1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the Lighthouse Baptist Church in
2 Santa Maria, CA—and your brain masseur—it's time for your brain massage.

3 [TRUTH]

4 Memorial Day! A day we pause to reflect on the price of liberty. Originally called
5 Decoration Day, because after the Civil War some mothers, wives, mostly, some fathers,
6 and sons, too, who lost loved ones in that awful war visited graves and decorated them in
7 memory of the fallen. This caught on, and spread, until there were family gatherings for
8 the occasion and then parades, and speeches, and this was done in the beginning of
9 summer and has come to mark the beginning of that season for us here in the US.

10 On May 5, 1868, General Logan, as leader of Northern Civil War veterans called for a
11 nationwide remembrance to be held the 30th day of May, 1868. Communities were
12 encouraged to decorate graves of fallen soldiers in the Civil War. So it began as a
13 memorial of the fallen in that war, and it was called Decoration Day.

14 On the first Decoration Day, General James Garfield made a speech at Arlington National
15 Cemetery — 5,000 gathered to decorate the 20,000 graves of Union and Confederate
16 soldiers buried there.

17 Over time, the observance came to be called Memorial Day.

18 The Southern States organized their observance for a separate day — until after WWI.

19 After WWI, Memorial Day was expanded to include a remembrance of all soldiers fallen
20 in battle to protect liberty.

21 WWII increased the value of this remembrance, and discovery of the Holocaust added to
22 the regard we have for those who died in service to humanity, to justice, and so increased
23 the solemnity of the occasion — at least formally. Informally, most Americans take it as
24 another excuse to revel, shamefully, in some respects. But at least officially, I mean by our
25 President, Congress, and the Judiciary, and especially our Military, the day is taken very
26 seriously — as it should be.

27 In 1968, Congress moved to establish the last Monday of May as Memorial Day — and
28 made it a national holiday. The idea was to make it a *three-day holiday* for Federal
29 workers. That was likely the beginning of the trivialization of the holiday — it became a
30 three day weekend for partying. That's too bad. Incidentally, this was a year after America
31 ruled it was unconstitutional to lead children in prayer in the public schools. Not even a
32 moment of silence was permitted. And not even though no one was *forced or compelled*
33 to participate — of course, today, our children are led to recall the Islam conversion prayer
34 — she had already been subjected to listening to her teacher belittle Christianity and
35 elevate Islam, speaking disparagingly against her faith while praising Islam — when the

36 opposite ought to be done — but, that aside for the moment — you see what happens
37 when you create a vacuum — something else moves it to fill it.

38 But we are talking about Memorial Day, aren't we?

39 We think of *holiday* as a festive occasion; and many are. But the word actually comes
40 from *holy day* and can include a solemn observance. Anyway, the new law went into
41 effect in 1971, and we immediately went into a depression that nearly destroyed our
42 economy led by a President who was ready to throw in the towel on the American Dream.

43 Happily, Christians stirred themselves, and prayed, and voted, and we got Reagan. Pulled
44 us back from the brink, but the left never lets up, and they worked diligently until they
45 brought us right up to the brink again with Obama — and the Christians prayed, and
46 voted in great numbers, and it pulled us back from the brink again.

47 We are coming into the 2020 election and it's the most important election in the history
48 of this nation — and all God fearing patriots are called upon to step up to their
49 responsibilities. Speak the TRUTH against the LIES that are blinding Americans,
50 especially our young Americans —

51 I understand 43% of Americans today believe Socialism is a good thing for America. That
52 changes significantly when socialism is explained to them.

53 Reminds me of a young lady who attended a church where I served as an assistant pastor.
54 She was in college, and I asked her some questions about what courses she liked and she
55 made a statement that alerted me she was confused about conservative versus liberal
56 political ideologies. So I asked her if she was a socialist. She thought about it, really hard,
57 and said, Yes! I asked her why. She explained that she was a very sociable person and
58 liked socializing. She said this to me seriously — she was not joking! That was a while
59 back — then I struggled to keep from laughing out loud — but now, I'm not laughing at
60 all.

61 I have an article here about a college kid who was asked if she believed redistribution of
62 wealth was a good thing? You know, taking from those who have more than they need
63 and giving it to people who have less than they need.

