28 Are hospitals over-reporting COVID cases? And other COVID  
29 news.  
30 Mask debate continues to percolate.  
31 Good for thee, but not for me—will elitist politics face voter wrath?  
32 More news on the plot to Chicom America!  
33 Okay, my friends—It's time for your Brain Massage.

45 Minneapolis burning—CNN reporter tells us he would not  
46 describe it as a riot: while a building is in full flames behind him  
47 and you can see rioters running about. Reminds many of us of ole  
48 Baghdad Bob—remember him? Hussein's information Director —  
49 that tells you a lot all by itself — in his black beret pompously  
50 declaring there is no invasion by America into Baghdad in the  
51 grandiloquent style of the impressive clergyman, only without the  
52 lisp — while the viewer can see behind him American tanks  
53 moving into the city and the city on fire from the air attacks.  
54 This character, reporting for CNN, of course, is standing on site  
55 with a backdrop showing a burning building and rioters running  
56 amuck, obviously really wanting to say, *there is no riot here, don't*

57 *pay attention to that burning building and the people running about*  
58 *in a frenzy behind that curtain over there.* But, this guy was simply  
59 too grounded in the reality of the moment, and you can see him  
60 squirming and struggling, he had not the grandiloquence of his  
61 predecessor of which he is an archetype, so he stammered about  
62 what we were seeing and saying, well, "it's mostly a protest."  
63 Hahaha! You gotta love it when the jackals—a canine the feeds on  
64 carrion and hunts in packs—(remember that Jesus called king  
65 Herod a *fox* because that animal aptly described his character)—so  
66 it is amusing when CNNs jackals go slack-jaw, discombobulated,  
67 and distressed by fear of offending George Soros who paid these  
68 Antifa thugs to turn that peaceful protest into anarchy, and pays  
69 him too.

70 Minneapolis Mayor, Jacob Frey holds a presser to explain his  
71 decision to let his city burn—his decision to turn it over to the

73 danger became necessary and I made the decision to evacuate the  
74 third precinct." Hold it! The danger became necessary? I'm going  
75 to assume he meant the danger made it necessary to evacuate the  
76 precinct. But sometimes I wonder if these guys play on Fried's  
77 slip-n-slide—The *danger* was Soros funded Antifa anarchists  
78 attacking the homes, and businesses of the people there to protest  
79 the brutality of a cop that had a record of this sort of excessive

86 So, the *danger* intruded into this situation from Soros-thugs from  
87 Black Lives Matter and Antifa intimidated this wimpy Mayor to  
88 leave the town in the power of these radical devils — for, as you

89 know, devils come to steal, kill, and destroy — and these Antifa  
90 thugs declare their intention to "burn it down." And this  
91 milquetoast Mayor says, "the symbolism of a building cannot out  
92 weigh the importance of life of our officers or public, could not risk  
93 serious injury to anyone, will continue to patrol 3rd precinct  
94 entirely, will continue to do our job."

95 What is your job? What did you hire a police force to do? Is it not  
96 to protect the persons and property of your citizens? If you guys  
97 don't step in and bring this evil down, it will grow, it will grow  
98 beyond your control.

99 What does the burning of the building "symbolize"? Surrender to  
100 the lawless. That's what you have. Surrender to the lawless. But  
101 that's liberalism for you. Paralyzed by risk. Put a liberal in power  
102 and he or she will be paralyzed by risk into inaction—which is a far  
103 greater risk than the risk police officers HIRE ON to bear — that's  
104 their job — to bear the risk involved in MAINTAINING LAW  
105 AND ORDER —. People under these sorts of liberal spineless  
106 leaders have no protection from anarchists—.

107 Dinesh is right — see Minneapolis! That's what you get when you  
108 put liberals in power—they will simply sit back and "watch it burn."  
109 Like Nero! They will fiddle around thumb-twiddling while the lives  
110 of citizens are shattered by violence. Liberals do not understand  
111 what government is for.

112 Don't you find it strange that these blue states can get so rough and  
113 tough with Christians—right?—Chicago Mayor sends the police  
114 force out the break up a Church that is meeting in defiance of her  
115 unconstitutional stay-from-church orders — but when it comes to  
116 applying the force of law to actually do something about crime?  
117 Hah! In a city that gets excited when as of May 25, only 191 people  
118 have been murdered on Chicago streets, down from 2019—by

119 ONE.<sup>1</sup> She can't stop Chicagoans from killing each other, but, by  
120 GOD, she is going to stop those Christians from going to church  
121 during this pandemic. Of course, as Horowitz put it—"You can  
122 leave your home to get drunk, you can leave your home to get high,  
123 you can leave your home to kill your unborn child ... but you can't  
124 leave your home to worship your GOD."

