

# Brain Massage®: Show No. 911 Crises Triage / A "Christian" Evaluation of Trump

1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the  
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain  
3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

4 Crises triage — you know what triage is, right? Many episodes of  
5 MASH began with a triage scene where Hawkeye is seen looking at  
6 a group of incoming wounded to determine which soldiers got  
7 immediate attention and which ones would have to wait, or who  
8 were too far gone to help. Crises triage is when you are  
9 overwhelmed with multiple crises and you have to sort them out  
10 strategically to know which must get your full and immediate  
11 attention. The rules for crises triage are different—so let's think  
12 about what issues require immediate and drastic attention.

13 And while none of us should be surprised that Trump is once again  
14 is trying to navigate his campaign flight through a huge amount of  
15 flak, a significant amount of it coming at him from his own party,  
16 what might surprise some of us is the amount of resistance he is  
17 getting from elements within his own support base. At least some  
18 conservative, God and Country Christian Patriots are joining the  
19 "move on" chorus—here is a biblical assessment Trump that you  
20 will find helpful and intriguing.

21 I think this will cover today's show — but you should know  
22 something about Newsguard and you should begin praying GOD  
23 will expose and explode this spiritual stronghold Satan uses to  
24 choke free speech from the American body politic<sup>1</sup> — Newsguard  
25 is a news censoring organization that targets specific influencers  
26 and seeks to destroy them. You probably never heard of them.

27 They are self-appointed arbiters of truth. Their approach is to  
28 identify organizations that disseminate information that is not  
29 politically correct — in this case meaning, information that does  
30 not line up with the government narrative. But they don't come at  
31 you directly, like YouTube, or Facebook. They attack you  
32 indirectly.

33 Here is an example; JW Player serves Internet new and  
34 information organizations with bandwidth to air their product.  
35 Prager U uses their service. JW Player contacted Prager U and said  
36 the university had one month to remove their content from their  
37 servers. No explanation was offered. When asked why, JW Player  
38 explained they do not do business with organizations labeled by  
39 Newsguard as bad actors spreading misinformation and/or hate  
40 speech.

41 So Prager U looked into Newsguard and contacted them and asked  
42 what did we do wrong. The response was a list of demands. Here is  
43 what you must do if you want to be green-lighted like CNN, and  
44 New York Times — and they provided a list of demands, what will  
45 put you on the naughty or nice list at Newsguard: 1. You can't talk  
46 about the COVID-vaccine. 2. You can't talk against any COVID  
47 lockdowns. 3. You cannot discuss any possible alternate remedy for  
48 COVID. The director of Prager U mentioned there were other  
49 things also, but that essentially, Newsguard set them selves as the  
50 CONTENT CONTROLLER for Prager U. They discovered Prager  
51 U was a non-prof and demanded they reveal their donor list, and  
52 they were told they must reveal who signs off on content. When  
53 asked by what criteria do they decide what is misinformation it  
54 came out and I was not at all surprised, I've been saying this for a  
55 long time — Newsguard said if the information is not endorsed by  
56 WHO, or CDC, or FDA, it's DEEMED FALSE — period! So it's the  
57 old Lenin school of thought control — if you don't hear it from the  
58 government, it's not true! The current president of New Zealand

59 said the quiet part out loud — "if you didn't hear it from the  
60 government, it isn't true." Governments never lie! I mean, what  
61 government would lie that called their controlled media outlet  
62 Pravda — Russian for *the truth*. [Insert laughing squirrel. — that's  
63 a Russian squirrel that lapped up a bit too much vodka. Yeah, this  
64 drunken Russian stumbled and spilled his vodka — I don't think  
65 they do this any more but when I visited back in the early nineties  
66 they rolled out their tanker trucks filled with vodka and the drunks  
67 would line up at the tanker and thump their jugular, holding out  
68 their bottle to be filled with the drug that made communism  
69 bearable to them for another day.]

70 Anyway, I caught that from Prager just a few minutes ago, and I  
71 never heard of Newsguard before — so let's begin praying against  
72 that wicked and unreasonable arm of the Nimrodians.

73 It's time for your brain massage®!

74 [TRUTH]

75 Crises triage! Triage is generally used in a medical context and it is  
76 the "assignment of degrees of urgency to wounds or illnesses to  
77 decide the order of treatment of a large number of patients or  
78 casualties." By extension, it's the "process of determining the most  
79 important people or things from among a large number that  
80 require attention."<sup>2</sup> The triage doctor assigns degrees of urgency to  
81 cases. A crises triage attempts to sort through an array of crises to  
82 determine which are the most urgent and essential. The rules  
83 guiding crises triage are similar but not identical to medical triage.

