- 4 My thoughts woke me at 3 am—and I'll share some of those 5 morning ruminations with you today.

Another Trump Tweet storm and Barr's consternation. Did Barr
release McCabe to get a dig at Trump? Not likely. Let's talk about
what it takes to work for Trump.

- 9 The reduced sentence for Stone who never admitted to the charge 10 he lied to FBI nor was it ever proved — this is a joke. He should be
- 11 pardoned. McCabe admitted he "mislead" investigators but walks!

12 What is going on here? Yesterday, rumors were that Stryzok and

- 13 McCabe were about to be arrested. Today, McCabe is cut loose.
- 14 A professor in UK dresses up like a witch and channels Satan—says 15 she thinks to save the planet humankind should go extinct. The
- 16 same people who flip out over the extinction of a species of frog.
- 17 Talk about channeling Satan: The abortion fight continues to heat
- 18 up. Now the debate is over whether we should allow a mother and
- 19 her doctor to decide a baby's fate after the child has been delivered.
- 20 We've got a white guy and a gal who stoop to kiss the boot of a
- 21 black Hebrew Israelite racemonger! And they are proud of
- themselves.
- 23 It's time for your Brain Massage!
- 24 [TRUTH]

25 Some 3 am thoughts—ever wake up to deep ruminations? My 26 thoughts woke me! Hah! I've been woked. You have heard of the 27 Divine Right of Kings doctrine? Many believe that is a Christian 28 doctrine. It's a pagan notion recast in Christian language. It is 29 constructed out of an array of isolated texts, such as "The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth 30 it whithersoever he will" (Proverbs 21:1). Another is "A divine 31 32 sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in 33 judgment" (Proverbs 16:10). A favorite is Romans 13:1 "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but 34 35 of God: the powers that be are ordained of God."

36 I say the doctrine is pagan because belief that the king is god, or 37 that he stands in the place of God over the people, is a pagan 38 notion. It is the doctrine of Nimrod, and of every pagan nation 39 throughout history.

40 So-called Christian support for the doctrine depends on Scriptures 41 taken out of context. For example, Scripture tells us King 42 Rheoboam, son and successor to Solomon, "Did evil, because he 43 prepared not his heart to seek the LORD" (II Chronicles 12:14). 44 The truth that God Sovereignly turns the hearts of kings does not 45 mean everything in the heart of kings is from GOD, nor does it 46 mean the king is not responsible for preparing his heart to seek the LORD. Some kings start of with a new heart given to them by God 47 48 only to pervert it in the end — I'm thinking of a king named Saul.

49 Sometimes leaders "cause" the people to err: "As for my people, 50 children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my 51 people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way 52 of thy paths" (Isaiah 3:12). God does not turn the heart of kings to 53 cause His people to err. The fact that God does turn the hearts of 54 kings does not mean everything they do is something God wants 55 them to do. 56 The divine sentence in the lips of the king only means God 57 sovereignly works His judgments through leaders it does not mean 58 everything a ruler says is divine. For example, when Belshazzar 59 blasphemed the God of Israel, this came from his own corrupt 60 heart, but the judgment that fell upon Babylon because of it 61 certainly came from God.

And as for all power (exosuia—authority, rule) being ordained by 62 God—that certainly does not mean every personality that holds the 63 power is of God, or ordained of God. Hosea 8:4 tells us Israel "set 64 up kings" but not by the LORD: "They have set up kings, but not by 65 me: they have made princes, and I knew it not: of their silver and 66 their gold have they made them idols, that they may be cut off" 67 (Hosea 8:4). This is a verse Americans need to hear and heed. We 68 69 have the power to "set up" our rulers, and we had better take heed how we use that power. 70

John Jay, founder and first Chief Justice of the US said, 71 "Providence has given to our people the choice of their rulers. And 72 73 it is the duty as well as the privilege and interest, of a Christian nation to select and prefer Christians for their rulers."¹ He also 74 observed: "Whether our religion permits Christians to vote for 75 76 infidel rulers is a question which merits more consideration than it seems yet to have generally received either from the clergy or the 77 laity. It appears to me that what the prophet said to Jehoshaphat 78 about his attachment to Ahab ["Shouldest thou help the ungodly 79 and love them that hate the Lord?" 2 Chronicles 19:2] affords a 80 salutary lesson."² 81

82 Hosea also reveals the underlying sin that moves His people to 83 prefer wicked rulers—"of their silver and their gold they have made

The wicked doctrine called the Divine Right of Kings was used to manipulate unlearned Christians into a superstitious fear of opposing their rulers when those rulers oppressed them.

