1 Segment.01 Hello. I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor of the  
2 Lighthouse Baptist Church in Santa Maria, CA—and your brain  
3 masseur—get ready for your brain massage.

4 Meaningful Memorial Day—it's tough to say "happy Memorial  
5 Day," unless we are focusing on the liberties secured by the  
6 sacrifice paid it! Today we must resolve to make whatever sacrifice  
7 is needed to preserve what our brave soldiers sacrificed all to  
8 procure. Let's remember!

9 My Apologies—I believe Trump is the legitimate President now  
10 and has been displaced by a coup. Furthermore, I believe there is  
11 an ongoing attempt to bury him in exile. I intend to vote for him in  
12 2024. So, let's talk about the botched DeSatan announcement.

13 A note on the Rhetoric Wars — WOKE is not woke, it's a JOKE.  
14 But "they" craft their lies in deceitful language. Cleverly, you are  
15 positioned so that to oppose to have to say you are "not woke." This  
16 is intended to be a confession that you're asleep, not awake to  
17 reality, asleep in a dream — when the exact opposite is the truth.  
18 The "wokies" are the ones that are sleep walking—living in a dream  
19 world of fantasy — totally disconnected with reality, obnoxious to  
20 nature and an abomination to nature's GOD. Wokies are at war  
21 with nature.

22 Okay, my friends! It's time for your Brain Massage®.

23 [TRUTH]

24 This Memorial Day celebration is overcast by a dark cloud of  
25 menacing enemies crossing our borders with intelligence  
26 suggesting some real terrorists are crossing and preparing to  
27 launch a series of devastating attacks. Storm clouds are certainly  
28 gathering. And we know the only thing that will turn this around is

29 when the American people stand up to these bullies and push back  
30 — take our RIGHT OF CONSENT back into our power, and put  
31 people in positions of authority who will represent AMERICA, and  
32 AMERICANS. So, while we work on getting rid of the machines,  
33 blocking the Deep State voter fraud machine, we still have to fight  
34 the battle over which candidate shall we place in the Oval Office.

35 In view of the DeSantis announcement that he is running for  
36 President, I am compelled to offer my apology for rejecting  
37 DeSantis and supporting Trump.

38 My Apologies: Apology for what?

39 When you hear the word *apology* you probably think of someone  
40 saying *I'm sorry*. Dictionaries usually provide meanings that reflect  
41 current usage, and today, that would be the first meaning.

42 My laptop onboard dictionary shows 1. a regretful  
43 acknowledgment of an offense or failure; 2. *an apology for* indicates  
44 something that is an inadequate example of; and then 3. a reasoned  
45 argument or writing in justification of something.

46 The usage of this word today is the opposite of how the word was  
47 used back in the 1800s.

48 In Webster's 1828 nothing is said about asking forgiveness, or  
49 expressing remorse for a wrong of offense. It's entirely about  
50 providing an explanation supporting or attacking a position or an  
51 action.

52 However, by the 1913 edition of Webster's, while the meaning  
53 given to the word in 1828 appears first, the secondary meaning is  
54 an acknowledgment intended as atonement for some improper or  
55 injurious remark or act.

56 So the way the word is used today was no part of the meaning in  
57 Webster's 1828 and before, but was introduced about 100 years  
58 later, in Webster's 1913, when this new meaning was introduced as

59 the second. But today, it's upside down, like everything else. The  
60 first meaning of *apology* today is about admission of guilt for  
61 something.

62 So, first off, when I say my apologies for supporting Trump, I don't  
63 mean *I'm sorry*. Instead, I mean to explain, to provide arguments  
64 supporting my support.

65 I am a theologian! My doctorate is in Theological Studies. My  
66 background includes extensive research in Contemporary  
67 Theology, and Apologetics—Apologetics is the work of examining  
68 theological beliefs and systems of beliefs to expose error, and  
69 convince of the truth. So an *apology* provides arguments not only  
70 intended to explain a position, but also to prove, and thereby to  
71 convince others, or to persuade them to embrace that position.

