- 7 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the
- 8 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain
- 9 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.
- 10 FREEDOM essentials that are being undermined by the
- 11 Democrats: the nature of truth (where science and education are
- being corrupted), innocent until proven guilty, right to face your
- 13 accuser, right to present evidence in your defense, rule of law
- 14 versus rule of the mob, natural law as ordained by God versus
- 15 anarchy, justice and judgment for all versus special rights and
- 16 protection of the privileged class. In fact, I challenge you to think
- 17 of one single support of freedom that is not being daily
- 18 undermined by the left today.
- 19 And the brain masseur will provide his assessment of what is really
- 20 concerning about the impeachment proceedings. Impeachment
- 21 predictions—we will get our turn!
- 22 My friends, it's time for your brain massage.
- 23 [TRUTH]
- 24 There are at least six planks in the foundations for our LIBERTIES
- 25 in AMERICA that are being torn up out from under our feet. First,
- 26 the nature of truth (where science and education are being
- 27 corrupted).

- 28 Second, innocent until proven guilty.
- 29 And third, connected with that, the right to face your accuser,
- 30 And fourth, the right to present evidence in your defense,
- 31 And fifth, generally speaking the rule of law versus rule of the mob,
- 32 And natural law as ordained by God versus anarchy,
- 33 And justice and judgment for all versus special rights and
- 34 protection of the privileged class.
- 35 As I said in my introduction, I challenge you to think of one single
- 36 principle protecting our freedoms that is not being daily
- 37 undermined by the left today. Let's run this down —
- 38 First, the nature of truth (where science and education are being
- 39 corrupted). You have heard Democrats say stuff that probably
- 40 sounds strange to you like Democrats don't care about facts,
- 41 they care about the truth and you probably sat there wondering
- 42 if you heard right. Many of you, I dare say, assumed it was nothing
- 43 more than another example of bumbling Biden but Hillary said
- 44 something very near this a little while before, and it's something
- 45 that has become a fundamental assumption among many
- 46 philosophy thinkers truly, the notion has quite a long history of
- 47 development that we don't have time to get into, except to point
- 48 out one root you will almost certainly recognize, situational ethics
- 49 but it goes deeper into arguments over epistemology, what
- 50 distinguishes justified belief from mere opinion—but it has evolved
- 51 to the place where truth is a word that identifies what advances
- 52 whatever one believes is a JUST CAUSE so TRUTH does not
- refer to factual information but to the CAUSE to which someone is
- 54 committed.
- 55 For that reason, when FACTS impede the advancement of the
- 56 CAUSE they are dismissed because in that case, they contradict the
- 57 TRUTH. Weird, huh?

- 58 But what you need to understand is this is what Democrats believe
- 59 about TRUTH today. Their cause is the TRUTH. The ideology that
- 60 supports and advances their CAUSE is TRUTH and everything
- 61 contrary to that CAUSE is the LIE.
- 62 If someone assembles FACTS in such a way as will expose their
- 63 ideology as faulty, or, FALSE, they will dismiss those facts because
- 64 they are not interested in FACTS they are interested in the
- 65 TRUTH.
- You've heard me say often that if you separate facts from truth you
- 67 have nothing left the nature of facts is ignored and the nature of
- truth is destroyed, so you end up with neither.
- 69 The impeachment proceedings illustrate where this philosophy
- 70 leads. They do not have facts to support their allegation.
- 71 What is the allegation?
- 72 Adam Schiff and Pelosi allege that Trump attempted to strong-arm
- 73 President Zelensky of Ukraine to dig up dirt on his political
- 74 opponent, Joe Biden. (Lay aside, for the moment, that it is highly
- 75 questionable whether Joe Biden will actually win the Democratic
- 76 Nomination—)
- 77 This is based on the testimony of a whistleblower, so-called, who
- 78 claims Trump attempted to pressure Zalensky to investigate
- 79 Biden's actions to strong-arm then Ukrainian president to fire a
- 80 certain Ukrainian prosecutor, who, it happened, was investigating
- 81 a Ukrainian company, Burrisma, who had hired Joe Biden's son to
- 82 sit on their board. And they paid him upwards of six million
- 83 dollars for his "services" whatever they were. Biden's son can't
- 84 explain what value he brought to the board of Burrisma—really, he
- was asked, and he said he did not know. So!
- 86 DID YOU HEAR THAT. Let's run it by again.

