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1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the  
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain  
3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.  
4 Now Ukraine-gate! Just know one thing. Each of these obscene  
5 attacks is about covering up crimes committed by Demoncrats.  
6 Actually, know two things. It's all going to blow back on them!  
7 Get ready for your Brain Massage!  
8 [TRUTH]  
9 Would you vote for a Communist to be President of our country?  
10 That sounds incredible to the ears of anyone over the age of 40 —  
11 but do you realize that a significant number of our younger  
12 generation are prepared to vote away our liberties?  
13 They have been told, for decades, that our Founders were evil men  
14 and that our principles of governance are "out of date," "old  
15 fashioned," and oppressive. Why? It's actually very simple. The  
16 answer is Psalm 2 and Ephesians 2:1-2; it's Luke 19:12-27. That's it!  
17 It's surreal to all of us who grew up through the fifties and sixties—  
18 but our kids, many of them, are seriously considering candidates  
19 that are Communists.  
20 The two primary distinguishing features of Communism are these:  
21 1. there is *no God*, and 2. *the State is God*. That's it! The *State*  
22 defines morality, the *State* defines your values, and your beliefs, the  
23 *State* owns (or virtually owns) all property and the means of  
24 production, the *State* controls access to health care, to food, to land  
25 — the *State* completely takes the place of GOD in the lives of every  
26 body.

27 The Democrat Party today is the Party of *there is no God, and the*  
28 *State is God.*

29 Those in this country who want to pull America out from under  
30 God have taken over the Democrat Party. Christians are in so  
31 many words invited to leave! Who are these Democrats today?

32 Name this political party from the past: confiscated guns, took over  
33 healthcare, blamed all the nation's woes on one group of people,  
34 brought industry under the control of the State, denied the  
35 existence of any God but the State, controlled what the people  
36 could say and attempted to control what they thought —  
37 DEMOCRATS! Wrong! Nazi Party under Hitler. But you are also  
38 right. The DEMOCRATS are the modern day version of Hitler's  
39 freedom hating Nazis. The Democrat Party is Nazi Party USA.

40 The Democrats want to pull America out from under God and they  
41 have hoodwinked millions of our children to join them, and  
42 millions of Christians think there is nothing they can do about it.

43 But listen, the Dems don't have enough brainwashed young people  
44 to pull it off—yet! So they, and by *they* I mean the *Demoncrats*, will

50 Listen to the advice of one of our esteemed founders:

51 John Jay, first Chief Justice of the US Supreme Court said,  
52 "Whether our religion permits Christians to vote for infidel rulers  
53 is a question which merits more consideration than it seems yet to  
54 have generally received either from the clergy or the laity. It  
55 appears to me that what the prophet said to Jehoshaphat about his

56 attachment to Ahab affords a salutary lesson."<sup>1</sup> This honorable  
57 Founder of our nation was referring to II Chronicles 19:2, where  
58 the LORD through the prophet rebuked Jehoshaphat for joining  
59 himself to the wicked king of Israel, Ahab: saying, "Shouldest thou  
60 help the ungodly and love them that hate the LORD?"

61 The prophet Hosea cried against Israel because "They . . . set up  
62 kings [rulers], but not by Me . . ." (Hosea 8:4).

63 John Jay warned: "Providence has given to our people the choice of  
64 their rulers. And it is the duty as well as the privilege and interest of  
65 a Christian nation to select and prefer Christians for their rulers."<sup>2</sup>

66 *John Adams*, SIGNER OF THE DECLARATION OF  
67 INDEPENDENCE; JUDGE; DIPLOMAT; ONE OF TWO  
68 SIGNERS OF THE BILL OF RIGHTS; SECOND PRESIDENT OF  
69 THE UNITED STATES said:

70 "The general principles on which the fathers achieved  
71 independence were the general principles of Christianity."

72 He said, "The Holy Ghost carries on the whole Christian system in  
73 this earth. . . . There is no authority, civil or religious – there can be  
74 no legitimate government but what is administered by this Holy  
75 Ghost."

76 *John Quincy Adams*, SIXTH PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED  
77 STATES; DIPLOMAT; SECRETARY OF STATE; U. S. SENATOR;  
78 U. S. REPRESENTATIVE; known as the "HELL-HOUND OF  
79 ABOLITION" — *ANTI SLAVERY!*

80 "Whoever believes in the Divine inspiration of the Holy Scriptures  
81 must hope that the religion of Jesus shall prevail throughout the  
82 earth."