72 Why do I need to provide an apology for supporting Trump? My  
73 apology is not directed at the wokies. They are welcome to examine  
74 my apology, and it would be very agreeable if any were convinced  
75 by my arguments to vote for Trump. Neither is my apology  
76 directed at the RINO never Trumpers. Those people want to  
77 preserve the status quo (wars, corporate welfare, and there is no  
78 argument that will dissuade them from their course. But I do hope  
79 to knock the props from under the disingenuous, pretentious  
80 arguments they use to dissuade Christian patriots from supporting  
81 Trump, including their effort to present an alternative in DeSantis,  
82 the latest Trump wannabe.

83 I'm going to frankly address what I believe are Trump's negatives,  
84 some areas where I strongly disagree with him, and offer an  
85 apologetic explaining why my preferential decision to support him  
86 is not inconsistent with Christian precept or principle, but in fact,  
87 perfectly consistent. And why for any God fearing patriot to fail to  
88 support Trump is in fact inconsistent with the values we cherish as  
89 Christians.

90 Let's get started.

91 First, Trump's position on homosexuality is not in conformity with  
92 what the Bible says on this subject. Trump appointed the first  
93 openly queer man to a Cabinet position in his administration,  
94 Richard Grennell, and two openly queer federal court appointees;<sup>1</sup>  
95 and has made repeated statements that he is okay with people with  
96 same-sex preference. In 2019, he launched a campaign to "end the  
97 criminalization of homosexuality."<sup>2</sup> The Trump campaign hosted a  
98 "Trump pride" event in Minnesota in October of his 2016  
99 campaign.<sup>3</sup>

100 Before becoming President, Trump supported including sexual  
101 orientation in the Civil Rights Act of 1964. However, in 2015,  
102 during his campaign, he told Jake Tapper that he is "just for  
103 traditional marriage." [IBID] But then, as President, he resisted  
104 extending special work place protections to the queer community.  
105 In fact, his justice department argued before the SCOTUS that the  
106 Civil Rights Act of 1964 "doesn't include sexual orientation or  
107 gender identity."<sup>4</sup> That was a reversal of his position before  
108 becoming President. While on the issue of gay marriage, about one  
109 year later, he said the nationwide legality of same-sex marriage is  
110 "settled," and said he was "fine" with the SCOTUS decision to  
111 legalize queer marriage. [IBID] Pictures of the TRUMP PRIDE  
112 event, and of Trump holding an LGBT for TRUMP flag were  
113 galling, and disappointing.

114 And yet, during his administration, Trump refused to relax  
115 prohibitions against trans men and women in the military. He did

116 not support religious discrimination against Christians who  
117 refused to accommodate homosexual marriage, and opposed  
118 activists advocating for requiring churches to hire queers, or to  
119 teach the queer agenda in our public schools.

120 There are other inconsistencies too. For example, he advocated for  
121 the overturning of *Roe v Wade*, but when it came to questions  
122 about whether he would advocate to overturn the SCOTUS  
123 decisions to legalize queer marriage, he said, "it's irrelevant,"  
124 because it's "settled law." [IBID] Wasn't *Roe* "settled law"? Isn't that  
125 what the Democrats were howling as Trump used his SCOTUS  
126 appointment opportunities to place pro-life sympathizers on the  
127 court? But his position on abortion is not my focus right now—  
128 although, his position on that matter does not line up with biblical  
129 precept and principle, as we'll see in a future show.

130 Trump's position seems to be a version of live-and-let-live. He does  
131 not want government involvement in the issue, but I think Trump  
132 has a blind spot here, and it is concerning!

133 Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor  
134 at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern  
135 lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the  
136 enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our  
137 liberty.

138 I've already spoken to my concerns about DeSantis, and will again!  
139 But right now I'm concentrating on the questions that come up  
140 regarding Trump — questions that trouble Bible believing  
141 Christians, such as moi. I plan to look at objections raised by  
142 Christians against supporting Trump. I'll address them all, but I'm  
143 going to go straight for the ones that are most concerning and that  
144 have real substance. The first of those, and probably the most  
145 troubling, is Trump's endorsement of, and support for the  
146 homosexual, or queer lifestyle. I laid out the case supporting that

147 allegation in part one, and I don't have time to recap that. Right  
148 now, I want to state my objection to his position on this matter.

