1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the  
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain  
3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

19 Okay, let's go through the teasers. But I think I'll start with Nuevo  
20 California — New Cali!  
21 First, USA Today and CBS have reported on this — and by *this* I  
22 mean the effort to split California. Last election, some brouhaha  
23 was stirred over a proposal to split it into I think it was six states —  
24 which never made it to the ballot. But the two State split has been  
25 around for a while and has lately, as I said, got the attention of USA  
26 Today, CBS and some others — I think the dragon is keeping a

27 wary eye on this movement. Maybe it's beginning to make sense to  
28 enough Californians to actually get some traction.

29 So, in typical Brain Masseur fashion, I stepped into this to take a  
30 look — mostly because some ardent and faithful supporters of the  
31 Brain Massage show recommended it to me.

32 First, we must not confuse the 2019 version of New California with  
33 the earlier 1804 version. From 1804-1824 Northern California was  
34 a province of New Spain. Following the Mexican war for  
35 Independence it became territory of Mexico in 1822. At this time it  
36 was named Alta California. Neither Spain, nor Mexico, ever fully  
37 colonized the land — IT WAS HELD MOSTLY BY INDIGENOUS  
38 PEOPLE. Uh huh! Mexico was not the indigenous people of  
39 California — Spain and Mexico occupied the territory of  
40 indigenous people. It was not until after several "land grants" were  
41 secured from Spain and from Mexico to settlers coming in from  
42 the US did the land actually become settled and established.

43 In 1836 Mexico initiated some reforms that reunited Northern CA  
44 with the Baja — then, in 1848, most of it was ceded to the U.S. in  
45 the treaty of Guadalupe-Hildago. In 1850, California joined the  
46 Union as the 31st state. I was born 101 years later — so, that's  
47 important California history right there, you know. Haha.

48 Anyway, New California — 2019, is different, but in some ways it is  
49 the ongoing story that is California.

50 It's always about representation. The indigenous people were few  
51 and scattered, and often at war with one another. One group  
52 pillaging the villages of another — and busy dancing to various  
53 deities — the spirits in trees, and animals, and so forth, some  
54 groups taking the life of their enemies and drinking their blood to  
55 extend their own lives — with some elements of naturalism mixed  
56 in with their spiritism — some groups had what has been called  
57 peyote religion!

58 To be fair, of course, they fished, and harvested, and hunted, and  
59 made beads, and drew interesting designs, and loved their children,  
60 and their mothers and fathers were honored, in some cases their  
61 spirits worshipped, and — you know! They were people!

62 But they did not form beyond tribal groups living in thatched  
63 shelters — there was no written code of law that we know about, or  
64 defined concepts of property — essentially, the strong man ruled  
65 and the old man judged.

66 So the Spaniards came, found the land virtually desolate, killed any  
67 one there that interfered with their occupation of the land, because,  
68 of course, they were superior to all other people, so they occupied  
69 the land, built structures, and developed it — their investment of  
70 time, talent and treasure in the development of the land was an  
71 investment that added value and established ownership so they  
72 defended against those indigenous people of California who, from  
73 time to time, felt encroached upon, and protested — however, the  
74 indigenous peoples of Mexico being more organized and civilized,  
75 and who formed communities, and cities, and had government  
76 structures in place, resented the occupation of Spain and revolted,  
77 and the Mexican war of Independence was fought because they felt  
78 oppressed by the Spaniards, and then US citizens began coming  
79 into California-Mexico, and Texas Mexico, at the behest of the  
80 Mexican government by the way, and began settling California, but  
81 these US immigrants thought in terms of land grants and land  
82 purchase, and so forth, so they bought the land, or received land  
83 grants from Mexico — and they settled the land, and built  
84 structures and added value to the property — so when the Mexican  
85 government began encroaching on their rights of property and  
86 finally a war broke out, and the US beat Mexico back until they  
87 surrendered, and America gave what is today Mexico to the  
88 Mexican government and through a treaty, Mexico ceded