125 Modern liberals are unreasonable, and wicked.

126 But it's typical of liberals today. Paralyzed by risk into inaction,  
127 which gives way to evil. Or motivated by risk into foolish actions  
128 that unleashes all manner of evil upon our cities. Do you see the  
129 irony in this?

130 Modern liberals are paralyzed by risk into inaction against mobs  
131 destroying their cities. And yet, these same liberals are hyper-  
132 motivated into all kinds of activity to oppress us, to take away our  
133 liberties because they want to protect us from—risk????

134 Afraid of "risk" they refuse to employ the force of law to maintain  
135 order and restore the peace in a community attacked by Soros-  
136 funded anarchists.

137 Afraid of "risk" they deploy the full force of law to attack law-  
138 abiding, peaceful people, whose only crime is they want to go to  
139 church to worship God because they want to protect us from the  
140 risk of getting a disease—never mind that the disease kills only 2%  
141 of those afflicted, never-mind that we now know 42% of that 2%  
142 are the elderly, who live in nursing homes, that liberal idiots forced  
143 to admit sick patients into facilities not equipped to care for  
144 them—I wonder about these dictator types that run these large  
145 Blue cities and States that force a nursing home to receive sick  
146 elderly patients even after they were told about the risk—De Blasio,  
147 and Cuomo—and then Blue state Whitmer, after Cuomo's  
148 disastrous results from doing this, DOES THE SAME THING in

149 Michigan—DO THESE DEMOCRAT GOVERNORS WANT TO  
150 KILL THE ELDERLY IN THEIR STATES? Wow! Are we going to  
151 find some email, or text that shows these people actually wanted to  
152 "depopulate" their states of old people?

153 Okay, let's wrap the first segment. We are being oppressed by  
154 people who want to protect us from the risk of getting sick by the  
155 China Virus, sometimes called COVID-19. (Which, of course, does  
156 not stand for CoronaVirusInfectionDisease—of 2019, but instead,  
157 it stands for Certificate Of Vaccination ID, and the 19, well that  
158 stands for AI—artificial intelligence. Yeah! More on that on the  
159 other side of the break.)

160 But, we are being oppressed by MASTERS who want to treat the  
161 public as if it's their personal hospital and control us like they do  
162 their patients, and strip away the liberties of perfectly healthy  
163 people because of their perceived "risk" of infection from a disease  
164 that simply refuses to kill as many people as they predicted, and so  
165 they have to find ways to manipulate the COVID death count (and  
166 they ARE doing this, it's been admitted, in fact I heard Birx reveal  
167 this right out loud in front of God and everybody) okay, just trying  
168 to provide the context for my statement here — we are being  
169 oppressed by masters taking away our liberties to protect us from a  
170 relatively minor risk of danger—but, friend, we live with risk every  
171 day of our lives.

172 Do you realize that your chances of dying in a car crash is 1 in 106  
173 crashes,<sup>2</sup> and your chances of dying from COVD are 1 in a every  
174 358 people.<sup>3</sup> The problem in getting a true per capita count is the  
175 case count is artificially low, which everyone admits, and the death  
176 count is artificially high, which only some admit—like Birx—so it's

177 almost impossible. But the best estimate would be .0028 — or 1 in  
178 every 358. But it's admittedly a squishy number.

179 Using the same logic of our "doctors" protecting us from risk — we  
180 should immediately forbid everyone from driving in any sort of  
181 motor vehicle.

182 Right? After all, you don't know who on the road is, uh, wearing  
183 their mask—you don't know which of the persons out there on the  
184 road is going to do something stupid and end up killing someone.  
185 WE LIVE WITH RISK. We take reasonable precautions, but we  
186 cannot eliminate all risk—but fascists will use risk to make you  
187 afraid so you will give them total control over your lives.

188 Risk is part of life! The only way to eliminate risk is to eliminate  
189 living. And that's what they are doing to us. They are taking away  
190 our LIVES under the pretense of protecting us from RISK.

191 I'll be right back.

192 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
193 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
194 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
195 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
196 liberty.

197 Mike and Alacia Edwards invite you to STAND FIRM in  
198 DIFFICULT TIMES and join them on the corner of Grande Ave  
199 and Oak Park in Arroyo Grande Saturday between 1-3 to support  
200 our call to our Governor to OPEN CALIFORNIA. I'll be on my  
201 way to North Carolina, but my thoughts will be with you all in this  
202 effort.

203 So, Minneapolis is burning. In another, unrelated story, a Police  
204 officer killed a man. That's right! This is a totally unrelated story, at  
205 least in terms of what Newton called cause and effect. I bring it up  
206 because when whites came out to join the protest some black  
207 protestors told them, this is not your place!!!! What is it about

208 whites showing up to protest excessive force and what appears to  
209 have been the murder of a human being that gets in the way of  
210 what these particular "protestors" were there to do? I want you to  
211 think about this.

