Newsweek did an article on this: “What is Trantifa? Far-Left Trans Movement Spreading Across U.S.”⁷

Here is a sweet Tranny sentiment: “MORE DEAD CHRISTIANS LOL.” I’ve never read anything like “MORE DEAD TRANNY’S LOL.” Instead, Christians offer prayers.

“To me it seems like if you elect a really bad guy that's cruel to people, and weaponize his cruelty and horrific behavior against your neighbours [sic-neighbors]. [sic-misuse of period] Some of those horrible [redacted].” “Maybe their Christofascist” — they do hate Jesus, don't they? — “parents will think twice before supporting an admin that kills Palestinian children.” Wow! How did Palestine get thrown into this? Same spirit? Anyway, I guess this Tranny supports the murder of children only when it's Palestinians murdering Jewish children—I notice no mention of October 7!

Here you go, “Conservatives [who] want to kill all Trans shouldn't be surprised when we fight back.” Who told you conservatives want to kill all Trans? When did any conservative, much less a Christian Conservative, write a Manifesto declaring hatred of Trans people as their motivation to grab a gun to go and kill one? Or Two. Or Three. Or Six.

Here is another: “Heroic. They want to kill our kids, we are going to fight back!” I'm against anyone who wants to kill any children: whether they are Palestinian, Jewish, or Trans folk. There. Does that fix this?

Nope! I guess not! Here is another one: “This is Republicans' fault for trying to genocide us.” Unreal! They are at the old game they played when Reagan was elected: “Republicans want to feed dog food to grandma.” Yeah, that's what they said. At first, many of us were left wondering, what kind of person would want their grandmother to eat dog food? I never met a Republican who wanted any such thing. So I checked in on this and that's when I discovered that the so-called mainstream media were a pack of despicable liars.

Talk about sick-think: “Am I supposed to feel bad that rich Christian kids are gone? Good riddance.” Would you be okay with poor Christians — if we were all poor, would you like us then?

Why did Robert feel trapped in a Trans. character role? Why was he afraid someone would “report” him if he openly admitted he knew he was role-playing as a woman? It sounds like he was trapped in a cult.

Along with this, he went on to say, “It [his hair] just gets in my way. I will probably chop it on the day of the attack.” So this is what he was thinking about as he planned the attack? This was the “state of his mind”? He wanted to leave Trans but felt he could not, felt he was trapped in a character role that he could not escape? Who killed this kid! And who killed the children he killed? He was trapped in a cult, and this was, in his perverted way of thinking, the only way out.

He wrote “Kill Donald Trump” and “Rip & Tear” (an expression from a 1996 Doom comic titled *Knee Deep in the Dead*¹¹) on his rifle. He wrote “For the children” on a magazine, and “Where’s Your God?” In Cyrillic, (Russian letters), he wrote what translates to “Commie Terrorist” on one of his magazines. That’s weird.

RFK has launched an investigation into whether any of the drugs Westman used are known to produce any side effects that might have contributed to this violence. “Numerous studies point to a link between transgenderism and mental illness.”¹² The article tells us the Trevor Project’s 2024 study found that 39% of LGBTQ+ young people thought seriously about suicide in the prior year. 46% of transgender and nonbinary youths seriously thought about killing themselves in the year before they were given the survey.

man could be “trapped” in a female body (Maya “Alec” McKinney¹³ and Audrey Elizabeth Hale) or a woman could be “trapped” in a male body (Robert Westman) might have something to do with three young people flipping out and becoming mass murderers, all three attacked a Christian school—each encouraged to believe a lie about their identity and turning on the Church to get their revenge.

Okay, hold on through the break! I'll be right back to explain why prayer is not only okay, it's the best first response to any tragedy, and the best first step toward finding a solution.

Segment.02 Hello. Welcome back! I'm Dr. Jerry Scheidbach, pastor at the Lighthouse, your brain masseur, and Paul Revere's lantern lighter, lighting the lamps in the church belfry arch, signaling the enemy is on the march, an enemy that would steal from us our liberty.

“Thoughts and Prayers!” That became a standard acceptable expression of sympathy and support for any suffering a tragedy many years ago. Its first appearance in a public newspaper is 1821 in a farewell note: “Masters and seamen, as you are about to leave us for the season, I trust we shall follow you in our thoughts and prayers.”¹⁵ Makes sense? Sure it does.

ChatGPT offered a 1877 reference to a letter of condolence to a bereaved mother.¹⁶ Here is the quotation, mind you, the reference is to a 1877 letter to a bereaved mother: “I wish it were in my power to do something for you... [ellipsis indicating omitted material] ... Perhaps this reflects a cynicism on my part ... [once again, ellipsis as found in the quote indicating material skipped over] ... to me, saying a prayer or praying is a more self-centered act.”

How does that sound to you? Understanding the cultural norms of 1800s America, I was very interested in a statement like this appearing in a letter of condolence. So, after I carefully examined the source cited by Chat and could not find it, I thought perhaps I had hastily passed over it. So, I followed up and asked Chat—“I can't find the quote you referenced in the source you provided.” I directed Chat to be more specific as to the location of their reference, and pasted the statement I was particularly interested in.