64 This sounded reasonable to the young lady until she was challenged to make a personal
65 application of this principle.

66 She happened to be a very good student, got straight As in fact. So she was asked, would
67 you be happy with a school policy that took points from your scores and distributed them
68 to students who were struggling to get passing scores? She was appalled at the notion that
69 the school would take points she earned and redistribute them to students who did not
70 earn them — she was encouraged to rethink her position.

71 One of the things our soldiers died to preserve was our right to keep what is ours — we
72 fought The *National Socialist German Worker's Party* in WWII. Remember? By the way,
73 that's what the word *Nazi* means: *National Socialist German Worker's Party*. Many try to
74 say Hitler was not a *socialist* "in any meaningful way," but that's a lie. He believed in
75 government control of capital and the means of production. And he illustrates one of the

76 great dangers of that system. If you get a "strong man" in control of the government, you
77 have a virtual dictator. But it is a dictatorship system any way it's organized.

78 The bottom line in a socialist society is that private ownership of capital and means of
79 production is granted by the State — so certain people get to decide who owns what, and
80 for how long, and controls what you do with what you own so that in truth you don't own
81 it — the STATE DOES. It's a ruse. The trick is to say it's collective ownership when in fact
82 is POLITICIAN'S OWNERSHIP.

83 The difference between communism and socialism is that in communism there is no
84 pretense about private ownership — in socialism, there is a pretention of private
85 ownership; but capital and property are so much under the control of government
86 bureaucracy the reality is it's OWNED by government and not by individuals.

87 Here is another dirty little secret about socialism — it is antichrist.

88 Socialism is an economic system is incompatible with a biblical model of economy. It
89 transfers to the State responsibilities God gave to the family and His churches. You will
90 notice that in every socialist country the family and the church are weakened. Socialism
91 attempts provide for needs God ordained should be provided by individual diligence,
92 supported by the family and the church.

93 When the State interjects itself into these things, several negative consequences follow.

94 The first is, people begin looking to the State to meet all their needs rather than to GOD.
95 When the State attempts to be GOD to the people, they have to take more and more
96 control of their resources. At some point this will collapse. Like Margaret Thatcher
97 observed, "socialism is great until you run out of other people's money."

98 God is infinite in His resources; states are finite. God is infinite in His wisdom; states are
99 infinite in their stupidity. Take California for example. Which, although for all intents
100 and purposes, is a socialist State, it is for the present, happily, still checked at least
101 somewhat by the Constitution.

102 Socialism is also militant against the notion of inalienable individual liberties endowed by
103 GOD. In fact, the concept of individual liberties become anathema in virtually every
104 socialist society. Individual liberties are sacrificed on the altar of the "public good," which
105 is decided by the "State" — this puts the State in control of shaping the public morality
106 and values — the State becomes the arbiter of social values and begins to dictate to the
107 conscience of the individual —

108 This becomes a serious problem because it invariably leads to conflicts between
109 individual liberties and the interests of the State. When that happens, the collective power
110 of the State will of course subordinate and squash any individual liberty that is asserted
111 against that interest.

112 It is for this reason that our framers adopted the Bill of Rights — to lay the chains of
113 LIMITATIONS upon the monster called GOVERNMENT — so that creature could not
114 come under the power of the spirit of antichrist and begin trampling down our
115 inalienable rights endowed to us by GOD.

