1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain

9 Obamagate—Question: is a former president prosecutable for
10 crimes committed while in office?
11 Update on CA COVID: Barr's office sent a warning letter to CA,

13 from SBC too, Lancaster Mayor hunkering down in near terror
14 over COVID, seven pastors covenant together to fast and pray for

29 Here is a Quinnipiac University Poll that has Biden beating Trump

32 Quinnipiac has slipped in its status since, in 2016, it followed the

47 Okay, my friends. It's time for your Brain Massage.

48 [TRUTH]

49 Is a former president prosecutable for crimes committed while in
50 office? I was disappointed when I heard that Lindsey and Atty
51 General Barr have both retreated from including Obama in the
52 crosshairs of their efforts to get at the truth regarding Russia-gate:
53 the phony dossier, the persecution of private citizens for political
54 reasons, oh yeah, Flynn was made a political prisoner by the
55 Obama administration. Gowdy is another one who has opposed
56 allowing the investigation into the abuse of power in the Obama
57 administration to include questioning Obama and Biden. Their

58 reason has to do with a longstanding unwritten law that we do not
59 prosecute former Presidents for their actions as President—and the
60 rationale is that once this starts, because the Presidency is a highly
61 charged political office, it will never end. Every President will be
62 harassed by lawsuits from his political enemies, and this will ham-
63 string the office of the President from thence forward. I'm going to
64 blow up that false doctrine today. Hear the ticking of the time
65 bomb [insert]. Haha. But, really!

66 First, I want to point out that after I had the chance to actually look
67 at what Barr said, it turns out he qualified his statement—he said
68 he did not foresee Obama and Biden being included as targets of
69 Durham's investigation with information he has currently in hand.
70 The door is left open! This suggests that Atty General Barr does
71 understand what I'm going to point out—the information-bomb,
72 that is, the TRUTH-BOMB I'm going to detonate in a few
73 moments.

74 So, let's review some of the newest information to surface about
75 Obama's involvement in spy-gate, #Obamagate.

76 Tom "Fit" Fitton, of Judicial Watch (send them all the support you
77 can) reports on revelations from some correspondence indicating
78 Obama wants to know what was going down with the dossier and
79 the matter of General Flynn. It appears there was pressure from the
80 top to implicate Trump in a charge of collusion, that Putin wanted
81 Trump to be elected.

82 And now we know that on January 5, 2017, only weeks before
83 Trump began assembling his clean up crew in preparation to
84 invade the Obama White House—Obama et al, devastated that
85 Hillary lost, and no doubt panicked that Trump would discover all
86 the corruption Obama and Hillary had hidden in the swamp—
87 Obama, Biden, then FBI director Comey, CIA director Brennan,
88 National Intelligence Director Clapper, and then Atty General Sally
89 Yates had a meeting in which they discussed the Russian—Steele

90 Dossier, and strategies on to do about Flynn. I've already
91 mentioned Obama's obsession with Flynn, and why—see Show No.
92 779.

93 After the meeting, Obama asked Comey and Yates to stay behind.
94 We know Biden also stayed behind for this private meeting.
95 Obama revealed to them that he had learned of "the information
96 about Flynn." Yates was surprised to discover Obama had detailed
97 information about a wiretapped conversation between Flynn and
98 the Russian ambassador. *THEY WERE SPYING ON FLYNN.*

99 Now we know that Obama instructed Comey to confront Trump
100 with the dossier. Let's see how he reacts. And the implications are
101 that he also instructed Comey to go after Flynn.

102 But now, Obama no longer controls the FBI, the CIA, the National
103 Intelligence office, or the Attorney General of the US. He feels it,
104 too. He feels this loss of control. No wonder Obama complains that
105 the Trump administration is "an absolute chaotic disaster." Justice
106 has been cut loose of his corrupt control and it's coming for him.
107 Justice is no longer controlled by the Obamabots. Hah! Indeed! It's
108 totally OUT OF OBAMA's CONTROL.

