- 19 Why do they hate him? Savanah Hernandez for Action News —
- 20 producer of the "War Room" goes into the streets of Austin, Texas
- 21 to ask Trump protestors what Trump has done that they are
- 22 protesting. The answers ran along the lines of what the Democrats
- 23 have been pushing: he abandoned the Kurds, he is caging the
- 24 children, has sought foreign assistance to investigate his political
- 25 opponent and that was the smattering of responses that were
- 26 coherent, and at least in some measure articulate most of the
- 27 responses were so overcharged with emotion the individual simply

- 28 could not speak. One guy was asked for one thing that triggered
- 29 him against Trump, he said there are so many, he could not narrow
- it down to one thing; so he was asked to name only one he could

- 32 One poor lady had to be confused by the question or something
- 33 because she listed several things Trump has done for the country,
- 34 and Savanah was understandably surprised and thought she
- 35 misunderstood the question, so she said, so those are the things
- 36 that are so bad that you are protesting, and the lady said yes, these
- 37 are the worst things it was bizarre but I think she was trying to
- 38 say although Trump says he does all these things, he is a bad

- 40 But I got to thinking about this and it's clear the one thing these
- 41 people have in common is, well, first off, they are liberal, and the
- 42 second common denominator is they all get their news from the
- 43 fringe media—CNN, ABC, CBS, and so on. I know these are
- 44 usually referred to as the mainstream media, but those who say that
- 45 really need to get caught up with the times. The audience share of
- 46 those networks combined cannot compete with the listenership of
- 47 Rush, Hannity, Levin or FOXNews.
- One guy was asked why he protested Trump and he mentioned the
- 49 Trump/Zelensky call. Savanah asked whether he had read the

- 51 he had not read it, and explained that he "follows it on the news."

- 60 sources such as Judicial Watch and American Center for Law and
- 61 Justice, for international news I look to DEBKA File, and Israel
- News Today, the Jerusalem Post, Haaretz, Arab News, and Foreign
- 63 Affairs to name a few that I use.
- 64 So, I try to stay informed and I try to form my own commentary
- 65 taking into consideration what is said by both sides on every
- 66 question I address.
- 67 Apparently, not one of the people Savanah talked to protesting
- Trump has bothered to actually listen to any opposing viewpoint.
- Now, that can be laziness. But I think it's something more than
- 70 that.
- 71 Also, the hatred for Trump is visceral what does that mean? It
- means the hatred does not come from the intellect, it does not arise
- 73 from reasoned argument, it arises from deep inward feelings
- 74 toward him but not actually toward him.
- 75 If you get into a conversation with a Trump hater, and you begin
- 76 exposing this fact, it goes emotional very quickly. For example, if
- 77 you ask, why do you oppose Trump's presidency? And they say,
- 78 because he puts children in cages. And you respond by saying, so,
- you are talking about the border policy that requires the children to
- be separated from their parents and held in temporary holds, made
- 81 of chain-link fencing, to be immoral and wrong? And they say, yes.
- 82 Then you say, did you feel this way about that when this policy was
- 83 put in place during Bill Clinton's presidency? You usually get, I did
- 84 not know about this being a policy put in place under Clinton. And
- you follow up with did you feel this anger about that policy when it
- 86 was being done during the Obama Presidency? And they say
- 87 something like they did not know about it going on then. And they
- 88 are beginning to be visceral you can see it— the veins in their
- 89 neck begin to pulse and their voice starts getting thin and you
- 90 ask, Why do you suppose you are hearing about this now, but

- 91 never heard about it before? And they have not slugged you, or
- 92 kicked you, or spat at you, or called you a bigot, or a homo-phobe,
- 93 or a racist and they are still talking to you and they have not
- 94 broken down in sobs muttering about how mean you are and
- 95 you have the chance to begin pointing out how hard Trump has
- 96 worked to get around this policy, and accommodate the children
- 97 caught in this situation through no fault of their own but because
- 98 of their parents bad decisions, and so forth who knows, you
- 99 might have thrown a little light into their dark world.
- 100 It's not likely you'll get that far with very many liberals these days
- 101 and that's because as my friend Zach Harman said this morning
- 102 during breakfast you can't reason someone out of a position
- 103 they did not arrive at through reason. You can, sometimes,
- 104 however, nudge them toward the LIGHT of TRUTH by jarring