83 "In the chain of human events, the birthday of the nation is  
84 indissolubly linked with the birthday of the Savior. The  
85 Declaration of Independence laid the cornerstone of human  
86 government upon the first precepts of Christianity."

87 *Samuel Adams*, SIGNER OF THE DECLARATION OF  
88 INDEPENDENCE; "FATHER OF THE AMERICAN  
89 REVOLUTION"; RATIFIER OF THE U. S. CONSTITUTION;  
90 GOVERNOR OF MASSACHUSETTS

91 "I conceive we cannot better express ourselves than by humbly  
92 supplicating the Supreme Ruler of the world . . . that the confusions  
93 that are and have been among the nations may be overruled by the  
94 promoting and speedily bringing in the holy and happy period  
95 when the kingdoms of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ may be  
96 everywhere established, and the people willingly bow to the scepter  
97 of Him who is the Prince of Peace."

98 He also called on the State of Massachusetts to pray that

99 "The peaceful and glorious reign of our Divine Redeemer may be  
100 known and enjoyed throughout the whole family of mankind."

101 *Charles Carroll*, SIGNER OF THE DECLARATION OF  
102 INDEPENDENCE; SELECTED AS DELEGATE TO THE  
103 CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION; FRAMER OF THE BILL  
104 OF RIGHTS; U. S. SENATOR

105 In *Congress*, chairing the *U. S. House Judiciary Committee*, 1854

106 Carroll said, "Had the people, during the Revolution, had a  
107 suspicion of any attempt to war against Christianity, that  
108 Revolution would have been strangled in its cradle..."

109 *John Dickinson*, SIGNER OF THE CONSTITUTION;  
110 GOVERNOR OF PENNSYLVANIA; GOVERNOR OF  
111 DELAWARE; GENERAL IN THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION

112 [Governments] "could not give the rights essential to happiness...  
113 We claim them from a higher source: from the King of kings, and  
114 Lord of all the earth."

115 *Alexander Hamilton*: desired the formation of a religious society  
116 named the *Christian Constitutional Society*, and listed two goals:  
117 first, the support of the Christian religion; and second, the support  
118 of the Constitution of the United States. He envisioned chapters in  
119 each state that would work to elect to office those who would  
120 support Christianity and the Constitution.

121 *John Hancock*, SIGNER OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPEN-  
122 DENCE; PRESIDENT OF CONGRESS; REVOLUTIONARY  
123 GENERAL; GOVERNOR OF MASSACHUSETTS

124 He called on the entire state where he was then Governor to pray  
125 "That all nations may bow to the scepter of our Lord and Savior  
126 Jesus Christ and that the whole earth may be filled with his glory."

127 My friends, there are so many like references from our Founders it  
128 is remarkable how Satan has succeeded to rewrite our history so  
129 dramatically as to have convinced an entire generation, 1. That  
130 America was not founded as a Christian nation, 2. That the  
131 Founders were not sincerely Christian, 3. That they actually  
132 designed our government in order to eradicate Christianity from  
133 government and from having influence on government policy, 4.  
134 That, in the end, SECULARISM was by them understood to be the  
135 STATE absent any Christian influence, or that such a state was  
136 preferred.

137 And it happened only because Christians let it happen. Well, we  
138 need to take our nation back UNDER GOD. The "secularists"  
139 policies are destroying our Republic, and undermining our  
140 liberties. If you are a Christian, you have no business voting for  
141 anyone representing the Democratic Party today.

142 Truly! If there was ever an election that was not about the man  
143 running, but the ideals and principles he supports, it's the 2020  
144 election. One Party wants to pull this nation out from under God,  
145 the other Party wants to keep this nation UNDER GOD and  
146 restore our liberties and reset our policies to conformity with the  
147 FOUNDING Principles of our Republic.

148 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
149 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
150 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
151 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
152 liberty.

153 Did you get the chance to actually read the transcript of the  
154 infamous phone call? I'm going to read it to you in full. You'll see  
155 it's another bogus attempt to conduct a coup against our  
156 government.