109 Now, the question of how close did Obama and Biden come to
110 crossing the line into criminal behavior is still an open question.
111 Clearly, if in fact he ordered the dossier to be used to gain warrants
112 to spy on Trump's campaign, or on his staff, well, there you go! Or
113 if he did instruct Comey to use his power to trip Flynn up in some
114 flimflam charge — well! But it's possible Obama and Biden were
115 clever enough to trust their stooges to pick up what needed to be
116 done without requiring them to be explicit. Whether Obama knew
117 in advance of the unmasking of Flynn to the press, or even more
118 disturbing, if it was done per his instructions, well, there you go
119 again. But all of that is yet to be determined. Any of these things
120 would be criminal behavior.

121 Some are advising Trump to give Obama and Biden a preemptory
122 pardon. The idea is that this will set in the mind of the electorate
123 the idea that Obama and Biden committed crimes. Of course, that
124 is absurd. Not that Obama and Biden are criminals. In my opinion,
125 there is no doubt about that. But a President cannot pardon
126 someone for a crime with which they have not been charged. It's
127 bad advice, and I think Trump's advisors will shield him from
128 something so obviously political gaming. Stay true!

129 But, to the question, the legal question whether a former President
130 can be charged for crimes committed during his administration.

131 We know the President has protection from prosecution while in
132 office. However, he may be impeached by the Congress, which
133 would be tried in the Senate, for "high crimes and misdemeanors."
134 In other words, the President is not ABOVE THE LAW — even
135 while in office. True, he is protected from being dragged into
136 courts to answer to any charges for and alleged crimes, and for
137 good reason. As I pointed out, the Presidency is a highly charged
138 political office and with people like the Democrats around, there is
139 no question but that Trump would be hauled into court every
140 other day for one or another phony charge. Right? Yeah! You know
141 that's right. The Democrats have no soul! That Party is corrupt at
142 its core today, and that's too bad.

143 But the point is, that even in office, the President is
144 ACCOUNTABLE and LAW provides for him to be charged with
145 high crimes and misdemeanors by Congress, and tried in the
146 Senate with the consequence being limited to being removed from
147 office — however, have you forgotten, that after he is removed
148 from office, he is prosecutable as a private citizen for his crimes.
149 Yeah! That's ALWAYS been the case. That's the LAW.

150 True, you can't, and indeed, no one should, allow a former
151 President to be made to answer for his policies—I mean beyond
152 whatever political come-uppance he might get from the voters with

153 regard to his legacy and so forth — but NO WAY can we
154 PROSECUTE a former president for any policy decisions he made.

155 For example, Obama sending the billion bucks to Iran—that was a
156 policy decision. How he went about getting the money to Iran,
157 however, needs to be looked at more closely because that might
158 have been illegal. I'm not sure what the law is on that matter.

159 His decision to run guns to the Cartels in Mexico, ostensibly to
160 track them into Cartels inner circles as a sort of sting op, that was a
161 policy decision. As for whether there were statutes violated in that
162 op, well, that's the point. There is a distinction to be made between
163 policy and criminal behavior in the implementation of these
164 policies.

165 The Benghazi travesty is likewise a matter of wicked policy, for
166 which Obama and Hillary should be held accountable politically,
167 and most certainly WILL be held accountable before the
168 SUPREME JUDGE OF THE EARTH — but only if criminal
169 charges may be brought out regarding that should there be any
170 move in prosecuting them.

171 But, when it comes to CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR — no office can
172 cover it — there is no COVER from JUSTICE against CRIMINAL
173 BEHAVIOR for any one — because, just like the libs like to remind
174 us — even though they do so hypocritically — NO ONE IS ABOVE
175 THE LAW. Not even Progressive politicians. Not even Obama, or
176 Hillary, or Comey, or Brennan, or Clapper, or Biden —.

177 And the progressives believe this too. Notice how hot they are that
178 Trump allegedly violated Michigan law and refused to wear a mask
179 in front of media! Yeah, did you know that? It's a law in Michigan
180 that you have to wear a mask in front of media. (I care too much
181 for the health and welfare of my fellow Americans to encourage
182 this mask wearing nonsense. It's unhealthy! Only wear them when

183 you have too. And, can I ask, any of you that wear your mask while
184 driving, alone, in your car, what is that about?)

185 Folks, I believe Obama is afraid for more than his legacy. I think he
186 knows he crossed the line—that he committed malfeasance—that
187 criminal charges might be brought against him and the process of
188 answering those charges will likely uncover a whole lot more than
189 his "handlers" want revealed. And he might face the Epstein
190 remedy.