- 113 testimony reveals WH cover up." PBS shows Democratic
- 114 questioning of Sondland, conveniently leaves out Jordan's smack
- down, which we'll get to in a moment.
- 116 If you watch the entire questioning of Sondland by Democratic
- "counsel" Daniel Sachs Goldman (yeah, not kidding—Daniel Sachs
- 118 Goldman—he is not a representative, but a LAWYER hired by
- 119 Adam Schiff to assist in the investigation of Trump's business
- dealings and tasked with interrogating witnesses in the Trump's a
- 121 rascal farce.)

- 122 So he goes on and on to set up the witness, in this case, Gordan
- 123 Sondland, current US ambassador to European Union, who had a
- 124 conversation with Zelensky during which he made a phone call to
- 125 Trump that was overheard and repeated to the news here spun in
- 126 such a way so as to make it look like Trump was pressuring
- 127 Sondland to pressure Zalensky to investigate Biden and this
- counsel carefully worked to direct Sondland's testimony to support
- 129 the Democratic narrative that the Trump White House is engaged
- in a scheme to pressure Ukraine to dig up dirt on Biden that he can
- 131 use in the upcoming 2020 election campaign so, Sondland
- 132 testifies that in his opinion, the President wanted Zalensky to
- announce the investigation on Biden and Burisma before he would
- release Security AID to Ukraine that it was his perception.
- 135 This is important because current Ukraine Ambassador Taylor's
- 136 belief that Trump tied Security Assistance to the Ukraine
- president's announcement of an investigation into Burisma and the
- 138 Biden connection came from SONDLAND —
- 139 And Sondland repeatedly, I watched this \*YAWN yeah, I
- 140 watched the whole thing Sondland repeatedly said the
- 141 PRESIDENT NEVER SAID he conditioned the call with him, or
- 142 the meeting in DC or the Security Assistance to any promise to
- 143 investigate the Biden connection to corrupt Barisma He
- repeatedly said it was his OPINION that he surmised this based
- 145 on all sorts of circumstances that to him added up to this
- 146 conclusion it was HIS PERSONAL OPINION —
- 147 The origination of this "theory" came from Sondland not from
- 148 Ambassador Taylor, not from Giuliani, not from Pompey, not
- 149 from the President NO ONE told him that the call, or the
- 150 meeting or the money was contingent upon any announcement
- 151 from Zalensky about an investigation in fact according to
- 152 Sondland, in a conversation he had with Trump about this, when
- 153 he finally asked directly for clarification on his instructions, he

- asked flat out, what do you want the Ukrainians to do, Trump said
- 155 NOTHING I want no quid-pro-quo, I want NOTHING ALL
- 156 I WANT FROM ZALENSKY IS THAT HE DO WHAT'S RIGHT,
- 157 THAT HE DO WHAT HE RAN ON —
- 158 That was the clarifying moment for Sondland —
- 159 And then as Jordan brought out THE CALL WAS MADE
- 160 WITHOUT UKRAINE MAKING ANY ANNOUNCEMENT,
- 161 THE MEETING TOOK PLACE WITHOUT ZALENSKY
- 162 MAKING ANY ANNOUNCEMENT, THE MONEY WAS
- 163 RELEASED WITHOUT ZALENSKY MAKING ANY
- 164 ANNOUNCEMENT obviously, Sondland was WRONG!
- 165 He made a mistake. He misunderstood the signals he was getting.
- 166 He misread this President. He thought he was dealing with Obama,
- 167 or Clinton he is not dealing with a corrupt Obama and his
- 168 Alinsky tactics he is dealing with an honest, straight shooting,
- 169 American President who has EVERY RIGHT TO DISTRUST
- 170 UKRAINE, EVERY LEGITIMATE REASON TO TEST THE
- 171 RESOLVE OF THE NEW PRESIDENT TO ROOT OUT THE
- 172 CORRUPTION IN UKRAINE —
- 173 Listen, if you ask me I don't think there is any problem at all
- 174 with the President of the US putting pressure on Ukraine to clean
- up their dirty house if they expect to get assistance from the US.
- 176 Are you kidding me? You know the so-called "black ledger" came
- 177 from NOT RUSSIA, from UKRAINE and that was used to
- 178 undermine a representative of the Trump campaign the DNC
- 179 specifically tasked their Ukraine connection to get dirt on Trump
- and his campaign this is over the top OUTRAGEOUS —
- 181 So, we'll have to take a short break to continue on the other side.
- 182 Hold on the Brain Masseur will be right back.
- 183 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
- 184 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern

lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the

186 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our

187 liberty.

188 There is this rule of law that says you cannot convict a person of a crime unless a crime has been committed. Trying to prove a 189 190 conspiracy to commit a crime is very nearly impossible — and the 191 point is, Sondland, Ambassador to the European Union, who was engaged in negotiations with Ukraine to set up a call, and a 192 meeting, between Ukraine and US — got the impression that the 193 call and meeting were conditioned upon the Ukraine President 194 195 Zalensky, making a public announcement that investigations into the Biden Burisma connection had been launched, and he just sort 196 197 of assumed that was the case, although no one told him this was 198 true, he assumed it, it was the impression he got from the fact that 199 he knew Trump wanted Zalensky to do this, and came to the conclusion that's what was the hang up for getting the call and the 200 meeting arranged, and when he learned the Security assistance was 201 202 being held up, he assumed it also was contingent upon this —

Now, the FACT IS — as I pointed out, WHO CARES? If the 203 204 President has a personal beef with Ukraine because of what he knows is true about their involvement in our elections on behalf of 205 Hillary and against him — and with all the fighting he has to do 206 here to get anything done in this ridiculous environment — I 207 would be suspicious of Ukraine too, and I would say, okay, a new 208 guy has come in, he has promised to drain the swamp there — but 209 210 he seems to be surrounding himself with bad actors from the old regime — so, let's see if he is going to clean up things over there or 211 is he going to continue — I THINK IT'S PERFECTLY 212 213 TO APPROPRIATE FOR THE **PRESIDENT** WITHOLD 214 ASSISTANCE FROM A COUNTRY THAT HAS BEEN A BAD ACTOR WHEN IT COMES TO US ELECTIONS IN THE PAST 215

- 216 UNTIL HE AS ASSURANCES whether it "helps his campaign"
- 217 is totally IRRELEVANT. How stupid is that.
- 218 The President can't do anything that might have the appearance
- 219 that it will HELP HIS CAMPAIGN? This is nonsense.
- 220 Obama told the Russian president to tell Vladimir to be patient,
- 221 because after THE ELECTIONS HE COULD BE MORE
- 222 FLEXIBLE and you could hear the power lines crepitating
- 223 (crackling) drowning out the crickets hah! And we don't even
- 224 have time to get started on Obama's involvement in Benghazi and
- the Hillary email scandal cover up, and delivering billions to Iran,
- and his involvement in spying on Trump's campaign and, and,
- 227 and, while crepitating power-lines and crickets compete in the
- 228 night.
- 229 But the point is nothing happened! There was no quid-pro-quo
- 230 because in fact there WAS NO QUID for the QUO there was no
- 231 THIS for THAT. Ukraine did not DELIVER the THAT for the
- 232 THIS. It didn't happen!
- 233 But Trump wanted it to happen? O, really! And to whom did
- 234 Trump say this? Well, I just inferred it; it's 2+2=4 I mean, I
- 235 know Trump wanted Zalensky to announce an investigation, and
- 236 Ukraine wanted a meeting, and they were looking for the security
- 237 aid so, you know, 2+2 I added that up and got QUID PRO
- 238 QUO. It's unbelievable.
- 239 I guess part of my own exasperation with this rises from my own
- 240 experience of this kind of nonsense. Some just puts together a
- 241 scenario based on their own personal assumptions and opinions
- 242 and starts acting on these things as if they are true and viola,
- you've got a bunch of people accusing you of something that is
- 244 completely untrue. But they believe it because that's what they
- come up with when they add it all up. Okay!
- 246 Let's do some math, shall we. Are you ready?

