5 pushing Nikki to replace Pence — antichrist spirit agitated! Kamala  
6 Caves! And the CA voter fraud industry thrives! Chic-Fil-A  
7 Spreads Its Wings For the LGBTQ — but her new chics scoff! Will  
8 Christians walk away from Chic-Fil-A? The new attack on Trump  
9 — it was Trump's a Racist — now it's Trump's A Liar. Here is a list  
10 of 5,700+ lies that Trump has told since he became President.  
11 Biden snarls at a voter who dared ask him about his son's cushy  
12 Ukraine job and Biden starts insulting the guy about his weight

30 was missing a button, you know, that sort of thing — I guess you  
31 might prefer to say he was facing "non-judicial punishment for a  
32 minor offense" — but, anyway! He killed two and wounded one

34 recent shooting and shooter in Pensacola than we do about the  
35 December 5 Pearl Harbor shooting and I'm just saying that's

45 RINO movement alert? The RINO's are pushing Nikki to replace  
46 Pence? Don't let the antichrist controlled left fool you. I don't see  
47 Trump dumping Pence and taking on Nikki. But while we are on  
48 the subject of Nikki, Levin has branded her a RINO—the only  
49 things I can find that Nikki has done to tweak conservatives is,  
50 first, call for the removal of the Confederate Navy Jack (the  
51 Confederate Flag) from South Carolina capitol grounds (I've  
52 always appreciated the tolerance Americans have, I mean generally  
53 speaking, we have ignored that fact that while the Southern state

65 came to be used as a verb meaning things that fit, or agree with one  
66 another). Back to Haley — I know she did not support Trump at  
67 first — but neither did Levin — and in the interest of full  
68 disclosure, neither did I — but we have all been wonderfully  
69 surprised and delighted at his extraordinary leadership, especially  
70 when the irrational, and down right evil opposition he has had to  
71 deal with is taken into consideration. It's truly remarkable! But,  
72 back to Haley — the charge that she is an establishment RINO  
73 seems almost as thin as the charge is that Trump colluded with  
74 Russia — some might interpret her softer-milder conservatism a  
75 threat to us on the battlefield we fight on today — but, Trump  
76 continues to think highly of her — but here is where this comes  
77 from the inside scuttlebutt (a word that comes from the drinking

88 have given up trying to take out Trump (Trump now has a 95%  
89 approval rating within the Republican Party) and they can see that  
90 the Dems are floundering in their efforts to take him out — they  
91 are trying a new angle. They want to set up Nikki Haley to replace

92 Pence as VP — or set her up to run against Pence in the Primary  
93 after Trump's second term.

94 I've said often that antichrist spirit is targeting Trump right now,  
95 and only giving secondary level attacks against Pence — but when  
96 Pence is up for President — watch out! It's going to be all out war  
97 on Pence.

98 The Devil is not going to willingly give up the territory he has held  
99 for so long in this country: politics, education, sciences, no way! He  
100 will fight to the end and so we must remain diligent to the end.

101 Back to the current battle for AMERICA! Kamala has folded her  
102 campaign tents and returned home. Big-Gulp regulator—and gun  
103 hater, Trumpophobe Bloomberg has stepped into the ring. Booker  
104 is complaining that there are more billionaires than blacks running  
105 for President.

106 What a weird thing to say. More billionaires than blacks—it's so  
107 weird to me because I just don't think that way at all. Being a  
108 billionaire does not disqualify someone from holding office, and  
109 being black does not qualify someone for holding office. What is  
110 with the Democrats superficial fixation on the veneer? At least with  
111 the billionaire thing, someone did something to accumulate that  
112 wealth — but being black or white or brown or yellow tinted is  
113 something no one has control over. It's about the heart, the beliefs,  
114 the soul of the person, not how much money he or she has or the  
115 color of someone's skin. When will the blacks in America hear  
116 what one of their greatest leaders said — he desired all men,  
117 created equal by their Creator, would be judged by the content of  
118 their character and not by the color of their skin?

