4 CA Governor Newsome outlines plan to move toward lifting the
5 stay at home decree.
6 Pelosi refuses to come off her isolation in SF, eating her \$13 a pint
7 chocolate ice cream, from her 24k refrigerator, talking about how
8 much she is enjoying her isolation while small business in America
9 are suffering because she wont call Congress back to Washington
10 to address needed funding to help them — Nancy Antoinette, as

13 Americans are beginning to rise up against the excessive and
14 unreasonable use of this pandemic to take away our liberties.
15 Looks like the conspiracy crowd got it right, again, well, somewhat.
16 Apparently, this new coronavirus did leak out of a virology lab in
17 Wuhan China after all! Let's take a look. Will we make China pay
18 for this?
19 Hey, I heard stimulus checks are being sent to some that are
20 deceased. Haha! What do you want to bet they are among the dead
21 that vote Democrat every year?

24 CA Governor Newsome outlines plan to move toward lifting the
25 stay at home decree. (To be fair, at least this governor has enough

26 respect for Californians to follow a persuasion rather than
27 punishment strategy to enforce his order.)

28 Trump also outlined the phase 1, 2, and 3 plan for getting America
29 back to work. Let's look at the Gavin plan.

30 At least he mentions the concept of immunity—"Until we build
31 immunity, our actions will be aligned to achieve the following:
32 ensure we can care for those who are sick, prevent infection among
33 those who are at risk of serious reaction to the disease, build that
34 capacity to protect the health and well-being of the public (I
35 wonder about what would be included in this) and reduce social,
36 emotional, and economic disruptions.

37 He admits that current efforts are, well, he said "hard to sustain," I
38 say they are unsustainable because of the impact on our economy,
39 poverty, and healthcare. Although, the truth is, our health care
40 providers are not overwhelmed here.

41 Then Governor Newsome outlined six things that he will use to
42 decide when and how much to modify his "stay-at-home" order.

43 1. When he is satisfied we have adequate facility to test everyone
44 who requires testing, and when he is satisfied we can handle the
45 necessary contact tracing, that will be one marker that in his mind
46 would justify relaxing his stay at home order. But there are five
47 more.

48 2. The second marker is the ability to prevent infection in people
49 who are at higher risk of severe reaction to the virus. He wants to
50 ensure older folks and those with medical vulnerabilities can be
51 supported in their homes. Also, when they have a plan to quickly
52 identify and contain outbreaks in what we call old folks homes, the
53 disabled, and those in jail — his outline includes concern for those
54 with co-morbidities here, but that would come under medical
55 vulnerabilities — anyway!

56 Number 3, the preparedness of our hospitals to handle any possible
57 surge of an outbreak: bed capacity, supplies, staffing, like
58 ventilators and masks. He asks whether our healthcare system can
59 adequately address COVID-19 and other critical healthcare needs?
60 What? CA has some of the best hospitals and doctors in, well, in
61 the world.

62 Number 4, have we built a coalition of private, public, and
63 academic partners to accelerate the development of therapeutics?
64 Uh, therapy or things we can do to treat those with diseases — and,
65 again, this is beginning to sound like a plan to launch a new
66 medical system in a country. We have the infrastructure in place,
67 so maybe this is a repeat of 3 and it's about capacities.

68 Number 5, the ability for business, schools, and childcare facilities
69 to support physical distancing with ability to implement the
70 distancing practices and guidelines to check employees and
71 patrons who enter premises. With concern we have supplies and
72 equipment to keep the workforce and customers safe.

73 6. And, finally, to determine when to reinstitute certain measures,
74 like the stay at home rule if it becomes necessary. He wants an early
75 warning system, and ability to quickly communicate his
76 reinstatement of the stay at home order if he deems it necessary to
77 do so.

78 His projections: restaurants will open with fewer tables, face
79 coverings will be more common — we will look more like China —
80 and new opportunities will likely arise to support mitigation — not
81 sure what he means unless he plans to hire an army of snitches ala
82 LA Mayor's public snitching policy, or employment of persons
83 hired to do a quick medical check of persons coming into any
84 workplace, or, I don't know.

85 Anyway, some of these make perfect sense and some of them only
86 make sense within the context of lib-think.

87 For example, the government cannot prevent infection in people
88 who are at higher risk of severe reaction to the virus. And how far
89 will he go in this effort? Will he justify locking old folks up in their
90 homes every flu season? How do you "prevent" infection? Even if
91 he instituted the most outrageous controls on the movements of
92 older folks and all who interact with them, he could not PREVENT
93 infection. He should have used the word mitigate — but we would
94 still have a problem. How far does the Governor think government
95 should, or can go to protect people from getting sick?