116 And so, in the end of the day, that's what Memorial Day is all about.
117 The men and women who, as Lincoln so aptly put it, laid down the last full measure of
118 devotion on the field of battle to protect our RIGHTS, our individual liberties.
119 Okay — a lot of people don't know that at 3 PM every Memorial Day there is supposed to
120 be a moment of remembrance — . A moment when we all stop, and reflect with gratitude,
121 and remembrance, the many brave patriots whose sacrifice on the field of battle secured
122 for us the rights and liberties that are our birthright as Americans.
123 In Israel, every May 27th, at evening, they begin their memorial of the Holocaust, called
124 Yom Hashoah, with a siren that calls all in Israel to pause, to stop whatever they are
125 doing. It's very moving to see. Every car, even on busy freeways, everyone stops, gets out
126 of their car, and they stand in silence for two minutes while the siren sounds — this is
127 observed throughout the entire country. All work stops, all play, all activity stops.
128 Everyone stands silently for two minutes.
129 We don't have a siren to signal us — but maybe you can set your phone or watch to alarm
130 you at 3 pm on Monday and take a minute or two and get quiet before GOD — and
131 reflect on the price our valiant soldiers have paid for our freedoms, and think too about
132 the price our Heavenly Father paid for our liberty — For God so loved the world that He
133 gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have
134 everlasting life." John 3:16. "And greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down
135 his life for his friends" did you know the context of that famous statement? Jesus followed
136 with "Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you." John 15:13-14.
137 Okay, time for a break. I'll be right back.
138 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse,
139 your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church
140 belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
141 liberty.
142 I trust you will have a meaningful Memorial Day — one way to do that is to visit
143 Lighthouse Baptist Church where we will observe Memorial Day, among other things, by
144 offering a free book about Prayer to every visitor.
145 We are in such a weird place with the demented Dems today. Pelosi, well, this is nothing
146 new from her — she is, well, she is a very sad case. You know, miss, gotta pass it into law
147 so we can find out what is in the law. It's mind blowing — lately she said that President
148 Trump is engaged in a cover up. — . I almost need two minutes of silence to recover from
149 the befuddlement this woman causes me almost every time I hear her speak. Cover up of
150 WHAT?
151 It is becoming increasingly clear that the cover up is on the other side. I guess she must be
152 complicit in that whole mess. I figured she was just sitting atop her turtle underlings
153 enjoying the view from her perch with that "there is nobody home" look on her face —
154 but, apparently, she was in on the conspiracy to cover up Obama's and Hillary's collusion

155 with Ukraine and Russia, and their collusion together to spy on the Trump campaign
156 hoping to get something — are you following what's coming out?

157 I went over the Papadopoulos Papers (that's what he'll have to call the book— right? —
158 well, actually no, but) a while back — it's becoming clear that members of Obama's FBI
159 and CIA were involved in a conspiracy to set him up. We've been over all that, but recent
160 revelations all but confirm this is the correct understanding of the mysterious goings on
161 around Papadopoulos.

162 But Pelosi thinks someone should do something about Trump. Now, I wonder what that
163 means? Here is an article titled: "I, Nancy Pelosi, wish someone would do something
164 about Trump." Pelosi did not say that. At least I can't find any supporting documentation.

165 Some liberal columnist used it as a headline for her article published in the Washington
166 Post.

167 The article is satirical, a spin off Pelosi's pathetic call for someone in the family to "have
168 an intervention for the good of the country."

169 She is mocking the speaker. But it's clear the Washington Post opinion columnist has
170 sympathy, at least, with the idea that something needs to be done, hence the title: "I,
171 Nancy Pelosi, wish someone would do something about Trump."

172 Let's hope some whacked out lefty does not take this as a call to arms. If I worked for the
173 FBI, I'd probably pay this author a visit. In fact, I call for an investigation — this is
174 sufficient evidence to get a FISA warrant to spy on this author and on Pelosi and all her
175 staff — we need to run this down. Sounds like a secret squirrel signal to trigger an
176 assassination attempt on the President. This is serious stuff — get a FISA warrant and spy
177 — oh, I mean surveillance, what was that Comey called it? He said the FBI does not spy.
178 Comey said, The FBI investigates." Then he lays out the Obama/Hillary spin about
179 Russian collusion, which we know never happened, and points to the pathetic propping
180 of Papadopoulos in an effort to construct evidence of collusion, but he did not play nicely
181 into their traps, and so Cooper doubles down on the message of the CNN hour IT'S NOT
182 SPYING when the government does it, "You said it's not spying." — so, allow me to give
183 you an opportunity to spin this out there in a way my supporters and fellow Trump
184 haters can get their head around this — so, why would Barr say such a thing? Watch:
185 "Why do you think Attorney General Barr used the word 'spying' which is OBVIOUSLY
186 THE WORD THE PRESIDENT USED AS WELL?"

187 There you go, all teed up, all Comey has to do is keep his head down and swing smoothly:
188 "The only explanation I can think of is he used it because the president used it, which is
189 really disappointing."