84 When faced with multiple crises, the temptation is to address the  
85 most immediate, or the one that has the greatest amount of felt  
86 impact on you personally.

87 If you don't stop and think it through, it's easy to find yourself  
88 jumping from one crisis to another almost indiscriminately — just  
89 reacting to the next thing to break into your awareness. It can  
90 become a game of whack-a-mole, which will allow the enemy to  
91 control you and keep you off the real issue.

92 Look how much attention what's her name, the gender confused  
93 basketball player that got "nicked" in Russia for drug smuggling,  
94 and possession of an illegal substance, and finally sentenced to 9  
95 years in a Russian prison. She's LGBTQ, hates America and has  
96 made that sentiment public, and so she is a darling to the Biden  
97 Admin, and the close to 30 million people who voted for him, and  
98 the 15 million that support him, among whom maybe 200,000  
99 actually, I mean truly believe he is doing a good job.

100 I saw a meme: featuring a light bulb and this question: how many  
101 Demoncrats does it take to change a light bulb? Answer: none.  
102 Biden says it's fixed and they all sit in the dark applauding his  
103 achievements. (I'm tellin' ya' folks — this is exactly the sort of joke  
104 they told in Russia between themselves! The only difference, then  
105 they dared not publish it publicly for fear the KGB would be  
106 knocking on your door. But give Biden a chance — man — he is  
107 working on it. Giving the FBI some field practice right now in  
108 preparation...well, you get the idea.)

109 So Biden trades a genuine bad guy — an arms dealer, who earned  
110 the moniker *merchant of death* – the sort of guy that arranges arms  
111 deals for terrorists (of course, Biden makes him look like a piker by  
112 comparison — hah, think this menace to the world ever delivered  
113 an 85 billion dollar arms deal to terrorists? No way! Only Biden  
114 could pull off something like that. (What's that I hear—a group of  
115 Demons applauding in the darkness?)

116 So this Russian dude was caught, tried, convicted and put in prison  
117 — and he is a friend of Putin's, by the way, so Putin demands him  
118 in trade for the LGBTQ gender confused basketball dope

119 smuggling chic — and then immediately attends an anti-gun event  
120 spouting about what he is going to do to take guns away from  
121 Americans — hmmm. Maybe the plan is Biden takes American's  
122 guns from them and he and — what's the guys name? — the arms  
123 dealer called the MERCANT OF DEATH? — So maybe Hunter  
124 will reach out to him and they'll work out a deal with 10% kick  
125 back for "the big guy." You didn't think Biden made that deal for

129 Now all the news is agog at this, and, understandably, the

131 Biden has ignored the cries of the family of American Marine Paul  
132 Whelan, who, while visiting Russia for a friend's wedding, was  
133 taken hostage in Russia four years ago on false charges of  
134 espionage.

135 So, leave the Marine, give me the dope smuggling ball player and  
136 I'll give you Putin's buddy, the merchant of death — and oh, by the  
137 way, I need to be at an anti-guns for American's rally — cause I'm  
138 very concerned about all these guns being held by Americans.

139 And all of this is to say, yep, I totally get it! How can you ignore  
140 such a story, pregnant with so much meaning and importance —  
141 makes the 2020 theft of the election, and the defiling of the sacred  
142 right of consent in our representative government seem like  
143 something that occurred, I don't know, on another planet or  
144 something; "old news" — almost as "old" as Hunter's Laptop, and  
145 far easier to digest and fume over than the amount of outrage  
146 demanded by things like James Baker, "EX" FBI agent planted in  
147 Twitter, back in the day, uh, BE — before Elon — who was a direct  
148 contact between FBI and Twitter in the collusion between Biden's  
149 campaign and Twitter to CONTROL THE NARRATIVE — to  
150 bury the Hunter Biden story, and inflame Trump's reluctance to

151 give up his tax records, which, and here is another media favorite,  
152 has shown Trump's financial controllers actually — GASP! — *holy*  
153 *gas lighting Batman* — I hope you can process this, especially if you  
154 are a Trump supporter — they actually read the IRS law, saw a way  
155 to provide some benefit to their executive employees without  
156 incurring a tax burden and — uh oh! I'm almost afraid to say it. So,  
157 look, Trump supporters, get a bag to breathe in just in case you  
158 panic and start hyperventilating — I usually have to give that  
159 advice to demoncrats listening to the Brain Masseur — but, today,  
160 I'm afraid my fellow Trump supporters might need to prepare —  
161 Trump's accountants actually used the tax code, and "conspired" —  
162 I mean, they discussed this, it's like they said, hey, according to this  
163 provision in the tax code, if we structure their package this way, we

