- 2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain
- 3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.
- 4 The State of the Union Address, Pelosi the Ripper, The Acquittal
- 5 and new revelations about the Ukraine point to China, the
- 6 disintegration of the Democrat Party primary, and the role of faith
- 7 in American politics what a week! It's time for your brain
- 8 massage.

- 10 President Trump never looked or sounded more Presidential than
- 11 he did during the State of the Union Address. Oh, quit rolling your

Did Pence and Trump agree they would not shake hands in order to dilute the 32 33 intended rebuff of der Nancy? Well, she got him back, right? She 34 ripped up the speech. But did you know that the speech she had 35 was pre-cut? Did you know that? No kidding. - 60 What the Democrats did to Trump is unconscionable despicable
- 61 it would have been an effrontery to dignity, or decency, to shake
- hands with the Devil as if congratulating him on succeeding in his
- 63 evil purpose.
- I am blessed to have a highly intelligent audience. I am also blessed
- 65 to have some who listen because even though they don't like much
- of what I say they like the way I say it. And we have some who
- 67 monitor the show in hopes I'll say something to justify their hatred.
- 68 So, I keep this in mind. And I know some will say I have just
- 69 likened Nancy Pelosi to Nazis, and the Devil!
- Well, in fact there are similarities! Haha! But actually, that is not
- 71 what I was doing here. Because I know some liberals are strangely
- 72 literal when attacking us and then bizarrely loose in their

- 84 honest trial or test of skill—but it's something else altogether to
- shake hands with a snake, a liar, a deceiver, and a person that is evil
- and hiding this behind prayer, or her Catholic faith.
- 87 So you get the point. You are not like AOC who just does not get it.
- 88 She goes off on the expression "pull yourself up by your own
- 89 bootstraps" getting all indignant and saying, "you know, it's actually
- 90 impossible to pull yourself up by your own shoe strings." Hahah.
- 91 You are kidding me, right? Do I need to explain the metaphor? Of

- 92 course no! Many of you listening to me toiled and labored in your
- 93 own sweat and tears, and even blood, to get where you are without
- 94 taking a handout you achieved your success by hard work, and
- 95 personal initiative you, "pulled yourself up by your own
- 96 bootstraps. Okay, maybe AOC was also being metaphorical, and
- 97 what she believes is NO ONE CAN MAKE IT WITHOUT
- 98 GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE.
- 99 What was the highlight of the speech? So many things the
- soldier brought home to be reunited with his family, the inspiring
- 101 testimonies of Americans who rose above hardship prospering

- 103 Presidency is restoring our confidence in the American Dream
- 104 (which goes way past a picket fence enclosed house on cherry
- 105 blossom lane—it's about freedom, liberty, justice) and, of
- 106 course, the well deserved honor given to Rush Limbaugh. Obama
- pinned that honor on pedophiles and criminals it's nice to see it
- 108 extended to a real American hero of FREEDOM. Congratulations
- 109 to America's anchor man! Many big moments during this speech.
- 110 And Although Nancy tried to steal the show with her premeditated
- 111 crime of destroying government property hehe! That speech will
- 112 continue to reverberate right on down to November.
- 113 About the charge that Nancy actually violated law when she tore
- 114 up the President's speech 18 US code 2071 clearly stipulates that
- any person mutilating an official document filed or deposited with
- any clerk is liable to be fined or imprisoned with the added
- provision that such person will be removed from office and will be
- barred from holding any future office. The question is whether the
- 119 copy of the speech provided to Nancy by the President is a personal
- 120 copy of the speech, or an official record of State and I think the
- 121 argument that the speech Trump handed Pelosi was an official
- 122 document filed with an official clerk of court or office that is —
- 123 property of the US government, will fail. I mean, if you, through a

