- 1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the
- 2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain
- 3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.
- 4 The SCOTUS ruling on mandates a huge disappointment, and
- 5 other COVID related news.
- 6 The new Biden TERRORISM PLAN behind the smoke screen of
- 7 COVID overreaction something much more ominous is in the
- 8 works. You should know about it.
- 9 Breaking Today, Stewart Rhodes, Oath Keeper's leader, was
- 10 arrested on charges of sedition conspiracy, adding to the long and
- 11 growing list of POLITICAL PRISONERS held by the Biden
- 12 Administration.
- 13 What must be done?
- Okay, my dear friends it's time for your BRAIN MASSAGE.
- 15 [TRUTH]
- 16 The SCOTUS ruling on mandates and it seems to me everyone
- 17 is very happy with the ruling. So, I went to the SCOTUS website
- 18 and downloaded, then read the case arguments. Frankly, I was
- 19 appalled. But I should say at the outset that I understand the court
- 20 must address the case set before it. I'll explain why that is
- 21 significant after I offer my analysis of the ruling.
- 22 Quickly, remember the present make up of the court: on the liberal
- 23 side of the court Breyer, Sotomayor, and Kagan— the
- 24 conservatives are Thomas, Alito, Gorsuch, and Barrett then you
- 25 have the Deep State spoilers: Roberts and Kavanaugh I base that
- on my observation that when a matter before the court has serious

- 27 implications contrary to the interests of the DS they will vote
- 28 contrary to the interests of the American.
- 29 The case set before the National Federation of Independent
- 30 Businesses (or NFIB—the PLAINTIFF) brought forward the case
- 31 against OSHA (DEFENDANT) opposing OSHA's vaccine
- 32 mandates.
- 33 The defendants supporting Biden's mandate essentially argued that
- 34 OSHA has received from Congress a mandate to act in the interests
- of the health and safety of employees in the work place and that
- 36 Biden's executive order directing OSHA to mandate vaccines for
- 37 employees in businesses with over 100 employees was consistent
- 38 with that authority.
- 39 The plaintiffs argued that OSHA was not given the power to
- 40 require companies to mandate medical treatment for its employees
- and that Biden's mandate extends the powers of OSHA beyond its
- 42 original scope.
- 43 The conservatives on the court prevailed, and argued essentially,
- 44 that the question comes down to this, who has the power to
- 45 respond to the pandemic, and their answer came down to this,
- 46 "That power rests with the States and the Congress, not OSHA."
- 47 In other words, the plaintiff approached their case by arguing
- 48 OSHA was not given the power to compel businesses to require
- 49 medical treatment for employees even in a pandemic scenario. The
- 50 State and the Congress, according to the court, has the power to
- 51 direct how the public will respond to a pandemic.
- 52 And I say THIS TOTALLY MISSES THE POINT.
- 53 The point is not whether OSHA has the power to direct
- 54 government response to a pandemic the question is WHETHER
- 55 GOVERNMENT, WHETHER LEGISLATIVE, OR EXECUTIVE,
- 56 OR THE JUDICIARY, has the power to OVERTURN THE
- 57 PERSONAL LIBERTIES of Americans.

- I was appalled that neither the plaintiff, nor even one of the Jurists,
- 59 thought to question the premise of the case presented by the
- 60 defendants the government lawyers arguing in defense of
- 61 Biden's mandate or raise the ESSENTIAL QUESTION that
- 62 underlies this case.
- 63 First, the PREMISE it is assumed that there is a PANDEMIC
- 64 that is extraordinarily dangerous to the lives of all Americans so,
- let's review the FACTS, shall we? 99.998% chance of recovery with
- 66 no hospital intervention for persons 4-45, above a 99% chance of
- 67 recovery for those 45-65, and above a 95% chance of recovery for
- 68 those over 65. Recovery rates are improved for those receiving
- 69 early treatment—treatment that is opposed by Fauci and friends.
- 70 The point I'm making here is that the COURT proceeded to rule
- 71 on a case that rests on a faulty premise and did not venture to
- 72 challenge the premise.
- 73 Second, the court totally MISSED the central question.
- 74 "The central question we face today is: Who decides? No one
- 75 doubts that the COVID-19 pandemic has posed challenges for
- 76 every American. Or that our state, local, and national governments
- all have roles to play in combating the disease. The only question is
- 78 whether an administrative agency in Washington, one charged
- 79 with overseeing workplace safety, may mandate the vaccination or
- 80 regular testing of 84 million people. Or whether, as 27 States before
- 81 us submit, that work belongs to state and local governments across
- 82 the country and the people's elected representatives in Congress.
- 83 This Court is not a public health authority. But it is charged with
- 84 resolving disputes about which authorities possess the power to
- 85 make the laws that govern us under the Constitution and the laws
- 86 of the land."¹