157 But, first, you will need the context in which the deceptive devilish  
158 Adam Schiffy and company are interpreting the conversation I'm  
159 going to read to you.

160 Remember when then Vice President Joe Biden was going around  
161 bragging that he got the Ukrainian prosecutor fired? Biden said,  
162 "I went over, I guess, the 12th, 13th time to Kiev. And I was  
163 supposed to announce that there was another billion-dollar loan  
164 guarantee. And I had gotten a commitment from Poroshenko and  
165 from Yatsenyuk that they would take action against the state  
166 prosecutor. And they didn't.

167 So they said they had—they were walking out to a press  
168 conference. I said, nah, I'm not going to—or, we're not going to  
169 give you the billion dollars. They said, you have no authority.  
170 You're not the president. The president said—I said, call him.  
171 (Laughter.) I said, I'm telling you; you're not getting the billion  
172 dollars. I said, you're not getting the billion. I'm going to be leaving

173 here in, I think it was about six hours. I looked at them and said:  
174 I'm leaving in six hours. If the prosecutor is not fired, you're not  
175 getting the money. Well, son of a (Democrat word for women) b-  
176 tch. (Laughter.) He got fired. And they put in place someone who  
177 was solid at the time."<sup>3</sup>

178 Now, why did Joe want the Ukrainian investigator fired? Times  
179 had tipped him off that the Ukrainian investigator was preparing  
180 to file charges against a company his son worked for. So, what's  
181 that about? Well, you see, Hunter Biden joined a Ukrainian  
182 company named Burisma in 2014 at a healthy stipend of 50k for  
183 this sinecure (Si-neh-kyoor— a cushy job requiring little to no  
184 effort) — PER MONTH — 600k per year. It's a natural gas  
185 company. What did Hunter Biden provide that was so valuable?  
186 Well, you see, although Hunter Biden has zero experience in the  
187 field, it just so happened, that his father, US Vice President Joe  
188 Biden, was the point man managing Ukrainian - U.S. policy. Now,  
189 it gets swampier: at the time Biden joined the board of Burisma, it  
190 was already the target of serious allegations of corruption and they

197 And then Biden brags about it on national TV during a Foreign  
198 Affairs gig — yeah, threatened to withhold 1 BN in loans to  
199 Ukraine unless they fired their chief prosecutor—why? Because he  
200 was going to question his son in connection with a company he  
201 worked for that paid him 600K per year for doing — NOTHING!

202 This is the Democrat's dream — if only Trump would do  
203 something like this! Then we could get him!

204 A little more context before I read the transcript.

205 The whistleblower is a CIA agent that worked in the White House  
206 (uh huh!~ A spy planted in the White House) — wrote a report on  
207 what he "heard" others say. Sounds like the Russian Dossier—a

228 So, Trump has heard rumors that the owner of CrowdStrike is  
229 Ukrainian based — Russian born, perhaps, but that he is based in  
230 the Ukraine — so! And Ukraine has been implicated in corrupt  
231 politics — and Zelensky campaigned on draining the swamp in  
232 Ukraine — so, you begin to see —



233 Trump wants all this uncovered! And so here is how the  
234 conversation goes.

235 The White House Situation Room, July 25, 2019, 9:03 - 9:33 a.m.  
236 EDT

237 The President: "Congratulations on a great victory. We all watched  
238 from the United States and you did a terrific job. The way you  
239 came from behind, somebody who wasn't given much of a chance,  
240 and you ended up winning easily. It's a fantastic achievement.  
241 Congratulations."

242 President Zelensky: "You are absolutely right Mr. President. We  
243 did win big and we worked hard for this. We worked a lot but I  
244 would like to confess to you that I had an opportunity to learn  
245 from you. We used quite a few of your skills and knowledge and  
246 were able to use it as an example to our elections and yes it is true  
247 that these were unique elections. We were in a unique situation  
248 that we were able to achieve a unique success. I'm able to tell you  
249 the following; the first time you called me to congratulate me when  
250 I won my presidential election, and the second time you are now  
251 calling me when my party won the parliamentary election. I think I  
252 should run more often so you can call me more often and we can  
253 talk over the phone more often.