191 Okay, gotta take a short break. Hold on, I'll be right back!

192 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
193 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
194 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the
195 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
196 liberty.

197 Update on COVID CA: Barr's office sent a warning letter to CA.

198 It was from the Office of the Attorney General, the Civil Rights
199 Division, dated May 19, 2020, and addressed directly to Dear
200 Governor Newsome. The opening sentence is "We are writing to
201 you to raise several civil rights concerns with the treatment of
202 places of worship in Executive Orders N-33-20 and N-60-20 and
203 documents relating to the California Reopening Plan." The letter
204 reminds the Governor that "Even in times of emergency, when
205 reasonable and temporary restrictions are placed on rights, the
206 First Amendment and federal statutory law prohibit discrimination
207 against religious institutions and religious believers."¹ In other
208 words, an emergency does not cancel the Constitution—only
209 partly, and temporarily, when these cancelations of our liberties are
210 even handed—so, yeah, I'm not in agreement with that idea any
211 more. I used to accept that. But thanks to Governors Brown,

212 Whitmer, Northam, and Pritzker, NO WAY! I don't trust godless
213 people and I don't believe them when they say they are protecting
214 public health. I think they are liars! I think they are trying to put
215 the infrastructure in place for a police state, for a totalitarian
216 regime to take over in November and exact their ungodly
217 vengeance on people of faith for interfering with their globalist
218 agenda, their agenda to subjugate Americans to the Tyrannical
219 control of Xi Jinping—to turn us into China, so they can do in
220 Madison Square gardens what they did in Tiananmen Square.
221 That's what I think is going on. They are working to steal the
222 November election, put a dupe in their, like Biden, who will allow
223 his puppet masters to trigger another "emergency" that they will
224 use to usurp the sword of divine justice and turn it to serve the
225 powers of darkness and attack people of faith.

226 In the spirit of the Harvard professor who recently said "Belief in
227 an afterlife is a malignant delusion, since it devalues actual lives
228 and discourages action that would make them [sic—live] longer,
229 safer, and happier." And he offers as "Exhibit A: What's really
230 behind Republicans wanting a swift reopening? Evangelicals." And
231 a guy who received one of my boosted posts and wrote that I'm
232 wasting my time because he is 100% atheist, and jabbed, "get a life."
233 And of course this jerk gets all sorts of stuff that he ignores and
234 casts aside but it was important for him to take this shot at me

236 informed him I was doing all I could to gather up my pearls—
237 hehe—but really—and that I considered him rude and had no
238 desire to have any interaction with him at all. So he wrote back,

251 I believe that when Pritzker says churches probably cannot expect
252 to be given his permission to resume in-person services for, oh,
253 maybe a year or so—that he is a corrupt, power mad man whose
254 antichrist bias, and obtuseness toward religious people is
255 inexplicable except it be understood in the context of Paul's
256 revelation about Satan being the "prince of the power of the air, the
257 spirit that now works in the children of disobedience" and his
258 revelation that "Satan takes them captive at his will" — because no
259 one hates the church like Satan does, and this yahoo has no
260 personal reason, that I know of, to hate churches like he obviously

262 Pritzker says he will not give his *permission* for churches to resume
263 their services until the state has fully implemented its citizen
264 surveillance infrastructure—that's right! He wants to finish

266 can't even get Chicago under control is going to set up spying
267 system to watch all citizens in his state—and when he see where

271 I believe they are corrupted by power. I think anyone who thinks
272 you can leave liquor stores and marijuana dispensaries open and
273 close down every other mom-and-pop-shop in the state is a
274 corrupt liar, because it's impossible to believe they could be that
275 STUPID. Anyone who tells a heart patient, you can't see your
276 doctor because we have to make sure we have room for COVID-19

277 patients when hospitals are virtually empty in most places in the
278 State, they are laying off nurses and even doctors, is either a
279 corrupt, lying, power crazed maniac, or they are dumb as a post.
280 Anyone who says we will reopen schools for in-person classes,
281 workers supporting the entertainment industries, and studios are
282 cleared for in-person work environments, and workers supporting
283 ecommerce are allowed to gather for in-person work
284 environments, providing that all reasonable social distancing is
285 practiced, but CHURCHES cannot open for in-person worship
286 regardless of whether they practice social distancing—is either a
287 stinking DEVIL, or a blithering DOLT.