- Okay, so the court did not want to posture themselves as ruling on
- 88 the question that lay at the foundation of the case: is there in fact a
- 89 serious threat to the public that OSHA is charged to address,
- 90 because "this court is not a public health authority."
- 91 So the court proceeded to rule within the following assumption:
- 92 "There is no question that state and local authorities possess
- 93 considerable power to regulate public health. They enjoy the
- 94 "general power of governing," including all sovereign powers
- 95 envisioned by the Constitution and not specifically vested in the
- 96 federal government." quoting ROBERTS.
- 97 And they followed this with a caveat: "The federal government's
- 98 powers, however, are not general but limited and divided" citing
- 99 McCullouch v. Maryland, 1819.
- 100 Stay with me!
- 101 Therefore, the court reasoned, "Not only must the federal
- 102 government properly invoke a constitutionally enumerated source
- of authority to regulate in this area or any other, it must also act
- 104 consistently with the Constitution's separation of powers."²
- 105 And because the defendant could not present any "enumerated
- source of authority" in the Constitution to support allowing OSHA
- 107 to mandate vaccines for employees of businesses with over 100
- 108 employees, the Court referred them to the power of the State
- and/or the Federal Legislative body and I say WHAT?
- 110 The Congress *can* require businesses to mandate vaccines for their
- 111 employees? Excuse me!!!!
- Where in the Constitution do we find this power given to the
- 113 Legislators?
- 114 You see, they have conceded the major premise without
- 115 challenging it. They grant to state and local authorities

- "considerable power" to regulate public health. BUT, as they argue
- in this case, "the federal government's powers ... are not general
- 118 but limited and divided."
- 119 How about we address some of those LIMITATIONS? Is not the
- 120 government's power restrained by the NATURAL RIGHTS of
- 121 citizens, the inalienable right, for example, TO DECIDE WHAT
- 122 GETS JABBED INTO OUR BODY?
- 123 Did not Nuremberg address this issue, and conclude to
- 124 EVERYONE's assent, that NO PERSON SHALL BE COERCED,
- 125 OR COMPELLED, TO PARTICIPATE IN A MEDICAL
- 126 EXPERIEMENT?
- 127 How could the court have not at least mentioned this
- 128 LIMITATION of government Congress cannot make a law that
- violates our basic human rights.
- 130 What is wrong with these people?
- 131 You don't have to forage out into the practice of medicine, dear
- 132 CONSERVATIVES on the COURT to rule that THE
- 133 NUREMBERG CODE has application here. This is not an
- 134 APPROVED vaccine it's being administered under
- 135 EMERGENCY USE AUTHORIZATION there is NO way
- anyone has the right to force you to stick something into your body
- 137 over your objections nor can they coerce you do so by
- 138 threatening to take away your livelihood if you refuse TO
- 139 PARTICIPATE IN A MEDICAL EXPERIMENT.
- 140 The premise must be challenged: not only must Biden, et al,
- 141 establish Constitutional authority to impose this regulation on
- 142 Americans, but Congress also, and any State, cannot COMPEL, of
- 143 COERCE, any human being to take a shot against their objections.
- 144 And, furthermore, they don't even provide fully INFORMED
- 145 CONSENT —

- Listen, the COURT missed this and I'm telling you these guys are
- 147 not dull witted. There was one moment during the oral arguments
- 148 that I thought I noticed Clarence Thomas stick a toe across the line
- 149 I think they were trying to avoid I think they were purposely
- avoiding getting tangled up in the REAL QUESTION of this matter
- and purposely navigated their course of enquiry away from what
- 152 I have to believe these guys KNOW is the REAL CORE
- 153 QUESTION here can the government, under emergency
- powers, suspend the INALIENABLE RIGHTS of citizens protected
- 155 by GOD and our Constitution?
- 156 They don't want to open that box for fear where it will lead them.
- 157 In summary, the Court turned the case into a separation of powers
- case that is not entirely without merit. But it MISSES the real point
- 159 of this case. Does the government have the power to compel
- 160 citizens to participate in a medical experiment?
- Becky and I were talking about this and she reflected that it sounds
- similar to what the COURT did with what we have come to call
- 163 Obamacare. They decided that the legislative branch had the power
- 164 to suspend the Constitution that would ordinarily prohibit the
- 165 government from mandating what the American people purchase
- and decided Congress could mandate every American purchase
- health insurance. Now they are doing it with vaccines.
- 168 You see, you are happy because the court stopped Biden's vaccine
- 169 mandate but when you read their decision you discover all they
- 170 did is punt it to the Congress. This ruling essentially says
- 171 CONGRESS can pass a LAW that requires all American's to be
- 172 vaccinated.
- 173 More and more, the Constitution is being supplanted by the will
- and whim of men in power.