- Hunter Biden joins the board of Burisma, an energy company in
- 248 Ukraine, in 2014. He is being paid 83K a month and admitted he
- 249 has no idea why the Burisma board hired him.
- 250 In 2015, our Ambassador to Ukraine under Obama was Geoffery
- 251 Pyatt he raised concerns about the optics of Hunter Biden's
- 252 connection with Burisma, and identified the president of
- 253 Ukrainian energy company as exceptionally corrupt and called for
- 254 him to be investigated by Ukraine. We are told that Obama was
- apprised of this and expressed concern.
- 256 In 2016, Pyatt was reassigned to Greece, and taking his place was
- 257 Yavanovitch. Yavanovitch had no problem with Burisma, but
- definitely had a problem with the Ukrainian prosecutor.
- 259 During the 2016 election, Yavanovitch worked with DNC
- 260 operatives and Ukrainian officials to undermine Trump and
- advocate for Hillary.
- 262 After the election, Yavanovitch was so distraught that Trump won
- she refused to hang Trump's portrait in the Embassy.
- 264 That, all by itself, was SUFFICIENT CAUSE for the President to
- 265 fire her! How in the world are you going to get anything done with
- a diplomat that hates you so much she conspired with Ukrainians
- 267 to undermine your election and then after you are elected, refuses
- to acknowledge that you are the President. YOUR FIRED!
- 269 Meanwhile after Pyatt recommended Burisma president be
- 270 investitated for corruption, the Ukrainian prosecutor begins an
- investigation. He raided the Burisma president's house on February
- 272 2, 2016.
- 273 On Feb. 4th, Biden contacts the State Department.
- 274 Daddy Biden, that's Joe to you, followed up with Ukraine on the
- 275 11, 18, and 19.

- Joe holds up US loan guarantees of a billion dollars (the QUID—of
- 277 THIS) unless the then corrupt Ukrainian president fired the
- 278 prosecutor (the QUO or THAT).
- 279 The President of Ukraine complies with Biden's demands and fires
- 280 the prosecutor. The Ukraine provided the THAT and got the
- 281 THIS. A clear, undeniable quid pro quo.
- 282 A THIS for THAT. An actual exchange of value occurred in a
- setting in which the VP of the US demanded a foreign leader DO
- 284 something fire the prosecutor that invaded the home of the
- 285 president of the company his son works for, Burisma before the
- 286 US would release a billion in loan guarantees.
- 287 How does THAT ADD UP in your inference calculator my Liberal
- 288 friends?
- 289 Do I think this is enough to CONVICT Biden or his son? NO! As a
- 290 matter of fact, I don't. I think it adds up to an INVESTIGATION.
- 291 The reason it goes past speculation and mere inference is that IN
- 292 FACT THERE WAS A DECLARED THIS FOR THAT AND THE
- 293 THIS FOR THAT HAPPENED. And Biden BRAGGED ABOUT
- 294 IT, openly. This situation SCREAMS for an investigation.
- 295 So, that's what Trump wants. The secondary issue that such an
- investigation might compromise Biden's bid for the presidency is
- 297 NOT THE POINT. Isn't that interesting, how the DEMS think
- 298 these days.
- 299 Does their fake investigation serve to compromise Trump's
- 300 campaign? Well, yeah! (It's actually backfiring on them, but the
- 301 chess board has developed in such a strange way, the Dems are
- 302 cornered they really no way out at this point they are
- 303 committed to a coup it's the only way they can keep their secrets
- 304 hidden. More on that in a moment.)
- 305 But here is what I want you to think about.

