1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain
3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.
4 My thoughts woke me at 3 am—and I'll share some of those
5 morning ruminations with you today.
6 Another Trump Tweet storm and Barr's consternation. Did Barr
7 release McCabe to get a dig at Trump? Not likely. Let's talk about
8 what it takes to work for Trump.
9 The reduced sentence for Stone who never admitted to the charge
10 he lied to FBI nor was it ever proved — this is a joke. He should be
11 pardoned. McCabe admitted he "mislead" investigators but walks!
12 What is going on here? Yesterday, rumors were that Stryzok and
13 McCabe were about to be arrested. Today, McCabe is cut loose.
14 A professor in UK dresses up like a witch and channels Satan—says
15 she thinks to save the planet humankind should go extinct. The
16 same people who flip out over the extinction of a species of frog.
17 Talk about channeling Satan: The abortion fight continues to heat
18 up. Now the debate is over whether we should allow a mother and
19 her doctor to decide a baby's fate after the child has been delivered.
20 We've got a white guy and a gal who stoop to kiss the boot of a
21 black Hebrew Israelite racemonger! And they are proud of
22 themselves.
23 It's time for your Brain Massage!
24 [TRUTH]

25 Some 3 am thoughts—ever wake up to deep ruminations? My
26 thoughts woke me! Hah! I've been woked. You have heard of the
27 Divine Right of Kings doctrine? Many believe that is a Christian
28 doctrine. It's a pagan notion recast in Christian language. It is
29 constructed out of an array of isolated texts, such as "The king's
30 heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth
31 it whithersoever he will" (Proverbs 21:1). Another is "A divine
32 sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in
33 judgment" (Proverbs 16:10). A favorite is Romans 13:1 "Let every
34 soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but
35 of God: the powers that be are ordained of God."

36 I say the doctrine is pagan because belief that the king is god, or
37 that he stands in the place of God over the people, is a pagan
38 notion. It is the doctrine of Nimrod, and of every pagan nation
39 throughout history.

40 So-called Christian support for the doctrine depends on Scriptures
41 taken out of context. For example, Scripture tells us King
42 Rheoboam, son and successor to Solomon, "Did evil, *because* he
43 prepared not his heart to seek the LORD" (II Chronicles 12:14).
44 The truth that God Sovereignly turns the hearts of kings does not
45 mean everything in the heart of kings is from GOD, nor does it
46 mean the king is not responsible for preparing his heart to seek the
47 LORD. Some kings start of with a new heart given to them by God
48 only to pervert it in the end — I'm thinking of a king named Saul.

49 Sometimes leaders "cause" the people to err: "As for my people,
50 children are their oppressors, and women rule over them. O my
51 people, they which lead thee cause thee to err, and destroy the way
52 of thy paths" (Isaiah 3:12). God does not turn the heart of kings to
53 cause His people to err. The fact that God does turn the hearts of
54 kings does not mean everything they do is something God wants
55 them to do.

56 The divine sentence in the lips of the king only means God
57 sovereignly works His judgments through leaders it does not mean
58 everything a ruler says is divine. For example, when Belshazzar
59 blasphemed the God of Israel, this came from his own corrupt
60 heart, but the judgment that fell upon Babylon because of it
61 certainly came from God.

62 And as for all power (exosuaia—authority, rule) being ordained by
63 God—that certainly does not mean every personality that holds the
64 power is of God, or ordained of God. Hosea 8:4 tells us Israel "set
65 up kings" but not by the LORD: "They have set up kings, but not by
66 me: they have made princes, and I knew it not: of their silver and
67 their gold have they made them idols, that they may be cut off"
68 (Hosea 8:4). This is a verse Americans need to hear and heed. We
69 have the power to "set up" our rulers, and we had better take heed
70 how we use that power.

71 John Jay, founder and first Chief Justice of the US said,
72 "Providence has given to our people the choice of their rulers. And
73 it is the duty as well as the privilege and interest, of a Christian
74 nation to select and prefer Christians for their rulers."¹ He also
75 observed: "Whether our religion permits Christians to vote for
76 infidel rulers is a question which merits more consideration than it
77 seems yet to have generally received either from the clergy or the
78 laity. It appears to me that what the prophet said to Jehoshaphat
79 about his attachment to Ahab ["Shouldst thou help the ungodly
80 and love them that hate the Lord?" 2 Chronicles 19:2] affords a
81 salutary lesson."²

82 Hosea also reveals the underlying sin that moves His people to
83 prefer wicked rulers—"of their silver and their gold they have made

84 them idols," and what will be the end result of this error: "that they
85 may be cut off."