89 California to the US — and it was a battle over oppression, and  
90 lack of representation, that led to cessation —

91 And now, here we are again. The people of California are feeling  
92 every increasingly resentful of taxation without representation, of  
93 government trampling all over their rights, and encroaching on  
94 their inalienable divinely endowed rights, and first requiring the  
95 citizens to give them their children and the indoctrinating the  
96 children in hateful lies about America as founded and about values  
97 — distorting their souls with tripe about 51 genders — total  
98 nonsense — but worse, because it distorts their understanding of  
99 nature and sets them on a course of conflict with nature's GOD —  
100 so that, today, the values and customs of about 5% of the territory  
101 of California is oppressing the rest of the State, the values of the  
102 densely populated cities such as SFO and LA control the lives of  
103 the rest of Californians who prefer to live in rural areas and shun  
104 the cities — so rural California values are disdained, mocked,  
105 ridiculed, and their rights are dismissed — they are forced to  
106 endure the spectacle of perversity manufactured in Hollywood  
107 which represents the distorted values and beliefs of people who  
108 have nothing but scorn for the values of rural Californians — and  
109 more and more conservative, God fearing Californians are getting  
110 tired have having NO REPRESENTATION, or very little of it, in  
111 Sacramento — so some are beginning to think it's time to break off,  
112 to split the state — to cut their ties, to create two Californias — one  
113 that will be called California and the other New California.

114 So, anyway, I have a great deal of sympathy with the idea but I  
115 cannot find who is leading the charge on this New California  
116 movement, and when I called the number on their website, it went  
117 directly to voice mail, with one of those messages that does not  
118 confirm who you called but only identifies the number you dialed  
119 — so I thought, wow! Okay, so it's probably way under funded, but  
120 to get something like this in flight you will have to do better.

121 Anyway, I'm all for it. But before I set my shoulder to any such  
122 movement, I need to know who is behind it, who is leading the  
123 effort. The website does not offer an about us that identifies its  
124 leadership.

125 Why did Israel ban Omar and Tlaib from entering Israel? The  
126 reason is simple. These members of the Squad are on record for  
127 hate speech against Israel, calling for boycotts against Israel, lying  
128 about Israel and about so-called Palestine. These are United States  
129 Representatives — and they promote anti-Israeli policies and  
130 express anti-Israeli sentiment. We should have a similar policy in  
131 America. If you are waving your Mexican flag and protesting  
132 America while taking a welfare check and getting your free  
133 education and health care — get-out-a here. That's not exactly the  
134 same, but you get the idea. Why should Israel welcome such people  
135 into Israel who are only there to stir up trouble?

136 So, Tlaib gets all weepy about wanting to visit her poor, oppressed  
137 grandmother in "Palestine." Benjamin sends word, oh, you want to  
138 come for humanitarian reasons, sure, come on in to ISRAEL and  
139 visit your grandmother. You say she is oppressed and miserable,  
140 you are welcome to take her to America to live with you. You are  
141 welcome anytime to come and visit your grandmother. Sure, we  
142 want you to come, as you say, so your grandmother can hug you  
143 and kiss you and see you — please, come! Tlaib, well, no, too busy,  
144 can't go. Haha. What a bunch of phonies.

145 Do Omar and Tlaib speak for all American Muslims? Miss Iraq,  
146 Sarah Idan, Muslim, "challenges the long-held media and political  
147 bias that Omar is representative of the American Muslim  
148 community." Miss Iraq, in an interview with Sara Carter, said,  
149 "Omar does not represent me as a Muslim." She said Omar does  
150 not represent millions just like her here, or millions in the Middle  
151 East. She said that in Arab countries, people with the beliefs and  
152 attitudes and sentiments of Omar are called Muslim Brotherhood.

153 Sarah Idan, Miss Iraq, has enough notoriety to encourage other  
154 Muslim leaders to speak up — "Idan drew strong support from  
155 powerful Muslim voices against Islamism."

156 A Muslim journalist that is based in the US challenged Omar to  
157 accept an interview with her — as "One Muslim immigrant woman  
158 to another." Omar, a US Representative, openly and publicly  
159 attacked a moderate, or what is called a Progressive Muslim leader  
160 — which is one that does not promote Islamic subjugation of  
161 America — she outlined three things that differentiate an Islamist  
162 — someone who believes in using force, either political, or force of  
163 arms, to subjugate America to Islam — and someone who is  
164 Muslim but content to live in a pluralistic culture at peace with  
165 other religions. Here are the three things:

166 First: Vitriolic hate for Israel, while blurring or tolerating gross  
167 anti-Semitism alongside sloppy scrutiny of Israeli policies.

168 Second: Absolute **disinterest in good faith engagement** and  
169 dialogue with non-Islamist personalities, particularly Muslim  
170 reformers.