119 Happily, many black Americans are beginning to see through all  
120 the lies the Democrats have used to continue slaving them into  
121 dependency on them in exchange for their votes. 34% of Blacks  
122 support Donald Trump now. For the Dems to be losing this key

123 block of votes has got to be getting under their skin — digging at  
124 them under the veneer — eating at their already distorted souls.

125 And that brings me to the close of the first segment — all of this  
126 gives rise to voter fraud concerns.

127 CA voter fraud industry thrives! (Hey, I wonder if all the libs who  
128 believe a *two-state* solution to the ongoing conflict between Hamas  
129 and Israel would work here in California. How about a two state  
130 solution to resolve the anger felt by millions of Californians who  
131 feel they have little or not representation in Sacramento, or  
132 Washington because of the densely populated liberal California  
133 enclaves pushing socialism down the throats of the rural  
134 Californians who stay as far from the dirty, filthy cities of SFO and  
135 LA as they can but whose interests are literally dictated by these  
136 liberal swamps —how about a Two State solution? Check out  
137 New\_California and Paul Preston and look into this.) Voter fraud  
138 is a huge problem in our state. Remember the 2018 election  
139 scandal? Oh, you did not hear about that?

140 Several elections in California were called for Republicans but  
141 switched to Democrats the next day. One dramatic example if  
142 Young Kim — a Korean American candidate who was leading by  
143 8k votes against the Democrat candidate. She had begun her  
144 orientation for the new GOP freshman class — but all of a sudden,  
145 her lead disappeared and the Democrat won.

146 Indeed, all six races in which Republicans led on election night fell  
147 into the hands of the Democrats the next day.

148 The thing is, voter fraud is not always done illegally! Uh huh! Get  
149 this.

150 AB 1921 allows voters to give "third party" persons the power to  
151 collect and turn in their ballot. So the Democrats would do  
152 something called ballot harvesting. They go to houses of possible  
153 Democrat voters and ask if they can carry their ballot for them to

154 the poll. In one case, that got out, some harvesters came to a  
155 Republican household and asked to speak to the 18 year old in the  
156 household who was a no-party-preference voter — they came by  
157 four times — anyway, this opens the door for these fraudsters to  
158 walk in with hundreds of allegedly "harvested" votes and turn them  
159 in with no questions asked. No verification is required. It invites  
160 voter coercion, bullying, something called "granny farming" where  
161 they take advantage of an elderly person and manipulate them into  
162 allowing them to complete his or her ballot and take it in, and even  
163 automated forgery. I mean, what are the odds that six races where  
164 Republicans were leading on election night and all of them fall into  
165 the hands of the Democrats the next day when "harvested ballots"  
166 are counted? You would reasonably assume the harvested ballots  
167 would be reflective of the general voting trends in that election and  
168 not be overwhelmingly skewed in one or another direction—except  
169 that it was the Democrats doing the harvesting!

170 Consider that 250,000 harvested ballots were brought in for the  
171 Orange County races that allowed Democrats to sweep Orange  
172 County, which is a Republican stronghold and has been for a very  
173 long time. Okay, I need to conclude the first segment of your brain  
174 massage for today; but, hold on through the break because, I'll be  
175 right back!

176 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
177 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
178 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
179 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
180 liberty.

181 Tell me it isn't so! Chic-Fil-A Spreads Its Wings For the LGBTQ?  
182 Chic-Fil-A was started by a dedicated Christian man who wanted  
183 to glorify God with his business. It says so in his mission statement.

184 The LGBTQ activists targeted Chic-Fil-A because the family was  
185 known for their Christian position on the issue, and complained  
186 against them for their contributions to organizations they  
187 considered to be antigay. Organizations like Salvation Army —  
188 unreal!