- In the wake of the American revivals that washed over this land in
 the decades leading up to the Revolution, God's SPIRIT began
 leading His people to TRUTH and the doctrine of DIVINELY
 ENDOWED RIGHTS of the individual overturned the heresy of
 the Divine Right of Kings.
- 94 The Divine Right of Kings put a man between the people and 95 GOD, and said, essentially, that this man was GOD's voice and to 96 break faith with that man was to break faith with GOD.
- 97 But the doctrine of the DIVINE RIGHTS OF MAN said every man 98 had DIVINE RIGHTS (that is, rights endowed to them by their 99 CREATOR) — the DIVINE RIGHTS OF MAN meant that every 100 individual was equal to the king in terms of DIVINE RIGHTS. When it came to DIVINE RIGHTS, neither the king, nor any caste 101 102 called the Nobles, nor any Priest, nor any Pope, enjoyed any special favor - none was above the LAW. ALL MEN WERE CREATED 103 104 EQUAL.

105 So, where does government fit in? God defined the role of the 106 powers that He ordained (the governments, authorities, the Bible 107 calls them rulers) when He called these ministers of God 108 commissioned by Him to protect and reward the good, and to 109 execute wrath upon evildoers (Romans 13:1-6). An evildoer 110 violates the DIVINE RIGHTS OF OTHERS and so must be punished. Justice occurs when the individual's DIVINE RIGHTS 111 112 are RESTORED and the violator is punished appropriately—God's Wrath is executed upon them) and the victim is appropriately 113 114 vindicated.

Under the DIVINE RIGHT OF KINGS the people looked to the
"government" for protection, provision, and punishment — the
government took the place of God and the people became subjects.
Under the DIVINE RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE government
became the servant of GOD to protect the RIGHTS of the
PEOPLE, and appointed by the PEOPLE for that purpose. THE
PEOPLE were FREE to pursue happiness as they pleased GOD.

The Bible teaches that JESUS is the only KING, and that all 122 mankind is under GOD. He declares LIBERTY to all mankind -123 and endows every man with inalienable rights under GOD. 124 125 Wherever His Spirit prevails among men, LIBERTY prevails. This 126 is partly because His SPIRIT is the SPIRIT of TRUTH and the TRUTH MAKES US FREE — and among the great LIBERTY 127 128 TRUTHS is the doctrine of the DIVINE RIGHTS OF THE 129 PEOPLE.

130 The Devil teaches that JESUS is not the king and that every man is 131 his own god. Satan moves those under his influence to reject the 132 reign of Jesus Christ and to "take the kingdom by force." This 133 means to take control of the kingdom of man by use of violence. 134 Satan deceives people into buying in to the idea that government is supposed to take care of them, and provide for them. He offers 135 them the world if only they will bow down and worship him. But 136 worshipping Satan always leads to tyranny and oppression and 137 misery. His system destroys liberty, justice, and perverts judgment. 138

And that is the choice before Americans today. It's never beenmade so clear as it is in this election.

141 You can choose LIFE, and LIBERTY or DEATH and TYRANNY.

142 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor

143 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern

144 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the

145 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our 146 liberty.

147 Another Trump Tweet storm and Barr's feeling the political heat. Brouhaha boils on both sides of the aisle: on the left, the boil over 148 the reduction in Stone's sentence—given 9 years for allegedly lying 149 150 to Congress, something he denies; and on the right, the boil is over 151 Barr dropping the investigation into McCabe for leaking and then 152 misleading investigators investigating the leak. This was the 153 Horrowitz referral given to the DOJ in 2018. By the way, it's important to understand that McCabe was fired from his job, and 154 155 apologized for misleading the investigators but denied he did it 156 purposely. Now, it's hard for us to hear this because we are 157 steaming mad at the Dems for what they did to Stone, and 158 especially the evil way they hounded and persecuted Flynn-but 159 the fact is, before all of this became totally partisan, in any other time in America, McCabe losing his job, his career ended in 160 disgrace, would not have been piled on with criminal charges. 161 162 Justice would have been satisfied with what he suffered already-163 but in this environment—everybody wants to see heads on platters, man. Another thing to keep in mind is that the Durham 164 165 investigation is ongoing, McCabe is a subject of that investigation 166 also, and Mr. McCabe could very well face much more serious 167 charges later. McCabe continues to be a subject in the Durham 168 investigation.

