Brain Massage*: Show No. 771 Reconciling the Governor's Powers And Our

Inalienable RIGHTS

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- 1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the
- 2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain
- 3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.
- 4 Northern CA Counties and LA County has issued a "shelter in
- 5 place" order making it a misdemeanor offense to violate the
- 6 order and threatening incarceration and a fine on violators. CA
- 7 Governor Newsome follows with order for all Californians to "stay
- 8 home."
- 9 What does all this mean? Did CA declare Martial Law? Has the US
- 10 Constitution been suspended, upended, or? Can the Governor
- simply order people to stay at home? Can County representatives
- make a law that contradicts the constitutionally protected rights of
- 13 the people by fiat, you know, by "DECREE"? How can they enforce
- such decrees? Will they enforce them? Is it a public trust thing, or
- 15 will the Governor send out the National Guard to patrol our
- 16 streets?
- 17 Will there be stops and check points, and guys in uniforms saying,
- 18 "papers please" —? And, then, the realllly important questions,
- 19 like, is saying China virus, or Chinese virus racist. Yeah, now that's
- a conversation we really need to have right now because I think we
- 21 might be hurting the feelings of Chinese people by saying that!
- Well, okay, let's all take off our tin-foil hats and look at all of this
- 23 honestly, and responsibly. Are you ready?
- 24 It's time for your brain massage.
- 25 [TRUTH]
- Obviously, I can't cover all this in my 29-minute broadcast—really,
- there is just way too much here that needs to be explored.

- 28 I think you will find my messages preached Sunday night and
- 29 Wednesday night at the Lighthouse to be very helpful and
- 30 enlightening. You can find them on our Facebook page and on our
- 31 YouTUBE channel. These messages provide important insight into
- 32 what's going on but in the Brain Massage today, I'm going to limit
- 33 my comments to responding to the Governor's executive order.
- 34 Let's begin by offering some clarity on what exactly the Governor
- 35 has said. I've read the "executive order" issued from the Governor's
- office. The essential elements of the order are as follows:
- 37 The Governor issued an executive order mandating compliance
- 38 with the current State public health directives. Specifically, the
- 39 language is "all residents are directed to immediately heed the
- 40 current State public health directives," These directives are
- 41 organized in a list of do's and don'ts —
- 42 Do: 1. Stay home; 2. Wash hands with soap and water for at least
- 43 20 seconds; 3. Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue; 4. Clean
- 44 and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces. (If soap and
- 45 water aren't available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.)
- 46 Don't: 1. Shake hands; 2. Touch your face; 3. Go to the doctor if
- 47 you aren't sick; 4. Stockpile masks or gloves.
- 48 The specific "sectors" unaffected, or that are authorized to continue
- 49 operations, are those formerly identified by the Department of
- 50 Homeland Security as critical infrastructure and include Chemical
- 51 (gotta keep them working on a vaccine), Commercial Facilities
- 52 (places of general public access with no or limited barriers to public
- 53 access—people need to have access to stores for food),
- 54 Communications sector (need to keep people informed), Critical
- 55 Manufacturing Sector (gotta make masks, and medicine, for
- 56 example), and obviously, Dams, Defense Industrial Base,
- 57 Emergency Services, Energy, Financial Services, Food and
- 58 Agriculture, Government Facilities, Healthcare and Public Health,

- 59 Information Technology, Nuclear Reactors, Materials and Waste,
- Transportation Systems; and Water and Wastewater.
- 61 Governor Newsome's executive order clearly stipulates: "The
- 62 Federal government has identified 16 critical infrastructure sectors
- 63 whose assets, systems, and networks, whether physical or virtual,
- are considered so vital to the United States that their incapacitation
- 65 or destruction would have a debilitating effect on security,
- 66 economic security, public health or safety, or any combination
- 67 thereof. I ORDER THAT CALIFORNIANS WORKING IN
- 68 THESE 16 CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE SECTORS MAY
- 69 CONTINUE THEIR WORK BECAUSE OF THE IMPORTANCE
- 70 OF THESE SECTORS TO CALIFORNIAN'S HEALTH AND
- 71 WEL-BEING."
- 72 Later he clarifies what he has particularly in mind as critical: "The
- 73 supply chain must continue, and Californians must have access to
- such necessities as food, prescriptions, and health care."
- 75 And then he offers a recognition that people will have the liberty to
- 76 leave their homes: "When people need to leave their homes or
- 77 places of residence, whether to obtain or perform the functions
- 78 above, or to otherwise facilitate authorized necessary activities,
- 79 they should at all times practice social distancing."
- 80 He gave the task of ensuring compliance to the Office of
- 81 Emergency Services, and stated it shall be "enforceable pursuant to
- 82 California law, including but not limited to, Government Code
- 83 section 8665."
- 84 What's that? The California Emergency Services Act provides for
- 85 government powers during a time of emergency. In the section
- 86 providing for enforcement, chapter 7, article 19 Penalties and
- 87 Severability, section 8665 states "Any person who violates any of
- 88 the provisions of this chapter or who refuses or willfully neglects to
- 89 obey any lawful order or regulation promulgated or issued as