212 A man was killed by a cop who did not control his rage, used  
213 excessive force on what may well have been a perfectly innocent  
214 man. That's something that concerns all persons who have any  
215 humanity. That's something that deeply upsets us all.

216 Here is what we know so far. George Floyd went into a store and  
217 made a purchase with what turned out to be a counterfeit 20. He  
218 left the store with his purchase, and the clerk figured out that the  
219 bill was counterfeit, and the police were called.

220 The police arrived; I think four officers responded to the call.  
221 When the clerk identified that man that had given them the  
222 counterfeit 20, the officers proceeded to confront the man, and  
223 initiated an arrest. It was all caught on camera. The three officers  
224 watched as the bully cop wrestled the man to the ground, and put  
225 his knee on the man's neck. Nothing indicates there was any effort  
226 on the part of the suspect to resist arrest, but we have not heard the  
227 testimony of the officers or others watching—we only have the  
228 video.

229 The video reveals the officer had the man on the ground with his  
230 knee on his neck, and you can hear the man telling the officer that  
231 he can't breathe, and we know this continue for about 7 minutes  
232 and that after something like four or five minutes the man stopped  
233 breathing altogether—when the paramedics arrived, they could  
234 find no pulse and at the hospital the man was pronounced dead.

235 Now, I told this story without pointing out that the officer was  
236 white and the hapless victim was black. If this was race related, we  
237 hope the courts will bring this out and the charges will reflect  
238 this—but friend, at the bottom line, color has nothing to do with



239 this. If that is a factor, then the issue is bigotry, and something  
240 called racism, not race. In other words, the white race did not kill  
241 this man, anymore than the black race burned down Minneapolis.  
242 We judge men not by the color of their skin, but by the content of  
243 their character. The cop who did this, by any reasonable reckoning,  
244 abused in power as a law enforcement officer when he refused to  
245 respond to the man's repeated protests that he could not breathe.  
246 The officer is Derek Chauvin, and he got in hot water with the law  
247 when he shot and killed a man in the city where at that time  
248 Klobachar was the city attorney. She refused to bring charges  
249 against him in that case. I have not had time to run down the  
250 particulars, so I don't know if she ignored compelling evidence of  
251 abuse then, but it's all coming out now, of course.

252 But, friend, the police force did not do this, Derek did. The white  
253 race did not do this, Derek did. His last name is Chauvin, sounds  
254 French to me—folks, the French did not do this, Derek did.

255 The white "race" did not do it. Derek did! What one white man  
256 does is not an indictment against the race any more than what fifty  
257 to a hundred black rioters did is an indictment against the Blacks.

258 So one wonders! What is it about whites showing up to protest a  
259 man being killed by a cop using excessive force gets in the way of  
260 the agenda of these black protestors — you following mere here?  
261 Apparently, for them, it's not about a man who was killed by a  
262 police officer using excessive force—it's about the WHITE RACE  
263 versus the BLACK RACE and so we can't have any whiteys here.

264 That's UW baby! Unreasonable and wicked! And where you see  
265 something that does not make sense, that is unreasonable on the  
266 face of it, stop and ask, what sense does this make. When you get  
267 the answer, you'll have discovered the wickedness that is in it. Only  
268 an evil agenda is pursued by unreasonable behavior.

269 The Twitter Wars—Trump versus Twitter. Trump sets off a  
270 Twitter storm with his Scarborough Tweet. Trump did not say  
271 Scarborough killed anyone, but the left like to twist his words out  
272 of context and, usually, into a prescient prediction of what the left  
273 has done or is up to. It's kind of eerie how often that happens.  
274 Anyway, Trump did not say Scarborough killed anyone. Here is  
275 what he Tweeted: "Psycho Joe Scarborough is rattled, not only by  
276 his bad ratings but all of the things and facts that are coming out  
277 on the internet about opening a Cold Case. He knows what is  
278 happening! ... He continued in a follow-up Tweet: "about whether  
279 or not Joe could have done such a horrible thing? Maybe or maybe  
280 not, but I find Joe to be a total Nut Job, and I knew him well, far  
281 better than most. So many unanswered & obvious questions, but I  
282 won't bring them up now! Law enforcement eventually will?"

283 Why does Trump call the guy a Psycho? Well, we could go back to  
284 the campaign, but we don't have to go that far. Here you go!  
285 Scarborough says, "EVERYBODY SAW THE PANDEMIC  
286 COMING IN JANUARY" and complains that Trump did nothing,  
287 costing American lives.<sup>4</sup> I will resist the temptation to lay out the  
288 citations: Fauci, definitely a reputed expert in the field, and every  
289 single MSM propaganda organ for the Democrat Communist Party  
290 (the DCP — the US equivalent of the CCP) they were all pushing  
291 the Chinese Communist line, saying it's no big deal—so in January,  
292 TRUMP bans travel into US from Wuhan, with the exception of  
293 Americans, and MSM criticizes him—and in April, Scarborough  
294 screeches about Trump not taking action in January when  
295 EVERYBODY SAW THE PANDEMIC COMING? I don't know

297 Works for me! And this propaganda line has become the basis for  
298 accusing Trump of KILLING AMERICANS. Totally psycho.