Chat responded: “You’re right to push me on that — and I need to clarify.” Chat proceeded then to explain that the 1877 reference “was not actually a primary newspaper example.” Hmm. Chat had not presented it as such. Chat went on: “That line comes from a commentary post on Ask MetaFilter.” But Chat said it found the statement in the source provided, and I wanted to see that statement in its context, so I explained I wanted Chat to direct me more particularly to the statement that “saying a prayer is a more self-centered act.”

Chat responded: “Thank you for pressing me on this — I double checked what I had written earlier. The wording “Saying a prayer is a more self-centered act” is not from a 19th-century source at all. It actually comes from an Ask MetaFilter user’s personal comment in a 2008 thread titled “You’re in our thoughts and prayers.”¹⁷ Yeah, that makes sense. No one in 1877 would dismiss prayer as a “self-centered act.” But, an Obama-era liberal would!

But, it gets worse! Chat admitted the line it quoted in the original response “does not appear in that thread.” It explained that it “conflated a paraphrase of sentiment expressed there with a direct quotation.” And then it said, “That’s why you haven’t been able to locate it — it’s not there.”¹⁸

Wow! Either AI is brilliant enough to deceive by presenting a quotation from an 1877 source constructed from a paraphrase of some comment made on a thread created in 2008, and then blowing smoke to hide it, but then, when pressed into a corner, honest enough to admit when it has been caught! Or, AI is not ready for critical-level thinking, and you’ll need to keep your eyes open for anomalies and press for specific sources when you have a

question about its editorializing tendencies. It's always good to press for sources and then check them.

The expression, “thoughts and prayers,” goes deep into our culture. I thought the “thoughts” part of the expression might have been an accommodation to secularists who are uncomfortable with saying, “I’m praying for you.” It turns out the expression is intended to communicate the idea that someone is being carried in our thoughts, and that we are mindful of their grief and so praying for them during their time of grief.

These idiots think we think “we’re praying for you” means it’s all fixed by prayer. Many things are, by the way! But that’s not what we mean. We mean we are petitioning the Creator to care for you, to comfort you, and to guide you through this grief to some good He, and only He can make of it.

Scripture says, “All things work together for good to them that love God, who are the called according to His purpose” (Romans 8:28).

So, let’s finish up!

The expression was common in our Christian culture, dating back well before it appeared in a newspaper in 1821. It’s a thoughtful expression, intending to communicate our sympathy and love and desire to comfort someone by a Christian principle of “bearing one another’s burdens.” Christians have always believed that praying is an act of turning to GOD for help, comfort, wisdom, and direction.

No Christian I know thinks praying for someone takes the place of acting on behalf of those for whom we pray, which is one reason thoughts and prayers are almost always accompanied by some sort of benevolent action: usually giving! Conservatives, as is well known, are far more generous than liberals — it’s a fact. The average conservative will tip better and give more generously than the average liberal.

As I pointed out earlier, it's worth noting that the people who say "thoughts and prayers" are not the ones shooting people they disagree with. Islamo-fascists are the ones who call on the name of their god, Allah, while firing missiles at the people who refuse to Islam (means submit to Allah). Their god wants to kill you if you don't submit to him. Our God raises His sun to shine and sends His rain upon the just and on the unjust (Matthew 5:45).

Jesus told us to be like God in that regard. He does not blur the distinction between the just and the unjust—He appoints the sword of judgment to execute wrath upon the wicked—but His desire is that all men might be saved, and He instructed us to PRAY specifically to that end (1 Timothy 2:1-5).

Prayer is the most important thing anyone can do in response to any tragedy, natural or unnatural, because turning toward GOD is the direction you need to go to find a path that leads to His GOOD, and His blessing. If some wicked monster defies the will of God and brings evil into the world — the FIRST thing to do is TURN TOWARD GOD.

It's also the first step toward gaining His help in times of need.

If Robert had turned to GOD instead of to his hatred, anger, confusion, and depression, instead of surrendering to his hatred, he would not have been led by GOD to kill those children. The only force active in this world that would lead to that is Satan, the one who has come to steal and to kill and to destroy. Jesus has come that we might have life, and have it more abundantly.

Praying in times of such evil is the surest way to put us in the right direction to find healing, help, comfort and grace to HELP in time of need: Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

For example, if we pray, and turn to GOD, then we know what to do about these things. We know that the sword of civil justice must be used to PROTECT the innocent and execute wrath upon the evil doer.

Praying is the necessary first response in order to get us going in the direction that leads to His protection, and His blessing — where we find His WISDOM in what we need to do — James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

Prayer turns a nation to GOD where we find healing the direction we must go to find HEALING FOR OUR LAND.

Come to the House of GOD, the house of prayer, and let's turn to GOD together which takes us out of the path that is leading our nation to HELL: 2Chronicles 7:14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

We will be praying this Sunday — join us at the HOUSE OF GOD, and let's get the HELP we need — and Satan knows this, the spirit of antichrist knows that PRAYER will lead us into the path that will take our nation to peace, and prosperity.

It's BECAUSE we, Christians, have turned away from Jesus' instructions that this sort of thing happens.