- 175 And you know that the Court's decision left the medical
- 176 professionals susceptible to Biden's vaccine mandate. Let's look at
- that and then we'll go to break.
- 178 The premise of this decision is that since the Federal government
- 179 funds Medicare and jointly, with each state, also funds Medicaid,
- 180 that therefore, the Federal government has a legitimate interest in
- 181 regulating the doctors that provide medical services to Medicare
- 182 and Medicaid patients. On this ground, the Court decided the
- 183 Federal government could mandate vaccines for all medical
- professionals who treat Medicare and Medicaid patients.
- Once again, the court is totally missing the point or hiding from
- 186 it. Do you want to know what the answer is to this situation? It's
- really very simple. Give the decision to the patient! If a patient does
- 188 not want someone unvaccinated treating them, let them say so, and
- let them have a physician that is vaccinated. And vice versa! You
- 190 see how SIMPLE it is? There is nothing at all hard about this
- 191 situation.
- 192 BUT THE IDEA THAT GOVERNMENT PURCHASES THE
- 193 RIGHT TO INTRUDE UPON THE INALIENABLE RIGHTS OF
- 194 AMERICAN CITIZENS BY FUNDING THEIR MEDICAL
- 195 TREATMENT SHOULD SEND A COLD SHIVER DOWN THE
- 196 SPINE OF EVERY AMERICAN —
- 197 There is no way the Constitution provides power to the
- 198 government to intrude upon the rights, right down to the right of
- 199 bodily autonomy, there is NO WAY the conservatives on that
- 200 court don't see this I can't believe it! What is GOING ON?
- The conservatives on the court, it seems to me, purposely evaded
- 202 the central question IS THERE ANY SCENARIO IN WHICH
- 203 IT IS OKAY FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO SUSPEND OUR
- 204 NATURAL, AND CONSTITUTIONALLY GUARANTEED
- 205 RIGHTS against our will?

- Okay, let's take a short break. I'll be right back.
- 207 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor
- at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern
- 209 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the
- 210 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our
- 211 liberty.
- 212 Biden had hardly shuffled from the stage where he was inaugurated
- 213 before he directed his national security team to review US
- 214 government efforts to address domestic terrorism.³ First thing he
- 215 did! The report was released in June and I've read through it, and
- 216 it's very alarming. It's titled National Strategy for Countering
- 217 Domestic Terrorism —
- 218 The behavior of the Demoncrats since November 3 suggests they
- 219 are expecting some sort of massive American "Revolution" to break
- 220 out they are looking over their shoulder like the Proverb,
- 221 "The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold
- as a lion" (Proverbs 28:1). It's like they have been waiting and even
- 223 hoping Americans will rise up against Biden the way they did
- 224 against King George they egged us out into the streets to
- 225 confront the real terrorists BLM and ANTIFA but we did not
- buy it. They staged a "riot" on Jan. 6, but with the exception of
- something like two out of the million Protesters there that day; the
- 228 Patriots there did not supply the large-scale "insurrection" they
- 229 planned. So they are making do with what they got!
- 230 The Demoncrats together with their Judas-Republicans
- perpetrated a coup on November 3, and they've been looking over
- their shoulder ever since.
- 233 So, what is the first thing Biden does as acting president? He tasks
- 234 the national security team to lead a 100 day comprehensive review