86 The wicked doctrine called the Divine Right of Kings was used to
87 manipulate unlearned Christians into a superstitious fear of
88 opposing their rulers when those rulers oppressed them.

89 In the wake of the American revivals that washed over this land in
90 the decades leading up to the Revolution, God's SPIRIT began
91 leading His people to TRUTH and the doctrine of DIVINELY
92 ENDOWED RIGHTS of the individual overturned the heresy of
93 the Divine Right of Kings.

94 The Divine Right of Kings put a man between the people and
95 GOD, and said, essentially, that this man was GOD's voice and to
96 break faith with that man was to break faith with GOD.

97 But the doctrine of the DIVINE RIGHTS OF MAN said every man
98 had DIVINE RIGHTS (that is, rights endowed to them by their
99 CREATOR) — the DIVINE RIGHTS OF MAN meant that every
100 individual was equal to the king in terms of DIVINE RIGHTS.
101 When it came to DIVINE RIGHTS, neither the king, nor any caste
102 called the Nobles, nor any Priest, nor any Pope, enjoyed any special
103 favor — none was above the LAW. ALL MEN WERE CREATED
104 EQUAL.

105 So, where does government fit in? God defined the role of the
106 *powers* that He ordained (the governments, authorities, the Bible
107 calls them rulers) when He called these ministers of God
108 commissioned by Him to protect and reward the good, and to
109 execute wrath upon evildoers (Romans 13:1-6). An evildoer
110 violates the DIVINE RIGHTS OF OTHERS and so must be
111 punished. Justice occurs when the individual's DIVINE RIGHTS
112 are RESTORED and the violator is punished appropriately—God's
113 Wrath is executed upon them) and the victim is appropriately
114 vindicated.

115 Under the DIVINE RIGHT OF KINGS the people looked to the
116 "government" for protection, provision, and punishment — the
117 government took the place of God and the people became subjects.
118 Under the DIVINE RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE government
119 became the servant of GOD to protect the RIGHTS of the
120 PEOPLE, and appointed by the PEOPLE for that purpose. THE
121 PEOPLE were FREE to pursue happiness as they pleased GOD.

122 The Bible teaches that JESUS is the only KING, and that all
123 mankind is under GOD. He declares LIBERTY to all mankind —
124 and endows every man with inalienable rights under GOD.
125 Wherever His Spirit prevails among men, LIBERTY prevails. This
126 is partly because His SPIRIT is the SPIRIT of TRUTH and the
127 TRUTH MAKES US FREE — and among the great LIBERTY
128 TRUTHS is the doctrine of the DIVINE RIGHTS OF THE
129 PEOPLE.

130 The Devil teaches that JESUS is not the king and that every man is
131 his own god. Satan moves those under his influence to reject the
132 reign of Jesus Christ and to "take the kingdom by force." This
133 means to take control of the kingdom of man by use of violence.
134 Satan deceives people into buying in to the idea that government is
135 supposed to take care of them, and provide for them. He offers
136 them the world if only they will bow down and worship him. But
137 worshipping Satan always leads to tyranny and oppression and
138 misery. His system destroys liberty, justice, and perverts judgment.

139 And that is the choice before Americans today. It's never been
140 made so clear as it is in this election.

141 You can choose LIFE, and LIBERTY or DEATH and TYRANNY.

142 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
143 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
144 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the

145 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
146 liberty.

147 Another Trump Tweet storm and Barr's feeling the political heat.
148 Brouhaha boils on both sides of the aisle: on the left, the boil over
149 the reduction in Stone's sentence—given 9 years for allegedly lying
150 to Congress, something he denies; and on the right, the boil is over
151 Barr dropping the investigation into McCabe for leaking and then
152 misleading investigators investigating the leak. This was the
153 Horowitz referral given to the DOJ in 2018. By the way, it's
154 important to understand that McCabe was fired from his job, and
155 apologized for misleading the investigators but denied he did it
156 purposely. Now, it's hard for us to hear this because we are
157 steaming mad at the Dems for what they did to Stone, and
158 especially the evil way they hounded and persecuted Flynn—but
159 the fact is, before all of this became totally partisan, in any other
160 time in America, McCabe losing his job, his career ended in
161 disgrace, would not have been piled on with criminal charges.
162 Justice would have been satisfied with what he suffered already—
163 but in this environment—everybody wants to see heads on platters,
164 man. Another thing to keep in mind is that the Durham
165 investigation is ongoing, McCabe is a subject of that investigation
166 also, and Mr. McCabe could very well face much more serious
167 charges later. McCabe continues to be a subject in the Durham
168 investigation.