- 87 Adam Schiff and Pelosi allege that Trump attempted to strong-arm
- 88 the Ukrainian President, Zalenski, to investigate Joe Biden's
- 89 admitted use of pressure to force the President of Ukraine to fire a
- 90 prosecutor that Biden claimed was corrupt —
- 91 So Trump is asking the current President of Ukraine to investigate
- 92 the admitted strong-arm tactics used by Biden to get a Ukrainian
- 93 prosecutor fired because Trump is concerned that there might be
- 94 corruption involved in that since, after all, Biden's son, at that
- 95 time, worked for the company that was under investigation by the
- 96 Ukrainian prosecutor for corruption. Hmmm!
- 97 Am I the only one who sees the obvious here the irony has a lot
- 98 of wrinkles but it really is not hard to, ha, iron out what's going on
- 99 here.
- 100 Is your iron hot? (psssst) Good! What is the "crime" Trump
- 101 supposedly committed?
- 102 According to Adam Schiff and Nancy Pelosi, when Trump asked
- 103 the Ukrainian President to investigate Joe Biden's threat to
- 104 withhold a billion in loan guarantees unless they fired Shokin, the
- prosecutor responsible to prosecute corruption cases in Ukraine
- 106 (Now, for the record, this guy, Shokin, was being accused of not
- doing his job and while some say he was set up others say he was
- taking huge bribes—that rather than investigating Burissma, he
- 109 was actually protecting the corruption going on there—etc.)
- HOWEVER, there is competing testimony on all of that that a trial,
- 111 or an investigation would uncover—
- 112 So, Adam and Nancy believe Trump pressured the current
- 113 Ukrainian president, Zelensky, to investigate Biden's admission
- 114 that he pressured Ukraine to fire their prosecutor because of
- allegations that Joe did this to protect his own interests his son
- being on the board of Burissma corporation—

- 117 And, that was an aside, by the way. The Joe Biden thing was
- 118 mentioned as a secondary interest. The primary interest was
- 119 Trumps request that Zalensky do US (he said us, not me) do US a
- 120 favor and look into how the whole Russian collusion thing
- 121 originated because he learned it originated in Ukraine—and
- 122 Zalensky assured the President he would take steps to investigate
- 123 that.
- 124 Hmmmm! So, the Biden thing was a side issue a, oh, and by the
- way, we concerned about the allegations that Biden interfered with
- 126 Ukrainian internal affairs using Congressional approved loan
- 127 guarantees as leverage to compel Ukraine to fire their prosecutor
- when his own son worked on the board of a company that had
- been the subject of investigation soooo!
- Okay, so, you see what I'm doing here? I'm trying to clarify what it
- is exactly that Adam and Nancy are concerned about.
- 132 It was good for Biden to pressure Ukraine to fire a prosecutor
- 133 because Biden was convinced the guy was corrupt—but it's not
- 134 okay for the President to ask for an investigation into Biden's
- threat to hold back 1 billion in loan guarantees and the allegations
- that surfaced that he did this to protect the interests of his son who
- 137 worked for a Ukrainian company at that time that had been the
- subject of investigation by that prosecutor —
- 139 You know, it seems to me that pressuring a foreign government to
- look into allegations of corruption is something the Democrats are,
- 141 as they say, their down with that. So, what's the problem here?
- 142 Perhaps there actually IS something to find in investigating Joe
- Biden's inappropriate use of a threat to manipulate a foreign power
- 144 to fire a prosecutor Biden considered corrupt.
- But, wait that was not the primary concern in the conversation
- transcript we all read between Trump and Zalensky.