166 You see, these are the stories we need to focus on! Right? Wrong.  
167 We need to do crises triage daily — stay focused on the REAL  
168 STORY. Demoncrats have stolen our country from us and we need  
169 to stay laser focused on getting it back. NOTHING IS MORE  
170 IMPORTANT THAN CORRECTING THE 2020 STEAL. Every  
171 Republican who pretends we can just "move on" from that is  
172 exposed as part of the uniparty that has stolen the RIGHT OF THE  
173 PEOPLE'S CONSENT IN GOVERNMENT — so long as they get  
174 away with stealing the presidency from Trump and not the  
175 governorship from Kari, AMERICA IS IN HOSTAGE TO A PACK  
176 OF DUPLICITIOUS TRAITORS.

177 I get it, it's impossible to ignore these moles that pop their head up  
178 and the temptation to go after them is very hard to resist—I just  
179 spent my entire first segment dealing it! But let's you and me keep  
180 our eye on the ball — we win or lose entirely on one question — do  
181 the American people actually have a voice in our elections? What

182 happened in 2020 clearly says no! And what happened in 2022  
183 clearly says it's STILL NO!

184 We must RESTORE THE PEOPLE RIGHT TO ELECT OUR  
185 REPRESENTATIVES IT IS THE ONLY WAY TO KEEP THEM  
186 ACCOUNTABLE TO THE PEOPLE. AND WE MUST RESTORE  
187 THE RIGHT TO EXERCISE OUR RIGHT OF CONSENT FULLY  
188 INFORMED. We must demand FULLY INFORMED CONSENT  
189 in our elections!

190 Hold on through the break; I'll be right back!

191 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
192 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
193 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
194 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
195 liberty.

196 A "Christian" evaluation of Trump! I discussed this last night on  
197 my Comfort & Counsel for the Present Distress — No. 562. You  
198 can view it on the Lighthouse Baptist Church Facebook page and  
199 you don't have to have a Facebook account to view it.

200 We expected the Looney left to start firing their flak at airship  
201 Trump - 2024. And we knew the deep state embedded RINOs  
202 would join them—McConnell, Cheney, Paul Ryan, Mitch, and the  
203 rest of that 12 pack of traitors that joined the demented dems to  
204 repeal DOMA and replace it with a bill that contradicts a social  
205 construct that has endured thousands of years, and upend the  
206 meaning of marriage, and create a law that will certainly be used to  
207 make criminals of conscience among believers by forcing them to,  
208 for one example, perform weddings for homosexual unions  
209 contrary to their religious convictions.

210 But I am surprised at the number of Christian conservatives who  
211 are turning their flak on Trump and joining in the piling on this  
212 man has had to endure ever since he take that fateful ride down his

213 elevator, or was it an escalator? So I thought I should at least begin  
214 to address where I stand on this issue.

215 The first thing we have to contend with is the knee jerk response  
216 from some that if you support Trump, as a Christian, then you are  
217 among the deluded brain dead bobble heads that Trump spoke of  
218 when he said something to the effect that he could kill someone  
219 and his base would continue supporting him. I chose this one  
220 because it provides a perfect example of exactly the sort of thing I  
221 object to in Trump and in his detractors too. It's a two-fer.

222 So let's begin there. That was a politically dumb thing to say! I  
223 don't have the proximity to the President to ask whether it was  
224 something he actually believes—it did come from his mouth, and  
225 Jesus told us to pay attention because what comes from the mouth  
226 originates in the heart! However, it's not always the case that when  
227 a statement is traced to the heart you will find arrogance at the  
228 source; you might find cynical amusement—which might be as  
229 bad! Yeah, dumb thing to say! But it might not have been  
230 something he encourages, only something he reflected on with  
231 some hyperbole. On the other hand, like I said, I don't have the  
232 proximity to him to ascertain either way.

233 But, either way — as offensive, and likely insulting as that is to his  
234 followers — whatever it says to me about Trump as a man, does  
235 not begin to rise to the level of what Biden's actions as a man, and  
236 as a politician reveals about the nasty devils that maneuver in and  
237 through that man.

238 So, am I a relativist! In other words, does Biden's out right evil  
239 character outweigh the apparent arrogance of Trump? Biden's out  
240 right evil character makes no difference at all in Trump's apparent  
241 arrogance. Trump's arrogance remains in tact! It is not a bit  
242 diminished by Biden's hellish character.