- of US efforts to address domestic terrorism. Why would you do
- that unless you had reason to believe you had just done something
- that was going to totally tweak the American PATRIOTS?
- 238 As I read through this doc, I noticed some of the old propaganda
- 239 tricks of Goebbels connect what would seem a benign and
- 240 irrelevant concern to one that is recognized by everyone as a
- serious problem. This way people begin seeing them as related and
- 242 as equal in concern. So you connect hate crimes motivated by
- 243 racial bias (which almost NEVER HAPPENS in America today—
- 244 unless you are talking about the line backer sized black thug that
- 245 jumped on a 75 year old Korean-American and knocked her
- 246 unconscious—anyway!) connect that concern to patriots agitated
- 247 about government overreach. THINK!
- 248 So, as I'm reading this, I'm thinking, what are these guys up to
- 249 here? It's written in a way to point almost exclusively to white
- 250 supremacists as the number one major threat of domestic
- 251 terrorism, but also uses language that would suggest to any
- 252 reasonable mind that any American that is disgruntled with the
- 253 present government is a potential terrorist.
- 254 It's a strategy to eliminate dissidents.
- 255 Here are some takeaways and some of this illustrates my point.
- 256 First, do you notice sense of urgency on the left regarding an
- 257 expectation of some uprising from "white militia" it's like white
- 258 supremacists are lurking behind every tree, and around every
- 259 corner, just looking for their opportunity uh, to take their rifles
- and go to a baseball game played by democrats and start shooting
- 261 them oh, wait, no, that was James Hodgkinson, the guy who
- 262 asked whether those playing on the baseball diamond were
- 263 Republican or Democrat and when he learned they were
- 264 Republican, opened fire almost killing Scalise, and seriously
- 265 injuring two US Capitol Police officers —. It happened in 2017,

- soon after Trump took office, and it took the FBI almost three
- years to admit this was an act of "domestic terrorism."⁴
- 268 The fact is, as odious and offensive as White Supremacy is, we
- 269 really have not seen a lot of that sort of thing since Byrd took off
- 270 his hood and join the Demoncrats pretending to be a defender of
- 271 the blacks. There have been no Democrat slave owners since they
- 272 lost the Civil War—and blacks have not been required to sit at
- 273 separate tables from whites since the Democrats lost their Jim
- 274 Crow laws, and the Civil Rights Act was passed I mean, ever
- since Biden tried to stop the integration of our public schools and
- 276 failed you know, the Democrat White Supremacists have pretty
- 277 much gone underground and now they carry out their
- 278 oppression of the black community from underground behind
- the facade of racial equality.
- 280 The fact is, the White Supremacists in this country have always
- been the Democrats, and they are forced to hide their racial hatred
- and sense of superiority over all others so who are these people
- 283 really trying to place in the cross hairs of their TERRORISM
- 284 PLAN?
- 285 I've referenced the document in my notes the link to the official
- 286 WH document called National Strategy for Countering Domestic
- 287 Terrorism let me give you some of the highlights.
- 288 It broadly defines identifies Domestic Violent Extremists (DVEs)
- as "persons motivated by a range of ideologies and galvanized by
- 290 recent political and societal events. Catch that: recent political and
- 291 societal events? They have specifically in view the concerns about
- 292 the Nov. 3 election. That's their focus. You'll see it come up
- repeatedly in the document.

- 294 The National Security Council assessment of the present danger of
- domestic terrorists seem to be fixated on anticipation of reaction to
- the Biden Presidency.
- 297 They say these recent events "pose an ELEVATED THREAT to the
- 298 Homeland in 2021." In 2021 they clearly expected to see some
- 299 sort of armed retaliation from the American people against them
- 300 for stealing the election in 2020.
- 301 Here are some of the things the National Security Council
- 302 identified as issues to watch: biases against minority populations,
- 303 and PERCEIVED GOVERNMENT OVERREACH which they said
- 304 would "almost certainly continue to drive Domestic Violent
- 305 Extremist radicalization and mobilization to violence."5
- 306 Along with that, they warn that "newer sociopolitical
- 307 developments-such as narratives of fraud in the recent general
- 308 election.
- 309 You've got to be kidding me. Tell me you remember how the
- 310 Demoncrats and Judas Republicans reacted to Hillary's loss. They
- 311 cried foul, and protested the election was rigged, they did all of that
- in 2016 and continued this all the way through Trump's first term.
- 313 Now they say questioning the legitimacy of an election marks
- 314 someone as a POTENTIAL DOMESTIC TERRORIST? Hmm.
- Perhaps we should consider who is saying this and go with the old
- 316 yarn about it takes one to know one or something!
- Only in this case, it takes one to suspect everyone else of being one.
- 318 What else oh, and "THE EMBOLDENING IMPACT OF THE
- 319 VIOLENT BREACH OF THE US CAPITOL."
- 320 So, if you question the legitimacy of Biden's election and/or if
- 321 you participated in the J6 protests or deny their hyped up claims
- 322 about that protest and point to Pelosi, Schumer, and others who