96 Along the same lines, insisting on preparedness to handle "any
97 possible surge of an outbreak" is unreasonable! The projections
98 we've been hearing from "professionals" have been soooooo way off
99 the mark. If he set the bar on their projections, it would be nearly
100 impossible to provide enough beds, and doctors and we would be
101 in indefinite lockdown. Also, whom will the Governor listen to?
102 Unreliable sources, such as the World Health Organization, run by
103 a pack China sycophants? It's too vague. A plan tailored to what we
104 have experienced in the past, such as the Swine Flu pandemic,
105 would be reasonable—at least it would be premised on concrete
106 data. Why not use the current pandemic? Well, they are not
107 counting deaths by COVID in an honest and straightforward
108 manner. We have to go back to when Obama did not care about all
109 the people dying of Swine Flu and spent his time on the golf course
110 and vacationing, like Nancy is doing now in her mansion, eating 13
111 per pint chocolate ice cream ignoring pleas of American small
112 business owners for much needed relief that the Congress must
113 provide—Trump can't spend money, only Congress can do that.
114 This is on her. Anyway, at least the Swine Flu numbers of deaths
115 can be relied upon since there was no political motive for Obama
116 and his propaganda machine called the MSM to lie about it —
117 because they simply ignored it, or whispered it on page ten.

118 Another example he wants to insure we have built a coalition of
119 private, public, and academic partners to accelerate the
120 development of therapeutics? The free market system has already
121 got this going for us, so, we are good to go there. Unless he means
122 he wants to add a new layer of government oversight and intrusion
123 into the free market to top down compel and control such a
124 coalition—nothing will more certainly kill any progress toward
125 development of anything than putting it into the hands of the
126 government.

127 This whole virus leaking out of a lab in China and China covering
128 it up resulting in a worldwide pandemic is an example of
129 government control of the development of anything.

130 And number 6 is just down right frightening: He wants an early
131 warning system, and ability to quickly communicate his
132 reinstatement of the stay at home order if he deems it necessary to
133 do so. The reason that troubles me is the example we have before
134 us right now. Here we are shutting down the entire State over
135 concerns about a virus that NEVER MATERIALIZED.

136 California began developing immunity to this early on—I've
137 addressed that before, Rush has brought it up several times. Others
138 have spoken to it. A vaccine introduces a controlled amount of the
139 virus, which triggers an immunity response shielding us from
140 further infection. That's what my mom was doing when she took
141 me to the neighbors' house to play with her kid that had the
142 mumps. It was a crude approach, but it worked okay — the fact is,
143 we know this about viruses. These pestilences come and over time
144 the population develops an immunity — but the fact is, these
145 viruses kill thousands of people every year — and they have killed
146 thousands of people every year throughout my lifetime, and back
147 in history, probably back into the days of Nimrod when God knew
148 it was best for folks to SPREAD OUT! And not huddle together
149 like rats.

150 And my concern is that now every time some very zealous doctor
151 creates a model predicting outrageous numbers of death from the
152 next virus to come along, there we go again.

153 And let me conclude segment one by pointing out that we don't do
154 this with ANY OTHER THING THAT ROUTINELY CAUSES
155 DEATH.

156 The liberals are perfectly comfortable tolerating the death toll
157 alcohol takes on our population every year.

158 Why are we reacting with soooo much concern about people dying
159 of the Chinese flu — when 7755 Americans die every day from all
160 sorts of causes.

161 If these governors rush in to save us from the death of several
162 hundred by a new flu, our liberties are gone. Hey, 80k died of
163 seasonal influenza from November 2017-to late February, or early
164 March of 2018. EVERY YEAR CDC estimates a range between 9-
165 45 million flu cases, 140K to 810K hospitalizations, and 12k to
166 61k deaths—but we never shut the country down for that.

167 And, by the way, let me interject here that I noticed Trump tried to
168 speak to this but he was shouted down by virtually everybody on
169 the right and on the left.

170 Liberals are perfectly content to sit back and watch 58,069
171 Americans DIE from alcohol related,¹ (And this number does not
172 include alcohol related traffic collisions resulting in death). Did
173 you notice that every State has gone out of its way to exempt the
174 booze industry as essential while many of these same Governors
175 and Mayors call churches nonessential. Some are harassing
176 churches and attempting to intimidate them. In New York, for
177 example, De Blasio has ordered churches to close down and he
178 threatened to close them permanently if they refuse. The Mayor in

179 Greenville, Mississippi has ordered churches closed but liquor
180 stores open.

181 Okay, hold on through the break; I'll be right back.

182 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
183 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
184 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the
185 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
186 liberty.