- 124 FOIA petition received copies of official documents you would not
- be considered in violation of this statute if you ran them through a
- shredder after you finished perusing them.
- But what about Nancy's charge that all she ripped up was the State
- of Trump's Mind address, or that she "shredded his speech because
- in the speech he shredded the truth."
- 130 That's the echo: the speech was full of lies. And the obvious
- 131 response is oh, well, name one. To which they respond the speech
- was full of lies, and you might as well give up trying to get them to
- 133 name one and the reason they won't go into specifics is that they
- are aware Trump is getting his numbers from reliable sources. You
- 135 remember what went on with Obama—how they artificially hid
- 136 how really bad the job numbers were by removing from the
- 137 number all who gave up looking for a job and we argued with
- them back and forth. They would put out some numbers, we would
- come back and say wait a minute; you changed the rules. We used
- to count all able-bodied people out of work, now you only count
- those on unemployment who are attempting to find work. So,
- while figures don't lie liars figure, statistics can be manipulated to
- 143 say almost anything you want to say so some of the Obama
- 144 holdovers lurking in the deep waters of the swamp bend the
- 145 numbers and manipulate the math but trust me on this one. If
- they had hard evidence that the job numbers, or the economy was
- bad, that evidence would be out there 24/7. So, all they can say is he
- lied. It's the same with the impeachment travesty that has happily

- 157 about what the Democrat Party has become. Wow! What a
- powerful answer to prayer we are seeing.
- 159 It's jaw dropping. The Democrats have failed at everything they
- have talked about doing for decades but they have been able to hide
- 161 their failure behind smooth talk and by pointing the finger at
- someone else, and keep their opponents down by the politics of
- personal destruction but GOD has raised up a man who simply
- 164 will not be intimidated, or cowed by their smear attacks. He just
- holds his head up and goes right back at them.
- 166 Now, talking about prayer! The prayer breakfast event following
- 167 the Acquittal Trump holding up the headlines TRUMP
- 168 ACQUITTED declaring his distaste for people who use their
- 169 faith to justify doing something they know is wrong, and these
- 170 phony people who say they are praying for you when it's obvious

- 173 He talks like a real person. He is constantly accused of being
- 174 dishonest, but this President is the most frank and honest
- 175 President we've ever seen. He does not shake hands with phonies,
- and he does not engage in the pretensions expected from sophists
- 177 if you are a scum bag, he is likely to openly call you a scum bag;
- if you are a backstabbing weasel, he has no respect for you and will
- 179 not pretend otherwise. Folks, I'm lovin' this. Hold on through the
- 180 break. I'll be right back.
- 181 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
- 182 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
- lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the
- 184 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
- liberty.

- 186 I hope you are listening to the "other side." The Democrat Deluded
- 187 Trump haters supporting a party that can't do anything right—they
- can't do an impeachment right—botched it, had no case, pushed it
- 189 through anyway, admitted they had no case when they started
- 190 calling on the Senate to do the job they virtually admitted they
- 191 failed to do, which is make their case, and that's because there was
- 192 no case to make—it was constructed entirely upon hearsay
- 193 evidence, and that amounted to presumptions about what the
- 194 President meant by what he said to Zelenski, then they botch the
- 195 first primary, I mean, out of the gate, they stumble all over
- 196 themselves can't even count votes right so for Democrats the
- 197 Iowa primary votes are frozen. I think what happened is too many
- 198 Democrats wrote in Trump haha.
- 199 Democrats for Trump they want to draft Trump to get the
- 200 Democrat nomination!!!
- 201 So what will the Democrats do now that Trump has been
- 202 acquitted? Exactly what we all expected they would do. Impeach
- 203 him again! They are going to impeach Trump until they get the
- 204 result they want. But impeachment did not help them in polls, it
- 205 has not reduced Trump's appeal to his base, and it has actually
- 206 enhanced his appeal to moderate Democrats.
- 207 Why would they continue sawing off the branch they are sitting
- 208 on?
- Well, Glen Beck brought out some new revelations about the
- 210 Ukraine that might explain this. And, actually, it goes to something
- 211 I've been saying right along the Democrats are desperate to
- 212 cover up the corruption in their own party, and to protect Obama's
- 213 legacy. They thought Obama would carry them forward to the full
- 214 transformation of America; it has unraveled, and they are trying to
- 215 regain the momentum they imagined they had with Obama.