288 Anyone who says your elective surgery is non-essential, but
289 electing to murder a baby in the womb, well, that's essential! Is
290 simply perverse in the core of their soul.

291 It's obvious what spirit this is coming from, and thank God we
292 have an Attorney General who STILL BELIEVES IN RELIGIOUS
293 LIBERTY.

294 And, thank God our President believes churches are essential. He
295 has sent a few subtle messages to this effect, but has come out now
296 boldly. Before he could go public with his sentiment on this matter,
297 some reporter shot a question at him asking whether Trump
298 planned to prioritize reopening churches over other
299 establishments" — and President Trump said no, but that he felt
300 churches are essential and that we could expect a statement on that
301 matter soon, he said, maybe today, or tomorrow. Well, again, true
302 to his word — the word came down today. Churches are
303 ESSENTIAL.

304 CNBC reports: Trump slams governors, demands they open
305 houses of worship 'right now.' Watch how the devils will howl. All
306 of you Christianettes who thought it did not matter that the House
307 of God was "closed" by order of the usurpers of the Divinely
308 Ordained powers, look how they resist giving you permission to

309 assemble. Happily, a quorum to execute business as a CHURCH
310 with the keys of the kingdom is only two or three—but assembled
311 they must be (Matthew 18)—special things happen in the assembly
312 of believers—the secrets of hearts are exposed, and God is
313 MANIFEST—I Corinthians 14)—anyway, one evidence we have
314 that God is not done with America, yet, is that God turned the
315 heart of our President to say CHURCH IS ESSENTIAL.

316 They say 1.58 million cases and "at least 95,052 deaths" from
317 COVID — liars. These people are lying. Kentucky recently
318 admitted to fudging the numbers by as much as 60%. 60%!!!! Birx
319 said she can't believe anything coming from CDC anymore—said
320 the numbers are inflated by 25%—and you heard me say, yeah,
321 well, it's more than that. And now Kentucky comes out and admits
322 the numbers reported there are inflated by as much as, well,
323 actually, over 60%.

324 So President Trump comes out and, well, I decided to get another
325 article because CNBC can't really be trusted. So, here is something
326 from The HILL, usually reliable, the headliner says, "Trump
327 Demands Governors Allow Churches to Open."² In the body of the
328 article, I read, "President Trump on Friday ordered governors to
329 allow houses of worship to open immediately, declaring them
330 'essential' to American life during COVID-19." They quoted
331 Trump as follows: "The governors need to do the right thing and
332 allow these very important essential places of faith to open right
333 now, this weekend." He went on to say, "If they don't do it I will
334 override the governors. America, we need more prayer, not less."

335 We all understand that Trump is not a politician, and political-
336 speech is not his forte'. I don't think Trump thinks he has the
337 power to simply decree churches open despite the blue state
338 oppressive governors edicts to the contrary. But I think he means

339 he will do, as he has now done, and will say to all people of faith,
340 "you've got a friend in me." We will support you! The office of the
341 President is going to stand behind your right to exercise your
342 fundamental, and inalienable rights. And his attorney General has
343 actually already led the charge—all wicked, oppressing governors
344 are hereby set on notice—the PEOPLE have a RIGHT TO
345 ASSEMBLE and WORSHIP GOD according to the dictates of their
346 own CONSCIENCE.

347 San Luis Obispo county has responded to the Attorney General's
348 letter to the governor with a statement they have no intention of
349 prosecuting alleged violations of the Governor's order.

350 Our Assemblyman, Cunningham, joined with some others to
351 petition SBC not to include COVID cases and deaths from the
352 Lompoc Prison in the numbers used to decide whether we are in
353 stage 2 or 3. That's good! But I was dismayed Cunningham's name
354 was not included with Gallager, Patterson, and some others on the
355 Concurrent Resolution declaring the governor's emergency
356 declaration void. I have not had time to contact his office to
357 ascertain where he stands on that matter, so, just expressing
358 concern that he was not included among the sponsors of that
359 resolution.