190 So, when the FBI plants bugs in your apartments, listens in on calls, and plants personnel
191 into campaigns to gather information — that's not spying, that's uh, electronic
192 surveillance — oh, so the plants were robots — but anyway, THERE IS A REASON THE
193 GOVERNMENT CAN'T DO THIS THING YOU CALLED ROUTINE SURVEILLANCE
194 ON A CITIZEN WITHOUT GETTING A WARRANT FROM A FISA COURT — and
195 that reason is this —you can't spy on citizens.

196 It is becoming seriously sadly obvious that Left's base are, at least in their opinion, dumb
197 as post. If there was ever a case of you say tomato and I say tomahto — here it is.

198 And Phoney Baloney Comey tries to pass this off as "totally normal" and "reasonable." Are
199 you ready for this.

200 Watch how these guys routinely step into it.

201 Comey says it was reasonable to go for the FISA warrant (without mention of the Dossier,
202 by the way—convenient omission) it was reasonable because the target of the warrant was
203 the guy the Australians told us had talked to "the Russians" — so, "that's a totally normal
204 step (to spy on him). See if you can get somebody close to the person and see if they'll
205 confirm what we heard from the Australians."

206 Okay, so, that means A. they could not trust the intel from the Australians, so they did
207 not ask for any corroboration of their information. They received a rumor — and decided
208 the way to proceed on gathering information about this rumor was to not call him in for
209 questioning, and begin an investigation directly into the evidence provided by the
210 Australians, but rather, SPY on the guy — but, wait, they did not get their warrant to SPY
211 on Papadopoulos — the target was Page, yeah, Carter Page. Hmmmm.

212 In other words, THERE WAS NOT ENOUGH INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE
213 AUSTRALIANS TO TAKE ANY ACTION SO THEY HAD TO SPY ON
214 PAPADOPOULOS IN ORDER TO GET SOME ACTIONABLE INFORMATION.

215 But, for my part YOU NEED ACTIONABLE INTEL TO START SPYING ON AN
216 AMERICAN CITIZEN. Not rumors.

217 Then there is this — you don't contact the Trump organization and say, hey, we have
218 concerns about one of your low level campaign volunteers making contacts with the
219 Russian government and you need to be aware of this? Well, you do unless you have
220 already decided he was acting on Trump's instructions —

221 But if it's your own crowd, then you let Feinstein know that she has a Chinese spy
222 working for her for, what was that, 20 years. They don't go get a spy ring working down
223 on Feinstein's home or offices to make sure she is not in cahoots with the Chinese because
224 she is one of yours and you don't want to create problems — so what all of this shows is
225 that it was a POLITICAL WITCH HUNT from the beginning.

226 And then, on top of all that, Comey puts it out there like Papadopoulos was the target of
227 the spying operation — but that was Carter Page —

228 So what's this about? You hear Papadopoulos interview on ABC and he sounds very
229 forgiving of the FBI and friendly to the whole process, you hear him talk to Bongino or
230 Hannity, and it sound 180 degrees out of phase. The suspicious contact is Mifsud, who
231 introduces Simone to Papadopoulos and they get married in 2018. They think she is a
232 Russian spy — she understands, after all she worked in a diplomat corpse that served as a
233 cover for spies??? Really??? Wow! So she understands why Mueller would investigate her,
234 and Papadop understands why Mueller would look closely at him, but all the mysterious

242 he was set up and it appears he is learning more about how he was being used as the story
243 unfolds — in fact in one interview, I think it was with Hannity, it was clear to me that
244 Papadopoulos was making some discoveries of his own as this all unfolded and that he
245 was becoming increasingly convinced he was being set up to be used as a pawn to bring
246 down Trump.

247 His wife seemed to suggest Papadopoulos sees himself as the first domino in the effort to
248 get Trump.

249 Anyway, I'm still looking at this closely and I'll bring more of it out as this proceeds —

250 But it is painful to watch what the Democrats these days are doing to our country — the
251 country for which so many brave God fearing patriots bled to preserve, and the liberties
252 they died to protect.

253 Remember to pause for a moment of silence before your Creator at 3 pm this Monday.
254 Gather your family together and pause a moment to say prayer of thanksgiving to GOD
255 for our liberties, and for His SON who died for our soul-liberty.

256 Come on by Sunday morning and let's remember together.

258 It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE ON and you will ride like Revere and spread
259 the warning, (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say LIGHTS
260 OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and disagree strongly with me. So, what