187 A few weeks ago I pointed out that Americans are wired for
188 LIBERTY and cherish their FREEDOM and wondered out loud
189 how long it would be before Americans began to cry —
190 FREEEEEEEEEEEDOOOOOOOOOMMMMMMMMMM.

191 Trump is tweeting LIBERATE MICHIGAN, LIBERATE
192 VIRGINIA — haha! He gets it! He does have an uncanny ability to
193 read Americans. I think it's because he IS ONE!

194 Well, I started crying FREEDOM a few weeks ago, and it appears
195 many of our fellow-Wallace-spirited Americans are chafing at the
196 chains and bucking against racks upon which they've been
197 manipulated into lying down and allowing themselves to be
198 strapped in.

199 They us to run to their stretcher and hastily let them strap us in,
200 and then they started turning the screws on us, and stretching us.

201 A few weeks, a month, now not likely any sooner than August and
202 maybe into 2021—what? Are you crazy? Michigan's Governor has
203 gone so over the top four sheriffs in the northern counties of her
204 state are sending out *we will not enforce* notices to the citizens in
205 their jurisdiction — citing their oath to protect and defend the
206 Michigan and US Constitutions. Large protests have risen up in
207 Michigan, North Carolina, Ohio, Utah, Wyoming, New York, and
208 Virginia as the governors there are stretching true blooded
209 Americans beyond their tolerance.

210 It's true that Americans are more tolerant of oppressive
211 government today than they were in 1776 when they organized a
212 massive rebellion against the English Tyrant, declared their
213 Independence and defended their liberties to the forfeiture of the
214 lives, who committed their lives, their fortunes, and their sacred
215 honor to break government oppression—but there comes a point
216 where it's just obviously unreasonable and wicked intrusion upon
217 the rights of man—and, well, liberals have their triggers, and
218 conservatives have theirs. And infringement upon our RIGHTS is a
219 trigger.

220 Look, I do appreciate the fact that our Governor has not played his
221 hand heavily, but he has sent supportive signals to LA's governor
222 who has overstepped and touched religious liberty—. Don't be too
223 surprised if you read about that Mayor and New York's mayor
224 joining each other out in the proverbial cow pasture chewing the
225 cud with the cows for seven years — uh huh! Oh yeah!

226 Okay, it's time to begin the landing. Flaps at 15%, increase throttle
227 slightly, nose down, end of runway in sight, and lined up with the
228 top of my engine housing, in descent —

229 Looks like the conspiracy crowd got it right, again, well, somewhat.
230 Apparently, this new coronavirus did leak out of a virology lab in
231 Wuhan China after all! The new story is that it accidentally escaped
232 a Wuhan laboratory where it was being researched for curative
233 purposes and not as a potential biological weapon. So, that's the
234 new China approved story.

235 Hmmm. Liars have a device they use that goes like this. When the
236 first lie begins to fail because facts surface that make it no longer
237 believable, they retreat to another lie that yields only to the amount
238 of truth they know is exposed. But they craft their new lie in a way
239 they hope will take suspicion away from what they are really trying
240 to hide.

241 This retreat will usually move toward the truth, but it does not go
242 all the way. When you see this, it's almost always a signal that there
243 is a damning truth being covered up.

244 So the lie that it began in a wet market in Wuhan (by the way, a wet
245 market sells fresh meat, fish, and other perishable goods, usually in
246 open air markets) anyway the lie that it started in a Wuhan wet
247 market won't do any more.

248 So let's put out the lie that, okay, it did accidentally leak from a
249 Wuhan virology lab, but it happened in an effort to compete with
250 America in our study of viruses.

251 Hey, don't look at that rock over there under which evidence lay
252 that China was monkeying around with this particular viral bat
253 attempting to prep it for use as a bio weapon. Huh? What do you
254 think about that? Well. Why wouldn't they say they were studying
255 the virus they discovered in this horseshoe bat to create a vaccine
256 because they wanted to get ahead of a possible outbreak? But you
257 see, in my experience, liars don't think clearly to begin with. And
258 when they are in cover-up mode, they make mistakes.