- 306 Trump cannot pursue justice on Biden, he cannot call for an
- 307 investigation on Biden without the left crying about the motivation
- being an effort to get dirt on Biden for his campaign.
- 309 They think that way about Trump because that is exactly the way
- 310 they OPERATE. And that is WHAT THEY ARE DOING with this
- investigation! It's all about trying to undermine Trump's campaign
- 312 and, really, something far more serious! But for the moment,
- 313 think about this.
- 314 Their inferential calculator adds up Trump's interest in
- 315 investigating Biden as a political move to compromise Biden's bid
- 316 for the Presidency. But the facts compelling an investigation into
- 317 Biden's quid-pro-quo move with Ukraine is by any reasonable
- 318 assessment, far more compelling than what they've come up
- 319 regarding Trump.
- 320 It's obvious their investigation into Trump is exactly what they are
- 321 accusing Trump of doing it's an effort to compromise Trump's
- 322 campaign for the 2020 election. Are you seeing this?
- 323 So, if in their rule book, Trump can't call for an investigation into
- 324 Biden because it will benefit his campaign, then THEY CAN'T
- 325 CONTINUE THIS CHARADE OF AN INVESTIGATION INTO
- 326 TRUMP BECAUSE IT SERVES TO COMPROMISE HIS
- 327 CAMPAIGN, AND HIS ENTIRE PRESIDENCY.
- 328 Anyway, the really big news today comes from the Senate —
- 329 Lindsey Graham launches investigation into Biden. That's right!
- 330 Lindsey Graham has initiated the first steps toward investigating
- 331 Biden for his collusion with Barisma and the corrupt president of
- 332 Ukraine in the firing of the prosecutor who dared to begin
- 333 investigating corruption charges against the company his son
- 334 worked for getting 83k per month for well, Hunter Biden
- 335 could not explain what for.

- 337 Vindman the Terpsichorean (Vindman the *dancer*) I can see I
- need to move toward my conclusion so, I'll not take time right
- 339 now to explain the Vindman dance the peacock pluming his
- 340 medals who expects his feathers make his opinion about Trump so
- 341 credible no one needs evidence his opinion alone is enough to
- 342 convict. Just look at those feathers! Wow! Dazzled by his pluming
- 343 everyone is expected to see that for sure Trump colluded with
- Russia and is trying to divert attention to Ukraine What a joke!
- 345 The Nunez/Jordan double team defense: hey, these guys are
- 346 champions of reason, and common sense.
- Nunez and Jordan have doubled up and officially called for Adam
- 348 Schifty to subpoena the Whistle Blower and Biden to testify before
- 349 the committee. That's exactly what any reasonable person would
- 350 expect Schiff to do. He is so panicked about hiding the identity of
- 351 the Whistle Blower he freaks out if anyone asks a question that
- 352 might reveal his identity and so jumps in and interrupts and
- 353 stammers about not allowing any line of enquiry that might reveal
- 354 the Whistle blowers name but, as was brought out, how could
- 355 Adam know if any name mentioned would be the Whistle Blower
- 356 since he does not know his identity?
- 357 Giuliani comes swinging out of the corner. He has been quiet while
- 358 taking a lot of hits from the left I've wondered what is he up to?
- Well, he has been trying to get the truth about what went on in
- 360 Ukraine into the light of day but, as he recently revealed, our
- 361 Ambassador to Ukraine, William Taylor is blocking visas of any
- 362 Ukrainian who wants to come here and "blow up Schiff's
- 363 completely fraudulent investigation" that from the Conservative
- 364 Review. How about that?
- 365 And, the IG (Investigator General) Report we've been waiting for
- 366 releases information proving Peter Strzok doctored a FISA
- 367 Warrant that's very damning to the Dems efforts to hide all this.
- 368 FBI agent Peter Strzok "doctored" the FISA Warrant —

