 that's how the liberals keep control of the Black and Hispanic vote. Every four year trot
 283 out there and shout, vote for Democrats because Republicans are racist — when that is a
 284 LIE.

285 However, beyond all of that — Trump's endorsement of Roy Moore was not an
 286 endorsement of racism, first, because even if he was racist, none of these lies about him
 287 began to come out until he ran for Senate, so at the time Trump endorsed him, these
 288 things had only just begun to come out and they had not been proved, because Trump's
 289 reason for endorsing Moore was that, at the time, it certainly looked like he was going to
 290 win, and more importantly, because he was certain Moore would be an ally in the Senate.

291 Okay, I'm sure it's becoming more and more clear to you — and thank God for the help
 292 we are getting from people like Alen West and Candace Owens, and Diamond and Silk,
 293 and many more — I'm hopeful. It's just that we had better pray, and fast and pray, that
 294 the election will be honest and fair —that voter fraud will not be a determining factor