169 Trump tweeted about the reduction in Stone's sentencing, and the 170 Left is salivating over the opportunity this gives them to charge 171 ahead with another "appearances" case against Trump — *Trump is* 172 *abusing his power as President by strong arming Barr to reduce the* 173 *sentence for his friend.* We need to investigate whether Trump 174 ordered Barr to reduce Stone's sentence.

175 And, you know what, here we go again! These people either have 176 never read the Constitution or they are intentionally doing the Pouting-Pelosi with it. Rip, Rip, Rip — Trump could order Barr to
reduce Stone's sentence. In fact, Trump could simply pardon
Stone. Second, Barr made the move to reduce Stone's sentence
before Trump tweeted about it, and third, Barr has openly stated
Trump has not instructed Barr regarding Stone, actually he said,
with regard to any case before him.

- 183 But Barr gets miffed—says Trump makes it very difficult for him to
- 184 do his job. I want to look at this for a few minutes.
- 185 What's with the Trump Tweets, what is it like to work for Trump,186 what does the Brain Masseur advise Barr
- 187 Legally, and Barr is supposed to be the guy that knows all about 188 this, legally, the President has a right to call in his Attorney General 189 and instruct him regarding cases. The ATTY General serves at the 190 pleasure of the President and is directly accountable to him. This gives the President a great deal of power, to be sure. Thomas 191 Jefferson used it to full measure to go after a political rival, Aaron 192 193 Burr—who, it was alleged later, attempted to start a war with Spain, and Jefferson, wanted him tried for treason. The bar for treason is 194 195 set very high and it was not reached, which peeved Jefferson so 196 much he wanted an amendment to be made that would allow a 197 President to remove a Supreme Court Justice with Congressional 198 approval — now, it is known that Jefferson and Burr were on very 199 unfriendly terms and political rivals — and it was suspected that Burr committed treason — and it's sure that Jefferson believed he 200 had done so — so, the question is, should Jefferson have been more 201 202 politically savvy and concerned with appearances and stayed completely out of the issue with Burr or should he have pursued 203 204 justice regardless - and so we know that Trump would be 205 motivated to step in for Stone, and Flynn, but whether this by itself proves his intervention was improper, beyond expressing his 206 207 concern, whether he ordered Barr to extend clemency to his friend, you see! 208

In other words, if you are controlled by political optics — and I think Trump does have some regard for this, after all, he has not pardoned Stone, or Flynn, for that matter, and I would not fault him if he did! But if the President seeks justice, if he wants done what is right to be done — and intervenes out of concern for justice — that's another matter, don't you think?

- 215 And my point is that Trump is one of the most non-political 216 politicians in American history. If you are working for Trump, and
- 210 pointerialis in American instory. If you are working for frump, and
- 217 you don't know about his twitter thumb twitches you have been
- 218 living in a cave somewhere. It's what he does.
- 219 And guys like O'Reily think it's because Trump craves negative 220 attention-I heard O'Reily, who presents himself as someone who 221 knows the President, says there are two things about Trump that 222 define his character-he loves money, and he loves controversy. 223 And if you push back against O'Reily's characterization of Trump, 224 you will get an O'Reily blast — he might even yell at you!!! Hahah! 225 I don't have time to explain that, sorry! I appreciate O'Reily and would concede he is in a better position than me to opine on 226 227 Trump's character. I can only speak to what I see.
- 228 Look, my explanation for Trump tweets, like the tweet about Barr reducing Stone's sentence, is that Trump says what he thinks. Like 229 230 I've said before, this President talks like average Americans talk, 231 like at a dinner table, at a barbeque, at the kitchen table, watching a football game with the guys, chatting over the fence with a 232 233 neighbor, he says the sorts of things American's say to each other 234 all the time — he is plugged in to rural, and suburban America — 235 to blue collar workers, and entrepreneurs. He talks their language, and so he says, nine years for what Stone supposedly did is 236 237 outrageous. Storming the guys house, sticking a gun in his wife's 238 face, it was staged and intended to intimidate, it's evil and wrong -239 and that's all. So he just says stuff like that, and if Barr gets his shorts in a knot over it, who did he think he was going to work for? 240