189 Anyway, the life destruction machine of the left under the control  
190 of the LGBTQ agenda went to work, attacked Chic-Fil-A. They  
191 called for boycotts and so forth, and of course, this led to Cathy  
192 being asked for statements on his personal beliefs about  
193 homosexuality. He said, "I think we are inviting God's judgment on  
194 our nation when we shake our fist at Him and say, 'We know better  
195 than you as to what constitutes a marriage'. I pray God's mercy on  
196 our generation that has such a prideful, arrogant attitude to think  
197 that we have the audacity to define what marriage is about."<sup>1</sup> And  
198 other statements like that — this generated a literal fire-storm of  
199 response from the liberals attacking them viciously — denying  
200 building permits in some towns, and some cities inviting them to  
201 leave — but the Christian base rose up and stood in defense of this  
202 families right to their own opinion. This is a part of the controversy  
203 many don't understand. Cathy had no intention of branding his  
204 company in this fight — the LGBTQ people did that — he was  
205 simply stating his personal beliefs about the issue.

206 And, what is happening now, that the "old man" has gone on to  
207 heaven, is very, very sad!! I don't think this would happen if Truett  
208 Cathy was still living. But, let's get it in a proper perspective!

209 Cathy is foolishly trying to kiss and make up with those who were  
210 offended by his statements, because, personally, he does not want  
211 to offend anyone, and corporately, he never intended to make  
212 Chic-Fil-A a battleground in the culture war. So, let's look at this.

213 Personally, I don't have a quarrel with Chic-Fil-A or anyone else  
214 desiring to make the point that they don't hate homosexuals, or  
215 transvestites, or transgendered whatevers —. I don't know any  
216 Christian who believes these people were excluded from the  
217 Atonement—I John 2:1-2 makes that very clear, and what I mean,  
218 the Scripture does not support the idea that these cannot be  
219 redeemed by the blood shed on the Cross for all our sins. I've  
220 spoken to the fact that homosexuality is a cross-over iniquity — I  
221 mean, when someone deviates from God's design physically and  
222 morally to the extent they engage in what the Bible describes as  
223 unnatural behavior, a behavior He has called abominable (among  
224 other things, by the way) — but any who will confess they are  
225 sinners, turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to  
226 God, calling on the NAME of the LORD, confessing with their  
227 mouth He is indeed LORD and believing in their heart God raised  
228 Him from the dead — they will be saved — and last time I checked,  
229 the Bible still says, FOR WHOSOEVER SHALL CALL UPON THE  
230 NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED. No exclusions!

231 And, furthermore, I think we need to remember that Christians did  
232 not rally to Chick-Fil-A because the company had made a negative  
233 statement against Homosexuals or even that owners of the  
234 company stood up for what we believe — all that happened was  
235 one of the owners expressed their opinion, in a non-combative  
236 manner, by the way, just simply expressed their personal opinion  
237 — an opinion that was not directly stated in any of their company  
238 literature — that he believed in the biblical model for marriage —  
239 one man for one woman. I don't know if he added, *for life*, but he  
240 made the point that the family believed in the traditional American  
241 model for the family and the LGBTQ community went out of their  
242 minds and then the heat began to get turned up.

243 Christians responded to the unfairness of this behavior, to the  
244 outrageous attack on a Christian's right to believe in traditional



245 marriage without being taken to the public square and flogged by  
246 these fascist bullies. We lined up at Chic-Fil-A to make a statement  
247 of support for freedom of speech — not hatred for LGBTQ people  
248 — for traditional marriage — not hatred for homosexuals. In other  
249 words, if Chic-Fil-A had made a public statement connecting their  
250 brand, Chic-Fil-A with a statement denigrating homosexuals as  
251 hate-filled bigots who want to push their perverse agenda on others  
252 — I would have approved of the statement, because it's true! But I  
253 would very likely have questioned whether the owners of the  
254 company spoke for everyone that worked for them. I would have  
255 said what I always say about this sort of thing — Hey, Chic-Fil-A,  
256 sell your chicken sandwiches. Chic-Fil-A was not incorporated as a  
257 non-profit political organization with a mission statement that  
258 declares its intention to change the world through political  
259 activism. Mr. Cathy did, however, dedicate the business to the  
260 glory of God. But, essentially, the company was started to sell  
261 chicken sandwiches, and they cleverly promoted their brand by  
262 capitalizing on our natural sympathy for the cows, which, in their  
263 advertisements, begged us to "eat more chicken."