299 As for whether Scarborough killed his aide, there was some  
300 concern about his involvement, but it was ruled a suicide, but  
301 lately, the rumor mill has been churning this up again, so—like I  
302 said. I've watched this President repeatedly point to something like  
303 this only, in the end, they have been proved prescient.

304 But, the Twitter wars heat up! Twitter does not like it that Trump  
305 has found their platform a useful way get his message out to the  
306 people unfiltered by the Marxist-Socialist Media (MSM). So they  
307 have been trying to find a way to filter him, to hide his messages  
308 from the American people, to stick a mask (oh, I mean, muzzle) on  
309 him. But he is not going to sit back and let them get away with this.

310 Trump Tweeted a warning to the Antifa-BLM thugs that turned a  
311 peaceful protest into a riot in Minneapolis that they had better  
312 beware because he will not sit back and watch, like the Mayor did,  
313 he will actually step in with action. He warned them they will face  
314 armed resistance—only, he did it in his own inimitable style: "the  
315 looting starts, the shooting starts." Twitter hid this message from  
316 the American people because they felt it "glorified violence."

317 What fools! What glorifies violence is when you pretend it's not  
318 happening. You allow the murderers to get out their message—  
319 "Two of you for every one of us." And, "We built it, and we will  
320 burn it down." What Trump is proposing to do is what GOD  
321 appointed the sword to civil government to do—execute wrath  
322 against EVILDOERS. These people are EVILDOERS and need to  
323 have DIVINE WRATH executed against them—the SWORD of  
324 the LORD. But Mayor Frey, he only uses the sword to go after  
325 people that want to go to church. Frey's spokesperson warned: "We  
326 have to take this very seriously. Our No. 1 goal is trying to get  
327 voluntary compliance, but if that should fail we will use  
328 enforcement measures that are appropriate."<sup>5</sup> He said the new

334 So, Twitter, at first, hid the message, but when pressure came to  
335 bear, they decided it's in the best interest of the public to have  
336 access to the Tweet. So, they are controlling what you will see and  
337 what you don't see based on their bias against Trump. Hmmm!  
338 You say! What proof have you of that? Really?

339 Well, okay, if it is not obvious to you. How about this? Here are  
340 some Tweets from Yoel Roth—Yoel Roth is Twitter's "Tweet  
341 integrity Czar" — yep! Head of "site integrity." He is the guy,  
342 ultimately, who sets the rules for what posts are acceptable for  
343 display on the Twitter platform. So, what is the integrity of the  
344 "Twitter integrity officer"? Here you go. Yoel Roth: "I'm just saying,  
345 we fly over those states that voted for a racist tangerine for a  
346 reason." Yeah! There you go! A senior staff member of Twitter, in  
347 control of what passes as appropriate for Twitter: "Today on Meet  
348 the Press, we're speaking with Joseph Goebbels about the first 100  
349 days..." What I hear whenever Kellyanne is on a news show."  
350 Hmmm! Nice! How about this one, "Yes, that person in the pink  
351 hat is clearly a bigger threat to your brand of feminism than  
352 ACTUAL NAZIS IN THE WHITE HOUSE." Oh, and ACTUAL  
353 NAZIS IN THE WHITE HOUSE is set off in ALL CAPS, cause  
354 Roth was wroth—and felt the need to HOLLER that hollow claim.  
355 One more: "How does a personality-free bag of farts like Mitch  
356 McConnell actually win elections?" Wow! That's what Twitter  
357 passes off as *integrity*?

358 Every time! Whenever you see Trump going off on some yahoo  
359 like this, every time you find out it's because they are truly yahoos!

360 (Not the email server, the low friends met by Gulliver on his  
361 travels.)

362 So, the latest is Twitter "fact-checked" the President's tweet because  
363 the President said mail in voting leads to fraud.

364 Do you understand what all mail in voting does in a state where the  
365 voting rolls are packed with dead people, or otherwise absent  
366 people? Here is a sample! Back in 2016, and 89 year old widow  
367 received 83 ballots delivered to her house. Too bad the "harvesters"  
368 did not get there before she blew the whistle on this or Hillary  
369 would have had gotten about 82 more votes. Now, wait a minute.  
370 Really? Really!

371 Do you like Snopes? I find them helpful because they allow me to  
372 see what the liberals do with a story that really nails them to the  
373 wall. When this story came out a while back, Snopes took a look.  
374 They talked to the Los Angeles County Registrar's Office. The  
375 Registrar admitted that too many ballots were sent to a single Los