- 90 provided in this chapter, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and,
- 91 upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine of not to
- 92 exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or by imprisonment for not
- 93 to exceed six months or by both such fine and imprisonment."
- 94 All of this is within the law, but there is one statement in the
- 95 executive order that I think will fail under Constitutional scrutiny.
- 96 It's open ended. He did not stipulate a time frame. He said the
- 97 order stands "until further notice." He should have stipulated a
- 98 time limitation that would require him to periodically revisit this
- 99 decision. Two weeks, then look at it again: three weeks, a month,
- something. Even if he had said until further notice or until the
- pandemic is declared over. THIS IS DANGEROUS! He does not
- 102 have the power to indefinitely suspend our Constitutional rights.
- 103 It's an unprecedented reach of power and anyone who cares about
- protecting our rights should be alarmed!
- 105 So, there you have it! The Governor has exercised his powers under
- the Emergency Services Act to make it illegal for you to leave your
- 107 home except for reasons he has given, and within criteria he has
- outlined, which, actually, is not so clearly defined, as, for example,
- it is in San Luis Obispo county.
- 110 SLO issued a countywide order that is very specific in its reach, and
- 111 addresses churches. Churches can continue providing relief,
- broadcasting services, "but no congregations of people." So, people
- 113 cannot get together to pray in their churches; however, when it
- 114 comes to distilleries workers can "congregate" to continue
- production and bottling of alcoholic beverages so, we can see
- 116 what's really important.
- 117 Let's get back to the Governor's executive order. Texas' governor
- issued a very similar executive order for the State of Texas. When
- 119 churches began asking for clarification regarding how it would be
- 120 enforced in their case, he clarified that churches were not

- mentioned in the executive order and are considered exempt on
- 122 first amendment grounds.
- 123 Governor Newsome did not mention churches in his executive
- order. But it seems unlikely he would have the same regard for
- 125 church assemblies as the governor of Texas has. I think Governor
- 126 Newsome has about as much regard for the importance of church
- assemblies as most Americans have today. Maybe I'm wrong! Hope
- 128 so!
- But the fact is most Christians have little regard for the importance
- of church assemblies. Most believe it is a non-essential function.
- 131 And they very easily set it aside! Not all mind you! But most!
- 132 In Texas there would be a general outcry of concern about this. In
- California, you get stuff like, "Jesus did not call us to go to church,
- He called us to be the church," and all sorts of very wise pastors
- 135 who are counseling Christians to act in accordance with their
- neighbor's expectations, because of appearances, and then many
- who remind us of the biblical injunctions to obey the laws, to obey
- magistrates, and so forth.
- One very excellent pastor made a very good point that I thought
- 140 was probably the very best faith response to this issue
- 141 accommodating the Governor's order—he observed that Jesus
- violated the Sabbath in order to address sickness—I thought he had
- 143 drawn an inference from that story that is very insightful and
- legitimate. I would consider that a biblical faith response to this.
- 145 I'm going in a slightly different direction—but that's for the next
- 146 segment.
- 147 Okay. Hold on through the break. Dr. Scheidbach, theologian
- 148 extraordinaire will weigh in on this.
- 149 What will the Brain Masseur do?
- 150 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
- 151 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern

- lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the
- 153 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
- 154 liberty.
- Before I lay out my response to the Governor's executive order I
- 156 want to say, I intend to comply. What that compliance will look
- like is something I'll clarify at the conclusion—but I intend to obey
- the executive order as it is laid out in the text of that order.
- But, first! I want to declare my STATEMENT OF FAITH related to
- 160 this issue. In that, I will respond to some faith issues that are raised
- by some believers with which I disagree. For example, is it true that
- 162 Jesus did not command us to go to Church but to be the church?
- 163 Not one Scripture says, be the church. That is premised on
- somebodies doctrine of the church being universal and the "true"
- 165 church being invisible. One thing is clear, Jesus' church is
- organized in churches today. Anyway, Jesus nowhere said be the
- 167 church. Did He instruct us to assemble? Yes! Hebrews 10:25 gives
- 168 clear instruction that we are to ASSEMBLE OURSELVES
- 169 TOGETHER. I Corinthians 16 recognizes the common practice of
- believers assembling themselves together when it says, "upon the
- 171 first day of the week, when ye are come together." The word *church*
- includes the idea of assembling, or congregating in its meaning.
- 173 Another favorite is to point out the many instances in Scripture
- 174 where churches congregated in homes. They did! They also
- 175 gathered in the synagogue, which became the model for the
- 176 Churches as the churches grew and expanded. The synagogue was
- 177 a public assembly house. Churches have since the very beginning
- of the church gathered in public assembly houses dedicated to that
- 179 function.
- 180 There is a spirit that wants to make the church invisible to the
- public—it's not the Spirit of Christ. In principle, Jesus everywhere
- 182 encourages us to make our confession public, and our presence
- 183 known.