171 Third: Using Western political channels to advance the agenda of  
172 Islamic supremacism, where Islam is narrowly defined by a small  
173 segment of a Muslim demographic. This demographic drives the  
174 public narrative through a visible Muslim identity, which must  
175 currently be seen as oppressed or victimized to gain additional  
176 public favor and tolerance that then reinforces the underlying  
177 supremacism."<sup>1</sup>

178 These Muslims complain that the so-called mainstream media  
179 promote the lie that people like Omar speak for all Muslims in  
180 America and represent Islam around the world.

192 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
193 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
194 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
195 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
196 liberty.

197 Did Epstein kill himself or did the Clinton clean up team get to  
198 him? Raise your hand if, frankly, you don't care! Wow~ And I  
199 understand. However, this is bad news. Epstein had the goods on  
200 some very bad people but now, well, it's like Disney's Pirate ride—  
201 "Dead Men Tell no Tales." Now, how many, and raise your hand  
202 high so I can see it — how many really believe Epstein killed  
203 himself? Hmm. Can't find anyone who believes that.

204 I did hear he was upbeat the day before — told his lawyer, "see you  
205 Sunday" — and talked hopefully about his case. And there is this  
206 thing about one of the bones in his neck was broken consistent  
207 with strangulation — but, it could have happened by the SHEET  
208 noose he allegedly used to kill himself — how do you make a noose  
209 from your sheet and no one sees this going on? And the guards are  
210 under reprimand for not giving diligent attention to the caged

211 pedophile and — well, it's not hard to understand why I can't find  
212 anyone who believes Epstein offed himself.

213 One more question. How many of you have strong suspicions the  
214 Clinton control operatives got to him? Wow — a sea of hands are  
215 up — what's that, there is a couple in the crowd, they look a lot like  
216 Hillary and Bill — oh my, they are trying to get a wave going.

217 Kidding! Did you ever see the list of suspicious deaths that  
218 surround the Clintons — I mean going all the way back long before

229 who has something of a reputation for eliminating those who speak  
230 badly of the family.

231 What does Stochastic mean and why it matters? In the wake of the  
232 late spate of mass shootings, the spin machines in msm are talking  
233 about the "lone wolf terrorist" phenomenon. Acts of terrorism that  
234 are not orchestrated by an organization, such as ISIS. Someone has  
235 coined a new word to explain what motivates these lone-wolf  
236 terrorists. It's Stochastic. It means "randomly occurring but  
237 statistically predictable — terrorism.

238 The idea is that there is no such thing as *lone wolf*. Juliete Kayyem  
239 is the assistant secretary at the Department of Homeland Security  
240 (DHS), and holds the faculty chair at Harvard University's



241 Kennedy School of Government. They left off that she is national  
242 security advisor for CNN — so!

243 She says, "Public speech that may incite violence, even without that  
244 specific intent, has been given a name: stochastic terrorism, for a  
245 pattern that can't be predicted precisely but can be analyzed  
246 statistically. It is the demonization of groups through mass media  
247 and other propaganda that can result in a violent act because  
248 listeners interpret it as promoting targeted violence — terrorism."

249 "Public speech may incite violence even without that specific  
250 intent." We simply cannot focus on the real origin of this devilish  
251 behavior — evil is in the world. It's why government is given the  
252 sword to execute wrath against evildoers — when the sword of  
253 justice sleeps, the evil in the world.

254 Proverbs 14:19 ¶ The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at  
255 the gates of the righteous.

256 Therefore, if a culture encourages wickedness, and  
257 unrighteousness, the evil man prospers and preys upon us.

258 Proverbs 16:17 ¶ The highway of the upright is to depart from evil:  
259 he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul.

260 Proverbs 20:8 ¶ A king that sitteth in the throne of judgment  
261 scattereth away all evil with his eyes.

262 When rulers fail to exercise judgment — evil becomes entrenched  
263 in our communities.

264 Proverbs 28:5 ¶ Evil men understand not judgment: but they that  
265 seek the LORD understand all things.

266 There is the answer — we did not see this sort of thing when the  
267 culture was respectful of Christian mores and recognized GOD and  
268 Jesus Christ — face it, it was very different.

269 Of course there was evil — but it was called evil and dealt with as  
270 evil.

271 Now we psychologize everything — so now, these wicked people  
272 go shoot up Wal Marts because someone "incited them to it" by  
273 something they said.

274 But, let's take a moment with this thought. Stochastic terrorism —  
275 terrorist acts that are induced by an environment that demonizes a  
276 certain group.