149 The behavior is unnatural, unseemly, and unhealthy. In other  
150 words, I believe what the Bible says about this behavior. In Romans  
151 1:27, you can see it right there. The SPIRIT of GOD was sent to  
152 REPROVE THE WORLD. Let me explain. To *reprove* means to  
153 admonish (officially rebuke), confute (to prove wrong), to convict  
154 — meaning to declare "guilty" — to EXPOSE a FAULT — Jesus  
155 sent HIS SPIRIT, the SPIRIT OF CHRIST, into the world to  
156 REPROVE it of sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:7-8)—

157 Here, in Romans 1:26-27, we read a clear statement from the  
158 SPIRIT on the issue of homosexuality.

159 First, it is unnatural: verse 26: "even their women did change the  
160 **natural** use into that which is against nature: and likewise also the  
161 men, leaving the **natural** use of the woman, burned in their lust  
162 one toward another."

163 Second, it is unseemly: the SPIRIT says these "men with men" are  
164 "working that which is unseemly" (Romans 1:27).

165 Homosexual behavior is unseemly: means that according to the  
166 BIBLE, the behavior is indecent, shameful, inelegant, or uncomely.  
167 Want proof? I've got a lot of it. I added these documents to my post  
168 for this show. Here, read this *Fistgate report*.<sup>5</sup> See *Statistics on*  
169 *Homosexuals*.<sup>6</sup>

170 Then the SPIRIT says the behavior is unhealthy: those practicing  
171 this behavior receive in themselves "that recompense of their error  
172 which was meet." The word *meet* here refers to something fitting or  
173 appropriate. The recompense refers to the consequence of their  
174 behavior.

175 Look at the horrible health risks involved in this unnatural and  
 176 unseemly behavior: See *Homosexual Behavior a National Public*  
 177 *Health Issue*.<sup>7</sup> See *Homosexual's Unhealthy Lifestyle*.<sup>8</sup> See also  
 178 *Negative Impacts of Homosexual Behavior*.<sup>9</sup> And see this article  
 179 titled *On The Unhealthy Homosexual Lifestyle*.<sup>10</sup> In summary, the  
 180 fact is queer behavior reduces life expectancy in active homosexual  
 181 males by nearly 50% when compared with those who live in  
 182 conformity to nature.

183 To champion such a lifestyle among our young people is to  
 184 encourage a death sentence. Queer teens are "more than four times  
 185 as likely to attempt suicide than their peers."<sup>11</sup> "Research has shown  
 186 that, when examined as a group, adults who identify as lesbian, gay,  
 187 or bisexual have higher rates of suicidal thoughts and attempts  
 188 relative to heterosexual adults."<sup>12</sup>

189 The Bible says we can learn from nature.<sup>13</sup> Any reasonable mind  
 190 contemplating what nature itself teaches can see this behavior is an  
 191 aberration; it is contrary to, that is, it is against nature.

192 It is also unseemly — the natural sensibilities recoil with revulsion  
 193 when they are exposed to revelations of the sorts of bizarre  
 194 behaviors associated with this sin. The behaviors engaged by those  
 195 practicing this lifestyle are shocking and disgusting to those whose  
 196 conscience has not been seared, and whose affections remain  
 197 natural. The SPIRIT said, "it is a shame even to speak of those  
 198 things which are done of them in secret" (Ephesians 5:12).

199 And medical science has shown repeatedly, by many studies, it is a  
200 deadly lifestyle.

201 On top of all of that, the behavior is an abomination to GOD—an  
202 insult to His gift to man of the imago dei (ehmago - day) — image  
203 of GOD.

204 Promoting this behavior in our society is unconscionable —  
205 intolerable to a reasonable mind, and inhumane. While I think  
206 Trump would argue he does not intend to encourage the behavior  
207 or endorse it, I think every reasonable mind would agree that by  
208 his enthusiasm for their support, and repeated statements of his  
209 support for them, what you have is tacit approval, or at the very  
210 least, acceptance of this unnatural, unseemly, and unhealthy  
211 lifestyle.

212 So, how can I support Trump for President when I disagree with  
213 him so completely on his support of homosexuality?