- 147 The first concern mentioned was this Trump asked Zalenski to
- 148 DO US A FAVOR and get serious about investigating how the
- Russian-Collusion farce originated because, as Trump pointed out,
- 150 Ukraine knows that corrupt politicians in Ukraine were neck deep
- 151 in that.
- 152 So, let's look at this again. Adam and Nancy are concerned that
- 153 Trump asked a favor of the Ukrainian president and the favor
- 154 was this, that the Ukrainian president would investigate the origins
- 155 of the Russian collusion scam —
- 156 Wait! Let's get the whole picture here. How many of you are
- 157 concerned about the Russian collusion scam that was run against
- 158 Trump by the Democrats for, well, it actually started before the
- election in 2016 so this has been going on for about four years.
- 160 I would say that ALL OF AMERICA would really to get to the
- 161 bottom of this and I would expect all truth loving, honest,
- patriotic, Americans would want this done.
- 163 And I think we can point to enough occasions in Trump's history
- 164 to support the belief that HE WOULD BE CONCERNED ABOUT
- 165 THIS EVEN IF HE HAD NEVER BEEN THE SUBJECT OF THE
- 166 INVESTIGATION. But, leaving that aside for the moment.
- 167 DOES ANYONE BLAME TRUMP FOR WANTING TO GET TO
- 168 THE BOTTOM OF THIS SCAM?
- 169 If it happens to be the case that Trump has a personal interest in
- 170 this matter that is part of what motivates him to pursue this it so
- 171 happens that his personal interest is DIRECTLY LINKED TO
- 172 OUR NATIONAL INTEREST in this matter, is it not?
- 173 I WANT UKRAINE TO INVESTIGATE THIS MATTER. I
- 174 WANT TO KNOW HOW THE RUSSIAN COLLUSION SCAM
- 175 GOT STARTED.

- 176 I think a million Americans ought to write their representatives
- 177 DEMANDING THAT INVESTIGATION TAKES PLACE.
- 178 So, let's recap and conclude this most fundamental of all questions
- in the impeachment hearings what is the allegation?
- 180 Adam and Nancy allege that Trump used the power of his office to
- pressure a foreign power to investigate how the Russian collusion
- scam got started, and, oh, by the way, while you are at it, look into
- 183 the Biden scandal too I want to get to the bottom of all this.
- 184 And here is the setting. Trump, doing his duties as the Chief
- 185 Executive of the United States, tasks his justice department to
- investigate how it is that America was dragged through this misery
- 187 for three years with Mueller, Comey, and all that, and this
- 188 investigation leads our Attorney General and FBI director into
- 189 enquiries concerning things that went down in Ukraine so the
- 190 President, in a conversation with their new President says, hey, do
- 191 us a favor COOPERATE with our effort to get to the bottom of
- 192 Ukraine's involvement in the origins of the Russian Collusion
- 193 scam.
- 194 That sounds like the most natural thing for our President to do —
- 195 personally, and for our NATIONAL INTERESTS.
- 196 If anyone really believes Trump needs the Ukraine to get dirt on
- 197 bumbling Biden to win an election against him they are hopelessly
- 198 delusional. They guy was VP for Obama, and the Party did not
- 199 even take a second to consider him to run. They guy is a joke! But
- it's one of those jokes that falls really flat.
- Now, when I get back, I'm going to tell the real reason Adam and
- Nancy are risking it all, putting it all in, on what amounts to a
- really bad hand. Hold on, I'll be right back.
- 204 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
- at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
- 206 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the