264 Chick-Fil-A never intended to attach their brand with political  
265 issues, or the cultural debate over homosexual marriage. But with  
266 the left, if you have an opinion contrary to theirs, they will brand  
267 you — they will attack you on every level. You see it was the  
268 LGBTQ community who branded the company, Chic-Fil-A, with  
269 this political point of view — as far as the owners were concerned,  
270 they were speaking for themselves, expressing their personal point  
271 of view.

272 Well, they enjoyed a huge bump in sales over this because  
273 Christians all over the country said, hey, that's not fair, that's not  
274 right; let's go eat some chicken.

275 The owners of Chic-Fil-A are Southern Baptist, the church they  
276 attend is First Baptist of Jonesboro, in Georgia; it's what we would

277 call a New Cart Church, and if you don't know what that means,  
278 you have not read my book, *The New Cart Church*, so call in and if  
279 you are in our area and want a copy, I'll have one brought to you.  
280 The ministry philosophy of First Baptist at Jonesboro appears to  
281 lack a clear idea of what it means to be salt and light in decaying  
282 and darkening America today. You know the type: they don't want  
283 controversy, they want everyone to be comfortable with them —  
284 they confuse everyone loving them with everyone loving God. It's a  
285 ministry that has positioned itself as near to the middle of the road  
286 as they can in their music, well, maybe a left of center but certainly  
287 not so outrageous as some hard rock churches — and the point I'm  
288 making is this. The founder is an old-timer, he died in 2014 at 93,  
289 and the church he raised his kids in is a Nikki Haley church — it  
290 will sound very strong conservatively when talking to  
291 conservatives, but the inside is squishy — and all of that to say, the  
292 accommodation we can see reflected in the church the family  
293 attends is appearing in the accommodating spirit that seems to  
294 have taken hold of the family because they want to accommodate  
295 the world.

296 Jesus warned us the world did not love Him and we should not  
297 expect it to love us. So maybe the Cathy's will get a first lesson the  
298 enmity of the Cross — they hate you because you are of the Spirit  
299 of Jesus Christ and no matter what you do, unless that changes,  
300 unless you flip over to their side completely, unless you virtually  
301 apostatize — the Devil's crowd will never be satisfied. You will be  
302 required to renounce your faith before the Devil is done with you.

303 Are you willing to go that far, Mr. Cathy? What would your father  
304 think of what you are doing?

305 Will Christians walk away from Chic-Fil-A? I don't know! I think  
306 this certainly has taken the wind out of the sails and there will be  
307 very little enthusiasm — but as far as raising a boycott of Chic-Fil-  
308 A — personally, I doubt it. Except for one thing! They would

309 withdraw their support of the Salvation Army and take up support  
310 for the Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC). Everyone knows that  
311 the SPLC is a front for the Marxist Socialists — it can defame  
312 people like David Horrowits, and Family Research Council, and  
313 others, but can't seem to see its way forward to identify Antifa as a  
314 hate group! Yeah! Chic-Fil-A withdrew support from Salvation  
315 Army and is now supporting the Southern Poverty Law Center —  
316 an arm of the hate Trump movement. For example, during  
317 testimony, the CEO of the Law Center testified that Trump's  
318 campaign "energized the white supremacist movement" that the  
319 number of registered users on the white supremacist website  
320 doubled from 140,000 in 08 to 330,000 in 2017.