243 You see, I can vote for an arrogant man. But I cannot vote for  
244 Satan. I'm not saying I know Trump to be arrogant! I know he says  
245 many things that would make him appear so! He once said he had  
246 never asked for forgiveness. And the question was answered in a  
247 religious context. I hope he has since repented of that ridiculous  
248 notion and humbled himself to Christ as LORD, and there have  
249 been many indications that he has humbled himself to the  
250 LORDSHIP of CHRIST! He has publicly referred to his own  
251 subordination to KING JESUS, more than once. In fact, I've never  
252 in my life heard a political figure in America speak so directly to  
253 his personal acknowledgement of CHRIST JESUS' lordship as  
254 Trump has, in personal statements, and in public declarations, as  
255 in his Easter declarations, and Christmas statements.

256 His record of defense of religious liberty is out there for anyone to  
257 see.

258 But he does challenge Christians who are sensitive to cultural  
259 expressions of pride, carnality, pragmatism, and these are things  
260 that really trouble me—to be sure.

261 But I hope I can differentiate between these carnal weaknesses, and  
262 the weightier matters of the LAW. I plan to do a series of these, and  
263 I fully expect any who wishes to do so will engage me with counter  
264 arguments — I really want to have this discussion! Seriously — and  
265 we need to have it now. But let me leave you with this to think  
266 about for now.

267 Listen carefully to how Jesus differentiated between good things,  
268 important things, from the CRITICAL THINGS, what He called  
269 the weightier matters of the Law: "Woe unto you, scribes and  
270 Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and  
271 cummin, and have **omitted the weightier matters of the law,**  
272 judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not  
273 to leave the other undone.

274 He further described these types that get focused so intensely on  
275 important matters, to be sure, but to the point they forget the  
276 weightier issues, the things that matter most to GOD:

277 "Ye blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel"  
278 (Matthew 23:24).

279 Sometimes I would read a Trump Tweet and cringe — Oh boy,  
280 that's going to give our enemies a stick to beat us with. And so a  
281 Trump supporter walks through the gauntlet of Pharisees piling  
282 on, beating them up with the latest zinger from the master zinger-  
283 in-chief. Many of us, like my wife, just totally enjoyed it — but, of  
284 course, she did marry the Brain Masseur® so she has a taste for  
285 succulent sagacity flavored by a touch of spicy sarcasm, and a flare  
286 for insightful satire. Haha!

287 But some of the things go past that, like what I mentioned earlier.  
288 When he made fun of the paraplegic, sorry, I can't truck with that.  
289 Or when he uses foul language — yeah, not "presidential," in my  
290 book.

291 But if you pile these things in the "scales" — the offenses, the carnal  
292 snipes, the apparent boasting — which when taken in context, I  
293 think I could provide significant mitigation against most objections  
294 — in the manner we usually do for friends, and family, and  
295 champions for our cause — oh yes, we do give some room for the  
296 peccadillos of our heroes. So pile them up on side of the scales and  
297 then on the other side, let's consider the WEIGHTIER matters of  
298 the law — like the fact that Trump told the TRUTH whether or not  
299 it was popular, and he kept every single PROMISE he made to the  
300 voters, and the promises he made were righteous, just, and, yes,  
301 MERCIFUL — put on the side of the weightier matters the fact that  
302 unlike any president before him, he promised and delivered on  
303 placing our embassy in Jerusalem, recognizing Israel's historic  
304 claim on that great city, and negotiated what is absolutely the most  
305 amazing peace deal ever for the Middle East — ever! He made

306 America great again — and foreign powers actually respected even  
307 if they hated him. Contrast that to what we have with Biden. In  
308 terms of social graces, well, beside the bumbling, poor old uncle Joe  
309 act, we can legitimately say he never wrote a mean Tweet — he  
310 called well over half of the American population terrorists in a  
311 Naziesque manner, he — do I need to go on here? I'm out of time,  
312 but really — Biden is a plagiarist, a thief, a traitor to this country,  
313 he has used political office for personal emoluments violating the  
314 Constitution — I mean, come on man!

315 The weightier matters of the LAW so far outweigh the paying of  
316 tithes—something we all consider important, in fact Jesus said,  
317 these things ought ye to have done — but THE WEIGHTIER  
318 MATTERS matter most — so I'll pray Trump becomes more  
319 sensitive to the sensitivities of his Christian supporters, but more  
320 importantly, I pray he will keep on being SUBSTANTIAL on the  
321 things that MATTER MOST — he tells the TRUTH, and DOES  
322 WHAT IS TRULY RIGHT FOR THE AMERICAN PEOPLE and  
323 he is an AMERICAN, and not a COMMUNIST! He is independent  
324 from the SWAMP...well, I'll stop there; Okay ...
