Constitution Day! (September 17, 1787—The Constitution was signed by the Constitutional Convention, presided over by George Washington, then president of the Convention, gathered in Philadelphia, at Independence Hall.

They began in May, and after four months of wrangling and debate, the new U.S. Constitution was approved. It was sent to the Confederate Congress assembled three days later, in New York, and after eight days of debate, on September 28, 1787, it was unanimously accepted and transmitted to the states for ratification.² This concluded the deliberations of the framers, and the beginning of the deliberations of the voters in each state.

During the ratification process, three principal Framers wrote essays, published by Franklin, and others, answering objections and concerns. These were Alexander Hamilton, James Madison, and John Jay (our first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court).

The principal objection was raised by those who felt it dangerous to invest so much power in the “Federal” government without a “Bill of Rights” to restrain it. A secondary concern was that it did not afford sufficient power to the national government to provide adequate security of the peace, and regulation of

commerce. Eighty-five essays were written between Hamilton, Madison, and Jay, debating these objections, and assuring the public they could, with confidence, vote to ratify the Constitution: these essays came to be called “The Federalist Papers.”³ Nine of the thirteen states were required to approve the Constitution or it would not become law.

Ratification went smoothly at first: Delaware, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey ratified quickly, within three months, in December of 1787. Georgia and Connecticut ratified in January of 1788. But the voices expressing concern about restraints against any national government encroaching the natural rights of man, began to sway states away from ratification. Massachusetts ratified in February, 1788, but narrowly: 187-186. Madison felt the shift and the framers became concerned. Joseph Spencer,⁴ organizer of the Virginian Orange County Militia, and a veteran of the Revolution, former representative of Orange County, in the Virginia House of Delegates in 1780-81, and by some reputed to be the same Joseph Spencer who was imprisoned in Orange County, VA in 1773 for

preaching as a Baptist without a license,⁵ is believed to be the author of the famous letter on record, expressing concerns about the ratification failing on account of Baptist objections, stipulated in a list of 10 objections against the Constitution published by influential Baptist pastor John LeLand, and enclosed with his letter to Madison, encouraging him to meet the pastor, whom he represented was one of Madison's Baptist friends.

This meeting took place in March of 1788, at a critical pivot point in the effort to secure ratification. LeLand supported Madison to represent Orange County in the Virginia State Convention to debate ratification. News of Madison's promise to seek a Bill of Rights in amendments to the Constitution began to spread, and LeLand's endorsement of Madison is regarded as critical to his election, traditions developed close to the events that Madison promised LeLand he would see to it that the Constitution would be amended to address his concerns, particularly, his concerns about the protections of religious liberty. This news encouraged the populous Baptists to support ratification: Maryland ratified in April of 1788, S. Carolina came on board in May, and the ninth state to ratify was New Hampshire in June of 1788.

However, even with the requisite nine states threshold being met, if the populous and very influential States of Virginia and New York did not come through, ratification without them would jeopardize the integrity of any Union. Virginia had a fierce and very influential opponent to ratification in Patrick Henry, and, frankly, if

you read his objections (here⁶) you'll see that many of his concerns were justified. Nevertheless, Virginia, Madison's home state, ratified the Constitution in June of 1788 by a narrow margin of only eleven votes.⁷ New York, Hamilton's home state, followed in July and passed ratification by only three votes.⁸ And what is interesting, in the context of our own life experience with New York and Virginia, the reasons that shaped the core of resistance in both States was remarkably close: The proposed Constitution gave the new federal government too much power without sufficiently securing the retained rights of the people and the states.⁹

Thomas Jefferson is credited with the language in drafting the Declaration, but James Madison is the framer credited for the new nation's plan of government, while Gouvenor Morris is credited for its final written form. Madison is called the "Father of the Constitution," and Morris is chiefly known for the opening words: "We the People!" This single, elegant, and powerful phrase, replaced what was a cumbersome and in a great measure limiting enumeration of the states. Henry objected to this change: he envisioned a confederation of states, and was against a

consolidation of power that could become tyrannical over the people of any state. While we understand “We the People” as a fundamental assertion that government derives its just powers from the consent of the governed, Henry saw it as a loophole through which a tyrant might usurp power trampling down the will of the people in individual states. He wanted the “power of the people” decentralized, and held closer to the interests of their immediate respective homelands, and not, as was the customary characterization at that time, a power consolidated under a national government empowered to supersede the States.

We have 250 years to test the contest and it appears much has happened justifying Henry’s concerns, and at the same time, justifying the Union of the States under a federal supremacy in matters of war, and other international relations. We have had times to feel strongly that the Federal Constitution has been rightly used to protect individual, personal liberties from oppressive States, and then to have the Federal government abuse its power over the States and encroach upon the liberties of individuals in the states.

Patrick Henry more than once cautioned that while George Washington’s temper and character were superlative, and that no hint of tyranny would ever be expected from him, that we cannot assume every person, or persons, holding the massive power of the Federal government will be so endowed.

And there it is—ultimately it comes down to that. Character and temperament separate tyrants from servant statesmen. Some cannot see past the superficial overlay of the *Broncs* frankness, toughness, and fight, from the man who refuses to take a salary for his service, is noted as extraordinarily generous, fastidious in his observance of the Law, passionate for fair play, and honest dealing, whose selfless devotion to his beloved U.S.A. is transparent, and deep—so deep he kept going through all the attacks Hell could muster against him, and still does.

It's easy to see the hand of GOD active in the deliberations, and final wording of the frame of our One Nation Under God.