321 When confronted with the uncomfortable truth that most of this  
322 growth of interest in white supremacy took place during  
323 Obama's watch, Mr. Cohen was visibly annoyed that someone was  
324 knowledgeable of such facts — and when asked, essentially, that  
325 the rise in interest was not on account of Obama, was it? And so, is  
326 it fair to say the increase in interest was caused by Trump, Mr.  
327 Cohen replied, it is "Depending on the individual."

328 The SPLC donates almost exclusively to Democrats, partners with  
329 liberal advocacy groups like Media Matters, and so on and this  
330 group has positioned itself as the sole arbiter of what is and what is  
331 not hate in America today.

332 So, Southern Poverty Law Center can brand the Family Research  
333 Council a hate organization, and rationalize away not branding  
334 Antifa a hate organization on the ground that Antifa is inclusive  
335 and FRC is exclusionary — makes perfect sense. You see, SPLC is a  
336 liberal organization, by its own admission, by the way, and liberals  
337 are inclusive, so hatred against exclusive groups is okay, because  
338 they believe in including every body's point of view except 1 — and  
339 that is the Christian point of view. In the liberal mindset, inclusive  
340 goes beyond a love for all mankind and a desire for all men every to

341 repent and believe on Jesus Christ — and to come to the  
342 knowledge of the truth — inclusiveness to the liberal means there  
343 are no distinctions between right and wrong, good and evil, sin and  
344 righteousness — there is only one criteria and that is either you  
345 agree that there are no distinctions between good and evil or you  
346 are evil. In other words, good is agreeing not to tell someone what  
347 they are doing is bad, unless you are talking about someone who  
348 tells other people that what they are doing is wrong! Then, that's  
349 wrong, because nothing is! So if you say someone is wrong, you are  
350 wrong, because you can say anyone is wrong — but, that's what  
351 you are doing when you brand Family Research Council as a hate  
352 group — you are saying it is an act of hatred to disagree with  
353 someone's personal point of view — so, since you disagree with my  
354 point of view, the SPLC must be a hate group by their own  
355 definition, and ironically, that's exactly what they are.

356 They are the very definition of a hate group. They have invented  
357 their own criteria for deciding what defines a hate group and apply  
358 it to people who have never committed an act of violence against  
359 anyone — and refuse to apply it to a group that routinely commits  
360 acts of violence against innocent victims because they do it in the  
361 name of inclusivity. Like the people who are threatening Turley,  
362 one of their own, by the way; a Hillary supporter, a Trump  
363 detractor, but a liberal that has so far escaped Trump-derangement  
364 disease, and is able to think with at least sufficient clarity as to see  
365 the utter paucity of evidence the Dems have to impeach Trump,  
366 and said so, out loud, in front of God and everybody — that the  
367 Dems were obviously doing this out of anger, because there is no  
368 legitimate evidence supporting their allegations — well, the  
369 tolerant and inclusive left have reacted to Turley with death  
370 threats. I noticed, by the way, that Schiff did not interrupt the  
371 proceedings to inform everyone about the death threats Turley was  
372 getting during his testimony — so, just sayin'!

373 Another example of the inclusiveness of the Left — liberals, you  
374 know, they're so inclusive. And you know that it's impossible to be  
375 truly inclusive because everyone is going to draw a line  
376 SOMEWHERE. Inclusiveness necessarily breeds hypocrisy!

377 Anyway! The message of the SPLC is that you can commit acts of  
378 violence against people that disagree with the political correct  
379 ideology of the LEFT and, while they will show case concern about  
380 this and say no, no, now, don't do that; they do understand — this  
381 sort of violence is not an act of ideological hatred because it is done  
382 on behalf of an ideology of inclusivity. Which, as we have shown, is  
383 not inclusivity — it's every bit as exclusive as anyone and even  
384 more so, because you don't see Christians beating people up for not  
385 believing they way they think you should—and if you bring up the  
386 Catholic persecution against detractors against the Catholic  
387 church, you did not listen carefully, I said, Christians don't behave  
388 this way. Catholics certainly have done so in the past and will do so  
389 in the future, by the way.