- 184 As to the question of whether Church is essential! I say it is the
- 185 MOST ESSENTIAL ORGANIZATION on the EARTH TODAY! It
- is the house of God and it is to be known as the HOUSE OF
- 187 PRAYER. In every disaster, our best SHELTER is the ROCK that is
- 188 Christ, Who is the chief cornerstone of the Church, and
- 189 FOUNDER of the churches, and its head. It is the PILLAR and
- 190 GROUND of the TRUTH in every community, and healing,
- 191 physically, and spiritually, is part of its commission.
- 192 As to the question of its importance everyone recognizes the
- 193 need to ensure access to food and yet, we do not live by bread
- 194 alone, but by every word of GOD repeatedly, the Bible talks
- about our responsibility to FEED the FLOCK OF GOD. They need
- spiritual food too. (By the way, I'm not saying the Governor's order
- 197 prohibits feeding the flock—it's an impediment, but not a
- 198 prohibition since we do have other avenues to provide for this—
- 199 please stay on point. Right now I'm speaking to the
- 200 IMPORTANCE of the CHURCHES in every community.
- Further on the point of its importance—Jesus does not walk in the
- 202 midst of the California assembly, at least not as an official presence;
- He does not walk up and down the halls of Congress, again, yes,
- 204 but not as His focused, or particularly presence—but the Bible
- 205 depicts Jesus as walking in the MIDST OF HIS CHURCHES.
- 206 That's HIS HEADQUARTERS that's His PLACE it's where
- He centers His attention and ACTIVITY.
- 208 The CHURCH is ESSENTIAL to every community, and to every
- 209 believer. I regard the CHURCH as vital, and certainly critical to
- 210 this crisis.
- 211 So, I argue that the Church assembling for PRAYER at this time is
- 212 certainly CRITICAL to getting through this threat. WE need to
- 213 SHELTER under the WINGS of the ALMIGHTY.

- 214 Finally, then, what do I recommend? I already said I intend to obey
- 215 the law. I regard my work as Pastor of Lighthouse Baptist Church
- 216 to be essential during this time. I have very carefully examined the
- 217 executive order, and studied all related documents, and believe that
- 218 I am within compliance by attending church this Sunday,
- 219 preaching, being available for counseling, and encouraging the
- 220 FLOCK of GOD.
- I outlined criteria in my Wednesday night message and will make a
- 222 few adjustments to bring us into more strict conformity to the
- 223 language of the executive order.
- First, I will ask only those to meet me at Church Sunday who are
- critical to my ability to present our services online, via livestream.
- The soundboard techs will be needed in order for me to broadcast.
- 227 These are critical to the operation, and I think I only need one
- 228 person for that. But it will certainly be no more than two and
- these will maintain a six-foot distance between them.
- 230 I will encourage those who have any concern at all about the
- 231 executive order, or about coming into contact with the virus, or
- 232 spreading the virus, to stay home and view the services via
- 233 livestream. As for what I will do with any who do come to services:
- No one experiencing symptoms of a cold, or the flu, will be
- 235 admitted into the auditorium, they will be encouraged to return
- 236 home. But if any desire to call for the elders of the church to come
- pray over them, we will respond. We will anoint with oil and pray
- 238 over any who request this but we will wear gloves and require
- 239 the sick person to wear a mask during this service. Also, it will be
- 240 provided in their homes.
- 241 Any who have no access to Internet, and who desire to come get
- 242 FED the WORD of GOD the necessary bread of life or to
- 243 drink of the WATER of HIS WORD will be admitted into the
- auditorium, although I suspect this will be very few.

- I encourage a run on this water—it's an eternal supply.
- 246 But the bottom line is that anyone coming to Church for comfort,
- and spiritual food, and spiritual water, will not be turned away.
- 248 This conforms to the same exception provided to those who need
- 249 access to stores to purchase necessary food. Or necessary
- counseling, or "spiritual healing" and even "physical healing."
- 251 Anyone requiring food is allowed to go into public and shop at a
- local store, or if they need medical attention, they may go to their
- 253 doctors likewise, anyone needing spiritual FOOD, or spiritual
- 254 healing can come to the church and they will be accommodated.
- 255 However, we will implement the social distancing protocols I laid
- 256 out for services with a few enhancements. All who enter will
- 257 receive sanitation for their hands upon entry, after which they will
- 258 be provided a pair of plastic gloves, and given a tissue to use to
- cover their mouth if they cough. They will be together as families,
- 260 but each family or anyone coming alone or with non-family
- 261 members, will be seated six feet apart. No handshaking.
- 262 These policies are conformable to the Governor's executive order
- and reasonably accommodate the State public health directives.
- 264 Church is a vital, critical social sector service to our community,
- 265 and I expect our SOCIAL and POLITICAL SERVANTS will
- 266 honor our FAITH and our inalienable RIGHT TO EXERCISE
- 267 IT.
- I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me
- 269 know if you see them. It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE
- 270 ON and you will ride like Revere and spread the warning,
- 271 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say
- 272 LIGHTS OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and
- disagree strongly with me. So, what will it be today, lights on, or
- 274 lights off?

- anoint with oil and pray over any who request it, while practicing
- 284 appropriate social distancing and taking all appropriate
- precautions against contacting or spreading COVID-19.