- 323 obviously conspired to agitate a riot they could use as a pretext to,
- well, to do what they are doing. Holding 700 + political prisoners,
- 325 without bail, without any right to speedy trial, without benefit of a
- 326 trial before a court of law, without the right to counsel they are
- 327 being treated like "terrorists." Get it?
- What's the third thing that marks you as a potential DOMESTIC
- 329 TERRORIST? Kicking back against the government's handling of
- 330 the COVID-19 pandemic so if you are resistant to succumbing
- 331 to the way over the top pressure to take a vaccine that is effectively
- 332 ineffective and UNNCESSARY and you resist the CCP MASK
- 333 MANDATE and effort to isolate Americans from one another,
- 334 carried out by their American puppets, Fauci and friends and if
- you question the election and call out the FRAUD, and point out
- 336 the Dominion machine manipulation of our elections turning
- 337 them into SELECTIONS by the Deep State rather than
- 338 ELECTIONS by the PEOPLE if you are a critical thinker, and
- 339 can see what is OBVIOUS and are willing to SEE what is right in
- 340 front of your face Biden's Admin has MARKED YOU as a
- 341 potential TERRORIST.
- Okay, I'm coming up on my time and I want you to see the context
- 343 in which this "National Strategy for Countering Domestic
- 344 Terrorism" is being implemented.
- 345 Haven't you noticed how many times in the course of a week
- 346 American Patriots concerned about the direction of this country
- 347 and about election integrity, and so on, have you noticed how
- 348 many times during the course of a single week we are called
- 349 WHITE SUPREMACISTS, and TERRORISTS?
- 350 The President himself, in a recent speech, effectively called
- 351 everyone a white supremacist racist that objected to his parties Bill
- 352 crafted to PERMANENTLY TAKE AWAY OUR RIGHT TO
- 353 VOTE by making the illegal activity that took place in 2020 the
- law of the land and a permanent fixture of our elections. He said if

- 355 we disagree with his wicked plan we are on the side of George
- 356 Wallace whose endorsement, by the way, Biden relished not too
- 357 long ago. He said we are on the side of Jefferson Davis against
- 358 Abraham Lincoln when in fact the Jefferson Democrats fought
- 359 to continue slavery —
- 360 This national strategy for dealing with domestic terrorism is
- written at a time when parents who object to CRT and masks in
- 362 their schools are called WHITE SUPREMACISTS and
- 363 TERRORISTS and I mean, officially designated potential
- 364 Terrorists by the Biden DOJ.
- 365 This strategy, and we did not even get into the provisions —
- 366 essentially, they want to take all the provisions in the Patriot Act
- and apply them domestically, to American citizens. And they are
- 368 already doing it 700 plus political prisoners held in DC and
- 369 today the arrest of Stewart Rhodes, leader of Oath Keepers, on
- 370 bogus charges of sedition conspiracy. They have been sitting on
- 371 this since J-6 2021, they have obtained NO NEW EVIDENCE —
- 372 but they run out to make the arrest after they were challenged if
- 373 there was an insurrection, why have there been no arrests —
- 374 POLITICAL.
- 375 It is in this environment, when almost daily someone in MSM is
- 376 calling white conservatives white supremacists, and terrorists. One
- 377 Democrat political pundit recently declared the Republican
- 378 PARTY is a TERRORIST ORGANIZATION. It's Jason something
- or other, sorry, can't take time to run down the name right now.
- 380 But I heard him say it, right in front of GOD and everybody —
- 381 AND INSIST ON IT, THE REPUBLICAN PARTY IS NOT A
- 382 POLITICAL PARTY, IT'S A TERRORIST ORGANIZATION.
- 383 Where is this headed?
- 384 It's obvious! The DS is a cornered black mamba one of the most
- 385 deadly snakes in the world someone will certainly try to make

- something racial out of the choice of black mamba you know
- 387 what, scratch that. The Deep State hydra-headed RED SERPENT is
- 388 cornered and it is RAGING in seething hatred of America and
- friend, this KIND will not GO out peacefully, it won't whimper off,
- 390 it will CAST to the ground, and hiss, and strike the ONE
- 391 WORLDERS have never gotten so close to completing their
- 392 TOWER they will not yield willingly they will try to bring the
- 393 entire country down with them into destruction and chaos —
- 394 But, tune in to my COMFORT AND COUNSEL tomorrow night,
- around 8 pm, on our church Facebook page and learn what we are
- 396 doing to prepare for the coming WAR!
- I have lit the lamps in the Church belfry arch and now you let me

- 400 (essentially, it means you agree with what I'm saying) or you say
- 401 LIGHTS OFF -- which means you reject what I'm saying and