- 207 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
- 208 liberty.
- 209 I listened to the Taylor/Kent testimony and what a bunch of
- 210 nonsense. The American people are smart enough to see through
- 211 this and I'll tell you something else I can see through. I can see
- 212 where in his testimony he was reading Adam Schiff's insertions—
- 213 tell you what, go back and watch the video of Taylor's testimony,
- almost every time he stops to drink some water, it's when it's clear
- 215 to me he is reading something he was told to say. Even that is not
- damning, but these are the only places in his monologue where he
- 217 actually says something that makes you think, okay, here is
- 218 something that has at least SOMETHING to do with the case —
- 219 then it fizzles out to nothing.
- 220 It's obvious this bureaucrat does not like his boss. He is a lifer, a
- 221 one-worlder, and he is angry that Trump was not playing the
- 222 political game he is accustomed to. Listening to Taylor repeatedly
- 223 made me think, what is this, is Trump's foreign policy on trial
- 224 here?
- 225 You can't impeach a president because you disagree with his
- foreign policy. If that's the case, Obama should have been rousted
- 227 out of the office long ago.
- 228 And Americans understand that saying "Withholding security
- 229 assistance in exchange for help with a domestic political campaign
- in the U.S. is crazy." does not amount to anything even remotely
- 231 resembling evidence that Trump did anything remotely resembling
- that concern. Then, to repeat it as if it's some sort of coup-de-grace
- in his statement: you remember, "I said it then, and I say it now."
- 234 Say WHAT?
- It's very near to saying; I said the sky was blue. That's what I said. I
- said it then, and I say it now.

- 237 How stupid do the Democrats think we are? But the fact is folks,
- that is as close as any witness came to actually making a charge that
- 239 Trump did something wrong.
- 240 Jim Jordan did a great job. Him and Devin Nunez handled their
- 241 job to represent America's interest admirably! Not everything
- 242 coming out of California is insane way to go Devin. We have
- 243 your back.
- 244 These men exposed the truth about what's going on. An
- anonymous so-called whistleblower, who has confessed he has no
- 246 firsthand knowledge, that he has admitted that he is repeated
- 247 hearsay, and who is known to have Trump-derangement syndrome
- 248 disease, and who worked for Joe Biden—reports something
- 249 someone from inside the White House we don't know who —
- 250 told him, and what they told him was that they were uncomfortable
- with a conversation Trump had with the Ukrainian president, and
- 252 we are not even sure that individual actually heard the
- 253 conversation, and revealing the private conversations of the
- 254 President with foreign leaders is AGAINST THE LAW, so the
- 255 information was LEAKED which is a crime in itself which
- 256 makes it evidence that is fruit of the poisonous tree and add to
- 257 this that we ALL READ THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE CALL and
- 258 by itself no one would say it PROVES the President bribed the
- 259 Ukrainian president to "dig up dirt on his political opponent."
- 260 There is no proof here!
- 261 So, Jim Jordan asks Taylor, "did you listen in on President Trump
- and Zelensky's call? And Taylor says, "I did not." And Jordan asks,
- 263 "You've never talked with Chief of Staff Mulvaney?" And Taylor
- says, "I never did." And Jordan: "You've never met the President?"
- 265 "That's correct." And then Jordan says, "And you're their star
- 266 witness?"

- 267 And pressed Adam to allow the Congress to hear from the
- 268 Whistleblower directly and give them a chance to ask him
- 269 questions.
- 270 I thought those were the most compelling moments in this show!
- 271 But I said I would tell you what's really behind Adam and Nancy
- 272 literally laying their political lives on the line in this phony
- 273 impeachment show. I mean, there is no impeachable offense here
- and every reasonable person knows that.
- 275 There is something else they are using this to hide—it's a cover
- 276 game. I've said this from the beginning that all of this is an effort by
- 277 the Democrats to keep Americans looking at Trump and not at
- them. But the evidence supporting this intuitive understanding of
- what's going on is piling up.
- Judicial Watch has been doing some digging.
- 281 Alexandra Chalupa is the DNC operative who was tasked with
- trying to dig up dirt on Trump with the help of Ukrainian officials.
- 283 This we know! Nothing particularly illegal about that—just, well,
- there are ethical questions, but, hey, that's politics, right? However,
- 285 the part about Ukrainian officials participating in this—well, you
- 286 see, that's what they are trying to get you to believe Trump's
- 287 campaign did. So, what happens if Zalensky agrees to cooperate
- 288 with our Attorney General, and FBI Director in their efforts to run
- down the connections between Ukrainians officials and the effort
- 290 to bring down Trump—you see, so it might be interesting to look
- into the 27 times Chalupa visited the White House during all of
- 292 this 27 times. Chalupa is not a super star in the DNC but she
- 293 had extraordinary access to the White House. So we have a DNC
- operative with extensive activity in Ukraine, working with the help
- of Ukrainian officials to get dirt on Trump visiting the White
- House 27 times during all of these goings on.