277 What I said about evil above is true — however, it is also true that  
278 certain environments encourage evil. That concept is included in  
279 the insights we took from the Scriptures I cited — one  
280 environmental contributor, for example, is one that encourages  
281 unrighteousness, and rewards wickedness — that promotes evil in  
282 our communities. Another is the absence of judgment, when  
283 wicked persons do not face justice, this encourages evil to grow  
284 stronger.

285 It's also true that if wicked people are allowed to demonize  
286 someone or a group, essentially, it's like giving a target to these evil  
287 people. It's tantamount to giving direction to the EVIL that is  
288 already there.

289 Evil is in the hearts of men, people! You put these things together.  
290 1. An environment that gives place to wicked behavior, and  
291 unrighteous behavior reverses God's intended order — He  
292 ordained that the wicked should bow to the righteous. But when a  
293 culture has the righteous bowing to the wicked — EVIL prevails in  
294 that culture.

295 2. When the sword ordained to execute wrath against evildoers is  
296 in the hands of people too weak or indolent to use it, or who are  
297 themselves perverse and so turn that sword away from the wicked  
298 and strike out against the righteous, EVIL prevails in that culture.

299 3. Then, add wicked and unreasonable men and women who  
300 demonize a certain group, with vitriol and anger, (the Jews in  
301 Hitler's Germany, Christians, well, everywhere) and it's constant,

302 that makes them a target for this evil, an acceptable vent for their  
303 evil.

304 And notice almost all these acts are perpetrated by left-leaning  
305 people. Why? The left today is amoral, it is openly against GOD  
306 and against Christian morality — it is a Party that literally defends  
307 wickedness and so breeds EVIL. This is the Party that is preaching  
308 hatred against Christian conservatives — this is the Party that  
309 incites mob like mentality — screeching at their followers to make  
310 us who oppose them politically, to know we don't belong, Maxine  
311 Waters, for example.

312 Here is a perfect example of what I'm saying. Why was the  
313 Philadelphia cop shooter on the streets? He had been arrested 12  
314 times prior to his attack? Someone did not want to use the sword of  
315 civil authority to correct this guy. Someone wanted him on the  
316 streets. He had evil in his heart and the Police have been presented  
317 to him as an acceptable target.

318 So, name the gun control law that would have stopped this guy  
319 from perpetrating this heinous crime? He violated several gun  
320 control laws in the commission of his crime. He illustrates the  
321 whole thing. The uselessness of second amendment encroachment  
322 laws to stop so-called gun violence (because there is nothing  
323 violent about a gun) — and the so called environmental  
324 contributors to such violence.

325 But at the bottom line, the EVIL was already lurking in the heart of  
326 this man — it was there. And rather than be confronted with a  
327 society of righteous and godly people who would humble him, he  
328 was encouraged to believe himself above the righteous — and a  
329 culture of demonizing police — made police his target.

330 No amount of rhetorical enticement can trigger an unloaded gun.  
331 This guy was a loaded gun from the start – what he needed was the  
332 Gospel, what he needed was the love of God in his heart. That's the

333 answer. Not more gun laws, but more GOSPEL — turn back to the  
334 righteousness of Christ.

335 I reposted a quip worth repeating — there is no such a thing as gun  
336 control of the kind the liberals promote — there is only gun  
337 centralization — those who call for gun control don't really mean  
338 it. What they want is guns in the hands of the government but not  
339 in the hands of the people. When Cain killed Abel, God did not  
340 blame the rock. He blamed Cain.

341 These domestic terrorists, these so-called lone wolves, now  
342 rebranded Stochastic Terrorists — they are evil men and women  
343 who, free from the divinely appointed restraints God provided  
344 against evil, were free to express their evil into our world.

345 And yet the foolish continue to cry, "Let us break their bands  
346 asunder and cast away their cords from us." Are you beginning to  
347 see that the cords and bands of biblical righteousness are what God  
348 has provided to keep us from the evil.

349 Okay, this keeps happening — I intend to lay out the biblical case  
350 for a Trump second term — or, actually to finish the case I started  
351 a few weeks ago, and I get carried away — you know what; I have  
352 to take a break next week, so, I'm going to prepare the show that  
353 presents the biblical argument supporting a Trump second term  
354 and air it while I'm taking a much needed rest next week. How is  
355 that? By the way, I'll be in my pulpit this Sunday, and next, too, by  
356 the way, so come on out to the Lighthouse.

357 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me  
358 know if you see them. It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE  
359 ON and you will ride like Revere and spread the warning,  
360 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say  
361 LIGHTS OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and  
362 disagree strongly with me. So, what will it be today, lights on, or  
363 lights off?