- 369 This pushes forward the mighty wheel of Justice: and it's just
- 370 getting started folks. It's like a great wheel, it takes a huge amount
- of energy to get it started to roll, but once this thing starts rolling,
- 372 Lord have mercy, look out! It's going to crash through all that the
- 373 Democrats have been trying to build up against Trump like a
- 374 hurricane through a house-of-cards.
- 375 So that's my take on the impeachment investigation so far. As for
- 376 will the Democrats impeach? At this point, I don't see how they
- have a way out. They are committed to this path—and even though
- 378 it is clearly leading to a CLIFF I don't see a way for them to have
- made all this noise and not go forward with a vote.
- 380 Whether they get the votes they need interestingly, that is
- actually up in the air at this time. I mentioned efforts already at
- 382 work in the Senate to get a secret ballot and we need to cry to
- 383 heaven against any such scheme to hide from the American people
- 384 by casting a secret ballot if it does go to the Senate for trial.
- 385 A while back, I would have said impeachment is a forgone
- 386 conclusion what we are watching is just show casing and
- 387 stalling. But, now, after seeing what they have, or should I say, after
- 388 seeing their case is nothing but hearsay and made up testimony —
- 389 I'm not sure the Democrat representatives who must face
- 390 reelection in 2016 are going to be willing to die on this hill.
- 391 Because, unless they come up with a whole lot more than they have
- 392 right now, this is going to be a huge embarrassment for the
- 393 Democrats and it's already energizing Trump's supporters and
- 394 adding an increasing number of Democrat defectors to his side.
- 395 The Sympathy vote is turning against Schiff and for Trump.
- 396 So, why do they hate Trump? I can see that I'll not have time to
- 397 finish that point this show is very dynamic my friends I can
- 398 start with a clear idea of where I want to go, but as I go, it just sort
- 399 of, well, goes ...

- 400 It's a question worth pondering, so I'll address it some more in my
- 401 Issachar Report Sunday night at 5 pm to 5:30. If you want a clear
- 402 biblical perspective on why they hate Trump, come on out to our
- 403 services Sunday night, 5 pm.
- 404 But I wanted to speak to the recent trend to force our young ladies
- in High School to undress in front of boys who claim they are girls.
- 406 Like you, I am sick and tired of these narcissistic LGBTQ activists
- 407 and their total disregard for the sensible sensitivities and liberties
- 408 of others. These are among the most selfish human beings on the
- 409 planet today.
- 410 Think about this. They demand a right to force us to use the
- 411 pronoun they believe identifies their gender. So if it's a boy we are
- 412 talking to who believes he is a girl, we have to use she in reference
- 413 to him rather than he. Well, I identify as an even tempered, well
- 414 adjusted, lover of all mankind so, they can never call me racist
- 415 again. They don't have a right to call bigoted, because I don't self-
- 416 identify with bigot. It offends me, it is contrary to what I believe is
- 417 true about myself so you begin to see how absurd this is.
- 418 YOU CAN'T FORCE ME TO ACCEPT YOUR DELUSIONS.
- Now, you have a right to your delusions. BUT YOU DON'T HAVE
- 420 A RIGHT TO FORCE ME TO AFFIRM THEM.
- 421 If you think you are Napoleon, I am not obliged to oblige your
- 422 insanity.
- 423 A boy who tells everyone around him that he is a girl has a right to
- 424 do so. He can call himself a girl if he chooses to do so but he
- 425 cannot force me to call him girl.
- Now, a boy who calls himself a girl competing in sports against
- 427 God ordained girls is CHEATING! He is stealing from real girls
- any chance they have to compete fairly. It's wrong.

- 429 A girl is denied the opportunity to compete fairly in such
- 430 situations.
- No one cares about those girls who have a legitimate expectation to
- be treated fairly, but their feelings don't matter.
- 433 The only thing that matters is that everybody bow down to the
- 434 LGBTQ agenda to FORCE their delusions and sexual perversity on
- 435 all of us.
- 436 You have no right to call what they do sexual perversity. Are you
- 437 kidding me?
- I have as much right to call that behavior perverse as you have to
- 439 call it normal. I don't deny to you the right to advocate for this

- and beat your drums but we are not going to bow down.
- 462 Anyway, I gotta go.

- 465 ON and you will ride like Revere and spread the warning,
- 466 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say

- 469 lights off?