- 297 Then, if Judicial Watch has correctly identified the Hearsay
- 298 LEAKER who is hiding behind the Whistleblower claim for
- 299 cover from criminal prosecution well, guess what? He was in the
- 300 Obama Administration at the time. So, you see, he was working in
- 301 the White House in the Obama Administration —
- 302 So, his involvement in a Soros group that was connected to the
- 303 Ukraine operatives that released the so-called "black-ledger" that
- 304 was used to implicate Manafort is at least interesting, don't you
- 305 think?
- 306 And does this not connect Obama's administration with the
- 307 Russian Collusion scam?
- 308 So, the DNC operative connects Hillary and this Whistleblower
- 309 connects Obama —
- 310 And then two FBI agents Peter Stryk and Lisa Page who were
- 311 totally WITH HER and hate Trump were assigned to work
- 312 the case against Hillary's mishandling of classified information and
- 313 the allegations against Trump in the Russian collusion thing —
- 314 maybe some effort at non partisanship would have been a good
- 315 idea but it turns out that after Hillary declared she never
- 316 transmitted classified information over her private server, Stryk
- 317 wrote an email saying, well, actually, she did and identified nine
- 318 email chains that were marked classified and the importance of
- 319 this is that the FBI had direct knowledge that she was lying —
- 320 Anyway folks, here is what they are tying to hide. The fact that
- 321 Obama and Hillary were both up to their necks in this conspiracy
- 322 to use a foreign government to interfere with our election—and
- 323 when they lost, they had to cover their tracks, so they have been
- 324 engaged in treason —a backdoor coup—and a coup depends on
- secrecy, speed, and suppression of opposition thank you Mr.
- 326 Sekulow.

- The impeachment proceedings are exactly what AOC said they are:
- it's "about preventing a potentially disastrous outcome next year."
- 329 And the disaster would be that if this blows up in their faces, and
- 330 they lose in 2020—then their entire house of cards is going to
- 331 collapse on them. Because then Trump will have the proverbial
- "mandate" to go after this cabal and really DRAIN THE SWAMP.
- 333 I said the Democrats are dismantling the platform upon which
- FREEDOM stands in this country. I mentioned six of these.
- First, the nature of truth is being corrupted. 51 genders —really?
- 336 Second, they are daily undermining innocent until proven guilty.
- 337 And third, connected with that, the right to face your accuser,
- 338 And fourth, the right to present evidence in your defense,
- 339 And fifth, generally speaking the rule of law versus rule of the mob,
- or, to put it another way, natural law as ordained by God versus
- 341 anarchy,
- 342 And sixth, justice and judgment for all versus special rights and
- 343 protection of the privileged class.
- 344 Protection of the privileged classes Democrat Politicians are the
- 345 Privileged class in our society today. LGBTQ rights eclipse the
- rights of everyone else.
- 347 At the bottom line the Democrat's case against Trump is
- 348 constructed entirely upon hearsay evidence and supported by only
- one thing the Democrats hatred for Donald Trump.
- 350 It's gotten so bad that Democrats are actually saying hearsay
- evidence can be better than direct evidence. I kid you not! There is
- 352 no limit to how far these people will go no limit to how far they
- 353 will distort common sense no limit to how much they will
- 354 torture logic Democrat Mike Quigley "Hearsay can be much
- 355 better evidence than direct evidence?"