- 217 Apparently, a document has surfaced that reveals why Trump was
- 218 interested in the Biden allegations being investigated in Ukraine
- 219 before he would release the funds. He shows that the timeline
- leading up to the July 25 call to Zalenski created by the Dems is
- fake it was fabricated to hide the real events that led to that call.
- Here is the timeline Beck put together:
- 223 1. Sept. 2014 1.8 BN US dollars disappeared from Kolomoiski's
- 224 ProvatBank. Where did this money go? ProvatBank is linked to
- Burissma, and Burissma was suspected of corruption.
- 226 2. December 2016 Ukraine seizes Provat Bank from Kolomoiski
- accusing him of enriching himself on IMF funding. This involves
- another 7 BN. What motivated Ukraine to seize assets of Provat
- Bank? Now, we are going to back up a little to see what led to this.
- 230 3. An election happened in America in which Trump beat Hillary
- with a campaign focused on addressing corruption, and it was clear
- what was coming. This happened in NOVEMBER of 2016, and by
- 233 December Ukraine began cleaning up their act.
- 4. After bank was seized, money was to begin going to Ukraine
- again, but the Trump administration wanted some token of trust
- 236 from Ukraine—something more than promises. In response to
- 237 this, an IMF mission visiting Kiev toward end of May indicated
- 238 recent developments with new government opened the door for
- 239 the team to stand ready to return to Kiev to continue discussions
- after the new govt. clarified some things.
- 5. So then comes the July 25 phone call: On the same day of that
- 242 CALL IMF had a press conference, to announce approval of a 5
- 243 BN loan and that 3.5 BN was ready to be disbursed. However,
- the IMF indicated a need for what is called an obligating event.
- 245 THIS WAS SENT ON THE SAME DAY AS PHONE CALL. This is
- 246 essentially what Trump was asking Zelenski to provide to show
- 247 good faith.

- 5. Sept. 10 The office of Management and Budget, sent email
- about obligating event; what was it? Zalenski met with Kolomoiski
- and, it is believed, likely informed him of a planned raid on his
- offices, and on Burisma. When this was done, on the next day, Sept
- 252 11 the raid took place on PrivatBank collecting evidence regarding
- 253 the missing 1.8 BILLION and fraudulent misuse of IMF funds. and
- 254 then the AID was released.
- 255 6. MILITARY AID was released. Obligating Event? The interest in
- 256 investigating Biden had to do with understanding his part, and the
- 257 part of the Obama administration, in the funny stuff going on with
- 258 the missing 1.8 BILLION and the funny stuff going on with the 7
- 259 BN being misused by Ukraine. And this was all tied to Burissma,
- where Biden's son worked, and the Pravat bank.
- 261 The President released Military Aid when he saw the raid that
- was the event he was looking for. Media tells us it's about politics,
- but it's actually about missing 1.8 billion dollars in which Burissma
- is implicated—a company Joe Biden's son worked for, and the
- suspicious interference of VP Biden in the investigation of
- 266 Burissma.
- 267 This whole thing is very strange. And the picture that is beginning
- to emerge is that in concert with the Obama Administration,
- 269 Ukraine was using this money to wage war with Russia. It's
- beginning to look like Obama did not want to openly support
- 271 Ukraine against Russia who knows why but used this
- 272 chicanery to hide from Russia and from America his secret war
- with Russia.
- 274 The truth was DANGEROUS for the Bidens because they were
- 275 personally benefitting from this—they were raking in millions in
- the process.
- You see, the Provat Bank was funding the war with Russia. Using
- 278 our money to fund a war Obama lied to the American people,