214 First, let me say that if anything has developed that could actually  
215 begin to erode Trump's support base it's the explosion of LGBTQ  
216 gender insanity. Trump must come forward and clearly  
217 differentiate himself from this. The second thing that is developing  
218 that could impact Trump's support is the revelations regarding the  
219 vaccines. If it comes out that these vaccines he supported and  
220 endorsed are in fact killing people — we received another report of  
221 one of the employees of a members business died suddenly — as  
222 reports like this continue, and more and more pressure builds  
223 against the wall of silence that has been artificially constructed  
224 around this — the latest that Pfizer in coordination with FDA and  
225 CDC conspired to hide from the public the truth about the dangers  
226 associated with their vaccine — I know, we already knew that, but  
227 what I'm saying is everyone else is about to find out about this —

228 The good news is that Trump has revealed a plan to "ban gender-  
229 affirming care for minors." He makes it simple: "The leftwing



230 gender insanity being pushed at our children is an act of child  
231 abuse — very simple!"<sup>14</sup> And he goes on from there to declare his  
232 position on this matter. So, first off, Trump is not in for all the  
233 nonsense that has exploded on us since Biden rolled into DC. He is  
234 soft on adults, who choose this aberrant behavior, but he is clear on  
235 the pronoun nonsense and especially on the gender transitioning  
236 that is being pushed on our children.

237 He fails to see the connection between opening society up to  
238 homosexuality and this recent free fall into sexual dystopia — but  
239 he does draw the line at accepting homosexuals into the  
240 mainstream of our culture.

241 Second, Trump, as I pointed out earlier, has never endorsed the  
242 radical homosexual agenda to teach this gender nonsense to our  
243 children, or create laws imposing their agenda on Christians, and  
244 so on.

245 Third, none of those running for President have a better position  
246 than Trump on this subject.

247 Fourth, no other candidate, no other President, has made a more  
248 clear statement of Christian faith. Now, what I'm talking about are  
249 his Christmas and Easter messages while he was President. No  
250 other president in recent history has been more open with their  
251 declarations of subordination to Christ Jesus.

252 He is wrong to express acceptance of the sin of homosexuality—so  
253 are DeSantis, and every other conservative politician today. And  
254 the longer this craziness continues, and the harder "they" push this  
255 gender dystopia program, the more pressure is going to rise against  
256 homosexuality generally. Trump has never failed to stand with us  
257 against encroachments of our rights in this and all regards — and I  
258 hope he will wake up and see the truth about the roots of the

259 current breakdown of social order and understand how much  
260 embracing homosexuality has and continues to contribute to it.

261 But because I know he will not abandon us to the raging of the  
262 Sodomites, I can support him. Even though on this matter, that is  
263 on his personal opinion about the sin of homosexuality, I disagree  
264 with him — he thinks what someone does in the privacy of their  
265 intimate life is their own business — well, to an extent, I agree.  
266 However, to go public with acceptance implies approval of a  
267 behavior that is against nature, against decency, and against public  
268 health.

269 Finally, we Christians know GOD has chosen some unsavory men  
270 to lead His people against His enemies. We don't refuse, for  
271 example, to accept the Proverbs though penned by a man who  
272 turned completely away from GOD and served the idols of his  
273 wives—Solomon! We don't take Jehudi's pen knife through the  
274 Psalms and cut out all attributed to David, and we don't discount  
275 the victory God gave Gideon although he established that stupid  
276 Ephod, and we understand GOD choose less than savory Samson  
277 to bring the house down on his enemies—the Philistines.

278 So, this Memorial Day, I suggest you consider that of all the rights  
279 our soldiers fought and died to protect, the right to CHOOSE OUR  
280 LEADERS is on top of the list — and we must stand up and take  
281 our RIGHT OF CONSENT back from these wicked usurpers, and  
282 then use that RIGHT OF CONSENT wisely — to choose the  
283 candidate that has already proved himself, already been tested in  
284 the crucible of fire, who EARNED our support — Listen, I feel very  
285 strongly that Trump is the right man for the job right now for  
286 many reasons — but added to that, it would be a horrible injustice  
287 if these wicked, filthy, good for nothing traitors succeed at taking  
288 our right of consent away from us — we voted Trump in on 2020  
289 and what these wicked people did, Biden, Hillary, Obama,  
290 Zuckerberg, Dorsey at Twitter, Google's YouTUBE, the CIA, the

291 FBI, all the DOJ, even the DOD got their hands in it — THE DEEP  
292 STATE ON BEHALF OF THE CCP AND GLOBALISTS