254 The President: [laughter] "That's a very good idea. I think your  
255 country is very happy about that."

256 President Zelensky: "Well yes, to tell you the truth, we are trying to  
257 work hard because we wanted to drain the swamp here in our  
258 country. We brought in many many new people. Not the old  
259 politicians, not the typical politicians, because we want to have a  
260 new format and a new type of government. You are a great teacher  
261 for us and in that."

262 The President: "Well it is very nice of you to say that. I will say that  
263 we do a lot for Ukraine. We spend a lot of effort and a lot of time.

264 Much more than the European countries are doing and they  
265 should be helping you more than they are. Germany does almost  
266 nothing for you. All they do is talk and I think it's something that  
267 you should really ask them about. When I was speaking to Angela  
268 Merkel she talks Ukraine, but she doesn't do anything. A lot of the  
269 European countries are the same way, so I think it's something you  
270 want to look at, but the United States has been very, very, good to  
271 Ukraine. I wouldn't say that it's reciprocal necessarily because  
272 things are happening that are not good, but the United States has  
273 been very, very, good to Ukraine."

274 President Zelensky: "Yes you are absolutely right. Not only 100%,  
275 but actually 1000% arid [and?] I can tell you the following: I did  
276 talk to Angela Merkel and I did meet with her. I also met and  
277 talked with Macron and I told them that they are not doing quite as  
278 much as they need to be doing on the issues with the sanctions.  
279 They are not enforcing the sanctions. They are not working as  
280 much as they should work for Ukraine. It turns out that even  
281 though logically, the European Union should be our biggest  
282 partner but technically the United States is a much bigger partner  
283 than the European Union, and I'm very grateful to you for that  
284 because the United States is doing quite a lot for Ukraine. Much  
285 more than the European Union especially when we are talking  
286 about sanctions against the Russian Federation.

287 I would also like to thank you for your great support *in the area*.  
288 We are ready to continue to cooperate for the next *set* of defense  
289 steps. Specifically we are almost ready to buy more Javelins from  
290 the United States for defense purposes."

291 The President: I would like you to do us a favor though because  
292 our country has been through a lot and Ukraine knows a lot about  
293 it. I would like you to find out what happened with this whole  
294 situation with Ukraine, they say CrowdStrike... I guess you have  
295 one of your wealthy people... The server, they say Ukraine has it.

296 There are a lot of things that went on, the whole situation . . . I  
297 think you are surrounding yourself with some of the same people. I  
298 would like to have the Attorney General call you or your people  
299 and I would like you to get to the bottom of it. As you said  
300 yesterday, that whole nonsense ended with a very poor  
301 performance by a man named Robert Mueller, an incompetent  
302 performance, but they say a lot of it started with Ukraine.  
303 Whatever you can do, it's very important that you do it if that's  
304 possible."

305 President Zelensky: "Yes it is very important for me and everything  
306 that you just mentioned earlier. For me as a President, it is very  
307 important and we are open for any future cooperation. We are  
308 ready to open a new page on cooperation in relations between the  
309 United States and Ukraine. For that purpose, I just recalled our  
310 ambassador from United States and he will be replaced by a very  
311 competent and very experienced ambassador who will work hard  
312 on making sure that our two nations are getting closer. I would  
313 also like and hope to see him having your trust and your  
314 confidence and have personal relations with you so we can  
315 cooperate even more so. I will personally tell you that one of my  
316 assistants spoke with Mr. Giuliani just recently and we are hoping  
317 very much that Mr. Giuliani will be able to travel to Ukraine and  
318 we will meet once he comes to Ukraine. I just wanted to assure you  
319 once again that you have nobody but friends around us. I will make  
320 sure that I surround myself with the best and most experienced  
321 people. I also wanted to tell you that we are friends. We are great  
322 friends and you Mr. President have friends in our country so we  
323 can continue our strategic partnership. I also plan to surround  
324 myself with great people and in addition to that investigation, I  
325 guarantee as the President of Ukraine that all the investigations will  
326 be done openly and candidly. That I can assure you."

327 The President: Good because I heard you had a prosecutor who  
328 was very good and he was shut down and that's really unfair. A lot  
329 of people are talking about that, the way they shut your very good  
330 prosecutor down and you had some very bad people involved. Mr.  
331 Giuliani is a highly respected man. He was the mayor of New York  
332 City, a great mayor, and I would like him to call you. I will ask him  
333 to call you along with the Attorney General.