169 Trump tweeted about the reduction in Stone's sentencing, and the
170 Left is salivating over the opportunity this gives them to charge
171 ahead with another "appearances" case against Trump — *Trump is*
172 *abusing his power as President by strong arming Barr to reduce the*
173 *sentence for his friend.* We need to investigate whether Trump
174 ordered Barr to reduce Stone's sentence.

175 And, you know what, here we go again! These people either have
176 never read the Constitution or they are intentionally doing the

177 Pouting-Pelosi with it. Rip, Rip, Rip — Trump could order Barr to
178 reduce Stone's sentence. In fact, Trump could simply pardon
179 Stone. Second, Barr made the move to reduce Stone's sentence
180 before Trump tweeted about it, and third, Barr has openly stated
181 Trump has not instructed Barr regarding Stone, actually he said,
182 with regard to any case before him.

183 But Barr gets miffed—says Trump makes it very difficult for him to
184 do his job. I want to look at this for a few minutes.

185 What's with the Trump Tweets, what is it like to work for Trump,
186 what does the Brain Masseur advise Barr

187 Legally, and Barr is supposed to be the guy that knows all about
188 this, legally, the President has a right to call in his Attorney General
189 and instruct him regarding cases. The ATTY General serves at the
190 pleasure of the President and is directly accountable to him. This
191 gives the President a great deal of power, to be sure. Thomas
192 Jefferson used it to full measure to go after a political rival, Aaron
193 Burr—who, it was alleged later, attempted to start a war with Spain,
194 and Jefferson, wanted him tried for treason. The bar for treason is
195 set very high and it was not reached, which peeved Jefferson so
196 much he wanted an amendment to be made that would allow a
197 President to remove a Supreme Court Justice with Congressional
198 approval — now, it is known that Jefferson and Burr were on very
199 unfriendly terms and political rivals — and it was suspected that
200 Burr committed treason — and it's sure that Jefferson believed he
201 had done so — so, the question is, should Jefferson have been more
202 politically savvy and concerned with appearances and stayed
203 completely out of the issue with Burr or should he have pursued
204 justice regardless — and so we know that Trump would be
205 motivated to step in for Stone, and Flynn, but whether this by itself
206 proves his intervention was improper, beyond expressing his
207 concern, whether he ordered Barr to extend clemency to his friend,
208 you see!

209 In other words, if you are controlled by political optics — and I
210 think Trump does have some regard for this, after all, he has not
211 pardoned Stone, or Flynn, for that matter, and I would not fault
212 him if he did! But if the President seeks justice, if he wants done
213 what is right to be done — and intervenes out of concern for justice
214 — that's another matter, don't you think?

215 And my point is that Trump is one of the most non-political
216 politicians in American history. If you are working for Trump, and
217 you don't know about his twitter thumb twitches — you have been
218 living in a cave somewhere. It's what he does.

219 And guys like O'Reily think it's because Trump craves negative
220 attention—I heard O'Reily, who presents himself as someone who
221 knows the President, says there are two things about Trump that
222 define his character—he loves money, and he loves controversy.
223 And if you push back against O'Reily's characterization of Trump,
224 you will get an O'Reily blast — he might even yell at you!!! Hahah!
225 I don't have time to explain that, sorry! I appreciate O'Reily and
226 would concede he is in a better position than me to opine on
227 Trump's character. I can only speak to what I see.

228 Look, my explanation for Trump tweets, like the tweet about Barr
229 reducing Stone's sentence, is that Trump says what he thinks. Like
230 I've said before, this President talks like average Americans talk,
231 like at a dinner table, at a barbeque, at the kitchen table, watching a
232 football game with the guys, chatting over the fence with a
233 neighbor, he says the sorts of things American's say to each other
234 all the time — he is plugged in to rural, and suburban America —
235 to blue collar workers, and entrepreneurs. He talks their language,
236 and so he says, nine years for what Stone supposedly did is
237 outrageous. Storming the guys house, sticking a gun in his wife's
238 face, it was staged and intended to intimidate, it's evil and wrong —
239 and that's all. So he just says stuff like that, and if Barr gets his
240 shorts in a knot over it, who did he think he was going to work for?

241 Trump did not pressure Barr to do it, he did not have a
242 conversation with Barr about doing it, he did not send a memo
243 instructing Barr to do it — Barr did it, and the President got word
244 of it, and said, good, that's what should be done. What's the big
245 deal?