259 Will another smoking gun be found revealing it was being prepped
260 as a bio-weapon, but a Chinese with a conscience, and there are
261 many such, by the way, decided to expose it. Aye?

262 There is an even darker conspiracy theory that some Deep State
263 nut jobs arranged to have this virus carried to China where the
264 plan was to release it into Wuhan population, shut down travel
265 from Wuhan to anywhere else in China, but allow travel from
266 Wuhan to, well, everywhere else, especially to America, where one
267 fellow came from Wuhan to America and discovered he had the
268 disease.

269 And meanwhile, the deep state organized a full court press attack
270 aimed at the Trump economy in hopes to derail it, stop his massive
271 rallies, have Americans cowering in fear — all to bring down a

272 President — but more than that, to bring down America as
273 founded and raise up in its place the Socialist Republic of North
274 America — hey, can I spin conspiracies or what?

275 But the point is that's what happens when special interests attempt
276 to quash the truth by dismissing it as a conspiracy, only to have
277 their lies exposed. It ends up fueling the conspiracy theory engines
278 that are native to human nature. Especially when the humans in
279 question have been lied to repeatedly—whatever you do, vote for
280 Trump in November. That is our only way to strike back at this
281 ongoing attempt to destroy America, the land that we love.

282 Well, they say this was not a manufactured virus, that it is a
283 creature of nature arising in a creation corrupted by the fall of
284 man—more on that Sunday Night, 5 pm, in my Issachar report as I
285 respond to Cuomo's latest antichrist rant against believers—but the
286 Chinese have a history of using viruses as a weapon.

287 Here is a document dated October 1, 1941 revealing concerns in
288 Japan about "Chinese employment of chemical and bacteriological
289 warfare against the Japanese."² Although, the same article offers
290 much evidence condemning Imperial Japan for extensive use of
291 biological weapons during WWII.

292 I found this interesting. This business of blaming an accidental
293 release of invisible people-killers from a lab on ingestion of
294 infected animal meat goes back to 1979 when an explosion
295 occurred at the Soviet Institute of Microbiology and Virology and a
296 bunch of folks down wind of the facility died of anthrax inhalation.
297 The Communists blamed it on Russians eating tainted meat. Anti-
298 Communist Russian Boris Yeltsin, in 1992, admitted the anthrax
299 was released from the research facility.

300 The then Communist Bulgarian government used an umbrella
301 fitted with a device that injected a pellet with a toxin called Ricin

302 that killed, assassinated, a hated dissident. This was 1978, and the
303 supplier of the toxin was the Soviet Union.

304 Oh, as an aside, we now KNOW that Iraq had bio-bombs prepared
305 in the run up to the war. 166 bombs: 100 with botulinum (baa-
306 chuh-lai'-nuhm) toxin, 50 with anthrax, and 16 with aflatoxin (a-
307 fluh-toxin).³ They also had equipped 25 Scud missiles with these
308 toxins. Spray tanks were built to be fitted to fighter aircraft or
309 drones that would spray these toxins over larger areas, and artillery
310 shells were fitted to deliver these toxins. Of course the Bush haters
311 never mention it, but "It is now clear that U.S. forces faced a
312 significant biological warfare capability in the desert" — WMD,
313 anyone? Why didn't we have 24/7 wall-to-wall coverage on this?

314 The fact is, our attack was so overwhelming and the invasion so
315 quickly moved in on them they never had a chance to deploy, and
316 when they might have, we were so deep into Iraq it would have
317 been suicide to do so.

318 All of this supports another theory I offered about our apparently
319 extreme reaction over the China virus — US security agencies,
320 such as Homeland Security, and the entire Department of Defense
321 has been deeply concerned about a bio-weapon attack and that
322 concern has not been abated. It was learned that our suspicions
323 regarding Russia's heavy investment and involvement in creating
324 biological weapons was justified when it was learned that Russia
325 continued 20 years after they signed the treaty prohibiting the
326 development of such weapons. Boris Yeltsin let the proverbial cat
327 out that bag in 1992. It all got exposed! Guess what? We also know
328 that other enemies of America eagerly hired many of those Russian
329 scientists! What programs did these scientists set up for those

332 Eleven Iranian Revolutionary Guard Naval vessels almost collide
333 with and harass 6 US ships in international waters.

334 Okay, flaps at full, got a bit of crosswind, a little right rudder,
335 floating some, a bit more throttle, there we go.

336 Did you hear that some stimulus checks are being sent to people
337 that are deceased—dead folks are getting stimulus checks. Wow!