- took the Congressional authority for war powers and illegally
- 280 engaged in a foreign war against Russia through Ukraine. But he
- did not want Russia, or Americans, to know it.
- We'll see where this leads. But slowly the truth is emerging and we
- will, Lord WILLING have the complete picture before too long.
- I want to conclude by addressing something I head in an exchange
- 285 between Tony Perkins and Fox News host Shannon Bream she
- 286 closed the conversation saying, "I think most of us want our
- 287 religion to be politically free, at least as much as possible." That
- 288 caught my attention, because I remember a time when I was
- 289 fastidious about segregating my personal political interests and
- opinions from my religious beliefs—and still do to some measure.
- But not so much any more! What happened.
- 292 Why do we want our religion to be politically free? Well, to
- understand this, we need to go back a few decades.
- 294 Once upon a time, American shared a common set of religious
- values and it was possible to have religion politically free. But today
- 296 politics has become RELIGIOUS. Politics has been totally mixed
- 297 with religion today and not by conservatives this was done by
- 298 liberals. Many don't know it, but Saul Alinsky was a strong
- 299 advocate for political activism through the churches. He saw the
- 300 churches as a powerful grass roots agency through which, if
- 301 motivated, and guided, could be used to fuel radical social and
- 302 political change. While we were sleeping, Alinsky and his radical
- 303 recruits, began using the churches to advance very specific political
- 304 objectives.
- Now look, all values come from what we believe about right and
- 306 wrong. And all laws come from someone's idea of what is right and
- 307 what is wrong. And our view of right and wrong is instructed by
- 308 our religious beliefs whether the religion is atheism, or
- 309 Catholicism, or Christianity, or Islam, or Hindu, or, etc. Our ideas

310 of right and wrong are shaped by our moral training. And once 311 upon a time in America, we had a shared common core of moral beliefs. In that situation, someone could argue about whether we 312 313 should tax people x dollars or xx dollars, and yet share a common 314 core of values and beliefs — they could debate over what is our personal responsibility to share our wealth with the poor and 315 316 needy, and how much of this should be done collectively, whether 317 we should have laws prohibiting child labor altogether, or whether 318 we should say families can have their own children work in their 319 businesses — and these debates could go on between people who 320 shared a common set of values and beliefs, and we would debate 321 about the legitimate role of government—but today, it's not like 322 that.

323 Today we have a radical divide at the heart of American traditional 324 values. Christians have been very patient, in all honesty, and 325 tolerant. Christians have been open to arguments such as, "you can't impose your religion on everyone else." Of course, we 326 Christian evangelicals totally believe that. So believing that, we 327 made room for greater and greater departures from our once 328 329 shared common morality — and those who cry "We will not have Jesus to reign over us," who "rage, and take counsel against the 330 331 LORD and against HIS ANOINTED (means Christ), saying let us break their bands asunder and cast away their cords from us" — 332 333 began to gain greater and greater political control in our country and here is where they crossed the line — they began FORCING 334 335 THEIR IMMORALITY UPON ALL OF US. They began using the 336 coercive power of government to bring us under laws that are 337 CONTRARY to OUR FAITH and the put us in a position to, as 338 Hillary openly said, choose between our religious beliefs and our political standing in communities. 339

Now, I will speak to this some more. But you really need to get my book. It provides biblical insight into the spiritual side of what's

- 342 going on in America and explains what Christians can do to fight
- 343 back against the encroachment against our inalienable rights.
- But, in answer to Bream's question we can no longer separate
- religion from politics because politics has invaded religion. And,

- 347 long, the presumptive "religion" instructing the conscience of

- 349 America from a Christian nation into an antichristian nation.
- 350 So, we need to STAND. And that's our theme at the Lighthouse for
- 351 2020 STAND.
- 352 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me
- 353 know if you see them. It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE
- 354 ON and you will ride like Revere and spread the warning,
- 355 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say
- 356 LIGHTS OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and