- 356 So, what's my prediction? Well, folks, you might remember before
- 357 the mid-term elections in November of 2018, I said, if the
- 358 Democrats retake the house, they will impeach. If they retake the
- 359 house and the Senate, they will get a conviction and issue an
- 360 eviction notice on Trump. The reaction of the American people
- 361 will be strong hopefully, there are enough restraints of the cords
- and bands of Christian grace to hold us back from all war in the
- 363 streets but, you really cannot rule that out.
- Jay Sekulow made similar predictions. But like him, I'm looking at
- 365 this situation and I'm wondering if Adam and Nancy actually have
- 366 the support they need to get an impeachment. It's too obvious that
- 367 there is no case here.
- 368 And Trump's support at the grassroots level is just soaring.
- 369 Trump's campaign is receiving support for his campaign in terms
- 370 of donations and volunteers that is outpacing any of his
- 371 challengers. Dems try to say Trump is losing support among
- women. They must be counting all the snowflakes twice because in
- fact Trump is receiving greater financial support from women than
- any of the Democrat candidates. That means he has the support of
- 375 the women that appreciate his performance in creating jobs and
- 376 protecting our nation.
- 377 But here is what we need to look out for and pray earnestly about.
- 378 Voter fraud that's a big issue. But also this: If the Democrats go
- 379 nuclear and force an impeachment vote, and get a simple majority
- 380 to indict it will go to the Senate, where the standard for
- 381 convictions is significantly higher. The Senate cannot convict
- 382 without a two-thirds majority vote. That means you need 66 Senate
- 383 votes to convict.
- Now, here is the problem. I read today that some in the Senate are
- 385 calling for a closed ballot. The Trump haters are desperate.

- 386 A GOP adviser argued last Tuesday that there is a path to removing
- 387 Trump with a Republican dominated Senate. How?
- 388 The Constitution does not stipulate the rules for how the Senate
- 389 conducts its trial for impeachment. It requires only a simple
- 390 majority to establish the rules. If we assume the Senate is required
- 391 to vote on the rules before they proceed to trial all that would
- 392 have to happen is for three turn-coat Republicrats to demand a
- 393 secret ballot or they will block any set of rules to pass. Assuming
- they had all the Dems on their side, this would effectively hold the
- 395 Senate hostage to their demand. If the Senate finally conceded to
- 396 their demand, then the Senate would adopt a set of rules that
- 397 included a secret ballot. The person advising the GOP in this
- matter raises the question: "If they (the Senate) didn't have to face
- 399 backlash from constituents or the media or the president himself,
- 400 who knows how many Republican senators would vote to remove?"
- 401 This is an unprecedented moment in American history. We quite
- 402 literally stand at a fork in the road where one path leads our nation
- 403 out from under God and into the power of tyrants. And the other
- 404 path leads us back toward our founding principles and toward
- 405 reasserting the foundations of our LIBERTY.
- 406 The "violent take the kingdom by force" to pull something like
- 407 what I described here is "taking the kingdom by force." It's force
- 408 because it's deceptive. If they try to pull that I am sure there will
- 409 be an outcry that will be heard around the world.
- 410 But you should call your representative and implore them to refuse
- 411 Schiff's phony impeachment ploy call 202-224-3121, and express
- 412 your concern that hearsay evidence is not enough to support
- 413 something so serious as impeaching a President.
- 414 Then, if they go ahead with that, you watch, and if you see the
- 415 Senate start playing around with the rules to let these guys hide
- 416 their vote from the people who hired them to represent them, you

- 417 call again and let them know what you think about that kind of
- 418 trickery and deceit and that you believe government should be
- 419 open, and transparent.