334 Rudy very much knows what's happening and he is a very capable  
335 guy. If you could speak to him that would be great. The former  
336 ambassador from the United States, the woman, was bad news and  
337 the people she was dealing with in the Ukraine were bad news, so I  
338 just want to let you know that.

339 The other thing, there's a lot of talk about Biden's son. That Biden  
340 stopped the prosecution and a lot of people want to find out about  
341 that so whatever you can do with the Attorney General would be  
342 great. Biden went around bragging that he stopped the prosecution  
343 so if you can look into it. It sounds horrible to me.

344 President Zelenskyy: I wanted to tell you about the prosecutor.  
345 First of all I understand and [and?] I'm knowledgeable about it,  
346 the situation. Since we have the absolute majority in our  
347 Parliament; the next prosecutor general will be 100% my person,  
348 my candidate, who will be approved, by the parliament and will  
349 start as a new prosecutor in September. He or she will look into the  
350 situation, specifically to the company that you mentioned in this  
351 issue. The issue of the investigation of the case is certainly [?] the  
352 issue of asking us to restore the honesty. So we will take care of that  
353 and will work on the investigation of the case.

354 On top of that, I would kindly ask you if you have any additional  
355 information that you can provide to us, it would be very helpful for  
356 the investigation to make sure that we administer justice in our  
357 country.

358 With regard to the Ambassador to the United States from Ukraine  
359 as far as I recall her name was Ivanovici. It was great that you were  
360 the first one who told me that she was bad ambassador because I  
361 agree with you 100%. Her attitude towards me was far from the  
362 best as she admired the previous President and she was on his side.  
363 She would not accept me as a new President well enough.

364 The President: Well, she's going to go through some things. I will  
365 have Mr. Giuliani give you a call and I am also going to have  
366 Attorney General Barr call and we will get to the bottom of it. I'm  
367 sure you will figure it out. I heard the prosecutor was treated very  
368 badly and he was a very fair prosecutor so good luck with  
369 everything.

370 Your economy is going to get better and better I predict. You have  
371 a lot of assets. It's a great country. I have many Ukrainian friends,  
372 their incredible people.

373 President Zelensky: I would like to tell you that I also have quite a  
374 few Ukrainian friends that live in the United States. Actually last  
375 time I traveled to the United States, I stayed in New York near  
376 Central Park and I stayed at the Trump Tower. I will talk to them  
377 and I hope to see them again in the future. I also wanted to thank  
378 you for your invitation to visit the United States, specifically  
379 Washington DC. On the other hand, I also wanted to ensure you  
380 that we will be very serious about the case and will work on the  
381 investigation. As to the economy, there is much potential for our  
382 two countries and one of the issues that is very important for  
383 Ukraine is energy independence. I believe we can be very successful  
384 and cooperating on energy independence with United States. We  
385 are already working on cooperation. We are buying American oil  
386 but I am very hopeful for a future meeting. We will have more time  
387 and more opportunity to discuss these opportunities and get to  
388 know each other better. I would like to thank you very much for  
389 your support.

390 The President: Good. Well, thank you very much and I appreciate  
391 that. I will tell Rudy and Attorney General Barr to call. Thank you.  
392 Whenever you would like to come to the White House, feel free to  
393 call. Give us a date and we'll work that out. I look forward to  
394 seeing you.

395 President Zelensky: Thank you very much. I would be very happy  
396 to come and would be happy to meet with you personally and get  
397 to know you better. I am looking forward to our meeting and  
398 [and?] I also would like to invite you to visit Ukraine and come to  
399 the city of Kiev, which is a beautiful city. We have a beautiful  
400 country, which would welcome you. On the other hand, I believe  
401 that on September 1 we will be in Poland and we can meet in  
402 Poland hopefully. After that it might be a very good idea for you to  
403 travel to Ukraine. We can either take my plane and go to Ukraine  
404 or we can take your plane, which is probably much better than  
405 mine.

406 The President: Okay, we can work that out. I look forward to  
407 seeing you in Washington and maybe in Poland because I think we  
408 are going to be there at that time.

409 President Zelenskyy: Thank you very much Mr. President.

410 The President: Congratulations on a fantastic job you've done. The  
411 whole world was watching. I'm not sure it was so much of an upset  
412 but congratulations.

413 President Zelensky: Thank you Mr. President bye-bye.