360 And Lancaster Mayor, Rex Parris, has surprised and disappointed
361 us. This guy is the Mayor who stood up to CA on the matter of
362 opening his meetings in prayer—he has been a friend of people of
363 faith in his city, and a close friend to Dr. Chappell, pastor of
364 Lancaster Baptist Church. I've heard him speak at Lancaster Baptist
365 several times, and participated, recently, in a conference call where
366 Mayor Parris, Dr. Chappell, David Gibbs of Christian Law
367 Association, and some others, discussed plans for reopening their
368 churches. Frankly, I felt a bit awkward for a couple of reasons.
369 First, I don't believe any Governor ever had the authority to declare
370 churches closed, and most especially when those same governors

371 were picking and choosing, clearly from an arbitrary, and biased
372 point of view, what businesses were essential and which were not.
373 Again, the absurdity that liquor stores and marijuana shops and
374 abortuaries were deemed essential, while hundreds and even
375 thousands of small businesses were closed, while the small stores
376 could not be trusted to practice social distancing but the big box
377 stores could be trusted — all these inconsistencies immediately
378 struck me as revealing an entirely different agenda was being
379 pursued here—the deceptive way they are counting COVID cases
380 and deaths—all of this screamed SCAM—LIBERTY THIEVING
381 SCAM—so, I did not find myself in the company of people who, in
382 my opinion, "got it!" I listened as great caution was warned, and all
383 this — and, not entirely inappropriately, by the way! Don't
384 misunderstand, I get that we must honor the office, and regard the
385 power with appropriate reverence—and we do, at Lighthouse, we
386 do are very careful about that. But when I heard Parris speak, I was,
387 frankly, I was appalled. I could not believe what I saw. He was
388 obviously terrified of COVID, he was practically whimpering, it
389 was sad. You could see his heart was filled with fear—and so when
390 I heard him come out and attack people of faith with a warning
391 that he would go so far as to lock them up in jail if they dared defy
392 his stay from church orders—it confirmed what I saw in him
393 during that conference call.

394 Pray for my friend in Lancaster—this can go very sideways very
395 quickly.

396 But then there are some champions—Pastor Stacey Shiflett, of
397 Calvary Baptist in Dundalk, MD, has had enough. He reopened his
398 church to in-person worship — the press gathered, treated him
399 respectfully, but the police did not show up. Praise God for that.
400 He recently preached in his pulpit and tore up the Governor's stay
401 at home orders before the congregation, and declared, "We are
402 going to Obey God."

403 I understand, 3,000 churches in California are planning to reopen
404 May 31st in defiance of the Governor's unconstitutional stay from
405 church order.

406 Newsome does not get to tell us when we can assemble for
407 worship.

408 I've come to the end of my time today and there is something I've
409 got to get to.

410 Eight California pastors have covenanted together in June to fast
411 and pray for California to be delivered from the power of
412 unreasonable and wicked men and women. Pastor Max Graves at
413 Liberty Baptist in Norwalk, Pastor Larry Cox, First Baptist in
414 Trona, Pastor Jerry Cook of Freedoms Way Baptist in Sloan
415 Canyon, Solid Rock Baptist in LA, with Pastor A.J. Harold, Faith
416 Baptist in Wheatland, with Pastor Campbell, Calvary Baptist in
417 American Canyon, with Pastor Marshal Stevens, and Pastor Tim
418 Johnson, Bible Baptist, in Willits, and, of course, Moi—and
419 Lighthouse Baptist Church here in Santa Maria. Friend, Satan does
420 not get to have California.

421 We must resist now, and it must begin in spiritual warfare.

422 Please hear me! If we do not rise up and resist this massive move of
423 Satan to establish tyranny in our land, now, when the cost of
424 resistance is still relatively low, now, before the cost will be blood in
425 the streets of our cities—now! We must stop the rise of the spirit of
426 antichrist NOW! Before it's too late to retrieve our liberties
427 politically. Don't let these violent people push us into violent
428 revolution. That's what Satan wants. Don't let it happen. Join us
429 now in prayer and fasting and civil protest, making our grievances
430 known forcefully, but civilly.

431 I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me
432 know if you see them. It's LIGHTS ON if you see the LIGHTS ARE
433 ON and you will ride like Revere and spread the warning,

434 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say
435 LIGHTS OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and
436 disagree strongly with me. So, what will it be today, lights on, or
437 lights off?