390 But back to the Southern Poverty Law Center — we should not be  
391 surprised that they would be so obviously self-contradictory. These  
392 are the same people who say boys can be girls if they fell like that's  
393 what they are. So!

394 Anyway, I'm not a fan of Chic-Fil-A — and it won't be hard for me  
395 to avoid dining there in the future.

396 The new attack on Trump — it was Trump's a Racist, right? Now  
397 it's Trump's A Liar. Here is a list of 5,700+ lies that Trump has told  
398 since he became President.<sup>2</sup> Wow! That's a lot of whoppers! But  
399 here is a collection from the Washington Post — and we are aware  
400 of their diligence in verifying a story and getting their facts straight  
401 — remember Jan. 1, 2017, the scare perpetrated by WAPO over  
402 allegations that Russia had hacked deep into the U.S. power grid?

403 Turned out the threat was what they reported; it was on a laptop  
404 that was unconnected to the utility grid. But the Post never did  
405 indicate to its readers that they had to update the story nor admit  
406 they jumped the gun with unverified information. So, since we are  
407 talking about a news organization with a reputation for carefully  
408 vetting its data, let's take a look at their list of lies — According to  
409 WAPO, "President Trump has made 13,435 false or misleading  
410 claims over 993 days." Wow!

411 Now, to analyze this will take some time and I'm very close to the  
412 end of my broadcast time for this show. So let me offer a summary,  
413 and then, just as I did with the claim that Trump is racist, I'll go  
414 over all these claims and what you are going to see is this —  
415 roughly 75% of the claims are based on debates about the facts,  
416 how one side interprets them; about 10% are errors in the category  
417 of inadvertent misstatements of facts, or incorrect knowledge of  
418 certain facts (some information he was given, and repeated, that  
419 turned out not to be completely accurate) — not like when Biden  
420 told his big fat fib about his involvement in an awards ceremony —  
421 and, really, not even like when Obama mistakenly said he visited all  
422 57 States — or consistently misquoted the Declaration of  
423 Independence, or when he said our national motto was e pluribus  
424 unum instead of In God We Trust. Liberals really hate the 50s, but  
425 we'll get deeper into that later.

426 The sort of thing I'm talking about is what happens when you are  
427 telling a story and your wife interrupts you and corrects you on a  
428 minor detail of the story that you misremembered. In other words,  
429 you were not lying; that is, you were not attempting to deceive  
430 anyone, you simply did remember every detail of the event  
431 correctly, and so you depended on your wife to straighten everyone  
432 out on the details because she is jealous to protect your integrity—I  
433 mean, if you slip and remember a certain dress someone wore was

434 yellow, and she reminds you it was ochre — haha! You see what I  
435 mean. That's about 10% of the 13k lies that WAPO has tracked.

436 So about 85% are actually no legitimately categorized as lies —  
437 such as when Adam Schiffy fabricates a version of what the  
438 President said on his phone call obviously intending to caste the  
439 call in a particularly unflattering light, who when he was called on  
440 this, dismissed it as parody! You see! I believe Schiff did that on  
441 purpose to read into the record his evil spin on the phone call,  
442 because he wanted to plant in the minds of the American people  
443 what he wanted them to believe and see when they read the  
444 transcript. This is Devilish — this is genuine deceiving!

445 Anyway, the rest of the occasions identified by WAPO and Daily  
446 Beast as *lies* are nothing more than opinions that liberals disagree  
447 with and so they argue they are lies.

448 But, may the weight of their lies finally cave in on their heads!  
449 They've got to be getting tired of trying to carry on this farce — the  
450 work involved in creating this fiction is heavy and the weight of it  
451 increases with every new lie — may it wear on them, may all the  
452 devils propping them up be driven off and the full weight of their  
453 lying fall on them and crush them — hopefully, to repentance —  
454 but if not then to their destruction.