246 But, apparently Barr gets embarrassed by what the Media makes of
247 it, apparently he is another of these guys that by God won't be
248 influenced by the President, but gets all sweaty hands over media
249 making something out of nothing. If you don't have the guts to
250 stand up to these media hacks and call them out, and simply tell
251 them what for — you had better resign because I will promise you
252 friend, it only gets worse from here.

253 Barr does not need to worry about what the media makes of what
254 decisions he makes. **THEY DON'T CONTROL THE NARRATIVE**
255 **ANY MORE BUDDY** — Trump has come to town and made fools
256 out of all of them.

257 Barr, just school the hacks in the Constitution and then **DO YOUR**
258 **JOB. Period!**

259 You say, well, the Constitution says the President can pardon Stone
260 if he was of a mind to — and I have no power over that, and
261 neither do you. The people can express their opinion at the voting
262 booth, but if the President wanted a reduced sentence, all he had to
263 do is send me a memo instructing me to do it — it's really that
264 simple. However, the fact is, the President has not asked me to do
265 that, but the **FACTS** in this case compel me to do it because in my
266 opinion, after reviewing all the facts in the case, the sentence was
267 politically motivated—good night, the foreperson on his jury was
268 an avowed Trump hating activist. What kind of justice was that?

269 Anyway, I hope Barr understands who his boss is—if he did not
270 know about Trump's tweeting habit before he took the job—well, I'
271 surprised. But he needs to wake up to the reality that he works for a

272 NON POLITICAL POLICITIAN — Trump does not lick his finger
273 and stick it in the wind to test which direction the wind is blowing,
274 or, if he does, he has amazing instincts and for once we've got a guy
275 whose sails is filled with the WIND OF GOD, driving this ONCE
276 GREAT NATION UNDER GOD back UNDER GOD and GREAT
277 AGAIN.

278 Anyway, let's move to a conclusion today.

279 A professor in UK dresses up like a witch and channels Satan—she
280 says she thinks to save the planet humankind should go extinct. To
281 do this, no one should have babies until finally the planet is rid of
282 the odious infestation of humans.

283 These are the same people who flip out over the near extinction of
284 a species of frog.

285 But this is Satan's agenda. You know, when he finally gets his man
286 in power, that guy is going to wipe out literally millions of people—
287 that's what the prophecies tell us about Antichrist. His agenda will
288 be to kill 1/4 of the planet's population, and right now that would
289 be 7.7 billion as of April last year. 1/4 would be almost 2 billion

292 And talk about channeling Satan: The abortion battle continues.
293 Now the debate is over whether we should allow a mother and her
294 doctor to decide a baby's fate after the child has been delivered.
295 Right. Northam, the anti-Constitutional governor of Virginia
296 explained his State's controversial abortion law allowing babies to
297 be murdered after they have separated from the womb this way,
298 the baby would be delivered, and resuscitated if needed and if the
299 parents desired it, then the doctor and mother would have a
300 conversation about whether or not to terminate the baby's life.
301 Obviously, in this case, if the parents decide to kill the baby, it
302 would be legal to do so. Happily, that law did not pass. But can you

303 believe we are having a conversation in which there is a side
304 advocating for this to be okay?

305 I appreciate Ted Cruz and his position on this matter. He asked a
306 panel of doctors if any of them thought it should be okay for a baby
307 to be killed after the baby was delivered. One of the doctors
308 answered and her answer literally sent cold chills up my spine. It
309 was so evil —

310 She spoke smooth as a Buttigieg — another silk tongued devil —
311 she spoke with compassion, sensitive to the terrible plight of such
312 parents, and said, "I trust the mother and her doctor with that
313 horrible decision . . ." I wonder if this woman "trusts" parents with
314 the decision about what school they choose for their children. She
315 talked about empathy for the dilemma of those parents, how hard
316 it would be for them to make such a decision, how she would be
317 concerned about how they spend their last moments with their
318 baby, how difficult a decision it would be, where there is no good
319 choice, and on and on, with apparent deep sympathy for the parent
320 — AND NOT ONE THOUGHT OF THE HELPLESS BABY
321 STRUGGLING FOR ITS LIFE — and, besides, we've heard all this
322 before, Satan. We've heard you say all this about abortion — how
323 hard a choice it is for a mother, how tragic, how our goal should be
324 that abortion is safe and seldom resorted to, how broken hearted
325 the mother must be who is force to make such a choice — WE
